

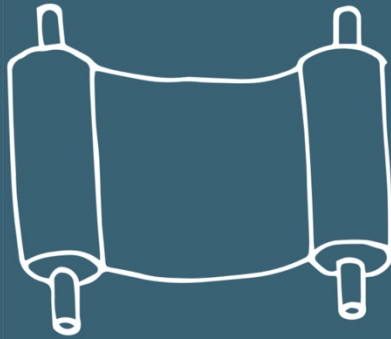

TORAH PORTION

Exodus 30:11-13a The Lord said to Moses, When you take the sum of the children of Israel after their number, then shall they give every man a ransom for his soul to the LORD, when you number them; that there be no plague among them, when you number them. This they shall give, every one that passes among them that are numbered, half a shekel after the shekel of the sanctuary:

Exodus 30:15,16 the rich is not to give more or the poor less than the half-shekel when giving Adonai's offering to atone for your lives. You are to take the atonement money from the people of Israel and use it for the service in the tent of meeting, so that it will be a reminder of the people of Israel before Adonai to atone for your lives."

Proverbs 10:2 Treasures of wickedness profit nothing, but righteousness **צדקה** delivers from death.

Acts 3:13-15 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his Servant Yeshua, whom you delivered up, and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had determined to release him. But you denied the Holy and Righteous One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead, to which we are witnesses.

Exodus 30:30-33 And you shall anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister to me in the priest's office. And you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil to me throughout your generations. On man's flesh shall it not be poured, neither shall you make any other like it, after the composition of it: it is holy, and it shall be holy to you. Whoever compounds any like it, or whoever puts any of it on a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people.

Exodus 31:13,14a "Tell the people of Israel, 'You are to observe My Shabbats; for this is a sign between me and you through all your generations; so that you will know that I am Adonai, who sets you apart for me. Therefore you are to keep My Shabbat, because it is set apart for you.

Exodus 31:16,17 The people of Israel are to keep the Shabbat, to observe Shabbat through all their generations as a perpetual covenant. It is a sign between me and the people of Israel forever; for in six days Adonai made heaven and earth, but on the seventh day he stopped working and rested."

Exodus 31:18 When he had finished speaking with Moshe on Mount Sinai, Adonai gave him the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone inscribed by the finger of God.

Exodus 32:1-3 When the people saw that Moshe was taking a long time to come down from the mountain, they gathered around Aaron and said to him, "Get busy; and make us gods to go ahead of us; because this Moshe, the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt — we don't know what has become of him." Aaron said to them, "Have your wives, sons and daughters strip off their gold earrings; and



Exodus 32:7,8 Adonai said to Moshe, “Go down! Hurry! **Your people, whom you brought up** from the land of Egypt, have become corrupt! So quickly they have turned aside from the way I ordered them to follow! They **have cast a metal statue** of a calf, **worshipped it, sacrificed to it** and said, ‘Israel! Here is your god, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!’”

Exodus 32:9,10 Adonai continued speaking to Moshe: “I have been watching these people; and you can see how stiffnecked they are. Now leave me alone, so that my anger can blaze against them, and I can put an end to them! **I will make a great nation out of you instead.”**

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people**, which **you have brought forth** out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 32:12 Why should **the Egyptians speak**, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from your fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against your people.

Exodus 32:15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written.

Exodus 32:21-24 Moshe said to Aaron, “What did these people do to you to make you lead them into such a terrible sin?” Aaron replied, “My lord shouldn’t be so angry. You know what these people are like, that they are determined to do evil. So they said to me, ‘Make us gods to go ahead of us; because this Moshe, the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt — we don’t know what has become of him.’ I answered them, ‘Anyone with gold, strip it off!’ So they gave it to me. I threw it in the fire, and out came this calf!”

Exodus 32:30-32 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said to the people, you have sinned a great sin: and now I will go up to the LORD; peradventure **I shall make an atonement** for your sin. And Moses returned to the LORD, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold. Yet now, if you will forgive their sin--; and if not, **blot me, I pray you, out of your book which you have written.**

Exodus 33:1 Adonai said to Moshe, “Leave, you and the people you brought up from the land of Egypt; and **move on** from here toward the land of which I swore to Avraham, Yitz’chak and Ya’akov, ‘I will give it to your descendants.’”

