TORAH PORTION

Genesis 20:1,2 And Abraham journeyed from thence toward **the south country**, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and **sojourned in Gerar. And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my sister: And Abimelech king of Gerar sent**, and took Sarah.

Genesis 22:19 So Abraham returned to his young men, and they rose up and went together to **Beersheba**. Abraham lived at Beersheba.

Genesis 23:1,2 Sarah lived one **hundred twenty-seven years**. This was the length of Sarah's life. **Sarah died in Kiriath Arba (the same is Hebron)**, in the land of Canaan. **Abraham came to mourn** for Sarah, and to weep for her.

Genesis 25:20 And Isaac was **forty years** old when he took Rebekah to wife.

Genesis 14:13 And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew, for he **dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: And these were confederate with Abram.**

Genesis 23:3,4 And Abraham stood up from before his dead, and spoke to the **sons of Heth**, saying, I am a stranger and a sojourner with you: give me a possession of a burial plot with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

Hebrews 11:13 In faith died all these, not having received the promises, but from afar having seen them, and having been persuaded, and having saluted them, and having confessed that strangers and sojourners they are upon the earth.

Ephesians 2:19 Now, therefore, you are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and of the household of God.

Genesis 23:7 And Abraham stood up and bowed (prostrate) himself to the people of the land, even to the children of Heth.

Genesis 23:10-16 And Ephron עפרון dwelled among the children of Heth: And Ephron עפרון the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, even of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying, No, my lord, hear me: the field give I you, and the cave that is therein, I give it you; in the presence of the sons of my people give I it you: Bury

your dead. And Abraham bowed down himself before the people of the land. And he spoke unto Ephron עפרון in the audience of the people of the land,

saying, But if you will give it, I pray you, hear me: I will give you money for the field, take it of me, and I will bury my dead there. And Ephron עפרון answered Abraham, saying to him, My lord, listen to me: The land is worth four hundred shekels of silver, what is that between me and thee? Bury therefore your dead. And Abraham listened to Ephron עפרון, and Abraham weighed to Ephron עפרון the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current money with the merchant.

Genesis 24:3,4 And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that you shall not take a wife to my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell: But you shall go to my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife to my son Isaac.

Genesis 9:25-27 And he said, Cursed be Canaan, a servant of servants shall he be to his brothers. And he said, Blessed be the LORD God of Shem, and Canaan shall be his servant. God shall enlarge Japheth, and he shall dwell in the tents of Shem, and Canaan shall be his servant.

Genesis 24:12,13 And he made the **camels** kneel down outside the city by the well of water at the time of evening, the time when women go out to draw water. And he said, O LORD, God of my master Abraham, please grant me success today and show steadfast love to my master Abraham.

Genesis 24:14 Let the young woman to whom I shall say, Please let down your jar that I may drink, and who shall say, Drink, and I will water your camels let her be the one whom you have appointed for your servant Isaac. By this I shall know that you have shown steadfast love to my master.

Genesis 24:17-20 And the servant ran to meet her, and said, Let me, I pray you, drink a **little water of your pitcher**. And she said, Drink, my lord: **And she hurried**, and let down her pitcher on her hand, and gave him drink. And when she had done giving him drink, she said, I will draw water for your camels also, until they have done drinking. **And she hurried**, and emptied her pitcher into the trough, and **ran** again to the well to draw water, and drew for all his camels.

Exodus 30:12,13a When you are taking the number of the children of Israel, let every man who is numbered give to the Lord a price for his life, so that no disease may come on them when they are numbered. And this is what they are to give, let every man who is numbered give **half a shekel**.

Genesis 24:22 And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a **golden** earring of **half a shekel** בְּקֶעַץ weight, and **two bracelets** for her hands of **ten shekels** weight of gold.

Exodus 32:19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: And Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and **brake them** beneath the mount.

Psalm 119:72 The law of Thy mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and silver.

Exodus 38:25,26 And the **silver** of them that were numbered of the congregation was a hundred talents, and a thousand seven hundred and three-score and fifteen shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary: A בְּקֶעַץ **head**, that is, בְּקֶעַץ **half a shekel**, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that passed over to them that were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

Matthew 27:33 And when they were come unto a place called גֹּלְגוֹתָא, that is to say, a place of a skull.

Genesis 25:7-10 And these are the days of the years **of Abraham's life** which he lived, an **hundred threescore and fifteen years**. Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full of years, and was gathered to his people. And his sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite, which is before Mamre, The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: There was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

Genesis 25:20 Isaac was **forty years old** when he took **Rebekah**, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Paddan Aram, the sister of Laban the Syrian, to be his wife.

Psalm 83:1-5 O God, do not keep quiet: Let your lips be open and take no rest, O God. For see! Those who **make war** on you are out of control, your haters are lifting up their heads. They have made wise designs against your people, talking together against those whom you keep in a secret place. They have said, Come, **let us put an end to them as a nation**, so that **the name of Israel may go out of man's memory**. For they have all come to an agreement, they are all joined together against you.

Psalm 83:6-8 The tabernacles of **Edom**, and the **Ishmaelites**, of **Moab**, and the **Hagarenes**, **Gebal**, and **Ammon**, and **Amalek**, the **Philistines** with the inhabitants of **Tyre**, **Assur** also is joined with them: They have holpen the children of Lot. Selah.

Edom, Ammon, Moab = Jordan / Gebal, Tyre = Lebanon

Assur = Iraq / Philistines, Amalek = Gaza

Hagarenes, Ishmaelites = Syria, Saudi Arabia, Egypt

Isaiah 17:1 The burden of Damascus. Behold, Damascus is taken away from being a city, and it shall be a ruinous heap.

Genesis 7:11 In the **Six Hundredth Year** of Noah's life, in the **Second Month**, the **Seventeenth Day** of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

1 Kings 9:26 King Solomon built a fleet of ships at Ezion-geber, which is near Elath on the shore of the Red Sea, in the land of Edom. And Hiram sent with the fleet his servants, seamen who were familiar with the sea, together with the servants of Solomon. And they went to Ophir and brought from there gold, 420 talents, and they brought it to King Solomon.

1 Kings 10:24,25 And **the whole earth** sought the presence of Solomon to hear his wisdom, which God had put into his mind. Every one of them brought his present, articles of silver and gold, garments, myrrh, spices, horses, and mules, so much year by year

2 Samuel 11:1a **In the spring of the year, the time when kings go out to battle**, David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel.

Jeremiah 8:7 Yea, the stork in the heaven knows her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the Lord.

Jeremiah 10:23 I know, O LORD, that the way of man is not in himself, that it is not in man who walks to direct his steps.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 To everything there is a season, **and a time** to every purpose under the heaven.
