

MARK BILTZ 2023 – SEATTLE: PAYMENT SCHEDULE OCTOBER 16-29, 2023 - \$4,995 PER PERSON WITH 2 SHARING A ROOM

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A non-refundable deposit of \$200 is required from each traveler along with their reservation form to guarantee the booking as soon as possible. The remaining balance is due in 3 payments.

- The first payment of \$1,900 is due on May 16, 2023.
- The second payment of \$1,900 is due on July 16, 2023.
- The final payment of \$995 is due on September 16, 2023.
- A supplement of \$1,280 for single occupancy must be paid in full with the final payment.

For those traveling on the land package only, air travel not included, the total is \$3,585 including the \$200 non-refundable deposit. The first payment of \$1,900 is due on May 16, 2023. The second payment of \$1,485 is due on July 16, 2023.

If using a credit card, a convenience fee (from 3.6% to 4%) will be added to the total.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations must be made in writing to Yosher Tours. See Terms and Conditions for cancellation fees and policies.

HEALTH INSURANCE: Health insurance with coverage for the treatment of COVID-19 virus is required for all travelers to Israel. Travel insurance is also highly recommended and available at AIG: Travel Guard.

PASSPORTS: You must provide Yosher Tours a copy of your passport by May 16, 2023. Israel requires that your passport have an expiration date not less than 6 months after your date of departure from Israel (expires after April 29, 2024).

LUGGAGE (PER PERSON) LIMITATIONS:

- Checked: weight = 50 pounds max
 Maximum Size: total of length + width + depth = 62"
- Carry-ons: you are allowed to bring one piece that will fit in an overhead compartment (up to 14"w x 22"h x 9" deep) plus a smaller piece that will fit under your seat (up to 10"w x 17"h x 9" deep).
- All carry-on luggage items such as liquids, gels and aerosols must be in 3.4 ounce (100ml) or smaller containers. Larger containers that are half-full or toothpaste tubes rolled up are not allowed. There is not a limit on the types of liquids, gels and aerosols in your checked baggage.
