TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 31:30 And Moses spoke in the ears of all the congregation of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended.

Deuteronomy 32:1 Give ear, O you heavens, and I will speak, and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

Deuteronomy 32:3,4 Because I will publish the name of the LORD: <u>Ascribe you greatness</u> to our God. <u>He is the Rock, his work is perfect</u>: For all his ways are **judgment**, a <u>God of **truth** and without iniquity, **just** and **right** is he.</u>

Revelation 15:3,4 And they <u>sing the song of Moses</u> the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, <u>Great and marvelous</u> are <u>your works</u>, Lord God Almighty; **just and true** are your ways, you King of saints. Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and **glorify** your name? For you only are holy: For all nations shall come and worship before you, for **your judgments** are made manifest.

Revelations 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

Psalm 19:1-4 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

Psalm 148:3-5 Praise ye Him, **sun and moon**, praise Him, **all ye stars** of light. Praise Him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that are above the heavens. Let them praise the name of the LORD, for He commanded, and they were created.

Revelation 5:11-13 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: And the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Deuteronomy 32:5 They have dealt corruptly with him. They are not his children, because of their defect. They are a perverse and crooked generation.

Deuteronomy 32:6 Do you do this to יהוה, O foolish and unwise people? <u>Is He</u> **not your Father,** who bought you, **Who created** you and established you?



Genesis 2:4 These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth <u>when they</u> <u>were created</u>, *in the day* that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

<u>Psalm 89:26-29</u> He shall cry to me, <u>You are my father</u>, my God, and <u>the rock</u> of my salvation. Also I will make him my firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth. My mercy will I keep for him for ever more, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. <u>His seed also will I make to endure forever</u>, and his throne as the days of heaven.

Psalm 89:30-36 If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments, If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments, Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. Nevertheless my loving kindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure forever, and his throne as the sun before me.

Deuteronomy 32:10 He found him in a desert land, and in the <u>waste howling</u> <u>wilderness</u>, <u>he led him about</u>, <u>he instructed him</u>, he kept him <u>as the apple of his</u> eye.

Deuteronomy 32:15-18 But <u>Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked</u>: You are waxen fat, you are grown thick, you are covered with fatness, then <u>he forsook God which made him</u>, and lightly esteemed <u>the Rock of his salvation</u>. They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger. They sacrificed to devils, not to God, to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not. <u>Of the Rock that begat you</u>, you are unmindful, and have forgotten God that formed you.

Isaiah 1:2,3 <u>Hear</u>, O heavens, and <u>give ear</u>, O earth: For the LORD has spoken, <u>I have nourished and brought up children</u>, and <u>they have rebelled against me</u>. The ox knows his owner, and the ass his master's crib: But Israel does not know, <u>my</u> people do not consider.

Zechariah 7:11-13 But they refused to listen, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear. Yes, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear **the law**, and the words which the LORD of hosts has **sent** in **his spirit** by the former prophets: Therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts. Therefore it is come to pass, that as he cried, and they would not hear; so they cried, and I would not hear, said the LORD of hosts.

Jeremiah 6:16-19 Thus says the LORD, Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, Where is the good way? And walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk in it. I set watchmen over you, saying,



<u>Listen to the sound of the shofar!</u> But they said, We will not listen! Therefore hear, you nations, and know, congregation, what is among them. Hear, earth! Behold, I will bring evil on this people, even the fruit of their thoughts, <u>because</u> they have not listened to my words, and as for **my law**, they have rejected it.

Deuteronomy 32:20,21 And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: For they are a very perverse generation, Children in whom is no faithfulness. They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God, They have provoked me to anger with their vanities: And I will move them to jealousy with those that are not a people, I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

Romans 10:19,20 But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses said, I will provoke you to jealousy by them that are no people, and by a foolish nation I will anger you. But Isaiah is very bold, and said, I was found of them that sought me not; I was made manifest to them that asked not after me.

Romans 11:11,12 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid, but rather through their fall <u>salvation is come to the Gentiles</u>, for to <u>provoke them to jealousy</u>. Now if the fall of them be the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles, how much more their fullness?

Jeremiah 16:19 O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come to you from the ends of the earth, and shall say, <u>Surely our fathers have inherited lies</u>, vanity, and things wherein there is no profit.

Deuteronomy 32:26,27 I said, I would scatter them into corners, I would make the remembrance of them to cease from among men: Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, and lest they should say, <u>Our hand is high, and the LORD has not done all this.</u>

Deuteronomy 32:29 O that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end.

Deuteronomy 32:30,31 How should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, except <u>their Rock</u> had sold them, and the Lord had shut them up? For <u>their rock is not as our Rock</u>, even our enemies themselves being judges.

Deuteronomy 32:41,42 If I <u>whet my glittering sword</u>, and my hand take hold on judgment, I will render vengeance to my enemies, and will reward them that hate me. I will make my arrows drunk with blood, and <u>my sword</u> shall devour flesh, and that with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from <u>the beginning</u> of revenges on the enemy.



