<u>Ruth 2:23</u> So she kept fast by the maidens of Boaz to glean unto the end of barley harvest and of wheat harvest; and dwelt with her mother in law.

<u>Exodus 19:18-20</u> And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly. And when **the voice of the trumpet** sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and **God answered him by a voice**. And the LORD came down upon mount Sinai, on the top of the mount: and the **LORD called Moses up to the top of the mount**; and Moses went up.

**Revelation 4:1** After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

Exodus 20:18-21 And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off. And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die. And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not. And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God was.

<u>Deuteronomy 15:1,2</u> At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release. And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth ought unto his neighbour shall release it; he shall not exact it of his neighbour, or of his brother; because it is called the LORD's release.

<u>Deuteronomy 16:1</u> Observe the month of Abib, and keep the Passover unto the LORD thy God: for in the month of Abib the LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night.

<u>Deuteronomy 16:9</u> Count off seven weeks from the time you begin to put the sickle to the standing grain.

<u>Deuteronomy 16:16</u> Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose; in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:

Ezekiel 3:12-14 Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, saying, Blessed be the glory of the LORD from his place. I heard also the noise of the wings of the living creatures that touched one another, and the noise of the wheels over against them, and a noise of a great rushing. So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me. Ezekiel 1:4 And I looked, and, behold, a whirlwind came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire infolding itself, and a brightness was about it, and out of the midst thereof as the colour of amber, out of the midst of the fire.

**Exodus 24:10** And they saw the God of Israel: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of **a sapphire stone**, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness.

Ezekiel 1:26-28 And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it. And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about. As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

**Revelation 4:2,3** And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

<u>Revelation 4:5</u> And out of the throne proceeded <u>lightnings and thunderings and voices</u>: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Revelation 1:10-18 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea. And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks; And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire; And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength. And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Acts 2:1-3 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Acts 2:5-11 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem <u>Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.</u> Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, <u>Jews and proselytes</u>, Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

Acts 2:15 these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

Acts 2:36,37 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Yeshua, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

<u>Acts 2:41</u> Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about **three thousand souls.** 

Acts 3:25-4:4 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Yeshua, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities. And as they spake unto the people, the priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them, Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Yeshua the resurrection from the dead. And they laid hands on them, and put them in hold unto the next day: for it was now eventide. Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.

Acts 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many (tens) of thousands of Jews there are which believe; and they are all zealous of the law:

<u>Acts 2:46</u> And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,

Acts 5:42 And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Yeshua HaMashiach.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

<u>Psalms 18:3</u> I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.

Psalms 55:16 As for me, I will call upon God; and the LORD shall save me.

<u>Psalm 116:13</u> I will take the <u>cup of salvation</u>, (Yeshuah) and <u>call upon the name of the Lord. (YHWH)</u>

The LORD's name is (YHWH)

Romans 10:10-13 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the Scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord (YHWH) over all is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord (YHWH) shall be saved.

<u>Isaiah 25:9</u> And it shall be said in that day, See, this is our **God**; we have waited for Him, and <u>He will save us</u>: this is the **LORD**; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in **his salvation**.

<u>Isaiah 44:1-5</u> Yet listen now, <u>Jacob my servant</u>, and <u>Israel</u>, whom I have chosen. This is what the <u>LORD (YHWH)</u> who made you, and formed you from the womb, who will help you says: "Don't be afraid, Jacob my servant; and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, and streams on the dry ground. I will pour my Spirit on your seed, and my blessing on your offspring: and they will spring up among the grass, as willows by the watercourses. <u>One will say</u>, 'I am the <u>LORD's</u>;' (YHWH) and another will be called by the name of Jacob; and another will write with his hand 'to the <u>LORD</u>,' (YHWH) and honor the name of Israel."

<u>Isaiah 44:6</u> This is what the LORD, (YHWH) the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD (YHWH) of Hosts, says: "<u>I am the first, and I am the last</u>; and <u>besides me there is</u> no God.

<u>John 12:13</u> Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, **Hosanna:** Blessed is the <u>King of Israel</u> that cometh in the <u>name of the Lord.</u>

**Revelation 1:17,18** When I saw him, I fell at his feet like a dead man. He laid his right hand on me, saying, "Don't be afraid. <u>I am the first and the last</u>, and the Living one. I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. I have the keys of Death and of Sheol.

<u>Isaiah 45:21,22</u> Declare and present it. Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has shown this from ancient time? Who has declared it of old? <u>Haven't I</u>, the LORD? <u>There is no other God besides me</u>, a just God and a Savior; There is no one besides me. "<u>Look to me</u>, and be saved, <u>all the ends of the earth</u>; for I am God, and <u>there is no other</u>.

<u>Philippians 2:9-11</u> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him <u>the name that is above every name</u>, so that <u>at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow</u>, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <u>and every tongue confess</u> that <u>Yeshua HaMashiach</u> <u>is LORD</u>, (YHWH) to the glory of God the Father.

Romans 14:10,11 But you, why do you judge your brother? Or again, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of Messiah. For it is written, "As I live,' says the LORD, 'to me every knee will bow. Every tongue will confess to God."

<u>Isaiah 45:23-25</u> I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That <u>unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear</u>. Surely, <u>shall one say, in the LORD</u> have I righteousness and strength: even to him shall men come; and <u>all that are incensed against him shall be ashamed</u>. <u>In the LORD (YHWH) shall all the seed of Israel be justified</u>, and shall glory.

<u>Ezekiel 9:4-6</u> And the LORD said unto him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a <u>mark</u> upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof. And to the others he said in mine hearing, Go ye after him through the city, and smite: let not your eye spare, neither have ye pity: Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not

near any man upon whom is the <u>mark</u>; and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which were before the house.

<u>Isaiah 53:4-6</u> Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

**<u>Deuteronomy 32:4</u>** He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a <u>God of truth</u> and without iniquity, just and right is he

2Samuel 7:28 And now, O Lord GOD, thou art that God, and thy words be true,

<u>Proverbs 12:19</u> The lip of **truth** shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment.

<u>Psalms 119:142</u> Thy righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and <u>thy law(Torah)</u> is the **truth.** 

<u>John 14:6</u> Yeshua said unto him, **I am** the way, <u>the truth</u>, and the life: no man comes to the Father, but by me.

**Exodus 34:6** And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness **and truth**,

<u>Daniel 8:12</u> And an host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast **the truth to the ground**. And it worked and succeeded. a person who chooses to be righteous despite the fact that they are not yet righteous.

<u>Psalms 85:10,11</u> Mercy and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other. <u>Truth shall spring out of the earth</u>; and righteousness shall look down from Heaven.
