TORAH PORTION

Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Till seven times? Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

Numbers 16:1-3 Now Korach, The son of *Izhar*, the son of *Kohath*, the son of *Levi*, and *Dathan and Abiram*, the sons of Eliab, and <u>On</u>, the son of Peleth, *sons of Reuben*, <u>took</u> men: And they rose up before Moses, with certain of the children of Israel, two hundred and fifty <u>princes</u> of the assembly, <u>famous</u> in the congregation, <u>men of renown</u>: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron, and said unto them, <u>Ye take too much upon you</u>, <u>seeing all the congregation are holy every one of them</u>, and the LORD is among them: Wherefore <u>then lift ye up</u> yourselves above the congregation of the LORD?

Numbers 14:35 I the LORD have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: In this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

Numbers 14:39-42 And when Moses put these words before the children of Israel, the people were full of grief. And early in the morning they got up and went to the top of the mountain, saying, We are here and we will go up to the place which the Lord said he would give us: For we have done wrong. And Moses said, Why are you now acting against the Lord's order, seeing that no good will come of it? Go not up, for the Lord is not with you, and you will be overcome by those who are fighting against you.

Deuteronomy 14:1,2 You are the children of the LORD your God: <u>You shall not cut yourselves</u>, nor make any <u>baldness</u> הרחה between your eyes <u>for the dead</u>. For you are a <u>holy people</u> to the LORD your God, and the LORD has <u>chosen you to be a people for his own possession</u>, above all <u>peoples</u> who are on the face of the earth.

Numbers 16:10-12 And He has brought you near to him, and all your brothers the sons of Levi with you. And you seek the priesthood also? For which cause both you and all your company are gathered against the LORD. And what is Aaron, that you murmur against him? And Moses sent to call Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab which said, We will not come up.

Numbers 16:13 Is it a small thing that you have brought us up out of a land flowing with milk and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, but <u>you must</u> also make yourself a prince over us?

Exodus 2:13,14 He went out the second day, and behold, **two men of the Hebrews were fighting with each other**. He said to him who did the wrong,

Why do you strike your fellow? He said, Who made you a prince and a judge over us? Do you plan to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? Moses was afraid, and said, Surely this thing is known.

Numbers 16:4-7 When Moses heard it, he fell on his face: And he spoke to Korah and to all his company, saying, In the morning the LORD will show who are his, and who is holy, and will cause him to come near to him: Even him whom he shall choose he will cause to come near to him. Do this: Take censers, Korah, and all his company, and put fire in them, and put incense on them before the LORD tomorrow: And it shall be that the man whom the LORD chooses, he shall be holy. You have gone too far, you sons of Levi!

Numbers 16:21-27 Separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment. And they <u>fell on their faces</u>, and said, O God, the God of the spirits of all flesh, shall one man sin, and will you be wroth with all the congregation? And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the congregation, saying, Get you up from about the tabernacle of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram. And Moses rose up and went unto Dathan and Abiram and the elders of Israel followed him. And he spoke to the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins. So they got up from the tabernacle of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram, on every side: And Dathan and Abiram came out, and stood in the door of their tents, and their wives, and their sons, and their little children.

Numbers 16:30,31 But if the LORD <u>make a new thing</u>, and the earth open her mouth and swallow them up with all that appertain unto them, and they go down alive into the pit, then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD. And it came to pass, as he had made an end of speaking all these words, the ground clave asunder that was under them.

Numbers 16:33-35 They, and all that appertained to them, went down alive into the pit, and the earth closed upon them: And they perished from among the congregation. And all Israel that were round about them fled at the cry of them: For they said, Lest the earth swallow us up also. And there came out a fire from the Lord, and consumed the two hundred and fifty men that offered incense.

Revelations 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were **cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.**

Numbers 16:41 But on the next day all the congregation of the children of Israel **murmured** against Moses and against Aaron saying, *You have killed the LORD'S people*!

Numbers 16:44-48 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Get away from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment! They fell on their faces. Moses said to Aaron, Take your censer, and put fire from off the altar in it, and lay incense on it, and carry it quickly to the congregation, and make atonement for them, for wrath has gone out from the LORD! The plague has begun. Aaron did as Moses said, and ran into the midst of the assembly, and behold, the plague has begun among the people: And he put on the incense, and made atonement for the people. He stood between the dead and the living, and the plague was stayed.

