Numbers 25:6,7 And, behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought unto his brethren a <u>Midianitish woman</u> in the sight of Moses, and <u>in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel</u>, who were weeping before the <u>door of the tabernacle of the congregation</u>. And when <u>Phinehas</u>, the son of <u>Eleazar</u>, the <u>son of Aaron the priest</u>, saw it, he <u>rose up from among the congregation</u>, and took a javelin in his hand.

Exodus 2:16,17 Now the priest of **Midian** had <u>seven daughters</u>, and they came and drew water and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. The shepherds came and drove them away, but Moses stood up and saved them, and watered their flock.

Exodus 2:18 When they came home to their father **Reuel**, he said, How is it that you have come home so soon today

Judges 4:11 Now Heber the Kenite, which was of the children of <u>Hobab</u> the father in law of Moses, had severed himself from the Kenites, and pitched his tent unto the plain of Zaanaim, which is by Kedesh.

Exodus 3:1 Now Moses kept the flock of <u>Jethro</u> his father-in-law, the priest of Midian: **His Excellency**

Exodus 6:23 And Aaron took him Elisheba, the daughter of Amminadab, the sister of Nahshon, to wife, and she bore him Nadab and Abihu, **Eleazar** and Ithamar.

Exodus 6:25 And Eleazar, Aaron's son took him one of the daughters of **Putiel** to wife, and she bare him **Phinehas.**

Fatness of God

Numbers 25:8,9 And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel. And those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.

Numbers 25:10-13 And the LORD <u>spoke</u> unto Moses, <u>saying</u>, <u>Phinehas</u>, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, hath turned my wrath away from the children of Israel, while <u>he was zealous for my sake</u> among them, that I consumed not the children of Israel in <u>my jealousy</u>. Wherefore say, Behold, I give unto him <u>my covenant of peace</u>: And he shall have it, and his seed after



him, even the covenant of an <u>everlasting priesthood</u>, because he was <u>zealous</u> **for his God**, and made an atonement for the children of Israel.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: And the government shall be upon his shoulder: And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, **The Prince of Peace**.

Numbers 4:35 From thirty years old and upward even unto fifty years old, everyone that entered into the service, for the work in the tabernacle of the congregation:

1 Chronicles 24:1-4 Now these are the divisions of the sons of Aaron. The sons of Aaron; Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar. But Nadab and Abihu died before their father, and had no children: Therefore, Eleazar and Ithamar executed the priest's office. And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service. And there were more chief men found of the sons of Eleazar than of the sons of Ithamar, and thus were they divided. Among the sons of Eleazar there were sixteen chief men of the house of their fathers, and eight among the sons of Ithamar according to the house of their fathers.

1 Chronicles 6:4-8a Eleazar begot Phinehas, Phinehas begot Abishua, and Abishua begot (6 generations and then) (**Ahitub begot Zadok**)

Ezra 7:1,2 Now after these things, in the reign of Artaxerxes king of Persia, **Ezra** the son of Seraiah, the son of Azariah, the son of Hilkiah, The son of Shallum, the **son of Zadok**, the son of Ahitub.

Ezra 7:5 The son of Abishua, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the chief priest.

Ezekiel 44:15,16 But the priests the Levites, **the sons of Zadok**, that kept the charge of My sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from Me, they shall come near to Me to minister unto Me, and they shall stand before Me to offer unto Me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord GOD, they shall enter into My sanctuary, and they shall come near to My table, to minister unto Me, and they shall keep My charge.

Judges 20:27,28 And the children of Israel enquired of the LORD, (for the ark of the covenant of God was there in those days, And Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, stood before it in those days,) saying, Shall I yet



again go out to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother, or shall I cease?

Romans 10:2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.

- **2 Samuel 21:1,2** Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year, and David enquired of the Lord. And the Lord answered, It is for Saul, and for his bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites. And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them, (now the Gibeonites were not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites, and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: And Saul sought to slay them **in his zeal** to the children of Israel and Judah.)
- **2 Kings 10:15-17** And when Jehu departed thence, he lighted on Jehonadab the son of Rechab coming to meet him: And he saluted him, and said to him, Is thine heart right, as my heart is with thy heart? And Jehonadab answered, It is. If it be, give me thine hand. And he gave him his hand, and he took him up to him into the chariot. And he said, Come with me, and see **my zeal for the Lord**. So they made him ride in his chariot. And when he came to Samaria, he slew all that remained unto Ahab in Samaria, till he had destroyed him, according to the saying of the Lord, which he spoke to Elijah.
- 2 Kings 10:28-31 Thus Jehu destroyed Baal out of Israel. Howbeit from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, to wit, the golden calves that were in Bethel, and that were in Dan. And the Lord said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing that which is right in mine eyes, and hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that was in mine heart, thy children of the fourth generation shall sit on the throne of Israel. But Jehu took no heed to walk in the law of the Lord God of Israel with all his heart: For he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin.

Genesis 12:6 And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Shechem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the <u>Canaanite</u> was then in the land. *3667. ken-ah'-an from 3665; humiliated*

Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt <u>not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them</u>: For I the LORD thy God am a jealous God.

Mark 3:16-18 And He appointed the twelve: Shim'on, to whom He added the name Kepha; and Ya'aqob the son of Zabdai, and Yochanan the brother of Ya'aqob, to whom He added the name Beni-Reges, that is, Sons of Thunder,



and Andri, and Philip, and Bartholomi, and Mattithyahu, and T'oma, and Ya'aqob son of Alphai, and Taddai, and Shim'on the **Kena'anite**.

Mark 3:16-18 And Simon he surnamed Peter, And James the [son] of Zebedee, and John the brother of James, and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder: And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

Mark 3:18 Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, Jacob, the son of Halfai, Taddai, Simon the **Zealot**.

1 Kings 19:7-14 And the angel of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise and eat, because the journey is too great for thee. And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God. And there he went into a (The) cave, and spent the night in that place, and behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and He said to him, What are you doing here, Elijah? And he said, I have been very zealous for Jehovah the God of Hosts. For the sons of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, thrown down Your altars, and have slain Your prophets with the sword. And I, I alone, am left. And they seek to take my life away. And He said, Go forth and stand on the mountain before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind tore the mountains, and broke the rocks in pieces before the LORD. But the LORD was not in the wind. And after the wind was an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake. And after the earthquake was a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire. And after the fire was a still, small voice. And it happened when Elijah heard, he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out, and stood at the cave entrance. And behold, a voice came to him and said, What are you doing here, Elijah? And he said, I have been very(zealously) zealous for Jehovah, God of Hosts, because the sons of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, have thrown down Your altars, and have slain Your prophets with the sword. And I, I alone, am left. And they seek to take my life away.

Exodus 33:22 And it shall come to pass, while my glory passed by, that I will put thee in a cleft of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by.

Acts 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou sees, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe, and they are all zealous of the law.



Numbers 28:1,2 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Command the people of Israel and say to them, My offering, My food for My food offerings, My pleasing aroma, **you shall be careful** to offer to Me <u>at its appointed time</u>.

Jeremiah 6:19,20 Hear, O earth, behold, I am bringing disaster upon this people, the fruit of their devices, because they have not paid attention to my words, and as for **my law, they have rejected it.** What use to me is frankincense that comes from Sheba, or sweet cane from a distant land? Your burnt offerings are not acceptable, nor your sacrifices pleasing to me.

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED BIBLICAL THINKING

Exodus 4:2,3 And the LORD said unto him, What is that in thine hand? And he said, A rod. And he said, Cast it on the ground. And he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpen, and Moses fled from before it.

Exodus 7:2 And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: And **Aaron cast down his rod** before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became **a serpent.**

Exodus 8:31,32 And the LORD did according to the word of Moses, and he removed the swarms of flies from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, there remained not one. And **Pharaoh hardened his heart** at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

Exodus 7:11-13 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: Now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments. For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: But Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. And **he hardened Pharaoh's heart**, that he hearkened not unto them, as the LORD had said.

John 4:39 And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman.

John 4:5-9 So he came to a city of Samaria, called Sychar, near the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son, <u>Joseph</u>. Jacob's well was there. Yeshua therefore, being tired from his journey, sat down by the well. It was about <u>the sixth hour</u>. A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Yeshua <u>said to her</u>, Give me a drink. For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food. The Samaritan woman therefore said to him, How is it that you, being a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a Samaritan woman? For <u>Jews have no dealings</u> <u>with Samaritans</u>.

John 4:11-14 The woman said to him, Sir, you have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. From where then have you that living water? Are you greater than our father, Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank of it himself, as did his children, and his livestock? Yeshua answered her, Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never thirst again, but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

John 4:15-19 The woman said to him, Sir, give me this water, so that I don't get thirsty, neither come all the way here to draw. Yeshua said to her, Go, call your husband, and come here. The woman answered, I have no husband. Yeshua said to her, You said well, I have no husband, for you have had five husbands, and he whom you now have is not your husband. This you have said truly. The woman said to him, Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.

1 Samuel 1:5 But unto Hannah he gave a worthy portion, for he loved Hannah: But the LORD had shut up her womb. And her adversary also provoked her sore, for to make her fret, because the LORD had shut up her womb.

Genesis 16:4 And he went in unto Hagar, and she conceived: And when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress was despised in her eyes.

John 4:35 Say not you, There are yet four months, and then comes harvest? Behold, I say to you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields, for they are white already to harvest.

Ecclesiastes 2:17-19a Therefore I hated life, because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: For all is vanity and vexation of spirit. Yea, I hated all my labour which I had taken under the sun: Because I should leave it unto the man that shall be after me. And who knows whether he shall be a wise man or a fool?

Luke 12:15-20 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: For a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth. And he spoke a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully: And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits? And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater, and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years, take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry. But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: Then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?



Ecclesiastes 2:4,5 I made me great works, I built me houses, I planted me vineyards: I made me gardens and orchards, and I planted trees in them of all kind of fruits.

Ecclesiastes 8:15a Then I commended mirth, because a man hath no better thing under the sun, than to eat, and to drink, and to be merry.

Mark 9:1 And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come **with power**.

Mark 9:30-32 And they departed thence, and passed through Galilee, and he would not that any man should know it. For he taught his disciples, and said unto them, The Son of man is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill him, and after that he is killed, he shall rise the third day. But they understood not that saying, and were afraid to ask him.

Mark 9:33,34 And he came to Capernaum: And being in the house he asked them, What was it that ye disputed among yourselves by the way? But they held their peace: For by the way they had disputed among themselves, who should be the greatest.

Mark 9:36,37 And he took a child, and set him in the midst of them: And when he had taken him in his arms, he said unto them, Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: And whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.

Mark 10:13-16 And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: And his disciples rebuked those that brought them. But when Jesus saw it, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: For of such is the kingdom of God. Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein. And he took them up in his arms, put his hands upon them, and blessed them.

Mark 10:17 Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?

Mark 10:19,20 Thou knows the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honor thy father and mother. And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth.



Mark 10:21,22 Then Yeshua beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: Go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: And come, take up the cross, and follow me. And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: For he had great possessions.

Mark 10:32-37 Now they were on the road, going up to Jerusalem, and Yeshua was going before them, and they were amazed. And as they followed they were afraid. Then He took the twelve aside again and began to tell them the things that would happen to Him: Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes, and they will condemn Him to death and deliver Him to the Gentiles, and they will mock Him, and scourge Him, and spit on Him, and kill Him. And the third day He will rise again. Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Him, saying, Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask. And He said to them, What do you want Me to do for you? They said to him, Grant to us that we may sit, one on your right hand, and the other on your left hand, in your glory.

Mark 10:45-52 For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. And they came to Jericho: And as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side Megging. And when he heard that it was Yeshua of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Yeshua, thou Son of David, have mercy on me. And many charged him that he should hold his peace: But he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. And Yeshua stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise, he calleth thee. And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Yeshua. And Yeshua answered and said unto him, What do you want Me to do for you? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive megasting in the way. And Yeshua said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Yeshua in the way.
