TORAH PORTION

Exodus 27:20,21 And <u>you shall command</u> the children of Israel, that they bring you pure oil olive beaten for the light, to <u>cause the lamp to burn always</u>. <u>In the tabernacle of the congregation</u> without the veil, which is before the testimony, **Aaron** and his sons shall order it from **evening to morning** before the LORD: It shall be a statute for ever to their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.

Exodus 28:1,2 Bring <u>Aaron</u> your brother, and his sons with him, near to you from among the children of Israel, that he may minister to me in the priest's office, even <u>Aaron</u>, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, <u>Aaron's</u> sons. You shall make holy garments for <u>Aaron</u> your brother, for glory and for beauty.

Deuteronomy 34:5-8 So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: But no man knows of his sepulcher to this day. And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab **thirty days:** So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:1,2 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead, now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you, and all this people, to the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Joshua 1:11 Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals, for within <u>three days</u> you shall <u>pass over this Jordan</u>, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God gives you to possess it.

Joshua 4:19 And the people <u>came up out of Jordan on the **tenth day of the first month**, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.</u>

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, <u>I am an hundred and twenty years old this day</u>, I can no more go out and come in: Also the LORD has said to me, You shall not go over this Jordan.

Exodus 32:32 Yet now, if you will forgive their sin, and if not, blot me, I pray, **from your book** which you have written.

Exodus 28:9-12 And you shall take <u>two onyx stones</u>, and you shall engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel. Six of their names shall be on one stone, and six of the remaining names on the other stone, **according to their birth**. With the work of an engraver in stone, like the engravings of a signet, you shall engrave the



two stones with the names of the sons of Israel. You shall make them to be set in settings of gold. And you shall put the two stones upon the shoulders of the ephod for stones of memorial to the sons of Israel. And Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial.

Exodus 32:21 And Moses said to Aaron, What did the people do to you that you let this great sin come on them? And Aaron said, Let not my lord be angry, you have seen how the purposes of this people are evil.

1 Samuel 15:24 And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: For I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: Because **I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.**

Exodus 28:15 You shall make a breastplate of judgment, the work of the skillful workman, like the work of the ephod you shall make it, of gold, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, you shall make it.

Exodus 28:21 The stones shall be according to <u>the names of the children of Israel</u>, twelve, according to their names, like the engravings of a signet, everyone according to his name, they shall be for the twelve tribes.

Exodus 29:19,20 You shall take the other ram, and Aaron and his sons shall lay their hands on the head of the ram, and you shall kill the ram and take part of its blood and put it on the tip of the right ear of Aaron and on the tips of the right ears of his sons, and on the thumbs of their right hands and on the great toes of their right feet, and throw the rest of the blood against the sides of the altar.

Exodus 29:38,39 Now this is that which you shall <u>offer on the altar</u>; two lambs of the first year <u>day by day continually</u>. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning; and the other lamb you shall offer at even.

Exodus 29:42-46 This shall be a <u>continual burnt offering</u> throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: <u>Where I will meet you, to speak there to you.</u> And <u>there I will meet</u> with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by my glory. And <u>I will sanctify</u> the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar: <u>I will sanctify</u> also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. And <u>I will dwell</u> among the children of Israel, and will be their God. And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, <u>that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt</u>, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.

Exodus 30:7,8 And **Aaron** shall burn thereon <u>sweet incense every morning</u>: When he dresses the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. And when **Aaron** lights the lamps



at even, he shall burn incense on it <u>a perpetual incense</u> before the LORD throughout your generations.

Leviticus 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the <u>feasts</u> (**Meeting times**) of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my <u>feasts</u>.(**Meeting times**)

Leviticus 23:4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.(times)

Exodus 30:10 Aaron shall make atonement on its horns once a year. With the blood of the sin offering of atonement he shall make atonement for it once in the year throughout your generations. It is most holy to the Lord.

Exodus 30:11-16 The Lord said to Moses, When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the Lord when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: **half a shekel** according to the shekel of the sanctuary (the shekel is twenty gerahs), half a shekel as an offering to the Lord. Everyone who is numbered in the census, from twenty years old and upward, shall give the Lord's offering. The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less, than the half shekel, when you give the Lord's offering to make atonement for your lives. **You shall take the atonement money from the people of Israel and shall give it for the service of the tent of meeting**, that it may bring the people of Israel to remembrance before the Lord, so as to make atonement for your lives.

Matthew 17:24-27 And when they were come to Capernaum, they that <u>received</u> the half-shekel came to Peter, and said, Does not your teacher pay the half-shekel? He said, Yea. And when he came into the house, Yeshua spoke first to him, saying, What do you think, Simon? The kings of the earth, from whom do they receive toll or tribute? From their sons, or from strangers? And when he said, From strangers, Yeshua said unto him, Therefore the sons are free. But, lest we cause them to stumble, go thou to the sea, and cast a hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up, and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a shekel: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

Matthew 5:13 You are the salt of the earth, but if its taste goes from the salt, how will you make it salt again? It is then good for nothing but to be put out and crushed under foot by men.

Matthew 5:14-16 You are the light of the world. A town put on a hill may be seen by all. And a burning light is not put under a vessel, but on its table, so that its rays may be shining on all who are in the house. Even so let your **light** be shining before



men, so that they may see **<u>your good works</u>** and **give <u>glory to your Father</u>** in heaven.

