

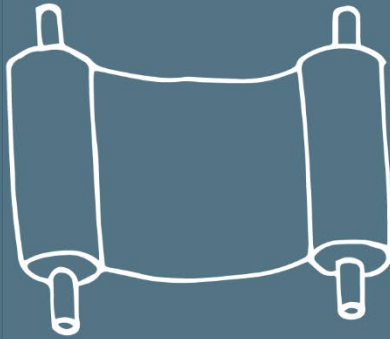

## TORAH PORTION

**Genesis 28:1-5** And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, You shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.

**Genesis 28:10,11** And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran. And he **lighted** (came to) on **a certain place**, and tarried there all night, because the **sun was set**; and he took of the stones of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in **that place** to sleep.

**Genesis 28:12,13** And he dreamed, and beheld a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven; and behold *the angels of God ascending and descending on it*. And, behold, **the LORD stood above it(HIM)**, and said, **I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac**: the land where on thou lie, to you will I give it, and to your seed;

**Genesis 28:15** And, behold, I am with you, and will keep you in all places where you go, and will bring you again into this land; for I will not leave you, until I have done that which I have spoken to you of.

**Genesis 28:17-19a** And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is **this place!** This is none other but the **house of God**, and this is **the gate of heaven**. And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took **the stone** that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it. And he called the name of **that place Bethel**:

**John 1:47-49** Yeshua saw Nathanael coming toward Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom is no deceit!" Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Yeshua answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you." Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!"

**John 1:51** And he said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, Hereafter you shall see heaven open, and **the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of man**.

**John 3:13** And no man has ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.

**Proverbs 30:4-6** Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who hath gathered the wind in his fists? Who hath bound the waters in a garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell? Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. **Add thou not unto his words**, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.

**Isaiah 48:12** Hearken unto **Me**, O Jacob, and Israel **My called**: **I am He**; **I am the first, I also am the last**. Yea, **My hand** hath laid the



foundation of the earth, and **My right hand** hath spread out the heavens; when I call out to them, they stand up together.

**Isaiah 48:16** "Come near to **Me**, hear this: I have not spoken in secret *from the beginning*, From the time that it was, **I** was there. **And now the Lord God and His Spirit** have sent **Me**."

**John 18:4-6** Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were coming upon him, went forth, and said to them, Whom are you seeking? They answered him, Yeshua of Nazareth. Yeshua said unto them, **I am He**. And Judas also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, **I am He**, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

**Psalms 2:5-9** Then will He speak unto them in His wrath, and affright them in His sore displeasure: 'Truly it is I that have established My king upon Zion, My holy mountain.' I will tell of the decree: the LORD said unto me: '**Thou art My son**, this day have I begotten thee. Ask of Me, and I will give the nations for thine inheritance, and the ends of the earth for thy possession. Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.'

**Revelation 2:26,27** And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

**Genesis 28:20-22** And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on, So that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall the LORD be my God: And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be God's house: and of all that you shall give me I will surely give the tenth to you.

**Genesis 29:2,3** And he looked, and behold a well in the field, and, see, there were three flocks of sheep lying by it; for out of that well they watered the flocks: and a great stone was on the well's mouth. And thither were all the flocks gathered: and they rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the sheep, and put the stone again on the well's mouth in his place.

**Genesis 29:7-9** And he said, See, it is yet high day, neither is it time that the cattle should be gathered together: water you the sheep, and go and feed them. And they said, We cannot, until all the flocks be gathered together, and till they roll the stone from the well's mouth; then we water the sheep. And while he yet spoke with them, Rachel came with her father's sheep; for she kept them.

**Genesis 29:10** And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother.



**Mark 16:1-4** And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. And very early in the morning the first day of the week, they came to the sepulcher at the rising of the sun. And they said among themselves, Who shall roll us away the stone from the door of the sepulcher? And when they looked, they saw that the stone was rolled away: for it was very great.

**Genesis 29:12,13a** And Jacob told Rachel that he was her father's brother, and that he was Rebekah's son: and she ran and told her father. And it came to pass, when Laban heard the tidings of Jacob his sister's son, that he ran to meet him, and embraced him, and kissed him, and brought him to his house.

