### TORAH PORTION

Genesis 41:1-3 And it came to pass at <u>the end</u> of <u>two full years</u>, that Pharaoh dreamed: And, behold, he stood by the river. And, behold, there came up out of the river seven well-favored cows and fat, and they fed in a meadow. And, behold, seven other cows came up after them out of the river, ill favored and skinny, and stood by the other cows on the brink of the river.

**Exodus 23:14-16** Three times you shall keep a feast to me in the year. You shall keep the feast of unleavened bread: You shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, in the time appointed of the month Abib,(Spring) for in it you came out from Egypt: And none shall appear before me empty: And the feast of harvest, (Summer) the first fruits of your labors, which you have sown in the field: and the feast of ingathering,(Fall) which is in **the end** of the year, when you have gathered in your labors out of the field.

**Genesis 41:9** Then spoke the chief butler to Pharaoh, saying, <u>I do remember my faults</u> this day.

**Leviticus 23:24** Speak to the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall you have a sabbath, <u>a memorial</u> of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

**Genesis 41:40,41** You shall be over my house, and according to your word shall all my people be ruled: Only in the throne will I be greater than you. And Pharaoh said to Joseph, See, I have set you over all the land of Egypt.

**Genesis 41:14a** Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him **hastily** out of the dungeon.

**Isaiah 56:1** Thus said the LORD, Keep you judgment, and do justice: For my salvation (Yeshua) is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

**Revelation 3:11** Behold, <u>I come quickly</u>: Hold that fast which you have, that no man take your crown.

**Malachi 3:1** Behold, I will send <u>my messenger</u>, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall <u>suddenly come to his temple</u>, <u>even the messenger of the covenant</u>, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.



**1 Corinthians 15:52** <u>In a moment</u>, in the <u>twinkling of an eye</u>, at the <u>last trump:</u> For the trumpet shall sound, and <u>the dead shall be raised</u> incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Daniel 12:1,2 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which stands for the children of thy people: And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: And at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

Genesis 41:38,39 And Pharaoh said to his servants, Can we find such a one as this, a man in whom the Spirit of God is? And Pharaoh said to Joseph, For as much as God has showed you all this, there is none so discreet and wise as you are.

Genesis 41:42,43 And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck, And he made him to ride in the second chariot which he had; and they cried before him, **Bow the knee:** And he made him ruler over all the land of Egypt.

**Philippians 2:10** That at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth.

**Romans 14:11** For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.

**Isaiah 45:23** Give the word, put forward your cause, let us have a discussion together: Who has given news of this in the past? Who made it clear in early times? Did not I, the Lord? And there is no God but me, a true God and a saviour, there is no other. Let your hearts be turned to me, so that you may have salvation, all the ends of the earth: For I am God, and there is no other. By myself have I taken an oath, a true word has gone from my mouth, and will not be changed, **that to me every knee will be bent, and every tongue will give honor.** 

Genesis 41:45a And Pharaoh called Joseph's name **Zaphn**athpaaneah.

Genesis 41:49,50 And Joseph gathered grain as the sand of the sea, very much, until he left numbering, for it was without number. And to Joseph were



<u>born two sons before the years of famine</u> came, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bore unto him.

Genesis 41:51-53 And Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: For God, said he, has made me forget all my toil, and all my father's house. And the name of the second called he Ephraim: For God has caused me to be fruitful in the land of my affliction. And the seven years of plenty, that was in the land of Egypt, were ended.

Genesis 42:1-5 Now Jacob, hearing that there was grain in Egypt, said to his sons, Why are you looking at one another? And he said, I have had news that there is grain in Egypt: Go down there and get grain for us, so that life and not death may be ours. Joseph's ten brothers went down to buy grain from Egypt. But Jacob didn't send Benjamin, Joseph's brother, with his brothers, for he said, Lest perhaps harm happen to him. The sons of Israel came to buy among those who came, for the famine was in the land of Canaan.

Genesis 42:14-18 And Joseph said, It is as I said; you have come with some secret purpose, But in this way will you be put to the test: By the life of Pharaoh, you will not go away from this place till your youngest brother comes here. Send one of your number to get your brother, and the rest of you will be kept in prison, so that your words may be tested to see if you are true, if not, by the life of Pharaoh, your purpose is certainly secret. So he put them in prison for three days. And on the third day Joseph said to them, Do this, if you would keep your lives: for I am a god-fearing man.

Genesis 42:19-24 If you be true men, let one of your brothers be bound in the house of your prison: Go you, carry corn for the famine of your houses: But bring your youngest brother to me; so shall your words be verified, and you shall not die. And they did so. And they said one to another, We are truly guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he sought us, and we would not hear, therefore is this distress come on us. And Reuben answered them, saying, Spoke I not to you, saying, Do not sin against the child, and you would not hear? Therefore, behold, also his blood is required. And they knew not that Joseph understood them, for he spoke to them by an interpreter. And he turned himself about from them, and wept, and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

**Romans 11:8** (According as it is written, <u>God</u> has given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and <u>ears that they should not hear;</u>) to this day.

Simeon is held back whose name means to hear.