Proverbs 6:20-23 My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother: Bind them continually upon thine heart, and tie them about thy neck. When thou goest, it shall lead thee, when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee, and when thou awakest, it shall talk with thee. **For the commandment is a lamp, and the law is light.**

Matthew 5:17,18 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to **fulfil.** For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Matthew 5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: But whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Acts 3:24-26 Yes, and all the prophets, <u>from Samuel</u> and those who follow, as many as have spoken, <u>have also foretold these days</u>. You are sons of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying to Abraham, And in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed. To you first, God, having raised up His Servant Yeshua, sent Him to bless you, **in turning away every one of you from your iniquities.**

1 Samuel 17:12 Now David was the son of that Ephraimite of Beth-lehem-judah named Jesse, who had eight sons, and he was an old man in Saul's day, and far on in years. **And the** <u>three oldest</u> sons of Jesse had gone with Saul to the fight.

Numbers 1:3 All those of twenty years old and over, who are able to go to war in Israel, are to be numbered by you and Aaron.

The others are under 20

Acts 4:11 This is the stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone. Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Psalm 118:20-22 This gate of the <u>LORD</u>, into which the righteous shall enter. I will praise **You**, **For You** have answered me, And have <u>become my salvation</u>. The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone.



John 7:3-5 His brothers therefore said to him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that your disciples also may see the works that you do. For there is no man that does anything in secret, and he himself seeks to be known openly. If you do these things, show yourself to the world. **For neither did his brothers believe in him.**

Psalm 69:1,2 To the chief Musician upon Shoshannim (trumpets), **A Psalm of David. Save me**, **O God**, for the waters are come in unto my soul. I sink in deep mire, where there is no standing: I am come into deep waters, where the floods overflow me.

2 Samuel 19:7 Now therefore arise, go forth, and speak comfortably unto thy servants: For I swear by the LORD, if thou go not forth, there will not tarry one with thee this night: And that will be worse unto thee than **all the evil that befell thee from thy youth until now.**

John 15:25,26 But this comes to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, <u>They hated me without a cause</u>. But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send to you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceeds from the Father, he shall testify of me.

Psalm 69:3,4 I am weary of **my crying: My throat is dried**: My eyes fail while I wait for my God. They that <u>hate me without a cause</u> are <u>more than the hairs of mine head</u>: They that would destroy me, being my enemies <u>wrongfully</u>, are mighty: **Then I restored that which I took not away.**

Psalm 69:8 I have become a <u>stranger מוזר</u> (Moozar) unto My brethren, and <u>an alien</u> unto My mother's children.

Deuteronomy 23:2,3 A bastard ממזר (mamzer) shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD, even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD. An Ammonite or <u>Moabite shall not enter</u> into the congregation of the LORD, even to their tenth generation shall they not enter into the congregation of the LORD forever.

Ruth 4:21b,22 Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.

Psalm 69:11,12 I made sackcloth also my garment, and I became a proverb to them. They that sit in the gate speak against me, and I was the song of the drunkards.

Psalm 51:5 Behold, I was shaped in iniquity, And in sin did my mother conceive me.

Matthew 1:18,19 Now the birth of Yeshua the Messiah was like this, for after his mother, Miriam, was engaged to Joseph, before they came together, she was



found pregnant by the Holy Spirit. Joseph, her husband, being a righteous man, and not willing to make her a public example, intended to put her away secretly.

John 8:39-41 They answered him, Our father is Abraham. Yeshua said to them, If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham. But now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth, which I heard from God. Abraham didn't do this. You do the works of your father. They said to him, We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father, God.

John 2:16,17 And said to them that sold doves, Take these things hence, make not my Father's house an house of merchandise. And his disciples remembered that it was written, <u>The zeal of your house has eaten me up.</u>

<u>Psalm 69:9</u> For the zeal of Your house has eaten Me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached You are fallen on Me.

Psalm 69:20 Reproach has broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, <u>but there was none</u>, and <u>for comforters</u>, <u>but I found none</u>.

1 Samuel 16:10 Again Jesse made <u>seven of his sons</u> to pass before Samuel, and Samuel said to Jesse, The LORD has not chosen these.

1 Samuel 16:11,12 And Samuel saith unto Jesse, Are the young men finished? and he saith, Yet hath been left the youngest, and lo, he delighteth himself among the flock, and Samuel saith unto Jesse, Send and take him, for we do not turn round till his coming in hither. And he sendeth, and bringeth him in, and he is ruddy, with beauty of eyes, and of good appearance, and Jehovah saith, Rise, anoint him, for this is he.

Psalm 69:21 They gave me also gall for my meat, and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

1 Samuel 17:34-36 And David said to Saul, Your servant kept his father's sheep, and there came <u>a lion and a bear</u>, and took a lamb out of the flock. And I went out after him and smote him, and delivered it out of his mouth. And when he arose against me, I caught him by his beard, and smote him and slew him. Your servant slew both the **lion and the bear.** And this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, since he has defied the armies of the living God.

Psalm 118:22 The stone which the **builders** rejected is become the chief cornerstone.

Psalm 118:23 This is the LORD'S doing, it is marvellous in our eyes.

Ruth 4:21b,22 Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.
