### TORAH PORTION

Genesis 28:1-5 And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, You shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.

Genesis 28:10,11 And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran. And he <u>lighted</u> (came to) on <u>a certain place</u>, and tarried there all night, because the <u>sun was set</u>, and he <u>took of the stones</u> of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in <u>that place</u> to sleep.

Genesis 28:12,13 And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: And behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it. And, behold, the LORD stood above it(HIM), and said, I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: The land where on thou lie, to you will I give it, and to your seed.

Proverbs 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, and descended? Who hath gathered the wind in his fists? Who hath bound the waters in his garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou knowest?

**John 3:13** And no man has ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even **the Son of man** which is in heaven.

Isaiah 33:22 For the LORD is our Judge, the LORD is our Lawgiver, the LORD is our King; He will save us.

John 1:49-51 Nathanael said to him, Rabbi, you are the Son of God, you are King of Israel! In answer Jesus said to him, You have faith because I said to you, I saw you under the fig-tree. You will see greater things than these. And he said to him, Truly I say to you all, You will see heaven opening and God's angels going up and coming down on the Son of man.

Daniel 7:13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, there came with the clouds of heaven one like unto a Son of man, and he came even to the Ancient of days, and he was brought near before Him.

**Genesis 28:15** And, behold, <u>I am with you</u>, and will keep you in all places where you go, and will <u>bring you again into this land</u>, for I will not leave you, until I have done that which I have spoken to you of.

Genesis 28:17-19a And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is <u>this</u> <u>place</u>! This is none other but the <u>house of God</u>, and this is <u>the gate of heaven</u>. And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took <u>the stone</u> that



he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and <u>poured oil upon the</u> top of it. And he called the name of **that place Bethel**.

**Isaiah 48:12** *Hearken unto* **Me**, O Jacob, and Israel **My** called: <u>I am He</u>, <u>I am the first, I also am the last</u>. Yea, **My hand** hath laid the foundation of the earth, and **My right hand** hath spread out the heavens, when I call out to them, they stand up together.

**Isaiah 48:16** Come near to  $\underline{\mathbf{Me}}$ , hear this: I have not spoken in secret from the beginning, From the time that it was,  $\underline{\mathbf{I}}$  was there. And now  $\underline{\mathbf{the Lord}}$   $\underline{\mathbf{God}}$  and  $\underline{\mathbf{His Spirit}}$  have sent  $\underline{\mathbf{Me}}$ .

**John 18:4-6** Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were coming upon him, went forth, and said to them, Whom are you seeking? They answered him, Yeshua of Nazareth. Yeshua said unto them, <u>I am He</u>. And Judas also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, <u>I am He</u>, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Genesis 28:20-22 Then Jacob took an oath, and said, If God will be with me, and keep me safe on my journey, and give me food and clothing to put on, So that I come again to my father's house in peace, then I will take the Lord to be my God, And this stone which I have put up for a pillar will be God's house: And of all you give me, I will give a tenth part to you.

**Genesis 29:5,6** And he said to them, Have you any knowledge of Laban, the son of Nahor? And they said, We have. And he said to them, Is he well? And they said, He is well, and here is Rachel his daughter coming with the sheep.

Genesis 29:18-20 And Jacob loved Rachel, and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter. And Laban said, It is better that I give her to thee, than that I should give her to another man: Abide with me. And Jacob served seven years for Rachel, and they seemed unto him but a few days, for the love he had to her.

Genesis 29:22,23 And Laban gathered together <u>all the men of the place</u> and made a **feast**. And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and brought her to him, and he went in unto her.

Genesis 29:25-27 And in the morning Jacob saw that it was Leah: And he said to Laban, What have you done to me? Was I not working for you so that I might have Rachel? Why have you been false to me? And Laban said, In our country we do not let the younger daughter be married before the older. Let the week of the bride-feast come to its end and then we will give



you the other in addition, if you will be my servant for another seven years. And Jacob did so, and fulfilled her week, and he gave him Rachel his daughter to wife.

Genesis 29:32,33 And Leah was with child, and gave birth to a son to whom she gave the name Reuben: for she said, The Lord has seen my sorrow, now my husband will have love for me. Then she became with child again, and gave birth to a son, and said, Because it has come to the Lord's ears that I am not loved, he has given me this son in addition: and she gave him the name Simeon.

Genesis 29:34,35 And she was with child again, and gave birth to a son, and said, Now at last my husband will be united to me, because I have given him three sons: So he was named Levi. And she was with child again, and gave birth to a son: And she said, This time I will give praise to the Lord: so he was named Judah, after this she had no more children for a time.

