<u>Sukkot</u>

In this Art-Peace called "<u>Sukkot</u>" we will be looking at <u>5 Hebrew words</u> to form a concept or an idea in our minds & in our hearts about what this Art-Peace is saying. We will forge a path together to seek out what's hidden inside these <u>12 Hebrew letters</u> making up these <u>5 words</u> which will result in finding a way to use these <u>12 letters</u> to calculate the speed of light which is 299,792 Kilometers per second & is denoted as the letter <u>C</u> in this Art-Peace.

First let's scratch the surface & begin to dig into this Art-Peace a little to see what's written here. The <u>1st</u> main BIG word in Hebrew reading from right to left with four letters reads "<u>La'bayit</u>" **\pm** which means "<u>to the house</u>". The first letter "<u>Lamed</u>" **\pm** is a prefix meaning "<u>to the</u>". The next letter is "<u>Beit</u>" **\pm** this letter by itself means a "<u>house</u>". You will notice behind this 2nd letter "<u>Beit</u>" is a slightly smaller letter with the same transparency. The letter "<u>Sheen</u>" **\pm** with the letter "<u>Beit</u>" **\pm** reading back to front, you get the <u>2nd</u> word "<u>Shuv</u>" **\pm** which means to return. So this two word combination says "return to the house". Then, written at the bottom upon this letter "<u>Sheen</u>" **\pm** you will see a <u>3rd</u> word written at the bottom of the letter "<u>Sheen</u>" **\pm**. It is a much smaller four letter word in blue which says "<u>Shalom</u>" **\pm** meaning "<u>Peace</u>". So the light that you see in this House is emanating from the "<u>Flame of Peace</u>". In Hebrew, every letter & word has a numerical value.

So, let's now look into the numerical total of this "<u>Flame of Peace</u>" & see if we can gain some mathematical insight as to where this "<u>Flame of Peace</u>" comes from. "<u>Sheen</u>" ψ , has a numerical value of <u>300</u>. The word "<u>Shalom</u>" has a numerical value of <u>376</u>. Adding the value of the letter <u>Sheen</u> (<u>300</u>) to the word Shalom (<u>376</u>) you get <u>300 + 376 = 676</u>. <u>676 is 26 squared</u>. You will notice the number <u>26 squared</u> to the left of the "<u>Sheen</u>". Why is this important? Well, <u>26 is the numerical value of the Divine Name of G-D</u> in the Hebrew Bible, The Holy Torah, the Creator of Heaven & Earth has a numerical value of <u>26</u>. This is where this "<u>Flame of Peace</u>" comes from as alluded to with the 26 squared in this house next to the "Flame of Peace".

Now this three word combo (Shuv Ju, La'bayit Ju, and Shalom Jusys "Return to the House of Peace". What happens when one "Returns to the House of Peace?" Well, let's do a numerical break down of these words. We already know that the "Flame of Peace" that is inside the house equals 676. The phrase "La'bayit" defined to the house" is equal to 442. Then, adding this up, 676+442 = 1118. Why is this number 1118 important? Well a "Return to the House of Peace" totaling 1118, means you would be reciting the most sacred prayer in the Holy Torah referred to as "The Shema." 1118 is the numerical value of the phrase "Shema Israel Adonai Elohaynu Adonai Echad." This means "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our G-D, the LORD is One." To reinforce this idea of the number 1118 we placed a Number Square in the bottom right corner of the Art-Peace. All of its rows, columns, diagonals, corners, & the 4 center digits all equal 1118. Get out a calculator & do the math, it's fun! Above the number square you will see 13x86 which equals 1118. 86 is the numerical value of Elohim, the word for G-D. 13 is the numerical value for Ahavah which means love. So we know we love G-D when we recite "Shema Israel Adonai Elohaynu Adonai Echad".

May we <u>Bless Adonai the King</u>, May we <u>Fear His Holy Name</u> & <u>Remember the Torah of His servant</u> <u>Moses</u>. The Hebrew Alphabet is the Genetic Fabric of the Universe, the Holy Torah is the Mirrored Reflection of Pure Divine Will (G-D) in the Cosmos, & May the Eternal Light of the Holy Torah fall like Rain upon the Earth. May this Art-Peace shed the Light & the Truth of the Holy Torah's Sublime Wisdom upon all those who See it & Hear the Words therein, & May this Art spark Holy conversations that are pleasing to our KING, the Holy One Blessed be He forever & ever Hallelu'Yah amen!
