

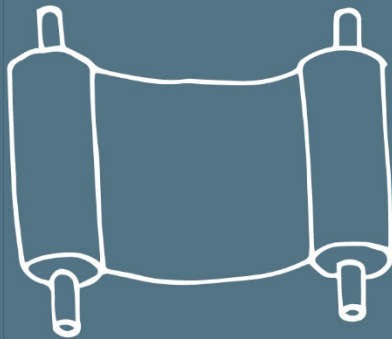

TORAH PORTION

Genesis 44:16 And Judah said, What shall we say to my lord? what shall we speak? or how shall we clear ourselves? God has found out the iniquity of your servants: behold, we are my lord's servants, both we, and he also with whom the cup is found.

Genesis 44:17 And he said, God forbid that I should do so: but the man in whose hand the cup is found, he shall be my servant; and as for you, get you up in peace unto your father.

Genesis 44:18 Then Judah **came near** to him, and said, Oh my lord, let your servant, I pray you, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not your anger burn against your servant: for you are even as Pharaoh.

Genesis 44:19-23 My lord asked his servants, saying, 'Have you a father, or a brother?' We said to my lord, 'We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, **a little one**; and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother; and his father loves him.' You said to your servants, 'Bring him down to me, that I may set my eyes on him.' We said to my lord, '**The boy** can't leave his father: for if he should leave his father, his father would die.' You said to your servants, 'Unless your youngest brother comes down with you, you will see my face no more.'

Genesis 46:21 And the sons of Benjamin were Belah, and Becher, and Ashbel, Gera, and Naaman, Ehi, and Rosh, Muppim, and Huppim, and Ard.

Genesis 44:32,33 For your servant became surety for the lad to my father, saying, If I bring him not to you, then I shall bear the blame to my father for ever. Now therefore, I pray you, let your servant abide instead of **the lad a slave** to my lord; and let **the lad** go up with his brothers.

Genesis 37:23 And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stript Joseph out of his coat, his coat of many colors that was on him.

1 Samuel 18:1,2 And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that **the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David**, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul. And Saul took him that day, and would let him go no more home to his father's house.

1 Samuel 18:3,4 Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul. And Jonathan stripped himself of the robe that was upon him, and gave it to David, and his garments, even to his sword, and to his bow, and to his girdle.

Romans 9:3,4 For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Messiah for my brothers' sake, my relatives according to the flesh, who are Israelites; whose is the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service, and the promises;



Genesis 45:1,2 Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known to his brothers. And he wept aloud: and the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard.

Leviticus 16:16,17 And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness. And there shall **be no man in the tabernacle** of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an **atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.**

Revelation 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the **seven plagues** of the **seven angels** were fulfilled.

Genesis 45:3 And Joseph said to his brothers, **I am Joseph**; does my father yet live? And his brothers could not answer him; for they were troubled at his presence.

Genesis 45:4,5 And Joseph said to his brothers, **Come near to me**, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, **I am Joseph** *your brother*, whom you sold into Egypt. Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that you sold me here: for God did send me before you to preserve life.

James 4:8-11 Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Speak not evil one of another, brothers. He that speaks evil of his brother, and judges his brother, speaks evil of the law, and judges the law: but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law, but a judge.

Genesis 45:9 Hurry, and go up to my father, and tell him, 'This is what your son Joseph says, "God has made me lord of all Egypt. Come down to me. Don't wait.

Genesis 45:13 You shall tell my father of all my glory in Egypt, and of all that you have seen. You shall hurry and bring my father down here."

Genesis 45:22a To all of them he gave each man changes of raiment;

Revelation 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Genesis 45:7 God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant



in the earth, and to save you alive by a great deliverance.

Isaiah 10:20-22 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay on him that smote them; but shall stay on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. The remnant shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God. For though your people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

Jeremiah 50:20 In those days, and in that time, says the LORD, the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I leave as a remnant.

Ezekiel 37:15-17 The word of the Lord came again unto me, saying, Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel his companions: And **join them one to another into one stick**; and they shall become one in thine hand.

Ezekiel 37:24-28 And David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them. And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and **my servant David** shall be their prince forever. Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and **will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore**. My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And the heathen shall know that I the Lord do sanctify **Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore**.

Ezekiel 38:1-3 And the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Son of man, set your face **against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince** of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him, And say, Thus said the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against you, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:

REVELATION

Revelation 4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, **a door was opened in heaven**: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a **shofar** talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and **I will show thee things which must be hereafter**.

Ezekiel 1:1 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives **by**



the river of Chebar, that **the heavens were opened**, and I saw visions of God.

Exodus 24:9,10 Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel: And they **saw the God of Israel**: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a **sapphire stone**, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness.

Ezekiel 1:23-25 And **under the firmament** were their wings straight, the one toward the other: everyone had two, which covered on this side, and everyone had two, which covered on that side, their bodies. And when they went, I heard the noise of their wings, like the noise of great waters, as the voice of the Almighty, the voice of speech, as the noise of an host: when they stood, they let down their wings. **And there was a voice from the firmament that was over their heads**, when they stood, and had let down their wings.

Ezekiel 1:26-28 And **above the firmament that was over their heads** was the likeness of a **throne**, as **the appearance of a sapphire stone**: and upon the likeness of **the throne** was the likeness as the **appearance of a man** above upon it. And I saw as the color of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about. As the **appearance of the bow** that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

Revelation 4:2,3 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, **a throne** was set in heaven, and one sat on **the throne**. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was **a rainbow** round about **the throne**, in sight like unto an emerald.

