TORAH PORTION

Genesis 46:27b Al the souls of the house of Jacob, which came into Egypt, were <u>threescore and ten.</u>

Acts 7:14 Then sent Joseph, and called his father <u>Jacob</u> to him, and <u>all his</u> <u>kindred</u>, <u>threescore and fifteen souls</u>.

Deuteronomy 25:5,6 If brethren dwell together, and one of them die, and have no child, the wife of the dead shall not marry without unto a stranger: **Her husband's brother shall go in unto her, and take her to him to wife, and perform the duty of an husband's brother unto her.** And it shall be, that the firstborn which she beareth shall succeed in the name of his brother which is dead, that his name be not put out of Israel.

Genesis 47:27 And <u>Israel</u> dwelled in the land of Egypt, in the country of <u>Goshen</u>, and they had possessions therein, and grew, and <u>multiplied</u> exceedingly.

Exodus 8:22 And I will sever in that day the land of <u>Goshen</u>, in which my people dwell, that <u>no swarms of flies shall be there</u>, to the end you may know that I am the LORD in the middle of the earth.

Exodus 9:26 Only in the land of <u>Goshen</u>, where the children of Israel were, <u>was there **no hail**</u>.

Exodus 10:22,23 Moses stretched out his hand toward the sky, and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days. They didn't see one another, neither did anyone rise from his place for three days, but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.

Genesis 47:28 Jacob lived in the land of Egypt **seventeen years**. So the days of **Jacob**, the years of his life, were **one hundred forty-seven years**.

Genesis 47:29,30 And when the time drew near that <u>Israel</u> must die, he called his son Joseph and said to him, If now I have found favor in your sight, put your hand under my thigh and promise to deal kindly and truly with me. Do not bury me in Egypt but let me lie with my fathers. Carry me out of Egypt and bury me in their burying place. He answered, I will do as you have said.

Genesis 48:1 And it came to pass after these things, that one told Joseph, Behold, your father is sick: And <u>he took with him his two sons, Manasseh</u> and Ephraim.

Genesis 48:3,4 And Jacob said to Joseph, God Almighty appeared to me at Luz in the land of Canaan, and blessed me, And said to me, Behold, <u>I will make you</u> fruitful, and multiply you, and I will make of you a multitude of people, and will give this land to your seed after you for an everlasting possession.

Genesis 48:15,16 And he blessed Joseph and said, The God before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, the God who has been my shepherd all my life long to this day, the angel who has redeemed me from all evil, bless the boys, and in them let my name be carried on, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac, and let them **grow** into a multitude in the midst of the earth.

Genesis 48:19 And his father refused and said, I know it, my son, I know it. He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great, but truly his younger brother (Ephraim) shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude $\alpha \delta \alpha$ of nations.

Exodus 1:7 But the people of Israel **were fruitful and increased greatly**, they <u>multiplied and grew</u> exceedingly strong, so that the land was filled with them.

Matthew 4:18,19 And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: For they were fishers. And he said to them, Follow me, and I will make you **fishers of men**.

Ezekiel 47:8-10 Then said he to me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: Which being brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed. And it shall come to pass, that everything that lives, which moves, wherever the rivers shall come, shall live: And there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: For they shall be healed, and everything shall live where the river comes. And it shall come to pass, that the fishers shall stand on it from Engedi even to Eneglaim, they shall be a place to spread forth nets, their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.

Ezekiel 47:12 And by the river on the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: It shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: And the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

Revelation 22:1,2 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the middle of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which

bore twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: And <u>the leaves</u> of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

Genesis 48:8-10 And Israel <u>beheld</u> Joseph's sons, and said, <u>Who are these</u>? Joseph said to his father, They are my sons, whom God has given me here. He said, Please bring them to me, and I will bless them. <u>Now the eyes of Israel</u> <u>were dim for age, so that he couldn't see</u>. He brought them near to him, and he kissed them, and embraced them.

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brothers, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own conceits, that <u>blindness in part</u> is happened to Israel, until the <u>fulness of the Gentiles</u> be come in.

Isaiah 49:18-22 Lift up thine eyes round about, <u>and behold</u>: <u>All these gather</u> themselves together, and come to thee. As I live, saith Jehovah, thou shalt surely clothe thee with them all as with an ornament, and gird thyself with them, like a bride. For, as for thy waste and thy desolate places, and thy land that hath been destroyed, surely now shalt thou be too strait for the inhabitants, and they that swallowed thee up shall be far away. The children of thy bereavement shall yet say in thine ears, The place is too strait for me, give place to me that I may dwell. Then shalt thou say in thy heart, <u>Who hath begotten</u> <u>me these</u>, seeing I have been bereaved of my children, and am solitary, an exile, and wandering to and fro? And <u>who hath brought up these</u>? Behold, I was left alone, these, where were they? Thus saith the Lord Jehovah, Behold, <u>I will lift up my hand to the nations</u>, and set up my ensign to the peoples; and they shall bring thy sons in their bosom, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders.

