TORAH PORTION

Genesis 17:15-18 And God said unto Abraham, As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall her name be. And I will bless her, and give thee a son also of her: Yea, I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations, kings of people shall be of her. Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall a child be born unto him that is an hundred years old? And shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear? And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee! And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed, and thou shalt call his name Isaac: And I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

Genesis 17:21,22 But my covenant will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year. And he left off talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.

Genesis 18:1,2 And the LORD (YHVH) appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: And he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day, He lifted up his eyes and looked, and saw that **three men** stood opposite him. When he saw **them**, he ran to meet **them** from the tent door, **and bowed himself to the earth.**

Genesis 18:3-9 and said, <u>My lord(s)</u>, (Adonai) if now I have found favor in <u>your</u> (plural) sight, please don't go away from your (plural) servant. Now let a little water be fetched, wash <u>your</u> (plural) feet, and rest <u>yourselves</u> under the tree. I will get a morsel of bread so you can refresh your heart. After that you may go your way, now that you have come to your servant. <u>They said</u>, Very well, do as you have said. Abraham <u>hurried</u> into the tent to Sarah, and said, **Quickly** prepare three measures of fine meal, knead it, and make cakes. Abraham <u>ran</u> to the herd, and fetched a tender and good calf, and gave it to the servant. He <u>hurried</u> to dress it. He took <u>butter, milk, and the calf which he had dressed, and set it before them</u>. He stood by them under the tree, and they ate. <u>They asked him</u>, Where is Sarah, your wife? He said, See, in the tent.

Genesis 18:10 And He said: I will certainly return unto thee when the season cometh round, and, lo, Sarah thy wife shall have a son. And Sarah heard in the tent door, which was behind him.

Genesis 18:12,13 Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also? And the LORD (YHVH) said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?

Genesis 18:14,15 And the LORD said unto Abraham: Wherefore did **Sarah laugh**, saying: Shall I of a surety bear a child, who am old? Is anything too hard for the **LORD (YHVH). At the set time** I will return unto thee, when the season



cometh round, and Sarah shall have a son.

Genesis 21:6 And Sarah said, God hath **made me to laugh**, so that all that hear will **laugh with me**.

Psalm 2:2-4 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us. **He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh**: The Lord shall have them in derision.

Psalm 37:12,13 The wicked plotteth against the just, and gnasheth upon him with his teeth. **The Lord shall laugh** at him: For he seeth that **his day is coming.**

Job 5:22,23 At destruction and famine **thou shalt laugh**: Neither shalt thou be afraid of the beasts of the earth. For thou shalt be in league with the stones of the field: And the beasts of the field shall be at peace with thee.

Genesis 18:20-22 And the LORD (YHVH) aid, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous, I will go down now, and see whether they have done altogether according to the cry of it, which is come unto me, and if not, I will know. And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: But Abraham stood yet before the LORD (YHVH).

Genesis 18:32,33 Then he said, Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak but once more: <u>Suppose ten should be found there</u>? And He said, <u>I will not destroy it for the sake of ten.</u> So the LORD went His way as soon as He had finished speaking with Abraham, and Abraham returned to his place.

Genesis 19:1 Now the two angels came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them, and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground.

Genesis 19:2 And he said, Behold now, my lords, (Adonai) turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay, but we will abide in the street all night.

Genesis 19:3 But he insisted strongly, so they turned in to him and entered his house. Then he made them a feast, **and baked unleavened bread**, and they ate.

Genesis 19:4 But before they lay down, the men of the city, even the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, **both old and young**, all the people from every quarter.

Ezekiel 16:49,50 Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. And they were haughty,



and committed abomination before me: Therefore I took them away as I saw good.

Genesis 19:14,15 So Lot went out and spoke to his sons-in-law, who had married his daughters, and said, Get up, get out of this place, for the Lord will destroy this city! But to his sons-in-law he seemed to be joking. When the morning dawned, the angels urged Lot to hurry, saying, Arise, take your wife and your two daughters who are here, lest you be consumed in the punishment of the city.

Genesis 19:24 Then the LORD(YHVH) rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD(YHVH) out of heaven.