Revelation 19:15 And out of his <u>mouth goes a sharp sword</u>, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the wine press of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Revelation 19:17,18,21 And I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the middle of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God, That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great. And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat on the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: And all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Deuteronomy 32:43 Rejoice. O you nations, with his people: For he will avenge the blood of his servants, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful to his land, and to his people.

Revelation 19:2 <u>For true and righteous are his judgments</u>: For he has judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and <u>has</u> avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

Romans 15:8-12 Now I say that Messiah has been made a servant of the circumcision for the truth of God, that <u>he might confirm the promises</u> given to the fathers, and that **the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy**. As it is written, Therefore will I give praise to you among the Gentiles, and **sing to your name**. Again he says, <u>Rejoice</u>, you <u>Gentiles</u>, with his people. Again, Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles! Let all the peoples praise him. Again, <u>Isaiah says</u>, <u>There will be the root of Jesse</u>, he who arises to rule over the Gentiles, in him the <u>Gentiles will hope</u>.

Isaiah 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a **Branch shall grow out of his roots.**

Isaiah 11:9,10 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: <u>For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD</u>, as the waters cover the sea. And in that day there shall be **a root of Jesse**, which shall stand for an ensign of the people, <u>to it shall the Gentiles seek</u>: And his rest shall be glorious.

Deuteronomy 32:44 And Moses came and spoke all the words of this song in the ears of the people, he, and Hoshea the son of Nun.

2 Samuel 22:1-4 Then David spoke to the Lord <u>the words of this song</u>, on the day when the Lord had delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul. And he said: **The Lord is my rock** and my fortress and my



deliverer, The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge, My Savior, *You save me from violence*. I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, So shall I be saved from my enemies.

Psalm 18:1,2 I will love thee, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer, my God, my strength, in whom I will trust.

Psalm 18:30-33 As for God, his way is perfect: The word of the Lord is tried: He is a buckler to all those that trust in him. For who is God save the Lord? Or who is a rock save our God? It is God that girds me with strength, and maketh my way perfect. He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and sets me upon my high places.

Psalm 18:46,47 The Lord liveth; And **blessed be my rock**, and let the God of my salvation be exalted. It is God that avenges me, and subdues the people under me.

2 Samuel 22:32-34 For who is God, except the Lord? And **who is a rock**, except our God? God is my strength and power, And He makes my way perfect. He makes my feet like the feet of deer, And sets me on my high places.

2 Samuel 22:47,48 The Lord lives! **Blessed be my Rock!** Let God be exalted, The Rock of my salvation! It is God who avenges me, And subdues the peoples under me.

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY HOW IT'S AFFECTED BIBLICAL THINKING Wrong theology: Shabbat changed

Exodus 19:1 In the third month of the going out of the sons of Israel from the land of Egypt, in <u>this day</u> they have come into the wilderness of Sinai, Why not that day? The giving of the Torah can never become a thing of the past!

Matthew 20:9,10 And when they came that were hired about the eleventh hour, they received every man a penny. But when the first came, they supposed that they should have received more, and they likewise received every man a penny. There are those who gain eternity thorough a lifetime, others gain it in one hour! Better is one hour of repentance and good deeds in this world than eternity in the world to come!

Leviticus 23:2,3 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts. Six days shall work be done: But the



seventh day is the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation, ye shall do no work therein: It is the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

Colossians 2:16,17 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holy day, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Messiah.

YLT Genesis 2:2 and God <u>completed</u> by the seventh day His work which He hath made, and ceased by the seventh day from all His work which He hath made.

KJV Genesis 2:2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

JPS Genesis 2:2 And <u>on the seventh day God **finished** His work</u> which He had made, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had made.

Genesis 26:5 Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

Genesis 19:3 And he pressed upon them greatly, and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house, and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

Genesis 21:2 And the LORD visited Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did unto Sarah as he had spoken. For Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age, at **the set time** of which God had spoken to him.

Isaiah 56:4,5 For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, and choose the things that please me, and take hold of my covenant, Even unto them will I give in mine house and within my walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off.

Isaiah 66:23 And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

Exodus 16:22,23a And it came to pass, that on the sixth day they gathered twice as much bread, two omers for one man: And all the rulers of the congregation came and told Moses. And he said unto them, **This is that which the LORD** hath said, **Tomorrow is the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD**.

Exodus 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.



Exodus 31:15 Six days may work be done, but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD.

Matthew 12:8 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

Mark 1:21 And they went into Capernaum, and straightway on the sabbath day he entered into the synagogue, and taught.

Luke 4:16 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: And, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

Luke 4:31 And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days.

Luke 13:10 And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath.

Luke 23:56 And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments, and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.

Acts 13:14,15 But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the **synagogue on the sabbath day**, and sat down. And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, Ye men and brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

Acts 13:42 And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath.

Acts 13:44 And the next sabbath day came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God.

Acts 15:21 For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

Acts 17:2 And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures.

Acts 18:4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

Isaiah 58:13,14 If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day, and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honorable, and shalt honor him, not doing thine own ways, nor



finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD, and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: For the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.
