TORAH PORTION

Exodus 21:1 Now these are the judgments which you shall set before them.

Genesis 26:5 Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, **my commandments**, my statutes, and my laws.

Deuteronomy 8:1 All the **commandments** which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 8:1 All the **commandment** which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers.

Exodus 12:24-27 You shall observe this thing for an ordinance to you and to your sons forever. It shall happen when you have come to the land which the LORD will give you, according as he has promised, that you shall keep this service. It will happen, when your children ask you, What do you mean by this service? That you shall say, It is the sacrifice of the LORD's Passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he struck the Egyptians, and spared our houses. The people bowed their heads and worshiped. Civil laws when we read that our civil laws are determined by Torah and not by our own thinking,

Exodus 21:16 Whoever steals a man and sells him, and anyone found in possession of him, shall be put to death.

Exodus 21:18,19 If, in a fight, one man gives another a blow with a stone, or with the shut hand, not causing his death, but making him keep in bed, If he is able to get up again and go about with a stick, the other will be let off, only he will have to give him payment for the loss of his time, and see that he is cared for till he is well.

Exodus 21:33-36 And if a man shall open a pit, or if a man shall dig a pit, and not cover it, and an ox or an ass fall therein, The owner of the pit shall make it good, and give money to the owner of them, and the dead beast shall be his. And if one man's ox hurt another's, that he die, then they shall sell the live ox, and divide the money of it, and the dead ox also they shall divide. Or if it be known that the ox has used to push in time past, and his owner has not kept him in, he shall surely pay ox for ox; and the dead shall be his own.

Exodus 22:1 If a man shall steal an ox, or a sheep, and kill it, or sell it, he shall restore five oxen for an ox, and four sheep for a sheep.

Exodus 22:2-6 If a thief be found breaking up, and be smitten that he die, there shall no blood be shed for him. If the sun be risen on him, there shall be blood shed for

him, for he should make full restitution, if he have nothing, then he shall be sold for his theft. If the theft be certainly found in his hand alive, whether it be ox, or ass, or sheep, he shall restore double. If a man shall cause a field or vineyard to be eaten, and shall put in his beast, and shall feed in another man's field, of the best of his own field, and of the best of his own vineyard, shall he make restitution. If fire break out, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed therewith; he that kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.

Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: But rather let him labor, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needs.

Luke 19:8 And Zacchaeus stood, and said to the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor, and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold.

Exodus 22:14 If a man borrows anything of his neighbor, and it is injured or dies, the owner not being with it, he shall make full restitution.

Exodus 22:22-24 You shall not afflict any widow, or fatherless child. **If you afflict them in any wise, and they cry at all to me, I will surely hear their cry**, And my wrath shall wax hot, and I will kill you with the sword, and your wives shall be widows, and your children fatherless.

Exodus 22:26,27 If you at all take your neighbor's raiment to pledge, you shall deliver it to him by that the sun goes down: For that is his covering only, it is his raiment for his skin: Wherein shall he sleep? And it shall come to pass, when he cries to me, that I will hear, for **I am gracious**.

Exodus 23:1,2 You shall not spread a false report. Don't join your hand with the wicked to be a malicious witness. You shall not follow a crowd to do evil, neither shall you testify in court to side with a multitude to pervert justice.

Exodus 23:7 Keep you far from a false matter.

Exodus 23:8 You shall take no bribe, for a bribe blinds those who have sight and perverts the words of the righteous.

Exodus 23:10,11 And six years you shall sow your land, and shall gather in the fruits thereof: But the seventh year you shall let it rest and lie still, that the poor of your people may eat: And what they leave the beasts of the field shall eat. In like manner you shall deal with your vineyard, and with your olive grove.

Exodus 23:14-17 Three times in the year you shall keep a feast to me. You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread. As I commanded you, you shall eat unleavened

bread for seven days at the appointed time in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt. **None shall appear before me empty-handed.** You shall keep the Feast of Harvest, of the firstfruits of your labor, of what you sow in the field. You shall keep the Feast of Ingathering at **the end of the year**, when you gather in from the field the fruit of your labor. Three times in the year shall all your males appear before the Lord God.

Exodus 23:19b You shall not seethe a kid in his mother's milk.

Exodus 23:20,21 Behold, I send an Angel before you, to keep you in the Way, and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and obey **his voice**, provoke him not, for **He will not pardon your transgressions: For my name is in him.**

Exodus 23:22 But if you carefully obey his voice and do all that I say, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.

Exodus 23:25,27 **You** shall serve the Lord your God, and he will bless **your** bread and **your** water, and I will take sickness away from among **you**. None shall miscarry or be barren in your land, I will fulfill the number of your days. I will send my terror before you and will throw into confusion all the people against whom you shall come, and I will make all your enemies turn their backs to you.

Exodus 23:31-33 And I will set your border from the Red Sea to the Sea of the Philistines, and from the wilderness to the Euphrates, for I will give the inhabitants of the land into your hand, and you shall drive them out before you. You shall make no covenant with them and their gods. They shall not dwell in your land, lest they make you sin against me, for if you serve their gods, it will surely be a snare to you.