**Genesis 29:18-20** And Jacob loved Rachel; and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter. And Laban said, It is better that I give her to thee, than that I should give her to another man: abide with me. And Jacob served seven years for Rachel; and they seemed unto him but a few days, for the love he had to her.

**Genesis 29:24-26** And Laban gave to his daughter Leah Zilpah his maid for an handmaid. And it came to pass, that in the morning, behold, it was Leah: and he said to Laban, What is this you have done to me? did not I serve with you for Rachel? why then have you beguiled me? And Laban said, It must not be so done in our country, to give the younger before the firstborn.

**Genesis 29:32** And Leah conceived, and bore a son, and she called his name Reuben: for she said, Surely the LORD has looked on my affliction; now therefore my husband will love me.

**Genesis 30:1,2** And when Rachel saw that she bore Jacob no children, Rachel envied her sister; and said to Jacob, Give me children, or else I die. And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, Am I in God's stead, who has withheld from you the fruit of the womb?

**Genesis 30:22** And God remembered Rachel, and God listened to her, and opened her womb.

**Genesis 30:23,24** And she conceived, and bare a son; and said, God hath taken away my reproach: And she called his name Joseph; and said, The Lord shall **add** to me another son.

**Genesis 31:3** And the Lord said unto Jacob, Return unto the land of thy fathers, and to thy kindred; and I will be with thee.

**Hosea 13:14** I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

**Hosea 14:5** I will be like the dew to Israel; he shall blossom like the lily; he shall take root like the trees of Lebanon;

**Hosea 14:9** Who is wise, and he shall understand these things?



prudent, and he shall know them? for the ways of the Lord are right, and the just shall walk in them: but the transgressors shall fall therein.

## THE VISION/REVELATION OF YESHUA

**Revelation 1:1** The Revelation of Yeshua the Messiah, which God gave unto Him, to show unto His servants' things which must shortly come to pass; and He sent and signified it by His angel unto His servant Yochanan:

**Daniel 2:28,29** But there is a God in heaven that **reveals secrets**, and makes known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Your dream, and **the visions** of your head upon your bed, are these; As for you, O king, your thoughts came into your mind upon your bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and he that **reveals secrets makes known to you what shall come to pass**.

**Deuteronomy 29:29** The **secret things** belong unto the Lord our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do **all the words of this law**.

**Amos 3:7** Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.

**Revelation 1:2,3** Who bare record of the **Word of God**, and of the testimony of Yeshua the Messiah, and of **all things that he saw**. Blessed is he **that readeth, and they that hear the words** of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

**Revelation 1:4** Yochanan to the **seven assemblies** which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from Him **which is, and which was, and which is to come**; and from the **Seven Spirits** which are before His throne;

**Isaiah 11:1,2** And there shall come **forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch** shall grow out of his roots: And the **Spirit of the Lord** shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of **wisdom and understanding**, the Spirit of **counsel and might**, the Spirit of **knowledge** and of the **fear of the Lord**;

**Revelation 1:5** And from Yeshua the Messiah, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and **the Prince of the kings of the earth**. Unto him that loved us, and **washed us from our sins in his own blood**,

**Daniel 9:25** Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the **Messiah the Prince** shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

**Psalms 89:27-29** Also I will make him my firstborn, **higher than the**



**kings of the earth.** My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to endure forever, and his throne as the days of heaven.

**Revelation 1:6** And has made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

**Exodus 19:3-6** The Lord called to him out of the mountain, saying, "Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the people of Israel: You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and **how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.** Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; and you shall be to me **a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.**' These are the words that you shall speak to the people of Israel."

**Zechariah 6:12,13** And say to him, 'Thus says the Lord of hosts, "Behold, the man whose name is the Branch: for he shall branch out from his place, and he shall build the temple of the Lord. It is he who shall build the temple of the Lord and shall bear royal honor, and shall sit and rule on his throne. **And there shall be a priest on his throne,** and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.'"

