## TORAH PORTION

**Deuteronomy 21:10** When you go to war against your enemies.

**Deuteronomy 21:15-17** *If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated, and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he makes his sons to inherit that which he has, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn: But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated for the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath for he is the beginning of his strength.*

**Deuteronomy 22:1-3** You shall not see your brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide yourself from them: You shall in any case bring them again to your brother. And if your brother be not near to you, or if you know him not, then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall be with you until your brother seek after it, and you shall restore it to him again. In like manner shall you do **with his ass**, and **so shall you do with his raiment**, and **with all lost things** of your brother's, **which he has lost, and you have found**, shall you do likewise: you **may not hide yourself**.

**Exodus 23:5** If you see **the ass** of him that hates you lying under his burden, and would forbear to help him, you **shall surely help** with him.

**Deuteronomy 22:4** You shall not see your brother's ass or his ox fall down by the way, and **hide yourself** from them: You **shall surely help him** to lift them up again.

**Deuteronomy 22:6,7** If a bird's nest chance to be before you in the way in any tree, or on the ground, whether they be young ones, or eggs, and the dam sitting on the young, or on the eggs, you shall not take the dam with the young: But you shall in any wise let the dam go, and take the young to you, that it may be well with you, and **that you may prolong your days**.

**Luke 13:34,35** Jerusalem, Jerusalem, that kills the prophets, and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, **like a hen gathers her own brood** under her wings, and you refused! Behold, your house is left to you desolate. I tell you, you will not see me, until you say, Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

**Deuteronomy 22:8** When you build a new house, then **you shall** make a battlement for your roof, that you bring not blood on your house, if any man fall from there.

**Deuteronomy 23:7,8** You shall not abhor an Edomite, for he is your brother! You shall **not abhor an Egyptian**, because you were a stranger in his land. The children that are begotten of them shall enter into the congregation of the LORD **in their third generation.**

**Deuteronomy 23:21–23** When you shall vow a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not slack to pay it: For the LORD your God will surely require it of you, and it would be sin in you. But if you shall forbear to vow, it shall be no sin in you. **That which is gone out of your lips you shall keep and perform**, even a freewill offering, according as you have vowed to the LORD your God, which you have promised with your mouth.

**Deuteronomy 23:24,25** When you come into your neighbor's vineyard, then you may eat grapes your fill at your own pleasure, but you shall not put any in your vessel. When you come into the standing corn of your neighbor, then you may pluck the ears with your hand, but you shall not move a sickle to your neighbor's standing corn.

**Matthew 12:1,2** At that time, Yeshua went on the Sabbath day through the grain fields. His disciples were hungry and began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. But the Pharisees, when they saw it, said to him, Behold, your disciples do what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath.

**Deuteronomy 24:9** Remember what the LORD your God did to Miriam by the way, after that you were come forth out of Egypt.

**Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue: And they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

**Proverbs 15:2-4** The tongue of the wise uses knowledge aright: But the mouth of fools pours out foolishness. **The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.** A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: But perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

**Deuteronomy 24:14,15** You shall not oppress an hired servant that is poor and needy, whether he be of your brothers, or of your strangers that are in your land within your gates: At his day you shall give him his hire, neither shall the sun go down on it, for he is poor, and sets his heart on it: Lest he cry against you to the LORD, and it be sin to you.

**Deuteronomy 24:19-22** When you cut down your harvest in your field, and have forgot a sheaf in the field, you shall not go again to fetch it: It shall be for the **stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow:** That the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands. When you

beat your olive tree, you shall not go over the boughs again: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow. When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, you shall not glean it afterward: **It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.** And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt: Therefore I command you to do this thing.

**Deuteronomy 25:4** You shall **not muzzle the ox** when he treads out the corn.

**1 Timothy 5:17,18** Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially they who labor in the word and doctrine. For the scripture said, You shall **not muzzle the ox that treads out the corn.** And, The laborer is worthy of his reward.

**Deuteronomy 25:15,16** You shall have a **perfect and just weight**, a perfect and just measure, **that your days may be lengthened** in the land which the LORD your God is giving you. For all who do such things, all who behave unrighteously, are an abomination to the LORD your God.

**Deuteronomy 25:17-19 Remember what Amalek** did to you by the way, when you were come forth out of Egypt, How he met you by the way, and smote the hindmost of you, even all that were feeble behind you, when you were faint and weary, and he feared not God. Therefore, it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from all your enemies round about, in the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance to possess it, that you shall blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven, you shall not forget it.

**Isaiah 54:1-3** Sing, O barren, you that did not bear, break forth into singing, and cry aloud, you that did not travail with child: For more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, said the LORD. Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of your habitations: Spare not, lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes, For you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left, and your seed **shall inherit the Gentiles,** and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

**Isaiah 54:5-7** For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name, and your Redeemer the Holy One **of Israel,** The God of the whole earth shall he be called. For the LORD has called you as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when you were refused, said your God. For a small moment have I forsaken you, but **with great mercies will I gather you.**

**Isaiah 54:8-10** In a little wrath I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on you, said the LORD your Redeemer.

For this is **as the waters of Noah** to me: For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed, but my kindness shall not depart from you, **neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, said the LORD that has mercy on you.**

**Malachi 3:7** Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances and have not kept them. **Return unto me, and I will return unto you,** saith the LORD of hosts.

**Matthew 24:27,28** For **as the lightning** cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For wheresoever the carcass is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

**Matthew 24:7** For **nation shall rise against nation**, and kingdom against kingdom: And there shall be famines, and pestilences, and **earthquakes**, in divers places.