Genesis 30:5-8 And Bilhah became with child, and gave birth to a son. Then Rachel said, God has been my judge, and has given ear to my voice, and has given me a son, so he was named Dan. And again Bilhah, Rachel's servant, was with child, and gave birth to a second son. And Rachel said, I have had a great fight with my sister, and I have overcome her: And she gave the child the name Naphtali.

Genesis 30:9-13 When it was clear to Leah that she would have no more children for a time, she gave Zilpah, her servant, to Jacob as a wife. And Zilpah, Leah's servant, gave birth to a son. And Leah said, It has gone well for me, and she gave him the name Gad. And Zilpah, Leah's servant, gave birth to a second son. And Leah said, Happy am I! And all women will give witness to my joy: And she gave him the name Asher.

**Genesis 30:18,19** Then Leah said, God has made payment to me for giving my servant-girl to my husband: So she gave her son the name Issachar. And again Leah became with child, and she gave Jacob a sixth son.

Genesis 30:20,21 And she said, God has given me a good bride-price, now at last will I have my husband living with me, for I have given him six sons: And she gave him the name Zebulun. After that she had a daughter, to whom she gave the name Dinah.

**Genesis 30:24** And she gave him the name Joseph, saying, May the Lord give me another son.



**Genesis 31:19** Now Laban had gone to see to the cutting of the wool of his sheep, so Rachel secretly took the images of the gods of her father's house.

**Genesis 31:41** These twenty years I have been in your house, I was your servant for fourteen years because of your daughters, and for six years I kept your flock, and ten times was my payment changed.

Genesis 32:1-4 And on his way Jacob came face to face with the angels of God. And when he saw them he said, This is the army of God: so he gave that place the name of Mahanaim. Now Jacob sent servants before him to Esau, his brother, in the land of Seir, the country of Edom; And he gave them orders to say these words to Esau: Your servant Jacob says, Till now I have been living with Laban.



**Daniel 10:4,5** And in the <u>four and twentieth day of the first month</u>, as I was by the side of the great river, which is Tigris, I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz.

Daniel 10:12-14 Then said he unto me: Fear not, Daniel, for <u>from the first day</u> that you did set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I am come <u>because of your words</u>. But the **prince of the kingdom of <u>Persia</u> withstood me <u>one and twenty days</u>, but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, and I was left over there beside the kings of <u>Persia</u>. Now I am come to make you understand what shall befall your people in the end of days.** 

**Daniel 10:20a** Then he said: Do you know why I came to you? And **now** *I will return* **to fight with the prince of Persia** 

**Isaiah 24:19,20** The earth is utterly broken down, the earth is clean dissolved, the earth is moved exceedingly. The earth shall reel to and fro



like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage, and the transgression thereof shall be heavy upon it, and it shall fall, and not rise again.

Isaiah 24:21-23 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the LORD shall punish the host of the high ones that are on high, and the kings of the earth upon the earth. And they shall be gathered together, as prisoners are gathered in the pit, and shall be shut up in the prison, and after many days shall they be visited. Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the LORD of hosts shall reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously.

- 1 Chronicles 20:1 Now in the spring, at the time when kings go out to war, Joab went out at the <u>head of the armed forces</u> and made waste all the land of the <u>Ammonites</u> and put his men in position before Rabbah, shutting it in.
- 1 Chronicles 20:4a Now after this there was war with the Philistines  $\underline{at}$  Gezer.
- 1 Chronicles 20:5a And again there was war with the Philistines.
- 1 Chronicles 20:6a And again there was war at Gath.
- **2 Samuel 11:2** And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: And from the roof he saw a woman washing herself, and the woman was very beautiful to look upon.

**Numbers 24:14** And now, behold, I am going to my people. Come, I will let you know what **this people will do to your people in the latter days.** 

Numbers 24:17-20 I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: There shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth. And Edom shall be a possession, Seir also shall be a possession for his enemies; and Israel shall do valiantly. Out of Jacob shall come he that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city. And when he looked on Amalek, he took up his parable, and said, Amalek was the first of the nations; but his latter end shall be that he perish forever.

**Psalm 83:6-8** The tabernacles **of Edom**, and the Ishmaelites, of <u>Moab</u>, and the Hagarenes, Gebal, and <u>Ammon, and Amalek</u>, the <u>Philistines</u> with the



inhabitants of Tyre, Assur also is joined with them: They have holpen the children of Lot.

Joel 3:19 Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the <u>violence</u> against the children of Judah, <u>because they have shed innocent blood in their land.</u> But Judah shall dwell forever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.

