

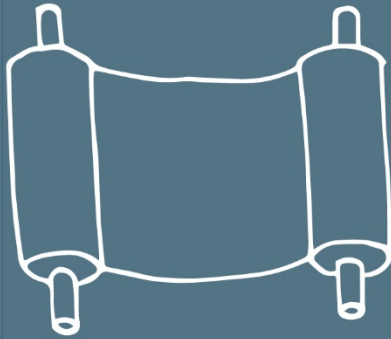

## TORAH PORTION

**Genesis 41:1-3** And it came to pass **at the end** of two full years, that Pharaoh dreamed: and, behold, he stood by the river. And, behold, there came up out of the river seven well-favored cows and fat; and they fed in a meadow. And, behold, seven other cows came up after them out of the river, ill favored and skinny; and stood by the other cows on the brink of the river.

**Exodus 23:14-16** Three times you shall keep a feast to me in the year. You shall keep the feast of unleavened bread: you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, in the time appointed of the month Abib; (*Spring*) for in it you came out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty: And the feast of harvest, (*Summer*) the first fruits of your labors, which you have sown in the field: and the feast of ingathering, (*Fall*) which is in **the end of the year**, when you have gathered in your labors out of the field.

**Genesis 41:9** Then spoke the chief butler to Pharaoh, saying, I do remember my faults this day:

**Leviticus 23:24** Speak to the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall you have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

**Genesis 41:40,41** You shall be over my house, and according to your word shall all my people be ruled: only in the throne will I be greater than you. And Pharaoh said to Joseph, See, I have set you over all the land of Egypt.

**Genesis 41:14a** Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him **hastily** out of the dungeon:

**Isaiah 56:1** Thus said the LORD, Keep you judgment, and do justice: for **my salvation (Yeshua) is near to come**, and my righteousness to be revealed.

**Revelation 3:11** Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which you have, that no man take your crown.

**Malachi 3:1** Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall **suddenly come to his temple**, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

**1 Corinthians 15:52** In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

**Daniel 12:1,2** And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every



one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

**Genesis 41:38,39** And Pharaoh said to his servants, "Can we find such a one as this, a man in whom the Spirit of God is?" And Pharaoh said to Joseph, "For as much as God has showed you all this, there is none so discreet and wise as you are.

**Genesis 41:45a** And Pharaoh called Joseph's name **Zaphnathpaaneah**;

**Genesis 41:49,50** And Joseph gathered grain as the sand of the sea, very much, until he left numbering; for it was without number. And to Joseph were born two sons **before the years of famine** came, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bore unto him.

**Genesis 41:51-53** And Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: For God, said he, has made me **forget** all my toil, and all my father's house. And the name of the second called he Ephraim: For God has caused me to be **fruitful** in **the land of my affliction**. And the seven years of plenty, that was in the land of Egypt, were ended.

**Genesis 42:3-5** Joseph's ten brothers went down to buy grain from Egypt. But Jacob didn't send Benjamin, Joseph's brother, with his brothers; for he said, "Lest perhaps harm happen to him." The sons of Israel came to buy among those who came, for the famine was in the land of Canaan.

**Genesis 42:14-18** And Joseph said to them, That is it that I spoke to you, saying, You are spies: Hereby you shall be proved: By the life of Pharaoh you shall not go forth hence, except your youngest brother come here. Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and you shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether there be any truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely you are spies. And he put them all together into ward three days. And Joseph said to them the third day, This do, and live; for I fear God:

**Genesis 42:19-24** If you be true men, let one of your brothers be bound in the house of your prison: go you, carry corn for the famine of your houses: But bring your youngest brother to me; so shall your words be verified, and you shall not die. And they did so. And they said one to another, We are truly guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he sought us, and **we would not hear**; therefore is this distress come on us. And Reuben answered them, saying, Spoke I not to you, saying, Do not sin against the child; **and you would not hear**? therefore, behold, also his blood is required. And they knew not that Joseph understood them; for he spoke to them by an interpreter. And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with



them, and **took from them Simeon**, and bound him before their eyes.

**Romans 11:8** (According as it is written, God has given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) to this day.

**Genesis 42:27,28** And as one of them opened his sack to give his ass provender in the inn, he espied his money; for, behold, it was in his sack's mouth. And he said to his brothers, My money is restored; and, see, it is even in my sack: and their heart failed them, and they were **afraid**, saying one to another, What is this that God has done to us?

