TORAH PORTION

Isaiah 40:1,2 Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God. Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: For she hath received of the Lord's hand double for all her sins.

Psalms 137:1,2 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion. We hung our harps upon the willows in the midst thereof.

Matthew 5:11 Blessed are they that mourn: For **they shall be comforted**.

Romans 12:15 Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.

2 Corinthians 1:3,4 Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all **comfort**, Who **comforts** us in all our tribulation, that **we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble**, by the **comfort** wherewith we ourselves are **comforted of God**.

Lamentations 1:2 She weep sore in the night, and her tears are on her cheeks: Among all her lovers she hath none **to comfort her**: All her friends have dealt treacherously with her, they are become her enemies.

Lamentations 3:21-23 This I recall to my mind, therefore have, I hope. Surely the LORD'S mercies are not consumed, surely His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Thy faithfulness.

Deuteronomy 3:23-25 **I begged** the LORD at that, saying, Lord the LORD, you have begun to show your servant your greatness, and your strong hand: For what god is there in heaven or in earth, that can do according to your works, and according to your mighty acts? **Please let me go over and see the good land** that is beyond the Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon.

Deuteronomy 3:26,27 But the LORD was angry with me for your sakes, and didn't listen to me, and the LORD said to me, Let it suffice you, speak no more to me of this matter. Go up to the top of Pisgah, and lift up your eyes westward, and northward, and southward, and eastward, and see with your eyes: for you shall not go over this Jordan.

Deuteronomy 4:1,2 Now, Israel, **listen to the statutes and to the ordinances, which I teach you, to do them, that you may live**, and go in and possess the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, gives you. You **shall not add to the word which I command you, neither shall you diminish from it**, that you may **keep the commandments of the LORD** your God which I command you.

Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: And they shall be one flesh.

Deuteronomy 4:4 But you that did cleave unto the LORD your God are alive every one of you this day.

Deuteronomy 4:5-8 Behold, I have taught you statutes and ordinances, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do so in the midst of the land where you go in to possess it. **Keep** therefore and **do** them, for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, who shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people. For what great nation is there, that has a god so near to them, as the LORD our God is whenever we call on him? What great nation is there, that has statutes and ordinances so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?

Deuteronomy 4:9 Only take heed to yourself, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things which your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life: but teach them to your sons, and your sons' sons.

Deuteronomy 4:28-31 But from there you will seek the Lord your God and you will find him, if you search after him with all your heart and with all your soul. **When you are in tribulation**, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, you will return to the Lord your God and obey his voice. For the Lord your God is a merciful God. He will not leave you or destroy you or forget the covenant with your fathers that he swore to them.

Deuteronomy 5:29 O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children forever!

1 John 2:3-6 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keep not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keep his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: Hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abides in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

1 John 3:24 And he that keeps his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

1 John 5:2,3 By this we know that we love the children of God, **when we love God, and keep his commandments.** For **this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments**: And his commandments are not grievous.

Deuteronomy 6:4,5 Hear, Israel: The LORD is our God, the LORD is one: And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 These words, which I command you this day, **shall be on your heart;** And you shall teach them **diligently** to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them for a sign on your hand, and they shall be for symbols between your eyes. You shall write them on the **doorposts** of your house, and on your gates.

Deuteronomy 6:24,25 The LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, **to fear the LORD our God, for our good always**, that he might preserve us alive, as at this day. It shall be righteousness to us, if we observe to do all this commandment before the LORD our God, as he has commanded us.

Deuteronomy 7:9 Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

John 1:23 He said, I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Isaiah.

Isaiah 40:3,4 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: And the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain.

Isaiah 40:5 And the Glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it(him) together: For the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

(JPS) **Isaiah 40:5** The **Presence of the Lord shall appear,** And **all flesh, as one, shall Behold** - For the Lord Himself has spoken!

John 1:29a The next day, he saw Yeshua coming to him, and said, **Behold, the Lamb of God.**

John 1:14 And **the Word** was **made flesh,** and dwelt among us, (and we **Beheld His Glory,** the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Isaiah 40:6-9 The voice said, **Cry.** And he said, What shall I cry? All flesh is grass, and all the goodness thereof is as the flower of the field: The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: Because the spirit of the LORD blows upon it: Surely the people are grass. The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but **the Word of our**

God shall stand for ever. O Zion, that brings **good tidings**, get thee up into the high mountain, **O Jerusalem**, that brings **good tidings**, lift up thy voice with strength, lift it up, be not afraid, say unto the cities of Judah, **Behold your God!**

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED BIBLICAL THINKING

Isaiah 46:9,10 Remember the former things of old: For I am God, and there is none else, I am God, and there is none like me, **Declaring the end from the beginning**,

1 Samuel 8:7 And the Lord said to Samuel, Give ear to the voice of the people and what they say to you: they have not been turned away from you, **but they have been turned away from me, not desiring me to be king over them.**

Isaiah 44:6 Thus says the LORD, the **King of Israel** and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: **I am the first and I am the last;** besides me there is no god.

John 1:49 Nathanael answered him, Rabbi, you are the Son of God! **You are the King of Israel!**

Revelation 1:8-11a I am the **Aleph and the Tav**, beginning and end, saith the Lord, who is, and who was, and who is coming--the Almighty. I, John, who also [am] your brother, and fellow-partner in the tribulation, and in the reign and endurance, of Yeshua HaMashiach, was in the isle that is called Patmos, because of the word of God, and because of the testimony of Yeshua HaMashiach, I was in the Spirit on the Lord's-day, and I heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, saying, **I am the Aleph and the Tav, the First and the Last.**

Revelation 1:17,18 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not, **I am the first and the last: I am he that liveth, and was dead;** and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen.

Psalms 22:16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: **They pierced my hands and my feet.**

Numbers 25:7-13 Wherefore say, Behold, I give unto him my covenant of peace: And he shall have it, and his seed after him, even the covenant of an everlasting priesthood.

Isaiah 9:6 For a Child hath been born to us, A Son hath been given to us, And the princely power is on his shoulder, And He doth call his name Wonderful, Counsellor, Mighty God, Father of Eternity, **Prince of Peace.**

Genesis 2:4 These are the **generations** of the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the generations of Adam.

Leviticus 19:2 Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: קדש for I the LORD your God am holy. קדוש

Leviticus 16:21 And Aaron shall (Samech) lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: **And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee**, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

Psalm 95:6 O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

1 Chronicles 29:20 And David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. And all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed down their heads,

Philippians 2:7,8 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Genesis 1:16,17 And God made two great lights, the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night: He made the stars also. And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth.

And I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

Romans 5:8 But God commended his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Ephesians 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace.