Ephesians 2:19 Now therefore <u>you are no more strangers and foreigners</u>, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God.

Isaiah 49:5,6 And now the Lord says, he who formed me from the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob back to him, and that Israel might be gathered to him for I am honored in the eyes of the Lord, and my God has become my strength—he says: It is too light a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back the preserved of Israel, I will make you as <u>a light for the nations</u>, that <u>my salvation may reach to the end of the earth</u>.

Revelation 7:9,10 After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, <u>from every nation</u>, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, <u>Salvation</u> belongs to our God who sits on **the throne**, and to the Lamb.

Revelation 7:13,14 Then one of the elders addressed me, saying, <u>Who are</u> <u>these</u>, clothed in white robes, and from where have they come? I said to him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Genesis 49:1,2 And Jacob called unto his sons, and said: Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the <u>end of days</u>. Assemble yourselves, and hear, ye sons of Jacob, and hearken unto Israel your father.

Genesis 49:10,11 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until <u>Shiloh</u> come, and to him shall the gathering of the people be. Binding his foal to the vine, and his ass's colt to the choice vine, he <u>washed</u> his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes.

Revelation 7:13-15 And answer did one of the elders, saying to me, These, who have been arrayed with the white robes who are they, and whence came they? And I have said to him, Sir, thou hast known, and he said to me, These are those who are coming out of the great tribulation, and <u>they did wash their</u> robes, and they made their robes white in the blood of the Lamb, because of this are they before the throne of God, and they do service to Him day and night in His sanctuary, and He who is sitting upon the throne shall tabernacle over them.

Isaiah 63:1-4 Who is this that comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? This that is glorious in his apparel, traveling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save. Why are you red in your apparel, and your garments like him that treads in the winefat? I have trodden the wine press alone, and of the people there was none with me: For I will tread them in my anger, and trample them in my fury, and their blood shall be sprinkled on my garments, and I will stain all my raiment. For the day of vengeance is in my heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

Revelation 19:14,15 And the armies which were in heaven followed him on white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the wine press of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Genesis 50:25 And Joseph took an oath of the children of Israel, saying, <u>God</u> will surely visit you, and you shall <u>carry up my bones</u> from here.



Going Deeper Into the Gospels

Matthew 1:1 The book of the generations of Yeshua HaMashiach, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Isaiah 11:1,2 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and **a Branch** shall grow out of his roots: And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Zechariah 3:8 Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, thou, and thy fellows that sit before thee: for they are men wondered at: For, behold, I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH.

Zechariah 6:12,13 And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH, and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD: Even he shall build the temple of the LORD, and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne, and he shall be a priest upon his throne: And the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Psalm 89:3,4 I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant, Thy seed will I establish forever and build up thy throne to all generations. Selah.

Psalm 89:34-37 My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure forever, and his throne as the sun before me. It shall be established **forever as the moon**, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah.

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are <u>fourteen</u> <u>generations</u>, and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are <u>fourteen</u> <u>generations</u>, and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Messiah are <u>fourteen generations</u>.

Matthew 1:21-23 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name YESHUA: For he shall save his people **from their sins**. Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

Isaiah 7:13,14 And he said, Hear ye now, **O house of David**, Is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also? Therefore, the Lord himself shall give you a sign, Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.



Matthew 2:1,2 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? For we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.

Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let <u>them</u> be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years.

Daniel 9:24-26 Seventy weeks are decreed on your people and on your holy city, to finish disobedience, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy. Know therefore and discern, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem to the <u>Anointed One</u>, the prince, shall be seven weeks, and sixty-two weeks: It shall be built again, with street and moat, even in troubled times. After the sixty-two weeks <u>the Anointed One shall be cut off</u>, and shall have nothing: And the people of the prince who shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary, and its end shall be with a flood, and even to the end shall be war, desolations are determined.

Genesis 24:16 And the damsel was very fair to look upon, a <u>virgin</u>, neither had any man known her: And she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

Genesis 24:43 Behold, I stand by the fountain of water, and let it come to pass, that the <u>maiden</u> that cometh forth to draw, to whom I shall say: Give me, I pray thee, a little water from thy pitcher to drink.

Joel 1:8 Lament like a virgin girded with sackcloth for the husband of her youth.

Matthew 2:1,2 Now when Yeshua was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? For we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.

Matthew 2:5,6 And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of Judaea: For thus it is written by the prophet, And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda: For out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.



Micah 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel, whose goings forth have been from of old, **from everlasting.**

Matthew 2:13-15 And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: For Herod will seek the young child to destroy him. When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: And was there until the death of Herod: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son.

Hosea 11:1 When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.
