TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 1:1a These are the words which Moses spoke unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue.

Psalm 34:12,13 Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit.

Ephesians 4:29,31 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all **malice**.

Deuteronomy 1:34,35 And the Lord heard “the voice” of your words, and was wroth, and swore, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I swore to give unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 1:2,3 (There are **eleven days' journey from Horeb by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.**) And it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spoke unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the Lord had given him in commandment unto them.

Remember:

THE COVENANT

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed unto yourselves, lest ye forget the covenant of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of anything, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.

Deuteronomy 4:9-13 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: But **teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons, Especially the day that thou stood before the LORD** thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children. And ye came near and stood under the mountain, and the mountain burned with fire unto the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness. And the **LORD spoke unto you out of the midst of the fire: Ye heard the voice of the words**, but saw no similitude, only ye heard a voice. And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, **even ten commandments, and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.**

THEIR PAST SLAVERY

Deuteronomy 5:15 And **remember that you were a servant** in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: Therefore, the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

THEIR GREAT DELIVERENCE

Deuteronomy 7:17-19 If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations are more than I, how can I dispossess them? Thou shalt **not be afraid of them**: But **shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt**, The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: So shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.

DIVINE LEADERSHIP

Deuteronomy 8:2 And thou **shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness**, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou would keep his commandments, or no.

PAST REBELLION

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember, and forget not, how thou provoked the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: From the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

DIVINE JUDGEMENTS

Deuteronomy 24:9 Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

THEIR HISTORY

Deuteronomy 32:7-8 Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: Ask thy father, and he will shew thee, thy elders, and they will tell thee. When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

KEY THOUGHTS

Deuteronomy 32:6 Is this your answer to the Lord, O foolish people and unwise? Is he not **your Father** who has given you life? He has made you and given you your place.

Deuteronomy 7:6-9 For you are an holy people unto the LORD your God: The LORD your God **hath chosen you to be a special people unto himself**, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all

people: But **because the LORD loved you**, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, **the faithful God**, which **keeps covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations.**

Deuteronomy 1:22,23 And **you** came near to me every one of you, and said, We will send men before us, and they shall search us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye murmured in your tents, and said, **Because the Lord hated us**, he hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.

Matthew 25:24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew you that you are an hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not strewed.

Deuteronomy 1:29,30 Then I said unto you, Dread not, neither be afraid of them. The Lord your God which goes before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes.

Deuteronomy 1:31 And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the Lord thy God bare thee, as **a man doth bear his son**, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place. Yet in this thing ye did not believe the Lord your God.

Deuteronomy 1:32-35 Yet in this thing **you did not believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to show you by what way you should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard **“the voice” of your words**, and was wroth, and sware, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this **evil generation** see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers,

Deuteronomy 1:39 Moreover **your little ones, that ye said should be a prey**, and your children, that this day have no knowledge of good or evil, they shall go in thither, and unto them will I give it, and they shall possess it.

Deuteronomy 1:45 And ye returned and **wept before the Lord, but the Lord would not hearken to your voice, nor give ear unto you.**

Deuteronomy 2:4,5 And command thou the people, saying, Ye are to pass through the coast of your brethren the **children of Esau**, which dwell in Seir, and they shall

be afraid of you: Take ye good heed unto yourselves therefore: **Meddle not with them**, for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth, because I have given mount Seir unto Esau for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:9 And the Lord said unto me, **Distress not the Moabites**, neither contend with them in battle: For I will not give thee of their land for a possession, because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:19 And when thou comes nigh over against the children of **Ammon**, **distress them not**, nor meddle with them: For I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon any possession, because I have given it unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:10 The Emims dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims, but the Moabites call them Emims.

Deuteronomy 2:12 The Horims also dwelt in Seir before time, but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead, as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the Lord gave unto them.

Deuteronomy 2:20 (That also was accounted a land of giants: Giants dwelt therein in old time, and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims, A people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, but the Lord destroyed them before them, and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead.

Isaiah 1:1-4 The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah. Hear, heavens, and listen, earth, for the LORD has spoken: I have nourished and brought up children, and **they have rebelled against me**. The ox knows his owner, and the donkey his master's crib, but Israel doesn't know, my people don't consider. Ah sinful nation, a people loaded with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children who deal corruptly! They have forsaken the LORD. They have despised the Holy One of Israel. They are estranged and backward.

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED OUR BIBLICAL THINKING

Genesis 2:19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them: And whatever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.

(HNV) 1 Thessalonians 5:23 May the God of peace himself sanctify you completely. May your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.

(AKJV) Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul.

(AKJV) Genesis 4:10 And he said, What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood η 7 cries to me from the ground.

(AKJV) James 4:14 Whereas you know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor, that appears for a little time, and then vanishes away.

Deuteronomy 4:24 For the LORD your God is a consuming fire.

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image.

Psalms 68:4 Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: Extol him that rides upon the heavens **by his name Yah**

Colossians 1:15-18 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: For **by him** were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: All things were created **by him, and for him**: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. And he is **the head** of the body, the assembly: Who is **the beginning, the firstborn** from the dead, that in all things he might have the preeminence.

Ephesians 2:21 So then you are no longer as those who have no part or place in the kingdom of God, but you are numbered among the saints, and of **the family of God**, Resting on the base of the Apostles and prophets, Yeshua HaMashiach himself being the **chief cornerstone**, In whom all the building, rightly joined together, comes to be a holy house of God in the Lord.

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore so says the Lord Jehovah, Behold, I place in Zion a Stone for a foundation, a tried Stone, a precious Cornerstone, a sure Foundation,

Revelation 13:8b And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Isaiah 46:10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure.

Jeremiah 23:29 Is not my word like as a fire? Saith the LORD, and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?

Deuteronomy 33:2b And he came with ten thousands of saints: From his right hand went a fiery law for them.

Leviticus 23:39,40 So on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruits of the land, you shall keep the feast of the LORD seven days: On the first day shall be a solemn rest, and on the eighth day shall be a solemn rest. You shall take on the first day the fruit of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook, and **you shall rejoice** before the LORD your God seven days.

John 7: Now the Jews' *feast of tabernacles* was at hand.

John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: He that follow me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

Exodus 15:1,2 Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spoke, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: The horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. *The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation*: He is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Psalm 118:14,15 *The LORD is my strength and song, and is become my salvation*. The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the *tabernacles* of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

John 7:14 But when it was now the midst of the feast, Yeshua went up into the temple and taught.

John 7:37,38 Now on the last and greatest day of the feast, Yeshua stood and cried out, If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink! He who believes in me, **as the Scripture has said, from within him will flow rivers of living water.**

Isaiah 12:2,3 Behold, God is my *salvation*, I will trust, and not be afraid: For the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song, he also is become my *salvation*. Therefore, with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation. (Yeshua)

Isaiah 12:6 Cry aloud and shout, you inhabitant of Zion, for **the Holy One of Israel is great in the midst of you!**
