TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 29:10-15 You stand *today*, all of you, before the LORD your God, your captains of your tribes, your elders, and your officers, all the men of Israel, your little ones, your wives, and your **stranger** that is in your camp, from the cutter of your wood to the drawer of your water, so that **you should enter into covenant** with the LORD your God, and into His oath, which the LORD your God makes you *today*, that He may establish you *today* for a people to Himself, and that He may be a God to you, as He has said to you, and as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. Nor do I make this covenant and this oath with you only, but with him who stands here with us *today* before the LORD our God, and also with him that is not here with us *today*.

Deuteronomy 29:19 And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst.

Deuteronomy 29:20,21 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law.

Deuteronomy 29:24-28 Even all nations shall say, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this land? What means the heat of this great anger? Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt: For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, gods whom they knew not, and whom he had not given unto them: And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book: And the LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may **do all the words of this law**.

Deuteronomy 30:1 And it shall be when all these things have come on you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and when you shall call them to mind לָבָב among all the nations where the LORD your God has driven you.

Deuteronomy 30:2 and shall return שׁוּב to the LORD your God and shall obey His voice according to all that I command you today, you and your sons, with all your heart, and with all your soul.

Deuteronomy 30:3,4 Then the LORD your God will **turn** שׁוּב your captivity. And He will have compassion on you, and **will return** שׁוּב and gather you from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you. If you are driven out into the outermost parts of the heavens, the LORD your God will gather you from there, and He will bring you from there.

Deuteronomy 30:5 And the LORD your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. And He will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers.

Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD your God **will circumcise your heart and the heart** of your seed, to love the LORD your God with **all your heart and with all your soul**, so that you may live.

Deuteronomy 30:7-10 And the LORD your God will **put all these curses on your foes and enemies who persecuted you.** And you shall again obey the voice of the LORD and keep all his commandments **that I command you today.** The LORD your God will make you abundantly prosperous in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your womb and in the fruit of your cattle and in the fruit of your ground. For the LORD will again take delight in prospering you, as he took delight in your fathers, when you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that are written in this Book of the Law, when **you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.**

Deuteronomy 30:11-16 **For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off.** It is not in heaven, that you should say, Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it. See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil. If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Deuteronomy 30:19,20 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live, loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, **I am an hundred and twenty years old this day.**

Deuteronomy 31:6-8 **Be strong and of good courage**, fear not, nor be affrighted at them, for the LORD thy God, He it is that doth go with thee, He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. And Moses called unto Joshua, and said unto him in the sight of all Israel: **Be strong and of good courage**, for thou shalt go with this people into the land which the LORD hath sworn unto their fathers to give them, and thou shalt cause them to inherit it. And the LORD, He it is that doth go before thee, He will be with thee, He will not fail thee, neither forsake thee; fear not, neither be dismayed.

Deuteronomy 31:10-12 And Moses commanded them, saying, At **the end of every seven years**, in the solemnity of **the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles**, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD your God **in the place which he shall choose**, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the people together, men and women, and children, **and your stranger** that is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and **to do all the words of this law.**

Deuteronomy 31:17-19 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and **I will hide** my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall come on them, so that they will say in that day, Haven't these evils come on us because our God is not **among us?** **I will surely hide** my face in that day for all the evil which they shall have worked, in that they are turned to other gods. **Now therefore write this song for yourselves**, and teach it to the children of Israel: put it in their mouths, **that this song may be a witness for me** against the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 31:20-23 For when **I have brought them into the land** flowing with milk and honey, which I swore to give to their fathers, and **they have eaten and are full and grown fat**, they will turn to other gods and serve them, and despise me and break my covenant. And when *many evils and troubles have come upon them*, this song shall confront them as a witness (for it will live unforgotten in the mouths of their offspring). **For I know what they are inclined to do even today, before I have brought them into the land that I swore to give.** So Moses wrote this song the same day and taught it to the people of Israel. And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said: **Be strong and of good courage**, for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I swore unto them; and I will be with thee.

Deuteronomy 31:28-30 Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to record against them. **For I know that after my death** you will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you, and evil will befall you in the latter days, because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to

anger through the work of your hands. And **Moses spoke in the ears of all the congregation of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended.**

Isaiah 61:4,5 And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations. **And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.**

Isaiah 61:8,9 For I the Lord love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering, and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. And **their seed shall be known among the Gentiles**, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that **they are the seed** which the Lord hath blessed.

