TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 26:1,2 And it shall be, when you come into the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance, and possess it, and live in it, you shall take of the <u>first</u> of all the <u>fruit of the earth</u> which you shall bring of your land that the LORD your God gives you, and you shall put it in a basket, and shall go to the place which the LORD your God shall choose to place His name there.

Deuteronomy 26:3,4 And thou shalt go unto the priest that shall be in those days, and say unto him, **I profess** this day unto the LORD thy God, that **I am come** unto the country which the LORD swore unto our fathers for to give us. And the priest shall take the basket out of thine hand and set it down before the altar of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 26:10 And now, behold, I have brought the first fruits of the land,

John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except **a grain** of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abides alone: But if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the first fruits of them that slept.

Leviticus 23:10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the **first fruits** of your harvest unto the priest.

Psalm 30:1 I will extol thee, O LORD, for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

Psalm 30:3 O LORD, you have brought up my soul from the grave: You have kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

Deuteronomy 26:8-11 And the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terribleness, and with signs, and with wonders: And he hath brought us into this place, and hath given us **this land**, even a land that floweth with milk and honey. And now, behold, I have brought the *firstfruits* of the land, which thou, O LORD, hast given me. And thou shalt set it before the LORD thy God, and worship before the LORD thy God: And thou shalt rejoice in every good thing which the LORD thy God hath given unto thee, and unto thine house, thou, and the Levite, and the stranger that is among you.



Deuteronomy 26:16-19 <u>Today</u> the LORD your God has commanded you to do these statutes and judgments. You therefore <u>shall keep and do them</u> with all your heart and with all your soul. <u>You have today said that the LORD is your God</u>, and that you would **walk in His ways**, and <u>keep His statutes and His commandments and His</u>

<u>judgments</u>, <u>and listen</u> to His voice. And <u>the LORD has taken you today to be</u> <u>His peculiar people</u>, as He has promised you, and to <u>keep all His commandments</u>, and to make you high above all nations which he has made, in praise and in name and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the LORD your God, even as He has spoken.

Deuteronomy 27:9,10 And Moses and the priests the Levites spoke to all Israel, saying: Take heed and listen, O Israel. **Today** <u>you have become the people of the LORD your God</u>. You shall therefore obey the voice of the LORD your God, and do His commandments and His statutes which I command you **today**.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these **blessings** shall come on thee, **and overtake thee**, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

Deuteronomy 28:8,9 The Lord shall **command the blessing** upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto, and he shall **bless** thee in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. The Lord shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, <u>if thou shalt keep the</u> commandments of the Lord thy God, and walk in his ways.

Deuteronomy 28:13 And the Lord shall <u>make thee the head, and not the tail</u>, and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath, if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the Lord thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them.

Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, **if thou wilt not hearken** unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day, that **all these curses shall come upon thee**, and overtake thee.

Deuteronomy 28:45-47 All these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and **overtake you** till you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your



offspring forever. Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, because of the abundance of all things.

Deuteronomy 27;25,26 Cursed be he that taketh reward to slay an innocent person. And all the people shall say, Amen. <u>Cursed be he that confirmeth not all the words of this law to do them. And all the people shall say, Amen.</u>

Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: For it is written, Cursed is every one that continue not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

Deuteronomy 27:19-24 Cursed be he that perverts the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his father's wife, because he uncovereth his father's skirt. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with any manner of beast. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his sister, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his mother-in-law. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that smiteth his neighbor secretly. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Deuteronomy 29:19,20 And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst: The Lord will not spare him, but then the anger of the Lord and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the Lord shall blot out his name from under heaven.

Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: For, The just shall live by faith.

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: But the just shall live by his faith.

Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropes in darkness,

Matthew 27:45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.

Amos 8:9,10 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day: And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into



<u>lamentation</u>, and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head, and I will make it as the mourning of an <u>only son</u>, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

Isaiah 60:1-3 Arise, shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: But the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

Isaiah 60:5 Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged, because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

Isaiah 60:11,12 Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought. For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish, yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.