Exodus 24:1-3 And he said to Moses, Come up to the LORD, you, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and worship you afar off. And Moses alone shall come near the LORD: But they shall not come near, neither shall the people go up with him. And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: And all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD has said will **we do.**

Exodus 24:4-8 And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD, and rose up early in the morning, and built an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel. And he sent young men of the children of Israel, which offered burnt offerings, and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen to the LORD. And Moses took half of the blood, and put it in basins, and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: And they said, All that the LORD has said will we do, and be obedient. And

Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD has made with you concerning all these words.

Exodus 24:12-14 And the LORD said to Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: And I will give you tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written, that you may teach them. And Moses rose up, and his minister Joshua: And Moses went up into the mount of God. And he said to the elders, Tarry you here for us, until we come again to you: and, behold, Aaron and Hur are with you: if any man have any matters to do, let him come to them.

Exodus 24:16,17 The glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. The seventh day he called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. The appearance of the glory of the LORD was like devouring fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.

DIGGING DEEPER INTO THE GOSPELS

Mark 13:1,2 And when he was going out of the Temple, one of his disciples said to him, **Master, see**, what stones and what buildings! And Jesus said to him, **Do you see** these great buildings? There is not one stone here resting on another which will not be overturned.

John 2:20 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days?

Mark 13:14,15 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains: And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take anything out of his house.

1 Maccabees 2:27,28 And Mattathias cried throughout the city with a loud voice, saying, Whosoever is zealous of the law, and maintaineth the covenant, let him follow me. So he and his sons **fled into the mountains, and left all that ever they had in the city**.

Mark 13:16-18 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment. But woe to them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.

1 Maccabees 1:54-64 Now the fifteenth day of the month Kislev, in the hundred forty and fifth year, **they set up the abomination of desolation** upon the altar, and builded idol altars throughout the cities of Juda on every side, And burnt incense at

the doors of their houses, and in the streets. And when they had rent in pieces the books of the law which they found, they burnt them with fire. And whosoever was found with any the book of the testament, or if any committed to the law, the king's commandment was, that they should put him to death. Thus did they by their authority unto the Israelites every month, to as many as were found in the cities. Now the **five and twentieth day of the month they did sacrifice upon the idol altar, which was upon the altar of God.** At which time according to the commandment they put to death certain women, that had caused their children to be circumcised. And they **hanged the infants about their necks,** and rifled their houses, and slew them that had circumcised them. Howbeit many in Israel were fully resolved and confirmed in themselves not to eat any unclean thing. Wherefore the rather to die, that they might not be defiled with meats, and that they might not profane the holy covenant: So then they died. And there was very great wrath upon Israel.

Mark 13:24-26 But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, And **the stars of heaven shall fall,** and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.

Isaiah 13:6-10 Howl ye, for the day of the LORD is at hand, it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty. Therefore shall all hands be faint, and every man's heart shall melt: And they shall be afraid: pangs and sorrows shall take hold of them, they shall be in pain as a woman that travaileth: They shall be amazed one at another, their faces shall be as flames. Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: And he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. **For the stars of heaven** and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: The sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine.

Mark 14:12-15 And the first day of unleavened bread, when **they killed the passover,** his disciples said unto him, Where wilt thou that we go and prepare that thou mayest eat the passover? And he sendeth forth two of his disciples, and saith unto them, Go ye into the city, and there shall meet you a man bearing a pitcher of water: Follow him. And wheresoever he shall go in, say ye to the goodman of the house, The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples? And he will shew you a large upper room furnished and prepared: There make ready for us.

Mark 14:22-26 And as they are eating, Jesus having taken bread, having blessed, brake, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat, this is my body. And having taken the cup, having given thanks, he gave to them, and they drank of it all, and he said to them, This is my blood of the new covenant, which for many is being poured out, verily I say to you, that no more may I drink of the produce of the vine till that day

when I may drink it new in the reign of God. And having sung an hymn, they went forth to the mount of the Olives.

Jeremiah 31:31-33 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a **new covenant** with the *house of Israel, and with the house of Judah*: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, which my covenant they broke, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel, After those days, saith the LORD, **I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts;** and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Daniel 7:13,14 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Mark 14:61-64 But he held his peace and answered nothing. Again, the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed? And Yeshua said, and ye shall see **the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.** Then the high priest rent his clothes, and saith, What need we any further witnesses? Ye have heard the blasphemy: What think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

John 18:31,32 Then Pilate said to them, Take him yourselves and let him be judged by your law. But the Jews said to him, We have no right to put any man to death. (That the word of Jesus might come true, pointing to the sort of death he would have.)

Mark 14:63,64 Then the high priest rent his clothes, and saith, What need we any further witnesses? Ye have heard the blasphemy: What think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

Leviticus 21:10 And he that is the high priest among his brethren, upon whose head the anointing oil was poured, and that is consecrated to put on the garments, shall not uncover his head, nor rend his clothes.

Mark 14:72 And the second time the cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Yeshua said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept.
