

TORAH PORTION

Genesis 1:1-3 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty. Darkness was on the surface of the deep. God's Spirit was hovering over the surface of the waters. God said, Let there be <u>light</u>, and there was <u>light</u>.

Isaiah 60:1-5 Arise, shine, for **thy light is come**, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the **darkness** shall cover the earth, and **gross darkness** the people: But the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the **Gentiles shall come to thy light**, and kings to the brightness of thy rising. Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: All they gather themselves together, they come to thee: Thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at thy side. Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged, because **the <u>abundance of the sea</u>** shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the <u>**Gentiles**</u> shall come unto thee.

Revelation 17:1 And there came one of the seven angels that had the seven bowls, and spoke with me, saying, Come hither, I will show thee the judgment of the great harlot that sitteth upon **many waters.**

Revelation 17:15 And he saith unto me, <u>The waters</u> which thou sawest, where the harlot sitteth, <u>are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues</u>.

John 8:12 Then spoke Yeshua again unto them, saying, <u>I am the light</u> of the world: He that follows me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp, and <u>the law is light</u>; And reproofs of instruction are the way of life.

Psalm 119:129-131 <u>PEH</u> Your testimonies are wonderful: Therefore does my soul keep them. The <u>entrance of your words give light</u>, it gives understanding unto the simple. <u>I opened my mouth</u>, and panted: For <u>I longed for your commandments</u>.

Psalm 104:1,2 Bless the LORD, my soul. The LORD, my God, you are very great. You are clothed with honor and majesty. He <u>covers himself with light</u> <u>as with a garment</u>. He stretches out the heavens like a curtain.

Isaiah 42:1 Behold my <u>servant</u>, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights, I have put <u>my Spirit</u> upon <u>him, He</u> will <u>bring forth justice to</u> <u>the Gentile nations.</u>

Isaiah 42:3,4 A bruised reed **he** will not break, and a faintly burning wick **he** will not quench, **he** will <u>faithfully bring forth justice</u>. He will not grow faint or be discouraged till **he** <u>has established justice in the earth</u>; and the coastlands wait for <u>his law</u>.

Isaiah 9:6,7 For unto us a child is born, unto us **a son** is given: And the government shall be upon his shoulder: And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon **the throne of David**, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and <u>to establish</u> <u>it with judgment and with justice</u> from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Isaiah 42:5,6 Thus says **God the LORD**, <u>he who created the heavens</u> and stretched them out, he who <u>spread out the earth and that which comes out of</u> it, <u>he who gives breath to its people and spirit</u> to those who walk in it. **I, the LORD**, have **called <u>you</u>** in righteousness, and will hold <u>your</u> hand, and will keep <u>you</u>, and <u>make you a covenant</u> for the people, as <u>a light for the Gentile nations.</u>

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, **and breathed** into his nostrils the **breath** of life; and man became a living soul.

Psalm 33:6 By the **Word of the LORD** were the heavens made, and all the host of them **by the breath of his mouth.**

2 Timothy 3:16 Every Scripture is **God-breathed** and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for instruction in righteousness.

John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life, and the life was <u>the light of men</u>. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Genesis 1:4,5 God saw <u>the light</u>, and saw that <u>it was good</u>. God <u>divided</u> the <u>light</u> from the darknesss and God called the <u>light</u> day, and **the darkness he** called night. There was evening and there was morning, day one.

Isaiah 42:21-23 The Lord is well pleased for his righteousness 'sake, <u>he will</u> <u>magnify the law</u>, and <u>make it honorable</u>. But this is a people robbed and spoiled, they are all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: They are for a prey, and none delivers, for a spoil, and *none say*, <u>Restore</u>.

Who among you will give ear to this? Who will hearken and hear for the time to come?

Acts 3:19-21 Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Yeshua HaMashiach, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until <u>the times of restoration of all things</u>, which God has spoken by the mouth <u>of all His holy prophets</u> since <u>the world began</u>.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 To everything there is a season, <u>and a time to every purpose</u> under the heaven: **A time to be born**.

Colossians 1:16-18 For <u>by him</u> were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: All things were created <u>by him</u>, and <u>for him</u>: And he is before all things, and <u>by him</u> all things consist. And he is the head of the body, the church: <u>Who is the beginning</u>,(Reisheet!) <u>the firstborn</u> from the dead, that in all things he might have the preeminence.

Isaiah 48:16 Come ye near unto me, hear ye this, I have not spoken in secret **from the beginning**, from the time that it was, there am I: And now the **Lord GOD**, and his Spirit, <u>hath sent Me</u>.