Ezekiel 10:1 Then I looked, and, behold, in the firmament that was above the head of the cherubims there appeared over them as it were a **sapphire stone**, as the appearance of the **likeness of a throne**. And he spake unto **the man** clothed with linen, and said, Go in between the wheels, even under the cherub, and **fill thine hand with coals of fire from between the cherubims**, and scatter them over the city. And he went in in my sight.

Isaiah 6:6,7 Then flew one of **the seraphim** unto me, having **a live coal in his hand**, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: and he touched my mouth with it, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin forgiven.

Isaiah 6:1-4 In the year that king Uzziah died **I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne**, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. **Above it** stood the **seraphims**: each one had **six wings**; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with



twain he did fly. **And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy**, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.

Revelation 4:6 And before **the throne** there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of **the throne**, and round about **the throne**, **were four beasts full of eyes before and behind.**

Revelation 4:7,8 And **the first beast was like a lion**, and **the second beast like a calf**, and **the third beast had a face as a man**, and **the fourth beast was like a flying eagle**. And the four beasts had each of them **six wings** about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, **Holy, holy, holy**, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

Revelation 4:5 And out of **the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings** and **voices**: and there **were seven lamps of fire** burning before **the throne**, which are the **seven Spirits of God**.

Zechariah 4:1-3 And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep, And said unto me, What do you see? And I said, I have looked, and behold **a candlestick all of gold**, with a bowl upon the top of it, and **his seven lamps** thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof: And **two olive trees** by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.

Revelation 11:4,5 These are the **two olive trees**, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth. And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceeds** out of their mouth, and devours their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

Ezekiel 1:5,6,9-14 Also out of the midst thereof came the likeness of **four living creatures**. And this was their appearance; they had **the likeness of a man**. And everyone had **four faces**, and everyone had **four wings**. Their wings were joined one to another; they turned not when they went; they went everyone straight forward. As for the likeness of their faces, **they four had the face of a man, and the face of a lion, on the right side**: and **they four had the face of an ox on the left side; they four also had the face of an eagle**. Thus were their faces: and their wings were stretched upward; two wings of every one were joined one to another, and two covered their bodies. And they went everyone straight forward: whither the spirit was to go, they went; and they turned not when they went. **As for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance was like burning coals of fire**, and like **the appearance of lamps**: it went up and down among the living creatures; and the fire was bright, and **out of the fire went forth lightning.** **And the living creatures ran and returned as the appearance of a flash of lightning.**



Ezekiel 1:15-19 Now as I beheld the **living creatures**, behold one wheel upon the earth by the living creatures, with his **four faces**. The appearance of the wheels and their work was like unto the color of a beryl: and they four had one likeness: and their appearance and their work was as it were a wheel in the middle of a wheel. When they went, they went upon their four sides: and they turned not when they went. As for their rings, they were so high that they were dreadful; and **their rings** were **full of eyes** round about them four. And when the living creatures went, the wheels went by them: and when the living creatures were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up.

Ezekiel 10:12-15a And their whole body, and their backs, and their hands, and their wings, and the wheels, were **full of eyes** round about, even the wheels that they four had. As for the wheels, it was cried unto them in my hearing, O wheel. And everyone had **four faces**: the **first face was the face of a cherub**, and the **second face was the face of a man**, and the **third the face of a lion**, and the **fourth the face of an eagle**. And the **cherubims** were lifted up.

Ezekiel 10:20-22 This is the living creature that I saw **under the God of Israel** by the **river of Chebar**; and I knew that they were the **cherubims**. Everyone had **four faces** apiece, and everyone **four wings**; and the likeness of the hands of a man was under their wings. And **the likeness of their faces was the same faces which I saw by the river of Chebar**, their appearances and themselves: they went everyone straight forward.

2 Chronicles 3:10-13 And in the most holy house he made two cherubim of image work; and they overlaid them with gold. And the wings of the cherubim were twenty cubits long: **the wing of the one cherub was five cubits, reaching to the wall of the house; and the other wing was likewise five cubits**, reaching to the wing of the other cherub. And the wing of the other cherub was five cubits, reaching to the wall of the house; and the other wing was five cubits also, joining to the wing of the other cherub. The wings of these cherubim spread themselves forth twenty cubits: and they stood on their feet, and their faces were toward the house.

Revelation 4:4 And round about **the throne** were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

Revelation 4:9-11 And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks to him that sat on **the throne**, who lives forever and ever, The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on **the throne**, and worship him that lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before **the throne**, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to



receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Revelation 5:1-6 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on **the throne a book** written within and on the backside, **sealed with seven seals**. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon. And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon. And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, **the Lion of the tribe of Judah**, the **Root of David**, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof. And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood **a Lamb as it had been slain**, having seven horns and **seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth**. And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon **the throne**.

2 Chronicles 16:9a For the **eyes of the Lord** run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him.

Daniel 12:1-4 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which stands for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. But thou, O Daniel, **shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end**: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not **depart from Judah**, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him **shall the gathering of the people be**.

Isaiah 11:10,11 And in that day there shall be a **root of Jesse**, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious. And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to **recover the remnant of his people**,

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as **a lamb to the slaughter**, and as a sheep before her shearers is **dumb**, so he opened not his mouth.

Revelation 5:8-10 And when he had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb,



each holding a harp, and golden bowls **full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints**. And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth."

Psalms 141:2 Let my **prayer be set forth before thee as incense**; and the lifting up of my hands as the **evening sacrifice**.

Revelation 5:11-14 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about **the throne** and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was **ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands**; Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon **the throne**, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth forever and ever.

Daniel 7:9,10 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: **thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.**
