TORAH PORTION

Exodus 1:1 And these are *the names* of the sons of Israel who are coming into Egypt with Jacob, a man and his household have they come.

Exodus 1:8,9 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, **which knew not Joseph**. And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we.

Exodus 1:10,11 Come on, let us deal wisely with them, lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falls out any war, they join also to our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land. Therefore they did set over them *taskmasters* to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for **Pharaoh** treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

Exodus 1:15,16 And the king of Egypt spoke to the **Hebrew** midwives, of which the name of the one was Shiphrah, and the name of the other **Puah**: And he said, When you do the office of a midwife to the **Hebrew women**, and see them on the stools, if it be a son, then you shall kill him: But if it be a daughter, then she shall live.

Exodus 1:17 But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive.

Exodus 1:22 And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born you shall cast into the river, and every daughter you shall save alive.

Exodus 2:1,2 And there went a man of the house of Levi, **and took to wife a daughter of Levi**. **And the woman conceived, and bore a son: And when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.**

Exodus 6:1 And the LORD said unto Moses: Now shall you see what I will do to Pharaoh, for by a strong hand shall he let them go, and by a strong hand shall he drive them out of his land.

Exodus 6:20 And Amram took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife, and she bore him Aaron and Moses. And the years of the life of Amram were a hundred and thirty and seven years.

Exodus 2:5-10 And **the daughter of Pharaoh** came down to **wash herself at the river**, and her maidens walked along by the river's side, and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it. And when she had opened it, she saw the child: And, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children. Then said his sister to **Pharaoh's daughter**, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee? And **Pharaoh's daughter** said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother. And **Pharaoh's daughter** said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it. And the child grew,

and she brought him unto **Pharaoh's daughter**, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: And she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

1 Chronicles 4:15a And the sons of Caleb the son of Jephunneh.

1 Chronicles 4:18b And these are **the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh**, which Mered took.

Exodus 2:11-15 And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brothers, and looked on their burdens: And he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brothers. And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand. And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: And he said to him that did the wrong, Why smite you your fellow? And he said, **Who made you a prince and a judge over us?** Intend you to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known. Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelled in the land of Midian: And **he sat down by a well**.

Numbers 16:12,13 And Moses sent to call Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and they said: We will not come up, is it a small thing that thou hast brought us up out of a land flowing with milk and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, but thou must needs **make thyself also a prince over us?**

Exodus 2:16-19 Now the priest of Midian had **seven daughters**: And they came and drew water, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. And the shepherds came and drove them away: But Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock. And when they came to **Reuel** their father, he said, How is it that you are come so soon to day? And they said, **An Egyptian** delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds, and also drew water enough for us, and watered the flock.

Exodus 2:23 And it came to pass in process of time, that the **king of Egypt died**: And the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage.

Exodus 3:1,2 Now Moses **kept the flock** of **Jethro** his father in law, the priest of Midian: And he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. And the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the middle of a bush: And he looked, and, behold, **the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed**.

Psalms 80:1 Give ear, **O Shepherd of Israel**, you who lead Joseph like a flock. You who are enthroned upon the cherubim, shine forth.

Exodus 3:3-6 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him

out of the middle of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, **Here am I**. And he said, Draw not near here: Put off your shoes from off your feet, for the place where on you stand is holy ground. Moreover he said, I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look on God.

Exodus 3:7 And the **LORD** said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows.

Deuteronomy 4:24 For the LORD your God is a consuming fire.

Psalm 68:4 Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: Extol him that rides upon the heavens by his name: **Yah**.

Exodus 3:8 And **I am come down** to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land to a good land and a large, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

Exodus 3:10 Come now therefore, and **I will send you** to Pharaoh, that you may bring forth my people the children of Israel **out of Egypt**.

Exodus 32:7 And the LORD said to Moses, Go, get you down, for **your people, which you brought out of the land of Egypt**, have corrupted themselves.

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people, which you have brought forth out of the land of Egypt** with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 3:11,12 And Moses said to God Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt? And he said, Certainly **I will be with you**, and this shall be a token to you, that I have sent you: When you have brought forth the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.

Exodus 3:13 And Moses said to God, Behold, when I come to the children of Israel, and shall say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they shall say to me, **What is his name?** What shall I say to them?

Exodus 3:14 And God said to Moses **I AM THAT I AM**: And he said, Thus shall you say to the children of Israel, **I AM** has sent me to you.

Isaiah 48:12 Hearken unto **Me**, O Jacob, and Israel My called: **I am He**, *I am the first, I also am the last*. Yea, **My hand** hath laid the foundation of the earth, and **My right hand** hath spread out the heavens, when I call out to them, they stand up together.

John 18:4-6 Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were happening to him, went forth, and said to them, Who are you looking for? They answered him, Yeshua of Nazareth. Yeshua said to them, I am he. Judah also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, **I am He**, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Exodus 3:18 And they will give ear to your voice: And you, **with the chiefs of Israel, will go to Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, and say to him, The Lord, the God of the Hebrews, has come to us: (Please) let us then go three days' journey into the waste land to make an offering to the Lord our God.**

Exodus 5:1 And after that, **Moses and Aaron came to Pharaoh**, and said, The Lord, the God of Israel, says, **Let my people go so that they may keep a feast to me in the waste land.**

Exodus 5:2 And Pharaoh said: **Who is the LORD**, why should **I obey His voice to let Israel go?** I know not the LORD, and moreover I will not let Israel go.

Exodus 5:3 And they said: **The God of the Hebrews hath met with us. Let us go, we pray thee, three days journey into the wilderness, and sacrifice unto the LORD our God, lest He fall upon us with pestilence, or with the sword.**

Exodus 4:21 And the LORD said to Moses, When you go to return into Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in your hand: But **I will harden** his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Exodus 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he **hardened** his heart, and listened not to them, as the LORD had said.

Numbers 21:9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

John 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up.
