TORAH PORTION

Genesis 33:17 And Jacob journeyed to <u>Succoth</u>, and built him a house, and made <u>booths for his cattle</u>: Therefore the name of the place is called <u>Succoth</u>.

Leviticus 23:33 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, and say, **On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of booths** for <u>seven days</u> to the LORD.

Isaiah 51:6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: For the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner.

2 Peter 1:13,14 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this <u>tabernacle</u>, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance, Knowing that shortly I must put off this <u>my tabernacle</u>, even as our Lord Jesus Christ hath showed me.

2 Corinthians 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house of this <u>tabernacle</u> were dissolved, we have a building of God, a house not made with hands, **eternal** in the heavens.

Leviticus 23:41-44 You shall keep it a feast to the LORD seven days in the year: It is a statute forever throughout your generations, you shall keep it in the seventh month. You shall <u>dwell in booths</u> seven days. All who are native-born in Israel shall <u>dwell in booths</u>, that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to <u>dwell in booths</u>, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt. I am the LORD your God. Moses declared to the children of Israel the appointed feasts of the LORD.

Exodus 25:8,9 And **let them make** me a sanctuary that <u>I may dwell among them</u>. According to <u>all that I show you, after the pattern</u> of <u>the tabernacle</u>, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall you make it.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt (Tabernacled) among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Revelation 21:1-4 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: For the first heaven and the first earth were passed away, and there was no more sea. And I John <u>saw the holy</u> <u>city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven</u>, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, <u>the tabernacle</u> <u>of God is with men</u>, and he <u>will dwell with them</u>, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Leviticus 23:1,2 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are MY feasts.



KJV Leviticus 23:4 These are the **feasts** of the LORD, even holy **convocations**, which ye **shall proclaim** in their **seasons**.

JPS Leviticus 23:4 These are the <u>appointed</u> seasons of the LORD, even <u>holy</u> <u>convocations</u>, which <u>ye shall proclaim</u> in their <u>appointed season</u>.

Zephaniah 1:7 Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord GOD: For the day of the LORD is at hand: For the LORD hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath **bid his guests**.

Matthew 22:1-3 And Jesus answered and spoke unto them again by parables, and said, The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, And sent forth his servants to call them **that were bidden to the wedding**: And they would not come.

Matthew 22:11-14 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: And he saith unto him, Friend, how come thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness, there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few are chosen.

Zephaniah 1:8 And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD's sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.

Revelation 19:9 And he saith unto me, Write, **Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb.** And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

Luke 12:35-37 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning, And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks, they may open unto him immediately. Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: Verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

Deuteronomy 16:13-15 You shall observe **the feast of tabernacles** seven days, after that you have gathered in your corn and your wine: And <u>you shall rejoice</u> in your feast, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are within your gates. Seven days shall you keep a solemn feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD shall choose: Because the LORD your God shall bless you in all your increase, and in all the works of your hands, therefore <u>you shall surely rejoice</u>.

Exodus 34:29 When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God.



Exodus 35:10 Let every skillful craftsman among you come and make all that the LORD has commanded: **The tabernacle**, its tent and its covering, its hooks and its frames, its bars, its pillars, and its bases.

Exodus 35:20-22 And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him up, and everyone whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy

work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: And every man that offered an offering of gold unto the LORD.

Numbers 29:12,13a On the fifteenth day of the seventh month you shall have a holy convocation. You shall not do any ordinary work, and you shall keep a feast to the Lord seven days. And you shall offer a burnt offering, a food offering, with a pleasing aroma to the Lord, thirteen bulls from the herd.

Deuteronomy 16:13-17 Thou shalt observe the **feast of tabernacles seven days**, after that thou hast gathered in thy corn and thy wine: And **thou shalt rejoice in thy feast**, **thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow**, that are within thy gates. Seven days shalt thou keep a solemn feast unto the LORD thy God in the place which the LORD shall choose: **Because the LORD thy God shall bless thee** in all thine increase, and in all the works of thine hands, therefore **thou shalt surely rejoice**. Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and **in the feast of tabernacles:** and they shall not appear before the LORD **thy God which he hath given thee.**

Zechariah 14:14-19 And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem, and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance. And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague. And it shall come to pass, [that] every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and <u>to keep the feast of tabernacles</u>. And it shall be, [that] whoso will not come up of [all] the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that [have] no [rain], there shall be the plague, wherewith the Lord will smite the heathen that come not up <u>to keep the feast of tabernacles</u>. This shall be the punishment of all nations that come not up <u>to keep the feast of tabernacles</u>.

Zechariah 14:3,4 Then the LORD will go out and **fight against those nations**, as when he fought in the day of battle. His feet will stand in that day on the Mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the **Mount of Olives will be split in two**, from east to west, making a very great valley. Half of the mountain will move toward the north, and half of it toward the south.



