TORAH PORTION

Exodus 13:17-19 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had <u>let the people go</u>, that God led them not through the way of <u>the land of the Philistines</u>, although that was near, for God said, Lest peradventure <u>the people</u> repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt: But *God led <u>the people</u>* about, through the way of the wilderness of the Red sea: And <u>the children of Israel</u> went up <u>harnessed out of the land of Egypt</u>. And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him: For he had straitly sworn the children of Israel, saying, <u>God will surely visit you</u>; and ye shall <u>carry up my bones away</u> hence with you.

Leviticus 23:6,7 And on **the fifteenth day** of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: Seven days ye must eat unleavened bread. In the **first day** ye shall have an holy convocation: Ye shall do no servile work therein. But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: In **the seventh day** is an holy convocation: Ye shall do no servile work therein.

Exodus 14:11-13 They said to Moses, Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness? What have you done to us in bringing us out of Egypt? Is not this what we said to you in Egypt: Leave us alone that we may serve the Egyptians'? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness. And Moses said to the people, Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again.

Exodus 14:19-22 The angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud moved from before them, and stood behind them. It came between the camp of Egypt and the camp of Israel and there was the cloud and the darkness, yet gave it light by night: And the one didn't come near the other all the night. Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all the night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided. The children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on the dry ground, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand, and on their left.

Exodus 14:26-29 The LORD said to Moses, <u>Stretch out your hand</u> over the sea, that the waters may come again on the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen. And Moses <u>stretched forth his hand</u> over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared, and the Egyptians fled against it, and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the middle of the sea. And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them, there remained not so much as one of them. But the children of Israel <u>walked on dry ground in the middle of the sea, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand, and on their left.</u>



<u>Deuteronomy 1:3</u> And it came to pass in the fortieth year, <u>in the eleventh month</u>, on the first day of the month, that Moses spake unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the LORD had given him in commandment unto them. What month is the 11th month called in the Bible? What month are we in now?

Zechariah 1:7a On the twenty-fourth day of the eleventh month, the month Shevat

Zechariah 1:8 I saw in the night a man on a red horse, between the mountains in the valley, and at his back were horses, red, black, white, and of mixed colors. Next weekend the shabbat is the 24th of shevat!

Deuteronomy 31:2 And Moses went and spake these words unto all Israel. And he said unto them, **I am an hundred and twenty years old <u>this day</u>**, I can no more go out and come in: also the LORD hath said unto me, Thou shalt not go over this Jordan.

Deuteronomy 34:7,8 And Moses was an **hundred and twenty years old when he died:** His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab **thirty days**: So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:1,2 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead, now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Joshua 1:10,11 Then Joshua gave their orders to those who were in authority over the people, saying, Go through the tents and give orders to the people, saying, Get ready a store of food, for in **three days you are to go over this river Jorda**n and take for your heritage the land which the Lord your God is giving you.

Joshua 4:18,19 And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, and the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as they did before. And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Joshua 2:1,2 Then Joshua, the son of Nun, sent two men from Shittim **secretly**, with the purpose of searching out the land, and Jericho.

Joshua 2:21,22 And she said, Let it be as you say. Then she sent them away, and they went, and she put the bright red cord in the window. And they went into the hill-country and were there **three days**, till the men who had gone after them had come



back, and those who went after them were searching for them everywhere without coming across them.

Joshua 2:23 Then the two men came down from the hill-country and went over and came back to Joshua, the son of Nun, and they gave him a complete account of what had taken place.

Joshua 5:5 All the people who came out **had** undergone circumcision, but all the people whose birth had taken place in the waste land on their journey from Egypt **had not.**

Joshua 5:8 So when all the nation had **undergone circumcision**, they kept in their tents till they were well again.

Joshua 5:10 So the children of Israel put up their tents in Gilgal, and they kept the Passover on the **fourteenth day of the month**, in the evening, in the lowlands of Jericho.

Exodus 12:34 The people took their dough before it was leavened, their kneading troughs being **bound up in their clothes on their shoulders**.

Exodus 16:2,3 And the whole congregation of the children of Israel <u>murmured</u> <u>against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness</u>: And the children of Israel said to them, **Would to God we had died by the hand of the LORD** in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when we did eat bread to the full, for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger.

Exodus 16:4 Then said the LORD unto Moses: Behold, I will cause to rain bread from heaven for you, and the people shall go out and gather <u>a day's portion</u> every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in My law, or not.

Exodus 16:25-29 Moses said, Eat that **today**, for **today** is a Sabbath to the LORD. **Today you shall not find it in the field**. Six days you shall gather it, but on the seventh day is the Sabbath. In it there shall be none. It happened on the seventh day, that some of the people went out to gather, and they found none. The LORD said to Moses, How long do you refuse to keep my commandments and my laws? Behold, because the LORD has given you the Sabbath, therefore he gives you on the sixth day the bread of two days. Everyone stay in his place. Let no one go out of his place on the seventh day.

Exodus 17:1b-3 And there was no water for the people to drink. Why the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said to them, Why chide you with me? Why do ye tempt the LORD? And the people thirsted there for water, and the people murmured against Moses, and said, Why is this that



you have brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst?

Exodus 17:4-8 And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, What shall I do to this people? They be almost ready to stone me. And the LORD said unto Moses, Go on before the people, and take with you of the elders of Israel, and thy rod, with which you smote the river, take in your hand, and go. Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb, and you shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel. And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, Is the LORD among us, or not? Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

Exodus 17:15,16 And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it <u>Jehovahnissi</u>: For he said, Because the LORD has sworn that the LORD will have <u>war with Amalek</u> from generation to generation.