Genesis 19:26 But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

Genesis 21:14 And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave it unto Hagar, putting it on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

Genesis 13:1,2 And Abram went up out of Egypt, he, and his wife, and all that he had, and Lot with him, into the south. And Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.

Genesis 14:14 And when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his trained servants, born in his own house, three hundred and eighteen, and pursued them unto Dan.

Genesis 22:2 <u>He said, Now take</u> your son, <u>your only son</u>, <u>whom you love</u>, <u>even Isaac</u>, and go into the land of Moriah. Offer him there for a burnt offering on one of the mountains which I will tell you of.

Hebrews 11:17-19 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: And he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall your seed be called: Accounting that God <u>was able to raise</u> <u>him up, even from the dead</u>, from where also he received him in a figure.

Genesis 22:19 So <u>Abraham returned</u> to his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba. <u>Abraham dwelled at Beersheba.</u>

Genesis 23:1,2 Sarah lived one <u>hundred twenty-seven years</u>. This was the length of Sarah's life. <u>Sarah died in Kiriath Arba (the same is Hebron</u>), in the land of Canaan. <u>Abraham came to mourn</u> for Sarah, and to weep for her.

Genesis 25:20 And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife.

Genesis 10:21,22 Unto Shem also, the (Great Grand) father of all the children of <u>Eber</u>, the brother of Japheth the elder, even to him were children born. The children of **Shem**, **Elam**, and Asshur, and <u>Arphaxad</u>, and Lud, and Aram.

Exodus 16:1-3 And they took their journey **from Elim**, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the **wilderness of Sin**, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the **fifteenth day of the second month** after their departing out of the land of Egypt. And **the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured** against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness: And the children of Israel said unto them, Would to God we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when **we did eat bread to the full, for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger.**

Exodus 17:1-3 And all the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, after their journeys, according to the commandment of the LORD, and pitched in **Rephidim:** And there was no water for the people to drink. Wherefore the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? Wherefore do ye tempt the LORD? And the people thirsted there for water, and the people murmured against Moses, and said, Wherefore is this that thou hast brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst?

Exodus 17:8-11 Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim. And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: Tomorrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand. So **Joshua** did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, **Aaron, and Hur** went up to the top of the hill. And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: And when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

Exodus 17:16 For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.

1 Samuel 15:2,3 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I remember that which **Amalek did** to Israel, how he laid wait for him in the way, when he came up from Egypt. Now



go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not, but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.

1 Samuel 15:32a Then said Samuel, Bring ye hither to me Agag the king of the Amalekites.

Esther 9:24 Because Haman the son of Hammedatha, the Agagite, the enemy of all the Jews, had devised against the Jews to destroy them, and had cast Pur, that is, the lot, to consume them, and to destroy them.

Esther 2:8 So it came to pass, when the king's commandment and his decree was heard, and when many maidens were gathered together unto Shushan the palace, to the custody of Hegai, that Esther was brought also unto the king's house, to the custody of Hegai, keeper of the women.

Jeremiah 49:34-36 The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against Elam in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, I will break the **bow of Elam**, the chief of their might. And **upon Elam** will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and will scatter them toward all those winds, and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.

Jeremiah 49: 37-39 For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: And I will bring evil upon them, even my fierce anger, saith the LORD, and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them: And I will set my throne in Elam, and will destroy from thence the king and the princes, saith the LORD. But it shall come to pass in the latter days, that I will bring again the captivity of Elam, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 25:15-18 For thus saith the LORD God of Israel unto me, <u>Take the wine cup of this fury at my hand</u>, and cause all the nations, to whom I send thee, to drink it. And they shall drink, and be moved, and be mad, because of the sword that I will send among them. Then took I the cup at the LORD's hand, and made all the nations to drink, unto whom the LORD had sent me: To wit, Jerusalem, and the cities of Judah, and the kings thereof, and the princes thereof, to make them a desolation, an astonishment, an hissing, and a curse, as it is this day.

Revelation 16:19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: And great Babylon came in remembrance before God, **to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.**

Revelation 14:9,10 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation, and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb.