John 3:16,17 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved.

Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended to heaven and come down? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has wrapped up the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and **what is his son's name**? Surely you know!

Psalm 2:7-9 I will tell of the decree: The LORD said to me, You are my Son, today I have begotten you. Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession. You shall break them with a rod of iron and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

Revelation 12:5 And she brought forth a man child, who was to **rule all nations with a rod of iron:** And her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

Revelation 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with **a rod of iron**: And he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Jeremiah 51:19-21 Not like these is he who is the portion of Jacob, for he is the one who formed all things, and Israel is the tribe of his inheritance, the LORD of hosts is his name. **You are my hammer and weapon of war:** With you I break nations in pieces, with you I destroy kingdoms, with you I break in pieces the horse and his rider, with you I break in pieces the chariot and the charioteer.

Revelation 1:12,13 And I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw **seven golden candlesticks**, And in the midst of the **seven candlesticks** one like unto the Son of man, <u>clothed with a garment down to</u> <u>the foot</u>, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.


Genesis 1:6-8 And God said: Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it <u>divide the waters from the waters</u>. And **God made the firmament**, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament, and it was so. And God called the firmament Heaven. And there

was evening and there was morning, a second day.

Genesis 1:9-13 And God said: **Let the waters** under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear. And it was so. And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering together of the waters called He Seas, and God saw that it <u>was good</u>. And God said: Let the earth put forth grass, herb yielding seed, and fruit-tree bearing fruit after its kind, wherein is the seed thereof, upon the earth. And it was so. And the earth brought forth grass, herb yielding seed after its kind, and tree bearing fruit, wherein is the seed thereof, after its kind; and God saw that it <u>was good</u>. And there was evening and there was morning, **a third day**.

Genesis 1:14-16 And God said Let there be **lights** in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let them be for **signs**, and for seasons, and for days and years, and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth. And it was so. And God made the **two great lights**: The **greater light** to rule the day, and the **lesser light** to rule the night, and the stars.

Genesis 1:17-19 And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide



the light from the darkness, and God saw that it was good. And there was evening and there was morning, **a fourth day**.

Genesis 2:7,8 And the LORD God <u>formed</u> רייצר man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul. And the LORD God <u>planted a garden</u> eastward in Eden, and <u>there he put</u> <u>the man whom he had formed</u>.

John 20:15a Yeshua said to her, Woman, why are you weeping? Who are you looking for? She, supposing him to be <u>the gardener</u>.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 May the God of peace himself sanctify you completely. May your whole <u>spirit</u>, <u>soul</u>, <u>and body</u> be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.

Genesis 4:10 And he said, What have you done? the voice of your brother's **blood** cries to me from the ground.

James 4:14 Whereas you know not what shall be on the morrow. For <u>what is</u> <u>your life</u>? It is even a vapor, that appears for a little time, and then vanishes away.


Genesis 2:16,17 And the LORD God commanded <u>the man</u>, saying, Of every tree of the garden **you** may freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, **you** shall not eat of it: for in the day that **you** eat thereof **you** shall surely die.

Genesis 2:18-20 And the LORD God said, <u>It is not good that the man should</u> <u>be alone</u>, I will make him an <u>help meet</u> for him. And out of the ground the LORD God <u>formed</u> ריצר <u>every beast</u> of the field, and every fowl of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them: And whatever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.

Genesis 3:23,24 Therefore the LORD God sent <u>him</u> forth <u>from the garden</u> of Eden, <u>to till the ground from where he was taken</u>. So he drove out <u>the man</u>, and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden <u>Cherubim, and a</u> <u>flaming sword</u> which turned every way, to keep <u>the Way of the tree of life</u>.

Genesis 4:9,10 And the LORD said unto Cain: Where is Abel thy brother? And he said:'I know not, am I my brother's keeper? And He said: What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's **blood** crieth unto Me from the ground.



Genesis 4:25,26 And Adam knew his wife again, and she bore a son, and called his name Seth: For God hath **appointed** me another seed instead of Abel, for Cain slew him. And to Seth, to him also there was born a son, and he called his name Enosh, then began men to call upon the name of the LORD.

Genesis 5:3 And Adam lived **a hundred and thirty years**, and begot a son in his own likeness, after his image, and called his name Seth.

Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the generations of Adam.

Genesis 2:4 These are the <u>generations</u> of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, <u>in the day</u> that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

Ruth 4:18 Now these are the generations of Pharez.



Genesis 6:6-8 And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air, for it repenteth me that I have made them. But <u>Noah found grace</u> in the eyes of the LORD.