Isaiah 60:14 The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come **bending unto thee**, and all they that despised thee shall **bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet**, and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

Replacement Theology

<u>Jeremiah 31</u>:5,6 Again you shall plant vineyards on the mountains of Samaria, the planters shall plant and shall enjoy the fruit. For there shall be a day when <u>watchmen</u> will call in the hill country of Ephraim: Arise, and let us go up to Zion, to the LORD our God.

Ezekiel 36:8-11 But ye, O mountains of Israel, ye shall shoot forth your branches, and yield your fruit to my people of Israel, for they are at hand to come. For, behold, I am for you, and I will turn unto you, and ye shall be tilled and sown: And I will multiply men upon you, all the house of Israel, even all of it: And the cities shall be inhabited, and the wastes shall be builded: And I will multiply upon you man and beast, and they shall increase and bring fruit: And I will settle you after your old estates, and will do better unto you than at your beginnings: And ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Isaiah 63:2-4 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that **treadeth in the winefat? I have <u>trodden the winepress</u> alone**, and of the people there was none with me: For **I will tread them in mine anger**,



and trample them in my fury, and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment. For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

Revelation 19:14-18 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. And I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God, That ye may eat the flesh

of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Revelation 14:16-18 And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped. And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire, and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe.

Matthew 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil, the <u>harvest is the end</u> <u>of the world</u>, and the reapers are the angels.

Isaiah 62:5-7 For as a young man marries a virgin, so shall thy sons marry thee: And as the bridegroom rejoiceth over the bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee. I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace, day nor night: Ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence, And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

Joel 2:15,16 <u>Blow the trumpet</u> in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: **Let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber**, and the **bride out of her <u>closet</u>**.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches, To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows saving he that receiveth it.



Revelation 3:12 Him that overcomes will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: And I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: **And I will write upon him my new name.**

Jeremiah 23:5-6 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: And this is his name whereby **He shall be called**, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Jeremiah 33:15-16 In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David, and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land. In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall

dwell safely: And this is the name wherewith **she shall be called**, The LORD our righteousness.

Matthew 1:18,19 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily.

- **1 Peter 1:18-19** Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers, But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.
- **1 Corinthians 6:20** For ye are bought with a price: Therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Jeremiah 2:2 Go and cry in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, Thus saith the LORD, I remember thee, the kindness of thy youth, the love of thine espousals, when thou went after me in the wilderness, in a land that was not sown.

Hosea 2:19-20 And I will betroth thee unto me forever, yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies. I will even **betroth** thee unto me in faithfulness: And thou shalt know the LORD.

2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.



1 John 5:14,15 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

Genesis 24:22 And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a golden earring of half a shekel weight, and two bracelets for her hands of ten shekels weight of gold.

Genesis 24:53 And the servant brought forth jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment, and gave them to Rebekah: he gave also to her brother and to her mother precious things.

Ephesians 4:7-8 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

Genesis 24:57,58 They said, Let us call the young woman and ask her. And they called Rebekah and said to her, Will you go with this man? She said, I will go.

Exodus 24:3 And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: And all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD hath said will we do.

Romans 10:8-10 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: That is, the word of faith, which we preach, That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Ezekiel 16:8-9 Now when I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, thy time was the time of love, and I spread my skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness: Yea, I swear unto thee, and entered into a covenant with thee, saith the Lord GOD, and thou becamest mine. Then washed I thee with water, yea, I throughly washed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil.

John 14:1-4 Let not your heart be troubled: Ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: If it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself, that where I am, there ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.



Matthew 25:6-7 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh, go ye out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps.

Proverbs 7:6-9 I looked through my casement, And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding, Passing through the street near her corner, and he went the way to her house, **In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night.**

Matthew 20:11 And when they had received it, they murmured against the goodman of the house, Saying, These last have wrought but one hour, and thou hast made them equal unto us, which have borne the burden and heat of the day.
