TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 7:12 And it shall come to pass, <u>because</u> ye hearken to these ordinances, and keep, and do them, that the **LORD thy God shall keep with thee the covenant and the mercy** which He swore unto thy fathers.

Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed, it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Genesis 25:26 And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called **Jacob**.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power **to tread <u>on serpents and scorpions</u>**, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Ezekiel 2:3-6 And he said to me, Son of man, I am sending you to the children of Israel, to an uncontrolled nation which has gone against me: They and their fathers have been sinners against me even to this very day. And the children are hard and stiff-hearted, I am sending you to them: And you are to say to them, These are the words of the Lord. And they, if they give ear to you or if they do not give ear (for they are an uncontrolled people), will see that there has been a prophet among them. And you, son of man, have no fear of them or of their words, even if sharp thorns are round you and you are living among scorpions: Have no fear of their words and do not be overcome by their looks, for they are an uncontrolled people.

Matthew 23:33 Ye **serpents**, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?

Malachi 4:1-4 For behold, the day is coming, burning like an oven, when all the arrogant and all evildoers will be stubble. The day that is coming shall set them ablaze, says the Lord of hosts, so that it will leave them neither root nor branch. But for you who **fear my name**, the sun of righteousness shall rise with healing in its wings. You shall go out leaping like calves from the stall. And you shall tread down the wicked, for they will be ashes under **the soles of your feet**, on the day when I act, says the Lord of hosts. **Remember the law of my servant Moses**, the statutes and rules that I commanded him at Horeb for all Israel.

Revelation 12:15-17 And the serpent **cast out of his mouth** water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth. And the dragon was wroth with **the woman**, and went to make war with **the remnant of her seed**, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Yeshua HaMashiach.



Luke 12:34-39 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning; And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately. Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching, verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them. And if he shall come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. And this know, that if the goodman of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through.

Malachi 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the great and awesome day of the Lord comes.

Deuteronomy 8:1 The whole commandment that I command you today you shall be careful to do, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land that the Lord swore to give to your fathers.

Deuteronomy 8:2,3 You shall remember all the way which the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, to prove you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments, or not. He humbled you, and allowed you to be hungry, and fed you with manna, which you didn't know, neither did your fathers know; that he might make you know that man does not live by bread only, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD.

Deuteronomy 8:6-8 Therefore **you shall keep the commandments of the LORD** your God, **to walk in his ways, and to fear him**. For the LORD your God brings you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills, A land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates, a land of oil olive, and honey.

Deuteronomy 8:10 When **you have eaten and are full**, **then you shall bless** the LORD your God for the good land which he has given you.

Deuteronomy 8:11-18 Beware that you forget not the LORD your God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command you this day. Lest when you have eaten and are full, and have built goodly houses, and dwelled therein, And when your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold is multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied, Then your heart be lifted up, and you forget the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, Who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought you forth water out of the rock of flint, Who



fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers knew not, that he might humble you, and that he might prove you, to do you good at your latter end, And you say in your heart, **My power and the might of my hand has gotten me this wealth**. But you shall remember the LORD your God: For it is he that gives you power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 9:4-6 Speak not you in your heart, after that the LORD your God has cast them out from before you, saying, For my righteousness the LORD has brought me in to possess this land: But for the wickedness of these nations the LORD does drive them out from before you. Not for your righteousness, or for the uprightness of your heart, do you go to possess their land: But for the wickedness of these nations the LORD your God does drive them out from before you, and that he may perform the word which the LORD swore to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Understand therefore, that the LORD your God gives you not this good land to possess it for your righteousness; for you are a stiff necked people.

Deuteronomy 10:12,13 And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to <u>fear the LORD your God</u>, <u>to walk</u> in all **his ways**, and **to love him**, and **to serve the LORD your God** with **all your heart and with all your soul**, To **keep the commandments of the LORD**, and **his statutes**, which I command you this day <u>for your good?</u>

Isaiah 33:5,6 The LORD is exalted, for he dwells on high; he will fill Zion with justice and righteousness, and he will be the stability of your times, abundance of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge; **the fear of the LORD is Zion's treasure**.

Deuteronomy 28:12 The LORD will **open to you his good treasury**, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands. And you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.