Digging Deeper into the Gospels

Mark 9:30,31 And they departed thence, and passed through Galilee, and he would not that any man should know it. For he taught his disciples, and said unto them, The **Son of man** is **delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill him, and after that he is killed,** he shall rise the third day. **But they understood not** that saying, and were afraid to ask him.

Mark 9:33-37 And he came to Capernaum: And being in the house he asked them, What was it that ye disputed among yourselves by the way? But they held their peace: For by the way they had disputed among themselves, who should be the greatest. And he sat down, and called the twelve, and saith unto them, If any man desire to be first, the same shall be last of all, and servant of all. And he took a child, and set him in the midst of them: And when he had taken him in his arms, he said unto them, Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: And whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.

Mark 10:1 And he arose from thence, and cometh into the coasts of Judaea by the farther side of Jordan: And the people resort unto him again, and, as he was went, he taught them again.

Mark 10:13-16 And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: And his disciples rebuked those that brought them. But when Jesus saw it, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God. Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein. And he took them up in his arms, put his hands upon them, and blessed them.



Mark 10:17 Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?

Mark 10:19,20 Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother. And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth.

Mark 10:21,22 Then Yeshua beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: Go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: And come, take up the cross, and follow me. And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

Mark 10:32-37 Now they were on the road, going up to Jerusalem, and Yeshua was going before them, and they were amazed. And as they followed they were afraid. Then He took the twelve aside again and began to tell them the things that would happen to Him: Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribe, and they will condemn Him to death and deliver Him to the Gentiles, and they will mock Him, and scourge Him, and spit on Him, and kill Him. And the third day He will rise again. Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Him, saying, Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask. And He said to them, What do you want Me to do for you? They said to him, Grant to us that we may sit, one on your right hand, and the other on your left hand, in your glory.

Mark 10:45-52 For even the <u>Son of man</u> came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. And they came to Jericho: And as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, <u>blind Bartimaeus</u>, the son of <u>Timaeus</u>, sat by the highway side <u>begging</u>. And when he heard that it was Yeshua of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Yeshua, thou <u>Son of David</u>, have mercy on me. And many charged him that he should hold his peace: But he cried the more a great deal, <u>Thou Son of David</u>, have mercy on me. And Yeshua stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise, he calleth thee. And he, <u>casting away his garment</u>, rose, and came to Yeshua. And Yeshua answered and said unto him, <u>What do you want Me to do for you</u>? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive <u>my sight</u>. And Yeshua said unto him, Go thy way, <u>thy faith</u> hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and <u>followed Yeshua in the way</u>.

Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace that was given me, to every man who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think reasonably, as God has apportioned **to each person a measure of faith.**



Luke 17:5,6 And the apostles said unto the Lord, **Increase our faith**. And the Lord said, If ye had faith **as a grain of mustard seed**, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

Luke 17:7-10 But which of you, having a servant plowing or **feeding cattle**, will say unto him by and by, when he is come from the field, Go and sit down to meat? And will not rather say unto him, Make ready wherewith I may sup, and gird thyself, and serve me, till I have eaten and drunken, and afterward thou shalt eat and drink? **Doth he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him**? I trow not. So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.

1 Corinthians 13:1-3 If I speak with the languages of men and of angels, but don't have love, I have become sounding brass, or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge, and **if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but don't have love, I am nothing.** If I dole out all my goods to feed the poor, and if I give my body to be burned, but don't have love, it profits me nothing.

1 Corinthians 13:13 But now <u>faith, hope, and love</u> remain these three. <u>The greatest</u> of these is love.

Galatians 5:6 For in Messiah Yeshua neither circumcision amounts to anything, nor uncircumcision, <u>but faith working through love</u>.

Galatians 5:13 For you, brothers, were called for freedom. Only don't use your freedom for gain to the flesh, but through love be servants to one another.

Luke 9:57-62 As they were going along the road, someone said to him, I will follow you wherever you go. And Jesus said to him, Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head. To another he said, Follow me. But he said, **Lord**, let **me first** go and bury my father. And Jesus said to him, **Leave the dead to bury their own dead.** But as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God. Yet another said, I will follow you, **Lord**, but let **me first** say farewell to those at my home. Jesus said to him, No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God.

Luke 12:54-56 He also said to the crowds, When you see a cloud rising in the west, you say at once, A shower is coming. And so it happens. And when you see the south wind blowing, you say, There will be scorching heat, and it happens. You hypocrites! You know how to interpret the appearance of earth and sky, but why do you not know how to interpret the present time?



Joel 3:2 I will also gather all nations and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.

Joel 3:9,10 Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up: Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruninghooks into spears: let the weak say, I am strong.

Joel 3:13-15 Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the fats overflow; for their wickedness is great. Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision. The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining.

Revelation 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

Genesis 49:10-12 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be. Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes: His eyes shall bered with wine, and his teeth white with milk.

Joel 3:18 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop **down new wine,and the hills shall flow with milk**, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Joel 3:19-21 Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence against the children of Judah, because **they have shed innocent blood in their land**. But Judah shall dwell forever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation. For I will cleanse their blood that I have not cleansed: for the LORD dwelleth in Zion.

Amos 5:7,8 Ye who turn judgment to **wormwood**, and leave off righteousness in the earth, Seek him that maketh **the seven stars and Orion**, and turneth the shadow of death into the morning, and maketh the day dark with night: that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD is his name:

Revelation 8:10,11 And the third angel sounded, and there fell **a great star** from heaven, <u>burning as it were a lamp</u>, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters; And the **name of the star is called Wormwood:** and