Exodus 33:2,3 **I will send an angel before you;** and I will drive out the Canaanite, the Amorite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, the Hivite. and the Jebusite: to a land flowing with milk and honey: for I



Exodus 33:12,13 Moshe said to Adonai, "Look, you say to me, 'Make these people **move on!**' But you haven't let me know whom you will be sending with me. Nevertheless you have said, 'I know you by name,' and also, 'You have found favor in my sight.' Now, please, if it is really the case that I have found favor in your sight, show me your ways; so that I will understand you and continue finding favor in your sight. Moreover, keep on seeing this nation **as your people.**"

Exodus 33:14-16 He said, "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." He said to him, "If your presence doesn't go with me, don't carry us up from here. For how would people know that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people? Isn't it in that you go with us, so that we are separated, I and your people, from all the people who are on the surface of the earth?"

Exodus 33:18-20 He said, "Please show me your glory." He said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy." He said, "You cannot see my face, for man may not see me and live."

Exodus 33:22 It will happen, while my glory passes by, that I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and will cover you with my hand until I have passed by;

Exodus 34:4,5 He chiseled two tablets of stone like the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up to Mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand two stone tablets. The LORD descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD.

Exodus 34:6-8 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abundant in **goodness and truth**, Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, and on the children's children, to the third and to the fourth generation. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of **grace and truth.**

Exodus 34:9 He said, "If now I have found favor in your sight, Lord, **please let the Lord go in the midst of us**; although this is a stiff-necked people; pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for your inheritance."

Exodus 34:11-14 Observe that which I command you this day. Behold, I drive out before you the Amorite, the Canaanite, the Hittite, the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite. Be careful, lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land where you are going, lest it



which were on the right hand of the mount of corruption, which **Solomon the king of Israel had builded for Ashtoreth** the detestation of the Zidonians, and **for Chemosh** the detestation of Moab, and **for Milcom** the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king defile. And he broke in pieces the pillars, and **cut down the Asherim**, and filled their places with the bones of men.

Exodus 34:29,30 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses knew not that the skin of his face **shone** while he talked with him. And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone; and they were afraid to come near him.

REVELATION

Revelation 15:1,2 Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and amazing, seven angels with seven plagues, which are the last, for with them the wrath of God is finished. And I saw what appeared to be **a sea of glass mingled with fire—and also those who had conquered the beast and its image and the number of its name, standing beside the sea of glass with harps of God in their hands.**

Revelation 4:4-6a Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and seated on the thrones were twenty-four elders, clothed in white garments, with golden crowns on their heads. From the throne came flashes of lightning, and rumblings and peals of thunder, and **before the throne were burning seven torches of fire**, which are the seven spirits of God, **and before the throne there was as it were a sea of glass**, like crystal.

Revelation 5:8-14 And when he had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, **each holding a harp**, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And **they sang a new song**, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth." Then I looked, and **I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice**, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!" And the four living creatures said, "Amen!" and the elders fell down and worshiped.



Deuteronomy 31:30 And Moses spoke in the ears of all the assembly of Israel the words of this song, until they were finished.

Deuteronomy 32:3,4 For I will proclaim the name of the Lord; **ascribe greatness** to our God! "The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, **just and upright is he.**

Psalm 92:5-7 How great are your works, O Lord! Your thoughts are very deep! The stupid man cannot know; the fool cannot understand this: that though the wicked sprout like grass and all evildoers flourish, they are doomed to destruction forever;

Psalm 111:2,3 Great are the works of the Lord, studied by all who delight in them. Full of splendor and majesty is his work, and his righteousness endures forever.

Jeremiah 10:7,8 Who would not fear you, O King of the nations? For this is your due; for among all the wise ones of the nations and in all their kingdoms there is none like you. They are both stupid and foolish;

Revelation 15:5,6 After this I looked, and the sanctuary of the tent of witness in heaven was opened, and out of the sanctuary came the **seven angels with the seven plagues**, clothed in pure, **bright linen**, with golden sashes around their chests.

Leviticus 26:21 And if ye walk contrary unto Me, and will not hearken unto Me; I will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins.

Revelation 15:7,8 And one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever, and the sanctuary **was filled with smoke from the glory of God** and from his power, and **no one could enter the sanctuary** until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished.

Leviticus 16:17 **No one may be in the tent of meeting** from the time he enters to make atonement in the Holy Place until he comes out and has made atonement for himself and for his house and for all the assembly of Israel.