Genesis 42:27,28 And as one of them opened his sack to give his ass provender in the inn, he espied his money, for, behold, it was in his sack's mouth. And he said to his brothers, My money is restored, and, see, it is even in my sack: And their heart failed them, and they were <u>afraid</u>, saying one to another, What is this that God has done to us?

Genesis 42:37,38 And Reuben spoke to his father, saying, Slay my two sons, if I bring him not to you: Deliver him into my hand, and I will bring him to you again. And he said, My son shall not go down with you.

**Genesis 43:8,9** And Judah said to Israel his father, Send the lad with me, and we will arise and go, that we may live, and not die, both we, and you, and also our little ones. <u>I will be surety for him</u>, of <u>my hand</u> shall you require him: If I bring him not to you, and set him before you, then <u>let me bear the blame</u> for ever.

**Genesis 44:12** And he searched, and began at the eldest, and left at the youngest: And the cup was found in Benjamin's sack. Then <u>they rent their clothes</u>.

## **Going Deeper Into the Gospels**

John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him, and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in darkness, and the darkness comprehended it not.

**Genesis 1:1,2** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and **darkness** was upon the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.** 

Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Colossians 1:9-17 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the **knowledge** of his will in all **wisdom** and spiritual **understanding**, That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God, Strengthened with all **might**, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness, Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who

hath **delivered us from the power of darkness**, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: **Who is the image of the invisible God,** the firstborn of every creature: For **by him were all things created**, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: All things were created **by him, and for him:** And **he is before all things, and by him all things consist**.

**John 1:10,11** He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

**Isaiah 1:2,3** Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: For the LORD hath spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me. The ox knows his owner, and the ass his master's crib: But Israel doth not know, my people doth not consider.

**Psalm 33:6** By the **Word of the LORD** were the heavens made, and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

**Proverbs 3:19,20** The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth, by understanding hath he established the heavens. By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew.

**Psalm 8:22,23** The LORD possessed **me** in the beginning of his way, before his works of old. **I** was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and <u>dwelt among us</u>, (and we beheld his <u>glory</u>, the <u>glory</u> as of the only begotten of the Father,) <u>full of</u> grace and truth.

Exodus 33:18 And he said, I beseech thee, shew me thy glory.

Exodus 34:6 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.

**John 1:17** For the law was given by Moses, *but* grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

Exodus 40:34Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and <u>the</u> glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.



Exodus 25:8 And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.

**John 1:18** No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

Revelation 1:12-16 And I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks, And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were as a flame of fire, And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars: And out of his mouth went a sharp two-edged sword: And his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

Ezekiel 43:2And behold, the glory of the God of Israel was coming from the east. And the sound of his coming was like the sound of many waters, and the earth shone with his glory.

Revelation 14:2 And a voice from heaven came to my ears, like the sound of great waters, and the sound of loud thunder: And the voice which came to me was like the sound of players, playing on instruments of music.

**Revelation 1:17-19** And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not, I am the **first and the last**: I am he that liveth, and was dead, and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen, and have the keys of hell and of death. Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter.

John 1:19-22 And this is the witness of John when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to him with the question, Who are you? He said quite openly and straightforwardly, I am not the Christ. And they said to him, What then? Are you Elijah? And he said, I am not. Are you the prophet? And his answer was, I am not. So they said to him, Who are you then? We have to give some answer to those who sent us. What have you to say about yourself?

**Malachi 4:5** See, I am sending you Elijah the prophet before the day of the Lord comes, that great day, greatly to be feared.

**Deuteronomy 18:18,19** I will give them a prophet from among themselves, like you, and I will put my words in his mouth, and he will say to them



whatever I give him orders to say. And whoever does not give ear to my words which he will say in my name, will be responsible to me.

John 1:29,30 The day after, John sees Jesus coming to him and says, See, here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, One is coming after me who is put over me because he was in existence before me.

Matthew 11:2-6 Now when John had news in prison of the works of the Christ, he sent his disciples To say to him, Are you he **who is to come, or are we waiting for another**? And Jesus, answering, said to them, Go and give news to John of the things which you are seeing and hearing: The blind see, those who were not able to, are walking, lepers are made clean, those who were without hearing, now have their ears open, the dead come to life again, and the poor have the good news given to them. And a blessing will be on him who has no doubts about me.

**John 1:33,34** I had no knowledge who he was, but he who sent me to give baptism with water said to me, The one on whom you see the Spirit coming down and resting, it is he who gives baptism with the Holy Spirit. This I saw myself and my witness is that he is the **Son of God.** 

**Proverbs 30:4** Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who hath gathered the wind in his fists? Who hath bound the waters in a garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and **what is his Son's name**, if thou canst tell?

**Psalm 2:12 Kiss the Son,** lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

**Daniel 7:13,14** I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the **Son of man** came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they **brought him** near before him. And there was **given him** dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, **should serve him**: **His dominion** is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and **his kingdom** that which shall not be destroyed.

**Psalm 89:18** For our breastplate is **the Lord, and our king** is the **Holy One of Israel's**.

John 1:49-51 Nathanael said to him, Rabbi, you are the Son of God, you are King of Israel! In answer Jesus said to him, You have faith because I said to you, I saw you under the fig-tree. You will see greater things than these. And he said to him, Truly I say to you all, You will see heaven opening and God's angels going up and coming down on the Son of man.