**Revelation 1:7** Behold, **he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him,** and they also **which pierced** him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

**Daniel 7:13,14** I saw in the night **visions,** and, behold, one like the **Son of man** came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

**Zechariah 12:10** And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me **whom they have pierced,** and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

**Revelation 1:8** I am Aleph and Tav, the beginning and the ending, says the Lord, **which is, and which was, and which is to come,** the Almighty.

**Isaiah 41:4** Who hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the Lord, the first, and with the last; **I am he.**

**Isaiah 44:6** Thus says the Lord the King of Israel, and his redeemer the Lord of hosts; **I am the first, and I am the last;** and beside me there is no God.

**Isaiah 48:12,13** Harken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; **I am**



he; I am the first, I also am the last. Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens: when I call unto them, they stand up together.

**Revelation 1:9** I, Yochanan, your brother and partner in the tribulation and the kingdom and the patient endurance that are in Yeshua, was on the island called Patmos on account of the **Word of God** and the testimony of Yeshua.

**Revelation 1:10,11** I was in the Spirit **on the Lord's day**, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a shofar saying, "Write what you see in a book and send it to the seven assemblies, to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea."

**Isaiah 13:9** Behold, **the day of the Lord** cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it.

**Jeremiah 46:10** For this is **the day of the Lord God of hosts**, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries:

**Zephaniah 1:14-16** **The great day** of Jehovah is near, it is near and hasteth greatly, even the voice of the day of Jehovah; the mighty man crieth there bitterly. That day is a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness, a day of the trumpet and alarm, against the fortified cities, and against the high battlements.

**Exodus 25:9** According to all that I shew thee, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it.

**Exodus 37:17** And he made the candlestick of pure gold: of beaten work made he the candlestick; his shaft, and his branch, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, were of the same:

**Exodus 37:23a** And he made its **seven lamps** and its tongs and its trays of pure gold.

**Revelation 1:12-15** And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw **seven golden candlesticks**; And **in the midst** of the **seven candlesticks** one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and **his eyes were as a flame of fire**; And his **feet like unto fine brass**, as if they burned in a furnace; and his **voice as the sound of many waters**.

**Ezekiel 43:1,2** Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east: And, behold, **the glory of the God of Israel** came from the way of the east: and **his voice was like a noise of many waters**: and the **earth shined with his glory**.



**John 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

**John 1:14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

**Zechariah 4:2** And said unto me, What do you see? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof:

**Zechariah 4:6** Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by **My Spirit**, says the Lord of hosts.

**Zechariah 4:10** For who hath despised the day of small things? For they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are **the eyes of the Lord**, which run to and fro through the whole earth.

**Revelation 4:5** And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

**Isaiah 11:1,2** And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: And the spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord;

**Revelation 5:6,7** And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

**Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

**Revelation 1:16,17** And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a **sharp twoedged sword**: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength. And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; **I am the first and the last**:

**Revelation 19:20,21** And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that



worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which **sword proceeded out of his mouth**: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

**Daniel 8:16-19** And I heard a man's voice between the banks of Ulai, which called, and said, Gabriel, make this man to understand the vision. So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, Understand, O son of man: for at the time of the end shall be the vision. Now as he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep on my face toward the ground: but he touched me, and set me upright. And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the time appointed the end shall be.

**Daniel 10:5** I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz; his body also was like the beryl, and his face as the appearance of lightning, and his eyes as torches of fire, and his arms and his feet like in colour to burnished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude.

**Daniel 10:10,11** And, behold, a hand touched me, which set me tottering upon my knees and upon the palms of my hands. And he said unto me: 'O Daniel, thou man greatly beloved, give heed unto the words that I speak unto thee, and stand upright; for now am I sent unto thee'; and when he had spoken this word unto me, I stood trembling.

**Revelation 1:18-20** I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death. Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter; The mystery of the **seven stars** which thou saw in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven assemblies: and the seven candlesticks which thou saw are the **seven assemblies**.

**Hosea 13:14** I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

**Revelation 13:8** And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of **the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world**.

**Isaiah 46:10** Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:
