TORAH PORTION

Numbers 30:1,2 Moses spoke to the heads of the tribes of the children of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD has commanded. When a man vows a vow to the LORD or swears an oath to bind his soul with a bond, **he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.**

Numbers 31:1-6 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Avenge the children of Israel for the Midianites. Afterward you shall be gathered to your people. Moses spoke to the people, saying, Arm men from among you for the war, that they may go against Midian, to execute **the LORD's vengeance** on Midian. Of every tribe one thousand, throughout all the tribes of Israel, you shall send to the war. So there were delivered, out of the thousands of Israel, a thousand of every tribe, twelve thousand armed for war. Moses sent them, one thousand of every tribe, **to the war**, them and Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, to the war, with the vessels of the sanctuary and **the shofars for the alarm** in his hand.

Numbers 31:8 They killed the kings of Midian with the rest of their slain: Evi, and Rekem, and Zur, and Hur, and Reba, the five kings of Midian: **Balaam also the son of Beor they killed with the sword.**

Numbers 32:1 Now the children of Reuben and the children of Gad had a very great multitude of livestock: And when they saw the land of Jazer, and the land of Gilead, that behold, the place was a place for livestock.

Numbers 32:5-7 They said, If we have found favor in your sight, let this land be given to your servants for a possession, don't bring us over the Jordan. Moses said to the children of Gad, and to the children of Reuben, Shall your brothers go to the war, and shall you sit here? Why do you discourage the heart of the children of Israel from going over into the land which the LORD has given them?

Numbers 32:16-18 They came near to him, **and said, We will build sheepfolds here for our livestock, and cities for our little ones:** But we ourselves will be ready armed to go before the children of Israel, until we have brought them to their place: And our little ones shall dwell in the fortified cities because of the inhabitants of the land. We will not return to our houses, until the children of Israel have inherited every man his inheritance.

Numbers 32:23 But if you will not do so, behold, you have sinned against the LORD, and be sure your sin will find you out.

Numbers 32:24 *Build cities for your little ones, and folds for your sheep, and do **that which has proceeded out of your mouth.***

Numbers 32:31-33 The children of Gad and the children of Reuben answered, saying, As the LORD has said to your servants, so will we do. We will pass over armed before the LORD into the land of Canaan, and the possession of our inheritance shall remain with us beyond the Jordan. **Moses gave to them**, even to the children of Gad, and to the children of Reuben, and to the half-tribe of Manasseh the son of Joseph, the kingdom of Sihon king of the Amorites, and the kingdom of Og king of Bashan, the land, according to its cities and borders, even the cities of the surrounding land.

Numbers 32:39-41 And the children of Machir the son of **Manasseh went to Gilead**, and took it, and **dispossessed the Amorite** which was in it. **And Moses gave** Gilead unto **Machir the son of Manasseh**, and he dwelt therein. And **Jair the son of Manasseh** went and took the small towns thereof and called them **Havoth-jair**.

Numbers 33:1,2 These are the journeys מסעי of the children of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron. And Moses wrote their goings out according to their journeys by the commandment of the Lord: And these are their journeys according to their goings out.

Numbers 33:38,39 And **Aaron** the priest went up into mount Hor at the commandment of the LORD, and **died** there, in the fortieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the first day of the fifth month. And Aaron was a **hundred and twenty and three years old** when he died in mount Hor.

Exodus 2:5-11 And **the daughter of Pharaoh** came down to wash herself at the river, and her maidens walked along by the river's side, and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it. And when she had opened it, she saw the child: And, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children. Then said his sister to **Pharaoh's daughter**, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee? And **Pharaoh's daughter** said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother. And **Pharaoh's daughter** said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it. And the child grew, and she brought him unto **Pharaoh's daughter**, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: And she said, Because I drew him out of the water. And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: And he spied an Egyptian smiting a Hebrew, one of his brethren.