Jeremiah 25:15-18 Thus the Lord, the God of Israel, said to me: "Take from my hand this cup of the wine of wrath, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it. They shall drink and stagger and be crazed because of the sword that I am sending among them." So I took the cup from the Lord's hand, and made all the nations to whom the Lord sent me drink it: Jerusalem and the cities of Judah, its kings and officials, to make them a desolation and a waste, a hissing and a curse, as at this day;

Revelation 16:1,2 Then I heard a loud voice from the temple telling the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of God." So **the first angel** went and poured out his bowl on



Pharaoh. It shall become fine dust over all the land of Egypt, and **become boils breaking out in sores** on man and beast throughout all the land of Egypt.”

Deuteronomy 28:35 The Lord will strike you on the knees and on the legs with **grievous boils** of which you cannot be healed, from the sole of your foot to the crown of your head.

Revelation 16:3 The second angel poured out his bowl **into the sea**, and it became like the blood of a corpse, and every living thing died that was in the sea.

Exodus 7:19 And the Lord said to Moses, “Say to Aaron, ‘Take your staff and stretch out your hand over the waters of Egypt, over their rivers, their canals, and their ponds, and all their pools of water, so that they may become blood, and there shall be blood throughout all the land of Egypt, even in vessels of wood and in vessels of stone.’”

Revelation 16:4-7 The third angel poured out his bowl **into the rivers** and the springs of water, and they became blood. And I heard the angel in charge of the waters say, “**Just are you, O Holy One**, who is and who was, for you brought these judgments. For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and you have given them blood to drink. It is what they deserve!” And I heard the altar saying, “Yes, Lord God the Almighty, **true and just** are your judgments!”

Revelation 16:8,9 The fourth angel poured out his bowl **on the sun**, and it was allowed to scorch people with fire. They were scorched by the fierce heat, and they cursed the name of God who had power over these plagues. **They did not repent** and give him glory.

Revelation 16:10,11 The fifth angel poured out his bowl **on the throne of the beast**, and its kingdom was plunged **into darkness**. People gnawed their tongues in anguish and cursed the God of heaven for their pain and sores. **They did not repent** of their deeds.

Exodus 10:22 So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was pitch darkness in all the land of Egypt three days.

Revelation 16:12-14 The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river **Euphrates**, and its water was dried up, to prepare the way for the kings from the east. And I saw, coming out of the **mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet**, three unclean spirits like frogs. For they are demonic spirits, **performing signs**, who go abroad to the kings of the whole world, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God the Almighty.

Deuteronomy 13:1-3 If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, ‘Let us go



Lord, saying, 'I will entice him.' And the Lord said to him, 'By what means?' And he said, 'I will go out, and will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' And he said, 'You are to entice him, and you shall succeed; go out and do so.' Now therefore behold, the Lord has put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these your prophets; the Lord has declared disaster for you."

Revelation 16:15,16 ("Behold, I am coming like a thief! Blessed is the one who stays awake, keeping his garments on, that he may not go about naked and be seen exposed!") And they assembled them at the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon.

Revelation 16:17,18 The seventh angel poured out his bowl **into the air**, and a loud voice came out of the temple, from the throne, saying, "It is done!" And there were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, and **a great earthquake** such as there had never been since man was on the earth, so great was that earthquake.

Zechariah 14:3,4 Then the Lord will go out and fight against those nations as when he fights on a day of battle. On that day his feet shall stand on the Mount of Olives that lies before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives shall be split in two from east to west by a very wide valley, so that one half of the Mount shall move northward, and the other half southward.

Revelation 16:19-21 The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell, and God remembered Babylon the great, to make her drain the cup of the wine of the fury of his wrath. And every island fled away, and no mountains were to be found. And **great hailstones**, about **one hundred pounds each**, fell from heaven on people; and they cursed God for the plague of the hail, because the plague was so severe.

Isaiah 51:17 Wake yourself, wake yourself, stand up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the Lord the cup of his wrath, who have drunk to the dregs the bowl, the cup of staggering.

Jeremiah 25:15-17 Thus the Lord, the God of Israel, said to me: "Take from my hand this cup of the wine of wrath, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it. They shall drink and stagger and be crazed because of the sword that I am sending among them." So I took the cup from the Lord's hand, and made all the nations to whom the Lord sent me drink it:

Exodus 9:23,24 Then Moses stretched out his staff toward heaven, and the Lord sent thunder and hail, and fire ran down to the earth. And the Lord rained hail upon the land of Egypt. There was hail and fire flashing continually in the midst of the hail, very heavy hail, such as had never been in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation.

Exodus 9:34 But when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunder had ceased, he sinned yet again and hardened his heart, he and his servants.
