

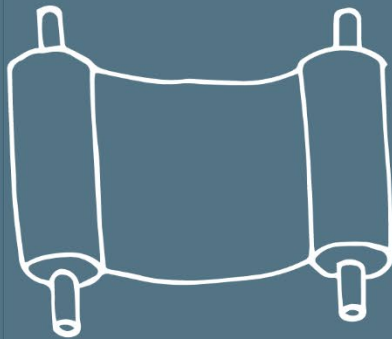

TORAH PORTION

Exodus 1:1 Now these are the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt; every man and his household came with Jacob.

Exodus 1:1 ¶ And these are *the names* of the sons of Israel who are coming into Egypt with Jacob; a man and his household have they come.

Exodus 1:7 And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them.

Exodus 1:8,9 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph. And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we..

Exodus 1:10,11 Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falls out any war, they join also to our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land. Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for **Pharaoh** treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

Exodus 1:15,16 And the king of Egypt spoke to the Hebrew midwives, of which the name of the one was Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah: And he said, When you do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them on the stools; if it be a son, then you shall kill him: but if it be a daughter, then she shall live.

Exodus 1:17 But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive.

Exodus 1:22 And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born you shall cast into the river, and every daughter you shall save alive.

Exodus 2:1,2 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi. And the woman conceived, and bore a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

Exodus 2:11-15 And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brothers, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brothers. And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand. And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Why smite you your fellow? And he said, Who made you a prince and a judge over us? intend you to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known. Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of



Pharaoh, and dwelled in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.

Exodus 2:16-19 Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters: and they came and drew water, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. And the shepherds came and drove them away: but Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock. And when they came to **Reuel** their father, he said, How is it that you are come so soon to day? And they said, **An Egyptian** delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds, and also drew water enough for us, and watered the flock.

Exodus 3:1,2 Now Moses kept the flock of **Jethro** his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. And the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the middle of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, **the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.**

Exodus 3:3-6 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the middle of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. And he said, Draw not near here: put off your shoes from off your feet, for the place where on you stand is holy ground. Moreover he said, I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look on God.

Exodus 3:7 And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows;

Exodus 3:8 And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land to a good land and a large, to a land flowing with milk and honey; to the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

Exodus 3:10 Come now therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh, that you may bring forth **my people** the children of Israel **out of Egypt**.

Exodus 32:7 And the LORD said to Moses, Go, get you down; for **your people, which you brought out** of **the land of Egypt**, have corrupted themselves:

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people, which you have brought forth** out of the **land of Egypt** with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 3:11,12 And Moses said to God, **אלהים** Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt? And he said, Certainly **I will be** **אֲהִיָּה** with you; and this shall



be a token to you, that I have sent you: When you have brought forth the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.

Exodus 3:13 And Moses said to God, Behold, when I come to the children of Israel, and shall say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say to them?

Exodus 3:14 And God **אלהים** said to Moses, **אשר אהיה, I AM** THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shall you say to the children of Israel, **I AM אשר אהיה** has sent me to you.

John 18:4-6 Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were happening to him, went forth, and said to them, "Who are you looking for?" They answered him, "Yeshua of Nazareth." Yeshua said to them, "I am he." Judah also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, "**I am** he," they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Exodus 4:21 And the LORD said to Moses, When you go to return into Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in your hand: but I will harden **הזק** his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Exodus 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened **כבד** his heart, and listened not to them; as the LORD had said.

Exodus 5:2 And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

Exodus 5:22,23 And Moses returned to the LORD, and said, LORD, why have you so evil entreated this people? why is it that you have sent me? For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in your name, he has done evil to this people; neither have you delivered **your people** at all.

Exodus 6:1 Then the LORD said to Moses, Now shall you see what I will do to Pharaoh: for with a strong hand shall he let them go, and with a strong hand shall he drive them out of his land.