1 Chronicles 4:15-18 *And the sons of Caleb the son of Jephunneh, Iru, Elah. And these are the sons of **Bithiah, the daughter of Pharaoh**, which Mered took.*

Numbers 33:50-53 *And the Lord spoke to Moses in the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, saying, Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When you pass over the Jordan into the land of Canaan, then you shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you and destroy all their figured stones and destroy all their metal images and demolish all their high places. And you shall take possession of the land and settle in it, for I have given the land to you to possess it.*

Numbers 33:55,56 *But if you will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you, then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them shall be pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell. Moreover, it shall come to pass, that I shall do unto you, as I thought to do unto them.*

Jeremiah 2:5,6 *Thus said the Lord, What iniquity have your fathers found in me, that they are gone far from me, and have walked after vanity, and are become vain? Neither said they, **Where is the LORD** that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, that led us through the wilderness, through a land of deserts and of pits, through a land of drought, and of the shadow of death, through a land that no man passed through, and where no man dwelled?*

Jeremiah 2:7,8 *And I brought you into a plentiful country, to eat the fruit thereof and the goodness thereof, but when you entered, you defiled my land, and made my heritage an abomination. **The priests** said not, **Where is the Lord?** And they that handle the law knew me not: **The pastors** also transgressed against me, and **the prophets** prophesied by Baal, and walked after things that do not profit.*

Revelation 3:20 *Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: If any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come into him, and will sup with him, and he with me.*

Jeremiah 2:11 *Has a nation changed their gods, which are yet no gods? **But my people have changed their glory** for that which does not profit.*

Romans 1:22,23 *Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four-footed beasts, and creeping things.*

Jeremiah 2:12,13 *Be astonished, O you heavens, at this, and be horribly afraid, be you very desolate, said the LORD. For **my people** have committed two evils: **They have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters,** and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.*

Jeremiah 2:25b but thou said, There is no hope: No, for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go.

Numbers 5:16,17 And the priest shall bring her near, and set her before the LORD: And the priest shall take **holy water in an earthen vessel**, and **of the dust that is in the floor of the tabernacle** the priest shall take and put it into the water.

John 7:37,38 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall **flow rivers of living water**.

John 7:45-49 Then came the officers to the chief priests and Pharisees, and they said unto them, Why have ye not brought him? The officers answered, Never man spoke like this man. Then answered them the Pharisees, **Are ye also deceived?** Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on him? But this people who know not the law are cursed.

John 8:1-4 Jesus went unto the mount of Olives. And early in the morning he came again **into the temple**, and all the people came unto him, and he sat down, and taught them. And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery, and when they had set her in the midst, They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act.

John 8:6-8 This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with **his finger** wrote on the ground, as though he heard them not. So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.

Jeremiah 17:13 O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that **forsake thee shall be ashamed**, and **they that depart from me shall be written in the earth**, because **they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters**.

Jeremiah 2:19,20 **Your own wickedness shall correct you**, and your backsliding shall reprove you. Know therefore and see that it is an evil thing and a bitter, that you have **forsaken the LORD your God**, and that **my fear is not in you**, says the Lord, the LORD of Hosts. For of old time, **I have broken your yoke, and burst your bonds, you said, I will not serve**, for on every high hill and under every green tree you bowed yourself, playing the prostitute.

Jeremiah 2:26-30 As the thief is ashamed when he is found, so is the house of Israel ashamed, they, their kings, their princes, and their priests, and their prophets, who tell wood, You are my father, and a stone, You have brought me out: **For they have turned their back to me, and not their face, but in the time of**

their trouble they will say, Arise, and save us. But where are your gods that you have made for yourselves? Let them arise, if they can save you in the time of your trouble: For according to the number of your cities are your gods, Judah. Why will you contend with me? You all have transgressed against me, says the LORD. I have struck your children in vain. They received no correction. Your own sword has devoured your prophets, like a destroying lion.

Jeremiah 2:31,32 Generation, consider the word of the LORD. Have I been a wilderness to Israel? Or a land of thick darkness? Why do my people say, We have broken loose. We will come to you no more? Can a virgin forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? Yet my people have forgotten me for days without number.

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED OUR BIBLICAL THINKING

Acts 3:1 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.

Acts 3:1-2 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of the prayer, after being the **ninth hour**. And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple.

Acts 4:22 For the man was **above forty years old**, on whom this miracle of healing was showed.

FOR HEALING: Heal us, Oh Lord, and we will be healed, save us and we will be saved. For You are our praise. Oh grant a perfect healing to all our ailments, for You, Almighty King, are a faithful and merciful healer. Blessed are You, Oh Lord, the healer of the sick of His people Israel.

Acts 3:6-9 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none, but such as I have - give I thee: In the name of Yeshua HaMashiach of Nazareth rise up and walk. And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: And immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. And all the people saw him **walking** and praising God.