Deuteronomy 10:17,18 For the LORD your God is <u>God of gods and Lord of lords</u>, <u>the great, the mighty, and the awesome God</u>, who is not partial and takes no bribe. He <u>executes justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the sojourner</u>, giving him food and clothing.

Deuteronomy 11:10-12 For the land, where you go in to possess it, is not as the land of Egypt, from where you came out, where you sowed your seed, and watered it with your foot, as a garden of herbs: But the land, where you go to possess it, is a land of hills and valleys, and drinks water of the rain of heaven: A land which the LORD your God cares for: The eyes of the LORD your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year even to the end of the year.



Deuteronomy 11:13-17 And if you will indeed obey my commandments that I command you today, to love the LORD your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul, he will give the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the later rain, that you may gather in your grain and your wine and your oil. And he will give grass in your fields for your livestock, and you shall eat and be full. Take care lest your heart be deceived, and you turn aside and serve other gods and worship them, then the anger of the LORD will be kindled against you, **and he will shut up the heavens, so that there will be no rain, and the land will yield no fruit, and you will perish quickly off the good land that the LORD is giving you.**

Deuteronomy 11:22-25 For if you will be careful to do all this commandment that I command you to do, loving the Lord your God, walking in all his ways, and holding fast to him, then the Lord will drive out all these nations before you, and you will dispossess nations greater and mightier than you. Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours. Your territory shall be from the wilderness to the Lebanon and from the River, the river Euphrates, to the western sea. No one shall be able to stand against you. The Lord your God will lay the fear of you and the dread of you on all the land that you shall tread, as he promised you.

John 14:4-6 Where I go, you know, and you know the way. Thomas said to him, Lord, we don't know where you are going. How can we know the way? Yeshua said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life.

Psalm 119:1 Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law(Torah) of the LORD.

Psalm 119:142 Thy righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and your law(Torah) is the truth.

Proverbs 13:14 The law(Torah) of the wise is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

Haftarah:

Isaiah 49:13-16 Sing, O heavens, and be joyful, O earth, and break forth into singing, O mountains: For the LORD <u>has comforted his people</u>, and will have mercy on his afflicted. But **Zion** said, The LORD has forsaken me, and my Lord has forgotten me. Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? Yes, they may forget, yet will I not forget you. Behold, <u>I have graven you on the palms of my hands</u>, your walls are continually before me.

Isaiah 51:1-4 Listen to me, you that follow after righteousness, you that seek the LORD: **Look to the rock from where you are hewn**, and to the hole of the pit from where you are dig. **Look to Abraham** your father, and to Sarah that bore you: For I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him. For the LORD shall comfort



Zion: He will comfort all her waste places, and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD, joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody. Listen to me, my people, and give ear to me, O my nation: For a *law* shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a *light* of the people.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp, and the **Torah is light.**

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED BIBLICAL THINKING

Acts 13:14,15 But when they departed from Perga, they came <u>to Antioch in Pisidia</u>, and went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and sat down. And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, Ye men and brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

Acts 13:42-44 And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath. Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God. And the next sabbath day came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God.

Acts 14:1 And it came to pass **in Iconium**, that they went both together into the synagogue of the Jews, and so spoke, that a great multitude both of the Jews and also of the Greeks believed.

Acts 17:2 And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures,

Acts 17:4 And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas, and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

Acts 18:4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

Acts 7:38 This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spoke to him in the mount Sina, and with our fathers: Who received the lively oracles to give unto us.

Acts 19:32 Some therefore cried one thing, and some another: For the assembly was confused, and the more part knew not wherefore they were come together.

Acts 19:39 But if ye enquire anything concerning other matters, it shall be determined in a lawful assembly.

Acts 19:41 And when he had thus spoken, he dismissed the assembly.

Genesis 4:25 And Adam knew his wife again, and she bare a son, and called his name Seth: For God, said she, hath appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew.

Exodus 12:15 Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread, even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: For whosoever eats leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

John 2:13-15 And the Jews' Passover was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem, And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting: And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen, and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables.

Matthew 26:59,60 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death, But found none: Yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses.

Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this man.

Luke 23:15 No, nor yet Herod: For I sent you to him; and, lo, nothing worthy of death **is done unto him.**

Luke 23:41 And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds: But this man hath done nothing amiss.

Matt 26:30 And when they had sung a hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives

Psalm 41:9 Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up **his heel** against me.

John 13:18 I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen, but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me.
