## TORAH PORTION

**Genesis 21:1,2** And the LORD visited Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did unto Sarah as he had spoken. For Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age, **at the <u>set time</u>** of which God had spoken to him.

**Genesis 21:4,5** And Abraham circumcised his son Isaac being eight days old, as God had commanded him. And Abraham was a hundred years old, when his son Isaac was born unto him.

**Genesis 21:6** And Sarah said, God hath made me to laugh, so that all that hear will laugh with me.

**Genesis 21:14** And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave it unto Hagar, putting it on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered **in the wilderness of <u>Beersheba.</u>** 

**Genesis 21:16,17** And she went, and sat her down over against him a good way off, as it were a bowshot: for she said, Let me not see the death of the child. And she sat over against him, and **lift up her voice,** and wept. And God heard <u>the voice of the lad</u>, and the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven, and said unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? Fear not, for God hath heard <u>the voice of the lad</u> where he is.

**Genesis 21:19-21** And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water, and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the lad drink. And God was with the lad, and he grew, and dwelt in the wilderness, and became an archer. And he dwelt in the **wilderness of Paran**: And his mother took him a wife out of the land of Egypt.

**Genesis 21:27-34** And Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech, and both of them made a covenant. And Abraham set seven ewe lambs of the flock by themselves. And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What mean these seven ewe lambs which thou hast set by themselves? And he said, For these seven ewe lambs shalt thou take of my hand, that they may be a witness unto me, that I have digged this well. Wherefore he called that place **Beersheba**, because there they sware both of them. Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: Then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines. And Abraham planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God. And Abraham sojourned in the Philistines' land many days.

**Genesis 22:1** Now after these things, God put Abraham to the test, and said to him, Abraham, and he said, Here am I. And he said to him, Take your son, your dearly loved only son Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah and give him as a burned offering on one of the mountains of which I will give you knowledge.



Genesis 22:4,5 And on the third day, Abraham, lifting up his eyes, saw the place a long way off. Then he said to his young men, Keep here with the ass, and I and the boy will go on and give worship and come back again to you.

Genesis 22:14 And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: As it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

**Jeremiah 31:3-7** The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: Therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. Again I will build thee, and thou shalt be built, O virgin of Israel: thou shalt again be adorned with thy tabrets, and shalt go forth in the dances of them that make merry. Thou shalt yet plant vines upon the mountains of Samaria: The planters shall plant, and shall eat them as common things. For there shall be a day, that the **watchmen** upon the mount Ephraim shall cry, Arise ye, and let us go up to Zion unto the LORD our God. For thus saith the LORD, Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout among the chief of the nations: Publish ye, praise ye, and say, O LORD, save thy people, the remnant of Israel.

**1 Samuel 1:1** Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah.

**1 Samuel 1:3** And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, were there.

**1 Samuel 1:20** Wherefore it came to pass, when the time was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and called his name **Samuel**, saying, Because I have asked him of the LORD.

**1 Samuel 1:25-27** And they slew a bullock, and brought the child to Eli. And she said, Oh my lord, as thy soul liveth, my lord, I am the woman that stood by thee here, praying unto the LORD. For this child I prayed, and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of him.

**1 Samuel 2:2,3** There is none holy as the LORD: For there is none beside thee: Neither is there any rock like our God. Talk no more so exceeding proudly, let not arrogancy come out of your mouth: For the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.

**1 Samuel 2:6,7** The LORD killeth, and maketh alive: He bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up. The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: He bringeth low, and lifted up.



**Luke 1:38-40** And Mary said: I am the servant of the Lord, may it be to me as you say. And the angel went away. Then Mary got up and went quickly into the high lands, to a town of Judah, And went into the house of Zacharias and took Elisabeth in her arms.

Matthew 24:30,31 And then the sign of the Son of man will be seen in heaven: And then all the nations of the earth will have sorrow, and they will see the Son of man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he will send out his angels with a great sound of a horn, and they will get his saints together from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Leviticus 23:23 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

Numbers 29:1 And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation, ye shall do no servile work: It is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you.

Matthew 2:23 And he came and dwelt in a city <u>called Nazareth</u>: That it might be fulfilled which was **spoken by the prophets**, **He shall be called a Nazarene**.

**Isaiah 11:1** And there shall come forth a rod out of **the stem of Jesse**, and <u>a Branch</u> shall grow out of his roots: And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Matthew 2:14,15 When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: And was there until the death of Herod: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, <u>Out of Egypt</u> have I called my son.

Hosea 11:1 When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.

**Deuteronomy 18:15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet** from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken.

John 7:40-43 Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, Of a truth this is **the Prophet**. Others said, This is **the Messiah**! But some said, Shall **Messiah come out of Galilee**? Has not the scripture said, **That Messiah comes of the seed of David**, and **out of <u>the town of Bethlehem</u>**, where David was? <u>So there was a division among the people</u> because of him.



Micah 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel, whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

**Matthew 2:4-6** And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born. And they said unto him, **In Bethlehem of Judaea**: for thus it is written by the prophet, And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Judah: For out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.

### REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED BIBLICAL THINKING Feast of Tabernacles

**Luke 1:5** There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest named Zechariah, of the <u>priestly division of Abijah</u>. He had a wife of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elisheva.

Luke 1:8,9 Now it happened, while he executed the priest's office before God in the order of his division, according to the custom of the priest's office, his lot was to enter into the temple of the Lord and burn incense.