**Genesis 42:37,38** And Reuben spoke to his father, saying, Slay my two sons, if I bring him not to you: deliver him into my hand, and I will bring him to you again. And he said, My son shall not go down with you;

**Genesis 43:8,9** And Judah said to Israel his father, Send the lad with me, and we will arise and go; that we may live, and not die, both we, and you, and also our little ones. I will be surety for him; of my hand shall you require him: if I bring him not to you, and set him before you, then let me bear the blame for ever:

**Genesis 44:1,2** And he commanded the steward of his house, saying, Fill the men's sacks with food, as much as they can carry, and put every man's money in his sack's mouth. And put my cup, the silver cup, in the sack's mouth of the youngest, and his corn money. And he did according to the word that Joseph had spoken.

**Genesis 44:8-10** Behold, the money, which we found in our sacks' mouths, we brought again to you out of the land of Canaan: how then should we steal out of your lord's house silver or gold? With whomsoever of your servants it be found, both **let him die**, and we also will be my lord's slaves. And he said, Now also let it be according to your words: he with whom it is found shall be my servant; and you shall be blameless.

**Genesis 31:19** And Laban went to shear his sheep. And Rachel had stolen the images which were her father's.

**Genesis 31:30-32** And now, though you would needs be gone, because you sore longed after your father's house, yet why have you stolen my gods? And Jacob answered and said to Laban, **Because I was afraid**: for I said, Peradventure you would take by force your daughters from me. With whomsoever you find your gods, **let him not live**: before our brothers discern you what is your with me, and take it to you. For Jacob knew not that Rachel had stolen them.

**Genesis 44:12,13a** And he searched, and began at the oldest, and left at the youngest: and the cup was found in Benjamin's sack. Then they rent their clothes,



**2 Samuel 22:29** For You are my lamp, O Lord, and my God lightens my darkness.

**Revelation 1:12-14** Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden **lampstands**, and **in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man**, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest. The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow. **His eyes were like a flame of fire**, his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters.

**John 1:4-9** **In him was life, and the life was the light of men.** The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him. He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light. **The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.**

**John 8:12** Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

**Revelation 3:7** And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things says He that is holy, He that is true, He that **has the key of David**, He **that opens, and no man shuts**; and shuts, and no man opens;

**Isaiah 22:22,23** And the **key of the house of David** will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open. And I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place; and he shall be for a glorious throne to his father's house.

**Revelation 3:8** I know your works: behold, I have **set before you an open door, and no man can shut it**: for you have a little strength, and have kept my word, and have not denied my name.

**Revelation 3:9** Behold, I will make them of the assembly of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and **worship before thy feet**, and to know **that I have loved you**.

**Isaiah 49:22,23** Thus saith the Lord God, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard to the people: and they shall bring thy sons in their arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders. And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the Lord: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.



**Micah 7:16-20** The nations shall see and be confounded at all their might: they shall lay their hand upon their mouth, their ears shall be deaf. They shall lick the dust like a serpent, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they shall be afraid of the Lord our God, and shall fear because of thee. Who is a God like unto you, that pardons iniquity, and passes by the transgression of the remnant of **His heritage**? He retains not his anger forever, because he delights in mercy. He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

**Isaiah 60:14,25** The sons of those who afflicted you shall come bending low to you, and all who despised you shall bow down at your feet; they shall call you the City of the Lord, the Zion of the Holy One of Israel. Whereas you have been forsaken and hated, with no one passing through, I will make you majestic forever, a joy from age to age.

**Joel 3:2** I will gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat; and I will enter into judgment with them there for My people and for **My heritage Israel**, whom they have scattered among the nations, and divided My land.

**Revelation 3:10,11** Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee **from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world**, to try them that dwell upon the earth. Behold, **I come quickly**: hold that fast which thou hast, **that no man take your crown**.