Leviticus 23:39,40 Also in the <u>fifteenth day of the seventh month</u>, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD <u>seven days</u>: On <u>the first day</u> shall be a sabbath, and on <u>the eighth day</u> shall be a sabbath. And ye shall take you on the first day the <u>boughs of goodly trees</u>, <u>branches of palm</u> <u>trees</u>, and the <u>boughs of thick trees</u>, and <u>willows of the brook</u>, and <u>ye shall rejoice</u> before the LORD your God seven days.

FEAST OF SUKKOT

Isaiah 2:1-5 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. And it shall come to pass <u>in the last days</u>, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills, and <u>all nations</u> shall flow unto it. And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob, and <u>he will teach us</u> of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: For out of Zion <u>shall go forth</u> the law(Torah), and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: And they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore. O house of Jacob, come ye, and let us walk in the light of the LORD.

Micah 4:1,2 But **in the last days** it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills, and people shall flow unto it. And <u>many nations shall come</u>, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: For the <u>law</u> (Torah) shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

1 Kings 8:2 And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto king Solomon at the feast, in the month Ethanim, which is **the seventh month**.

2 Chronicles **5:12b-14** 120 priests who were trumpeters, and it was the duty of the trumpeters and singers to make themselves heard in unison in praise and thanksgiving to the LORD), and when the song was raised, with trumpets and cymbals and other musical instruments, in praise to the LORD, For he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever, the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of God.

2 Peter 1:16 For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Yeshua HaMashiach, but were **eyewitnesses** of his majesty.

Mark 8:22a And he cometh to Bethsaida,

Mark 8:27 And Jesus went forth, and his disciples, to the villages of Caesarea Philippi.



Mark 9:1,2,5 And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the <u>kingdom of God</u> <u>come with power</u>. And <u>after six days</u> Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into <u>a high mountain apart</u> by themselves: And he was transfigured before them. And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: And let us make <u>three tabernacles</u>, one for you, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah.

John 8:12 Again, therefore, Yeshua spoke to them, saying, I am the light of the world. He who follows me will not walk in the darkness but will have the light of life.

Psalm 118:14 The LORD is my strength and song. **He has become my salvation** [yeshu`ah].

Psalm 118:15 The voice of **rejoicing and <u>salvation</u> is in the tabernacles** of the righteous: The right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Exodus 15:2 The LORD is my strength and song. **He has become my salvation** [yeshu`ah]. This is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

John 7:2,14,15 Now the Jewish festival, the **Feast of Sukkot**, was at hand. But when it was now the midst of the feast, Yeshua went up into the temple and taught. The Judeans therefore marveled, saying, How does this man know letters, having never been educated?

Isaiah 12:2-5 Behold, God is my salvation. I will trust, and will not be afraid, for the LORD, **the LORD, is my strength and song,** and <u>he has become my salvation</u> [yeshu`ah]. Therefore with joy you will draw water out of the wells of salvation [yeshu`ah]. In that day you will say, Give thanks to the LORD! Call on his name. Declare his doings among the peoples. <u>Proclaim that his name is exalted! Sing to the</u> LORD, for he has done excellent things! Let this be known in all the earth!

John 7:37,38 Now on the last and greatest day of the feast, Yeshua stood and <u>cried out</u>, If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink! He who believes in me, <u>as the</u> Scripture has said, from within him will flow rivers of living water.

Isaiah 12:6 Cry aloud and shout, you inhabitant of Zion, for the Holy One of Israel is great in the midst of you!

Zechariah 14:8,9 It will happen in that day, that <u>living waters</u> will go out from Jerusalem, half of them toward the eastern sea, and half of them toward the western sea, in summer and in winter will it be. The LORD will be King over all the earth. In that day the LORD will be one, and his name one.

Luke 2:6,7 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.



Luke 2:20-22 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them. And when **eight days were accomplished for the circumcising** of the child, his name was called Yeshua, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

Isaiah 9:6,7 For unto us <u>a child is born</u>, <u>unto us a son</u> is given: And the government shall be upon his shoulder: And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, <u>upon the throne of</u> **David**, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

HHBNT Matthew 1:20-23 Take notice, however, after he had resolved to do this, an angel of the LORD appeared to him by way of a dream saying, Yosef <u>son of David</u>, do not be afraid to take <u>Miriam</u> as your wife because the child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a Son. <u>You shall call His name Yeshua</u> because **He will save** His people from their sins. Now all this happened to fulfill what was foretold by the LORD through the prophet, Take notice of this! <u>The virgin shall</u> become pregnant and shall give <u>birth to a Son</u>. <u>They will call His name Immanuel</u> which interpreted means, <u>God is with us.</u>

Genesis 24:16 And the damsel was very fair to look upon, **a virgin**, neither had any man known her: And she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

Gen 24:43 Behold, I stand by the well of water, and it shall come to pass, that when the <u>virgin</u> cometh forth to draw water, and I say to her, Give me, I pray thee, a little water of thy pitcher to drink.

Exodus 2:8 And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Go. And the girl went and got the child's mother.

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign, Behold, <u>a virgin</u> shall conceive, and bear <u>a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.</u>