**Matthew 24:32-34** Now learn a parable of the fig tree, When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.**

### REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED BIBLICAL THINKING

#### *Day of Judgment*

**Psalm 98:6-9** With **trumpets** and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD, the King. Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof, the world, and they that dwell therein. Let the floods clap their hands: Let the hills be joyful together. Before the LORD, for **he cometh to judge the earth**: With righteousness shall he **judge the world**, and the people with equity.

**2 Corinthians 5:10** For we must all appear before the **judgment seat of Christ**, that everyone may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

**1 Samuel 8:9** Now then, obey their voice, only you shall solemnly warn them and show them the ways of the king who shall reign over them.

**1 Corinthians 3:13-15** Every man's work shall be made manifest: For **the day** shall declare it, because it shall be revealed **by fire, and the fire** shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built

thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: But he **himself shall be saved**, yet so as **by fire**.

**Daniel 7:10,11** **A fiery stream** issued and came forth from before him: Thousand thousands ministered unto him, and **ten thousand (10,000) times ten thousand (10,000)** stood before him: **The judgment was set, and the books were opened**. I beheld then **because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake**: I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the **burning flame**.

**Revelation 5:11-13** And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: And the number of them was **ten thousand (10,000) times ten thousand (10,000)**, and thousands of thousands **Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power**, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, **Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne**, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

**Psalms 24:7** Lift up your heads, O gates! And be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the **King of glory may come in**.

**Revelation 20:11,12** And I saw a great **white throne**, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away, and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God, and **the books were opened**: And **another book was opened**, which is the **book of life**: And the dead were judged out of those things which were **written in the books**, according to their works.

**Revelation 4:1-4,9-11** After this I looked, and, behold, **a door was opened in heaven**: And the **first voice** which I heard was as it were of a **trumpet** talking with me, which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter. And immediately I was in the spirit: And, behold, **a throne was set in heaven**, and one **sat on the throne**. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: And there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald. And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: And upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment, and **they had on their heads crowns of gold**. And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks to him that **sat on the throne**, who lives forever and ever, The four and twenty elders fall down before him **that sat on the throne**, and worship him that lives for ever and ever, **and cast their crowns before the throne**, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive

glory and honor and power: For thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

**Revelation 5:6-8** I saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, having seven horns, and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth. Then he came, and he took it out of the right hand of him who sat on the throne. Now when he had taken the book, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each one having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the holy ones.

**Daniel 7:13,14** I saw in the night visions, and behold, there came with the clouds of the sky one like a son of man, and he came even to the ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. There was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that **all the peoples, nations, and languages should serve him**: His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

**Matthew 24:30** And then shall appear the sign of **the Son of man in heaven**: And then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

**Revelation 14:14-16** And I looked, and **behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle**. And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to **him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: For the time is come for thee to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe**. And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

**Revelation 14:17-20** And **another angel** came out of the temple, which is in heaven, he **also having a sharp sickle**. And **another angel** came out from the altar, which had power over fire, and cried with a loud cry **to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe**. And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. And **the winepress** was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the **winepress**, even unto the **horse bridles**, by the space of a **thousand and six hundred furlongs**.

**Isaiah 63:2-4** Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat? **I have trodden the winepress alone**, and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury, and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment. For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and **the year of my redeemed** is come.

**Isaiah 63:7,8** I will mention the lovingkindnesses of the **LORD**, and the praises of the **LORD**, according to all that the **LORD** hath bestowed on us, and the great goodness *toward the house of Israel*, which he hath bestowed on them according to his mercies, and according to the multitude of his lovingkindnesses. For he said, Surely **they are My people**, children that will not lie: so He was their **Savior**.

**Psalms 2:6,7** Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion. **I will declare the decree**: The LORD hath said unto me, You art my Son, this day have I begotten you.

**2 Samuel 5:3** So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron, and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: And they **anointed David king** over Israel.

**1 Kings 1:39,40,45,46** And Zadok the priest took a horn of oil out of the tabernacle, and **anointed Solomon**. And they blew the trumpet, and all the people said, **God save king Solomon**. And all the people came up after him, and the people piped with pipes, and **rejoiced with great joy, so that the earth rent with the sound of them**. And Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet have anointed him king in Gihon: and they are come up from thence rejoicing, so that the city rang again. This is the noise that ye have heard.

**Genesis 49:10** The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come, and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

**Hebrews 1:8** But unto the Son he saith, **Thy throne**, O God, is for ever and ever: A scepter of righteousness is the **scepter of thy kingdom**.

**1 Kings 1:34** And let Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anoint him there king over Israel: And blow ye with the trumpet, and say, **God save king Solomon**.



**2 Kings 11:12** And he brought forth the king's son, and put the crown upon him, and gave him the testimony, and they made him king, and anointed him, and they clapped their hands, and said, **God save the king.**

**Psalm 50:4,5** He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that he may **judge his people**. Gather my saints together unto me, those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice.

**Psalm 47:1-4** **O clap your hands**, all ye people, **shout unto God** with the voice of triumph. For the LORD most high is terrible, **he is a great King** over all the earth. He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet. He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah.

**Psalm 47:5** God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.

**Psalm 47:6,7** Sing praises to God, sing praises: Sing praises unto our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth: Sing ye praises with understanding.

**Psalm 47:8** God reigns over the heathen: God **sits upon the throne** of his holiness.

**Psalm 47:9** The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: For the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

**Joel 3:12-14** Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about. **Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: Come, get you down, for the press is full, the fats overflow, for their wickedness is great. **Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision**: for the day of the LORD is near **in the valley of decision**.**

**Joel 3:18** And it shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down **new wine**.

**Acts 2:41** Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: And the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

**Acts 4:4** Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed, and the number of the men was about five thousand.