REVELATION

Genesis 1:26,27 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So **God created man in his own image**, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Psalm 8:4-9 **What is man**, that you are mindful of him? and the son of man, that you visit him? For you have made him a little lower than



the angels and have crowned him with glory and honor. You made him to have dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under his feet: All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field; The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever passes through the paths of the seas. O Lord our Lord, how excellent is your name in all the earth!

Genesis 2:20 And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field;

Deuteronomy 32:6 Do ye thus requite the Lord, O foolish people and unwise? is not he thy father that hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?

Proverbs 14:4 Where no oxen are, the crib is clean: but much increase is by the **strength of the ox**.

Philippians 2:5-8 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Deuteronomy 32:11,12 As an **eagle** stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings: So the Lord alone did lead him, and there was no strange god with him.

Exodus 19:4 Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and how I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself.

Psalms 91:4a He shall cover you with his feathers, and under his wings shall you trust:

Hosea 5:14 For I will be unto Ephraim as a **lion**, and as a young lion to the house of Judah: I, even I, will tear and go away; I will take away, and none shall rescue him.

Hosea 13:7 Therefore I will be unto them as a lion: as a leopard by the way will I observe them:

Proverbs 28:1 The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion.

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Ezekiel 1:4,5 And I looked, and, behold, a whirlwind came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire infolding itself, and a brightness was about it, and out of the midst thereof as the colour of amber, out of the midst of the fire. Also out of the midst thereof came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance; they had the likeness of a man.



Ezekiel 1:10 As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the face of a man, and the face of a lion, on the right side: and they four had the face of an ox on the left side; they four also had the face of an eagle.

Numbers 2:2,3a Every man of the children of Israel shall pitch by his own standard, with the ensign of their father's house: far off about the tabernacle of the congregation shall they pitch. And on the east side toward the rising of the sun shall they of the standard of the camp of Judah

Numbers 2:10a On the south side shall be the standard of the camp of Reuben according to their armies:

Numbers 2:18a On the west side shall be the standard of the camp of Ephraim according to their armies:

Numbers 2:25a The standard of the camp of Dan shall be on the north side by their armies:

Revelation 6:1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

Revelation 6:2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth **conquering, and to conquer.**

Revelation 6:4 And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great **sword.**

Revelation 6:5b,6 And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand. And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, **A measure of wheat for a penny,** and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

Revelation 6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the **fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.**

Revelation 6:9-11 And when he had opened the fifth seal, **I saw under the altar** the souls of them that were **slain** for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: And they **cried with a loud voice,** saying, **How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood** on them that dwell on the earth? And **white robes were given** unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.



Psalm 82:2 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked?

Psalm 94:1-3 O Lord God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, shew thyself. Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud. Lord, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph?

Deuteronomy 19:11-13 But if any man hate his neighbour, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally that he die, and fleeth into one of these cities: Then the elders of his city shall send and fetch him thence, and deliver him into the hand of the avenger of blood, that he may die. Thine eye shall not pity him, but thou shalt put away the guilt of innocent blood from Israel, that it may go well with thee.

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Revelation 6:12-14 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a **great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood; And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth**, even as a fig tree casts her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind. And the **heaven departed as a scroll** when it is rolled together; and every **mountain** and **island** were moved out of their places.

Isaiah 34:2-5a For the indignation of the Lord is upon all nations, and his fury upon all their armies: he hath utterly destroyed them, he hath delivered them to the slaughter. Their slain also shall be cast out, and their stink shall come up out of their carcases, and the mountains shall be melted with their blood. And all the host of heaven shall be dissolved, and the heavens shall be rolled together as a scroll: and all their host shall fall down, as the leaf falleth off from the vine, and as a falling fig from the fig tree. For my sword shall be bathed in heaven:

Revelation 6:15-17 And the **kings** of the earth, and the **great men**, and the **rich men**, and the **chief captains**, and the **mighty men**, and every **bondman**, and every **free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; And said to the mountains and rocks**, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sits on the throne, and **from the wrath of the Lamb**: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

Isaiah 2:12,17-19 For the day of the Lord of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low: And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and



the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day. And the idols he shall utterly abolish. And they shall **go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth**, for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.