Isaiah 62:10-12 Go through, Go through the gates! Prepare the way for the people, Build up, Build up the highway! Take out the stones, Lift up a banner for the peoples! Indeed the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world: Say to the daughter of Zion, Surely your **salvation**(Yeshua) **is coming**, **Behold, His reward is with Him**, **And His work before Him.** And they shall call them The Holy People, The Redeemed of the LORD, And you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.

Revelation 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly, and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am the Aleph and the Tav, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

Replacement Theology Yom Kippur

Exodus 28:4 And these are the garments which they shall make, a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a brodered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: And they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Leviticus 16:4 He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches upon his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen mitre shall he be attired: These are holy garments, therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and so put them on.

Leviticus 16:8-11 And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats, one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat. And Aaron shall bring the goat upon which the LORD's lot fell, and offer him for a sin offering. But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness. And Aaron

shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which is for himself.

Leviticus 16:12-15 And he shall take a *censer full of burning coals of fire from off the altar* before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring it within the vail: And he shall ***put the incense upon the fire before the LORD***, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not: And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward, and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger *seven times*. Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat.

Psalms 141:2 Let my *prayer be set forth before thee as incense*, and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

Leviticus 16:2 And the LORD said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: For I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat.

Leviticus 16:34 And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year.

Revelation 6:9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost **thou not judge and avenge our blood** on them that dwell on the earth?

Revelation 8:3-6 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer, and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the *golden altar which was before the throne*. And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. And the **angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth**: And there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake. And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

Revelation 11:15-19 And the seventh angel sounded, and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ, and he shall reign for ever and ever. And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come, because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned. And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great, and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. **And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament:** And there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Leviticus 16:16,17 And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: And so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remains among them in the midst of their uncleanness. And **there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement** in the holy place, **until he come out**, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

Revelation 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power, and **no man was able to enter into the temple, until the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.**

Genesis 45:1 And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.

Ezekiel 20:33-35 As I live, saith the Lord GOD, surely with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out, will I rule over you: And I will bring you out from the people, and will gather you out of the countries wherein ye are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out. And **I will bring you into the wilderness** of the people, and there will I plead with you **face to face.**

Genesis 45:6 For these two years hath the famine been in the land: And yet there are five years, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest.

Isaiah 25:7,8 And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the veil that is spread over all nations. He will swallow up death in victory, and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces, and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: For the LORD hath spoken it.

Zechariah 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: And **they shall look upon me whom they have pierced,** and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

John 19:37 And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced.

Revelation 19:2,13-15 For **true and righteous are his judgments**: For he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: And his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the *winepress* of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Deuteronomy 32:4 He is the Rock, his work is perfect: For all his ways are judgment: A God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

2 Corinthians 3:13-16 And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not steadfastly look to the end of that which is abolished: But their minds were blinded: For until this day remains the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament, which vail is done away in Christ. But even unto this day, when Moses is read, **the vail is upon their heart.** Nevertheless, when it shall turn to the Lord, the veil shall be taken away.

Revelation 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds, and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: And all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

Genesis 41:1 And it came to pass at the end of **two full years**, that Pharaoh dreamed: And, behold, he stood by the river.

Genesis 45:6 For these **two years** hath the famine been in the land: And yet there are **five years**, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest.

Genesis 42:8 And Joseph knew his brethren, but they knew not him.

Luke 12:35-37 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning, And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding, that when he *cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately.* **Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: Verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.**

Matthew 8:11,12 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom

of heaven. But the **children of the kingdom** shall be cast out into outer darkness: There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Zephaniah 1:7,8 Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord GOD: For **the day of the LORD is at hand**: For the LORD hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath bid his guests. And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD's sacrifice, that **I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.**

Zephaniah 1:14 The great day of the LORD is near, it is near, and hasteth greatly, even the voice of the day of the LORD: The mighty man shall cry there bitterly.

Matthew 22:1-5,8-11 And Jesus answered and spoke unto them again by parables, and said, The kingdom of heaven is like unto **a certain king, which made a marriage for his son**, And sent forth his servants to call them **that were bidden** to the wedding: And they would not come. Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them **which are bidden**, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: My oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: Come unto the marriage. But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise: Then saith he to his servants, The wedding is ready, but they which **were bidden were not worthy**. Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage. So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, **both bad and good**: And the wedding was furnished with guests. And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which **had not on a wedding garment**.

Luke 14:16-24 Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many: And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come, for all things are now ready. And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come. So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind. And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room. And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled. For I say unto you, That **none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper**.

Ezekiel 4:6 And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days: **I have appointed thee each day for a year.**