Numbers 16:49 Now they that **died in the plague** were <u>fourteen thousand</u> and seven hundred, beside them that died about the matter of Korah.

Numbers 17:12,13 And the children of Israel spoke to Moses, saying, Behold, we die, we perish, we all perish. Whoever comes anything near to the tabernacle of the LORD shall die: Shall we be consumed with dying?

Numbers 17:8-10 And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness, and, behold, the <u>rod of Aaron</u> for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds. And Moses brought out all the rods from before the LORD to all the children of Israel: And they looked, and took every man his rod. And the LORD said to Moses, Bring <u>Aaron's rod</u> again <u>before the testimony</u>, to be kept for a token <u>against the rebels</u>, and you shalt quite <u>take away their murmurings</u> from me, that they die not.

Numbers 26:11 Notwithstanding the children of Korah died not.

- **1 Samuel 11:14,15** Then Samuel said to the people, Come, let us go to Gilgal and there renew the kingdom. So all the people went to Gilgal, and there they made Saul king before the Lord in Gilgal. There they sacrificed peace offerings before the Lord, and there Saul and all the men of Israel rejoiced greatly.
- **1 Samuel 12:1,2** And Samuel said to all Israel, Behold, I have obeyed your voice in all that you have said to me and have made a king over you. And now, behold, the king walks before you, and I am old and gray, and behold, my sons are with you.
- **1 Samuel 12:12,13** And when ye saw that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon came against you, ye said unto me, Nay, but a king shall reign

over us: When the Lord your God was your king. Now therefore behold the king whom ye have chosen, and whom ye have desired! and, behold, the Lord hath set a king over you.

- **1 Samuel 12:16,17** Now therefore stand and see this great thing, which the Lord will do before your eyes. Is it not wheat harvest today? I will call unto the Lord, and he shall send thunder and rain, that ye may perceive and see that your wickedness is great, which ye have done in the sight of the Lord, **in asking you a king.**
- **1 Samuel 13:1 Saul reigned** one year, and when he had reigned two years over Israel.
- **1 Samuel 13:5a** And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which is on the seashore in multitude.
- **1 Samuel 13:7-11** And some of the Hebrews went over Jordan to the land of Gad and Gilead. As for Saul, he was yet in Gilgal, and all the people followed him trembling. And he tarried seven days, according to the set time that Samuel had appointed: But Samuel came not to Gilgal, and the people were scattered from him. And Saul said, Bring hither a burnt offering to me, and peace offerings. And he offered the burnt offering. And it came to pass, that as soon as he had made an end of offering the burnt offering, behold, Samuel came, and Saul went out to meet him, that he might salute him. And Samuel said, What hast thou done? And Saul said, Because I saw that the people were scattered from me, and that thou came not within the days appointed,
- 1 Samuel 13:13,14 And Samuel said to Saul, Thou hast done foolishly: Thou hast not kept the commandment of the Lord thy God, which he commanded thee: For now would the Lord have established thy kingdom upon Israel forever. But now thy kingdom shall not continue: The Lord hath sought him a man after his own heart, and the Lord hath commanded him to be captain over his people, because thou hast not kept that which the Lord commanded thee.
- **1 Samuel 14:35** And Saul built an altar unto the Lord: the same was **the first altar** that he built unto the Lord.
- **1 Samuel 14:37** And Saul asked counsel of God, Shall I go down after the Philistines? Will You deliver them into the hand of Israel? **But He answered him not that day.**

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY

Philippians 4:1-4 Therefore, my brethren dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved. I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of the same mind in the Lord. And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with **Clement** also, and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life. Rejoice in the Lord alway: And again I say, Rejoice

Hebrews 11:32-38 And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also of David and Samuel and the prophets: Who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. Women received their dead raised to life again. Others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection. Still others had trial of mockings and scourging's, yes, and of chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, in dens and caves of the earth.

1 Corinthians 13:12 For now we **see through a glass, darkly**, but then face to face: now **I know in part,** but then shall I know even as also I am known.

Romans 11:25 For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that <u>blindness in part</u> has happened **to Israel** until the **fullness of the Gentiles** has come in.

Daniel 9:3-6 And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes: And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments; We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments: Neither have we hearkened unto thy servants the prophets, which spoke in thy name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.