THE GOD OF NATURE: You, Oh Lord, are mighty forever, **You revive the dead**, You have the power to save. You sustain the living with loving kindness, **You revive the dead** with great mercy, and You support the falling, heal the sick, set free the bound and keep faith with those who sleep in the dust. restores to life, and causes **salvation to flourish**? And You are certain to **revive the dead**. Blessed are You, Oh Lord, who **revives the dead**.

HHBNT John 20:19 On that same first day of the week, **at evening time**, after the doors had been locked shut where the disciples were staying because they were afraid of some of the authorities of the people of Yehudah, Yeshua came and **stood** in the middle of them all and said to them, Shalom rest upon each of you.

3pm time of the evening sacrifice!

(AKJV) **Mark 3:1-6** And Jesus entered again into the synagogue, and there was a man there which had a withered hand. And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day, that they might accuse him. And he said to the man which had the withered hand, **Stand forth**. And he said to them, Is it **lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil?** To **save life, or to destroy?** *But they held their peace.* And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being **grieved for the hardness of their hearts**, he said to the man, **Stretch forth your hand. And he stretched it out:** And his hand was restored whole as the other. And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

(AKJV) **Deuteronomy 11:26-28:** Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse: The blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day, and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods which you have not known.

(AKJV) **Deuteronomy 30:15-18a** See, I have set before you this day life and good, and death and evil. In that I command you this day to love the LORD your God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that you may live and multiply: And the LORD your God shall bless you in the land where you go to possess it. But if your heart turn away, so that you will not hear, but shall be drawn away, and worship other gods, and serve them, I denounce to you this day, that you shall surely perish.

(AKJV) **Deuteronomy 11:1-4** Therefore you shall love the LORD your God, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his judgments, and his commandments, always. And know you this day: For I speak not with your children which have not known, and which have not seen the chastisement of the LORD your God, his greatness, his mighty hand, and his stretched out arm, And **his miracles**, and his acts, which he did **in the middle of Egypt** to Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and to all his land, And what he did to the army of Egypt, to their horses, and to their chariots, how he made the water of the Red sea to overflow them as they pursued after you, and how the LORD has **destroyed them** to this day.

Exodus 9:22 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Stretch forth thine hand** toward heaven, that there may be hail in all the land of Egypt, upon man, and upon beast, and upon every herb of the field, throughout the land of Egypt.

Exodus 10:12 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Stretch out thine hand** over the land of Egypt for the locusts, that they may come up upon the land of Egypt, and eat every herb of the land, even all that the hail hath left.

Exodus 10:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Stretch out thine hand** toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, even darkness which may be felt.

Exodus 14:15-17 And the LORD said to Moses, Why cry you to me? Speak to the children of Israel, that they go forward: But lift you up your rod, and **stretch out your hand** over the sea, and divide it: And the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the middle of the sea. And I, behold, **I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians**, and they shall follow them: And I will get me honor on Pharaoh, and on all his host, on his chariots, and on his horsemen.

Exodus 14:21b **And Moses stretched out his hand** over the sea, and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

Exodus 14:26,27 And the LORD said to Moses, **Stretch out your hand** over the sea, that the waters may come again on the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen. And Moses **stretched forth his hand** over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared, and the Egyptians fled against it, and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the middle of the sea.

2 Kings 4:8 And it fell on a day, that **Elisha passed to Shunem**, where was a great woman, and she constrained him to eat bread. And so it was, that as oft as he passed by, he turned in thither to eat bread.

2 Kings 4:14b-17 And Gehazi answered, Verily she hath no child, and her husband is old. And he said, Call her. And when he had called her, she stood in the door. And he said, About this season, according to the time of life, thou shalt embrace a son. And she said, Nay, my lord, thou man of God, do not lie unto thine handmaid. And the woman conceived and bare a son at that season that Elisha had said unto her, according to the time of life.

Luke 7:1,2 After he had finished speaking in the hearing of the people, he entered into Capernaum. A certain centurion's servant, who was dear to him, was sick and at the point of death.

Luke 7:11,12 And it came to pass the day after, that he went into a city called **Nain**, and **many of his disciples** went with him, **and much people**. Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: **and much people** of the city was with her.

Luke 7:13,14 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not. And he came and touched the bier: And they that bare him stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise. And he that was dead sat up and began to speak.