**1 Chronicles 24:1,2 19** Now these are the divisions of the sons of Aaron. The sons of Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar. But Nadab and Abihu died before their father, and had no children: therefore Eleazar and Ithamar executed the priest's office.

1 Chronicles 24:10 The seventh to Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah.

**1 Chronicles 24:19** These were the orderings of them in their service to come into the house of the LORD, <u>according to their manner</u>, under Aaron their father, as the LORD God of Israel had commanded him.

**Deuteronomy 16:16** Three times a year all your males shall appear before the Lord your God at the place that he will choose: At the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Booths.

**Luke 1:10,11** And <u>the whole multitude</u> of the people were praying without at the time of incense. And there appeared to him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense.



Luke 1:23,24 It happened, when the days of his service were fulfilled, he departed to his house. After these days Elisheva, his wife, conceived, and she hid herself five months,

**Luke 1:26** Now in <u>the sixth month</u>, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee, named Nazareth.

**Luke 1:35,36** The angel answered her, The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore also the holy one who is born from you will be called the Son of God. Behold, Elisheva, your relative, also has conceived a son in her old age, and this <u>is the sixth month</u> with her who was called barren.

Luke 1:56 Miriam stayed with her about <u>three months</u>, and then returned to her house.

Luke 2:6,7 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him <u>in swaddling clothes</u>, and laid him in a manger, because there was <u>no room for them in the inn.</u>

**Exodus 15:2** The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: He is my God, and <u>I will prepare him an habitation</u>, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

**Psalm 118:14,15a** The LORD is my strength and song, and is <u>become my salvation</u>. The voice of rejoicing and <u>salvation</u> is in the tabernacles of the righteous.

**Psalm 118:24,25** This is the day which the LORD has made, <u>we will rejoice</u> and be glad in it. Save now, I beseech you, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech you, send now prosperity.

**Luke 2:8-11** There were shepherds in the same country staying in the field, and keeping watch by night over their flock. Behold, an angel of the Lord stood by them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. The angel said to them, Don't be afraid, for behold, I bring you good news <u>of great joy</u> which will be to all the people. For there is born to you, this day, in the city of David, a <u>Savior</u>, who is Messiah the Lord.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and tabernacled among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.



**Luke 2:13** And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

**Luke 2:21** When <u>eight days were fulfilled for the circumcision</u> of the child, his name was called Yeshua, which was given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

### In the Temple shedding his blood confirming the covenant to Abraham

**Luke 2:22-24** When the days of their purification according to the Torah of Moses were fulfilled, they brought him up to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord (as it is written in the Torah of the Lord, Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord, and to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the Torah of the Lord, <u>A pair of turtledoves</u>, or two young pigeons.

Leviticus 12:6,8a And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring <u>a lamb of the first year</u> for a burnt offering, <u>and a young pigeon</u>, <u>or a turtledove</u>, for a sin offering, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, to the priest: And if <u>she be not able to bring a lamb</u>, then she shall bring <u>two turtles</u>, <u>or two young pigeons</u>, the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: And the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

**Leviticus 23:33** The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, and say, On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of booths for <u>seven</u> <u>days</u> to the LORD.

**Deuteronomy 16:13-15** You shall observe **the feast of tabernacles** seven days, after that you have gathered in your corn and your wine: And <u>you shall rejoice</u> in your feast, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are within your gates. Seven days shall you keep a solemn feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD shall choose: Because the LORD your God shall bless you in all your increase, and in all the works of your hands, therefore <u>you shall surely rejoice</u>.

**Leviticus 23:40** You shall take on the first day the <u>fruit of goodly trees</u>, branches of palm trees, and boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook, and **you shall rejoice before the LORD your God seven days**.

Leviticus 23:41-44 You shall keep it a feast to the LORD seven days in the year: It is a statute forever throughout your generations, you shall keep it in the seventh month. You shall <u>dwell in booths</u> seven days. All who are native-born in Israel shall <u>dwell in booths</u>, that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel



to **dwell in booths**, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt. I am the LORD your God. Moses declared to the children of Israel the appointed feasts of the LORD.

**Zechariah 14:14-19** And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance. And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague. And it shall come to pass, [that] every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and <u>to keep the feast of tabernacles</u>. And it shall be, [that] whoso will not come up of [all] the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that [have] no [rain], there shall be the plague, wherewith the Lord will smite the heathen that come not up <u>to keep the feast of tabernacles</u>. This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up <u>to keep the feast of tabernacles</u>.

**2 Peter 1:16** For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Yeshua HaMashiach, but were **eyewitnesses** of his majesty.

**Matthew 17:4** Then answered Peter, and said to Yeshua, Lord, it is good for us to be here: If you will, let us make here **three tabernacles**, one for you, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah.

**Exodus 25:8,9** And let them make me a sanctuary, that <u>I may dwell among them</u>. According to <u>all that I show you</u>, <u>after the pattern</u> of <u>the tabernacle</u>, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall you make it.

**Revelation 21:1-4** And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: For the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John <u>saw the holy</u> city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, <u>the tabernacle of God is with men</u>, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: For the former things are passed away.

**Numbers 29:12,13a** On the fifteenth day of the seventh month you shall have a holy convocation. You shall not do any ordinary work, and you shall keep a feast to the Lord seven days. And you shall offer a burnt offering, a food offering, with a pleasing aroma to the Lord, **thirteen bulls** from the herd.
