## UNDERSTANDING TODAY'S PROPHETIC TIMES THROUGH A BIBLICALLY HISTORIC LENS

Leviticus 12:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, saying, 'If a woman conceives, and bears a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days; as in the days of her monthly period she shall be unclean. In the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.

**Leviticus 12:6** And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, **she shall bring a lamb of the first year** for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest:

Luke 2:22-24 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord; (As it is <u>written in the law</u> of the Lord, Every male that openeth the womb shall be called holy to the Lord;) And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

Leviticus 12:7b-8 This is the law for her that hath born a male or a female. And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

Leviticus 13:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, "When a man shall have a rising in his body's skin, or a scab, or a bright spot, and it becomes in the skin of his body the plague YXI of leprosy, NYTY then he shall be brought to Aaron the priest, or to one of his sons, the priests: and the priest shall examine the plague in the skin of the body: and if the hair in the plague has turned white, and the appearance of the plague is deeper than the body's skin, it is the plague of leprosy; and the priest shall examine him, and pronounce him unclean.

05061. Ill neh'-gah; a blow, plague, sore, stricken, stripe, stroke, wound.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he has borne our sickness, and carried our suffering; yet we considered him plagued, struck 以り by God, and afflicted.

John 19:1 So Pilate then took Yeshua, and flogged him.

John 19:3 And said, Hail, King of the Jews! and they smote him with their hands.

Luke 22:63,64 The men who held Yeshua mocked him and beat him. Having blindfolded him, they struck him on the face and asked him, "Prophesy! Who is the one who struck you?"

**Matthew 27:30** And they spit upon him, and <u>took the reed</u>, <u>and smote him</u> on the head. As a leper was despised and rejected of men, so also was the Messiah despised and rejected.

Leviticus 14:1-7 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his <u>cleansing</u>. He shall be brought to the priest, and <u>the priest shall go forth</u> <u>out of the camp</u>. The priest shall examine him, and behold, if the plague of leprosy <u>is healed</u> in the leper, then the priest shall command them to take for him who is <u>to be cleansed</u> <u>two living clean birds</u>, and <u>cedar wood</u>, and <u>scarlet</u>, and <u>hyssop</u>.

Mark 1:40-45 A leper came to him, begging him, kneeling down to him, and saying to him, "If you want to, you can make me <u>clean</u>." Being moved with compassion, he stretched out his hand, and <u>touched him</u>, and said to him, "I want to. Be made clean." When he had said this, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was made clean. He strictly warned him, and immediately sent him out, and said to him, "See you say nothing to anybody, but <u>go show yourself to the priest</u>, and offer <u>for your cleansing</u> the things which Moses commanded, <u>for a testimony to them.</u>" But he went out, and began to proclaim it much, and to spread about the matter, so that Yeshua could no more openly enter into a city, but was outside in desert places: and they came to him from everywhere.

2 Kings 5:1 Now Naaman, captain of the army of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honorable, because by him the LORD had given victory to Syria: he was also a mighty man of valor, but he was a leper.

Luke 4:27-29 There were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet, yet not one of them was cleansed, except Naaman, the Syrian." They were all filled with wrath in the synagogue, as they heard these things. They rose up, threw him out of the city, and led him to the brow of the hill that their city was built on, that they might throw him off the cliff.

Ezra began the work of rebuilding the Temple in Iyar

Genesis 1:14 And God said: 'Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days and years;

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

**Revelation 22:1,2** He showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb, in the middle of its street. On this side of the river and on that was the tree of life, bearing <u>twelve kinds of fruits</u>, <u>yielding its fruit every month</u>.

**Ezekiel 46:1** Thus saith the Lord GOD: The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the sabbath day it shall be opened, and in the day of the new moon it shall be opened.

Isaiah 66:22,23 "For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me," says the LORD, "so your seed and your name shall remain. It shall happen, that from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me," says the LORD.

**Psalm 104:19-21** He made the moon to mark the seasons the sun knoweth his going down. You make darkness, and it is night: wherein all the beasts of the forest do creep forth. The **young lions roar** after their prey, and seek their meat from God.

Genesis 49:9-15 Judah is a lion's cub. From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He stooped down, he crouched as a lion, as a lioness. Who will rouse him up? The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs. To him will the obedience of the peoples be. Binding his foal to the vine, his donkey's colt to the choice vine; he has washed his garments in wine, his robes in the blood of grapes. His eyes will be red with wine, his teeth white with milk. "Zebulun will dwell at the haven of the sea. He will be for a haven of ships. His border will be on Sidon. "Issachar is a strong donkey, lying down between the saddlebags. He saw a resting place, that it was good, the land, that it was pleasant. He bows his shoulder to the burden, and becomes a servant doing forced labor.

**Exodus 15:24-26** The people murmured against Moses, saying, "What shall we drink?" Then he cried to the LORD. The LORD showed him a tree, and he threw it into the waters, and the waters were made sweet. There he made a statute and an ordinance for them, and there he tested them; and he said, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and will do that which is right in his eyes, and will pay attention to his commandments, and

keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you, which I have put on the Egyptians; for  $\underline{I}$  am the LORD who heals you."