**Lamentations 5:16** The crown is fallen from our head; woe unto us! for we have sinned.

**Isaiah 24:17-23** Terror, and the pit, and the trap, are upon thee, O inhabitant of the earth. And it shall come to pass, that he who fleeth from the noise of the terror shall fall into the pit; and he that cometh up out of the midst of the pit shall be taken in the trap; for the windows on high are opened, and the foundations of the earth do shake; The earth is broken, broken down, the earth is crumbled in pieces, the earth trembleth and tottereth; The earth reeleth to and fro like a drunken man, and swayeth to and fro as a lodge; and the transgression thereof is heavy upon it, and it shall fall, and not rise again. And it shall come to pass in that day, that the LORD will punish the host of the high heaven on high, and the kings of the earth upon the earth. And they shall be gathered together, as prisoners are gathered in the dungeon, and shall be shut up in the prison, and after many days shall they be punished. Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed; for the LORD of hosts will reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before His elders shall be Glory.



**Revelation 3:12,13** He that overcomes **will I make a pillar in the temple of my God**, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him **the name** of my God, and **the name** of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him **my new name**. He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the assemblies.

**1 Kings 7:21,22** He set up the pillars at the vestibule of the temple. He set up the pillar on the south and called its name Jachin, and he set up the pillar on the north and called its name Boaz. And on the tops of the pillars was lily-work. Thus the work of the pillars was finished.

**Psalms 87:5,6** And of Zion it shall be said, "This one and that one were born in her"; for the Most High himself will establish her. The Lord records as he registers the peoples, "This one was born there."

**Isaiah 62:2,3** The nations shall see your righteousness, and all the kings your glory, and you shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the Lord will give. **You shall be a crown** of beauty in the hand of the Lord, and **a royal diadem** in the hand of your God.

**Malachi 3:16,17** Then they that feared the Lord spake often one to another: and the Lord hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the Lord, and that thought upon his name. And they shall be mine, saith the Lord of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

**Revelation 3:14** And unto the angel of the **assembly of the Laodiceans** write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

**Jeremiah 42:5** Then they said to Jeremiah, **The Lord be a true and faithful witness** between us, if we do not even according to all things for the which the Lord thy God shall send thee to us.

**Revelation 3:15,16** I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot: I would you were cold or hot. So then because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of my mouth.

**Revelation 3:17** Because you say, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and know not that you are wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

**Hosea 12:8** And Ephraim said, Yet I am become rich, I have found me out substance: in all my labours they shall find none iniquity in me that were sin.

**Ecclesiastes 2:7,8a** I got me servants and maidens, and had servants born in my house; also I had great possessions of great



and small cattle above all that were in Jerusalem before me: I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces:

**Revelation 3:18** I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

**1 Corinthians 3:12,13** Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

**Job 23:10** But he knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.

**Revelation 3:19,20 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten:** be zealous therefore, and repent. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

**Job 5:17,18** Behold, happy is the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty: For he maketh sore, and bindeth up: he woundeth, and his hands make whole.

**Proverbs 3:11,12** My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord; neither be weary of his correction: For whom the Lord loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

**Song of Songs 5:2,3** I sleep, but my heart waketh: it is the voice of my beloved that knocketh, saying, Open to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, and my locks with the drops of the night. I have put off my coat; how shall I put it on? I have washed my feet; how shall I defile them?

**Revelation 3:21,22** To him that overcomes will I grant **to sit with me in my throne**, even as I also overcame, and am **set down with my Father in his throne**. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

**Isaiah 66:1,2** Thus saith the Lord, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? and where is the place of my rest? For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the Lord: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembles at my word.

**Jeremiah 3:17,18** At that time they **shall call Jerusalem The Throne** of the LORD; and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem; neither shall they walk any more



after the stubbornness of their evil heart. In those days the house of Judah shall walk with the house of Israel, and they shall come together out of the land of the north to the land that I have given for an inheritance unto your fathers.'

**Revelation 4:1** After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

**Revelation 4:2,3** And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a **throne** was set in heaven, and one sat on **the throne**. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

**Revelation 4:4** And round about **the throne** were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

**Revelation 4:5** And out of **the throne** proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before **the throne**, which are the seven Spirits of God.

**Revelation 4:6** And before **the throne** there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of **the throne**, and round about **the throne**, were four beasts full of eyes before and behind.

**Revelation 4:7,8** And the first beast was like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle. And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

**Revelation 4:9-11** And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks to him that sat on **the throne**, who lives forever and ever, The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on **the throne**, and worship him that lives for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before **the throne**, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.