Ezekiel 7:5-8 Thus saith the Lord GOD, An evil, an only evil, behold, is come. An end is come, the end is come, it watches for you, behold, it is come. The morning is come unto thee, O thou that dwellest in the land: the time is come, the day of trouble is near, and not the sounding again of the mountains. Now will I shortly pour out my fury upon you and accomplish mine anger upon you: And I will judge you according to your ways, and will recompense you for all your abominations.

Ezekiel 7:10,11 Behold the day, behold, it is come: The morning is gone forth, the rod hath blossomed, pride hath budded. <u>Violence is risen up</u> into a rod of wickedness: None of them shall remain, nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: Neither shall there be wailing for them.

**Exodus 16:1** And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the **fifteenth day of the second month** after their departing out of the land of Egypt.

**Exodus 16:2** And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness.

**Exodus 16:8** And Moses said, This shall be, when the LORD shall give you in the evening **flesh to eat**, and in the morning bread to the full, for that the LORD heareth your murmurings which ye murmur against him: And what are we? Your murmurings are not against us, but against the LORD.

**Exodus 16:12,13** I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: Speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread, and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God. And it came to pass, that **at even** the quails came up, and covered the camp: And **in the morning the dew** lay round about the host.

**Exodus 16:25,26** And Moses said, Eat that today, for today is a sabbath unto the LORD: Today ye shall not find it in the field. Six days ye shall gather it, but on the seventh day, which is the sabbath, in it there shall be none.



**Exodus 17:3** And the people thirsted there for water; and the people murmured against Moses, and said, Wherefore is this that thou hast brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst?

**Exodus 17:6** Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb, and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

**Exodus 17:8,9a Then came Amalek,** and fought with Israel in Rephidim. And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, **fight with Amalek.** 

Numbers 10:11-14 In the second year, in the second month, on the twentieth day of the month, the cloud lifted from over the tabernacle of the testimony, and the people of Israel set out by stages from the wilderness of Sinai. And the cloud settled down in the wilderness of Paran. They set out for the first time at the command of the LORD by Moses. The standard of the camp of the people of Judah set out first by their companies, and over their company was Nahshon the son of Amminadab.

**Numbers 11:1** And when the people complained, it displeased the LORD: And the LORD heard it, and his anger was kindled, and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp. And the people cried unto Moses; and when Moses prayed unto the LORD, the fire was quenched.

**Numbers 11:4** And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?

**Numbers 11:19,20** Ye shall not eat one day, nor two days, nor five days, neither ten days, nor twenty days; But even a whole month, until it come out at your nostrils, and it be loathsome unto you: because that ye have despised the LORD which is among you, and have wept before him, saying, Why came we forth out of Egypt?

**Numbers 11:31** And there went forth a wind from the LORD, and brought quails from the sea, and let them fall by the camp, as it were **a day's journey on this side**, and as it were **a day's journey on the other side**, round about the camp, and as it were **two cubits high** upon the face of the earth.

**Numbers 11:33** And while the flesh was yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people **with a very great plague.** 



**Numbers 12:1** And **Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses** because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: For he had married an Ethiopian woman.

Numbers 13:29 The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: And the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

**Genesis 36:12** And Timna was concubine to Eliphaz Esau's son; and she bare to Eliphaz **Amalek.** 

Genesis 14:5-7 And in the fourteenth year, Chedorlaomer and the kings who were on his side, overcame the Rephaim in Ashteroth-karnaim, and the Zuzim in Ham, and the Emim in Shaveh-kiriathaim, And the Horites in their mountain Seir, driving them as far as El-paran, which is near the waste land. Then they came back to En-mishpat (which is Kadesh), making waste all the country of the Amalekites and of the Amorites living in Hazazon-tamar.

Deuteronomy 2:12 And the Horites in earlier times were living in Seir, but the children of Esau took their place, they sent destruction on them and took their land for themselves.

**Isaiah 60:1,2** Arise, shine, for your light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon you. For, behold, **the darkness** shall cover the earth, and **gross darkness the people:** But the LORD shall arise upon you, and His glory shall be seen upon you.

**Isaiah 60:18,19** <u>Violence</u> shall no more be heard in your land, wasting nor destruction within your borders, but you shall call your walls **Salvation**, and your gates Praise. The sun shall be no more your light by day, neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto you: but the LORD shall be unto you an everlasting light, and your God your glory.

**Luke 21:25** And there <u>WILL BE SIGNS in the SUN</u>, and <u>in the MOON</u>, and in the STARS, and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity.

**Numbers 10:35,36** And it came to pass, when the ark set forward, that Moses said,Rise up, LORD, and let thine enemies be scattered, and let them that hate thee flee before thee. And when it rested, he said, Return, O LORD, unto the many thousands of Israel.
