TORAH PORTION

Exodus 30:11-13a The LORD said to Moses, When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the LORD when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: **Half a shekel** according to the shekel of the sanctuary.

Exodus 30:15,16 The rich is not to give more or the poor less than the <u>half-shekel</u> when giving Adonai's offering <u>to atone for your lives</u>. You are to take the atonement money from the people of Israel and use it <u>for</u> the service in the tent of meeting, so that it will be a reminder of the people of Israel before Adonai to atone for your lives.

Proverbs 10:2 Treasures of wickedness profit nothing, but <u>righteousness</u> delivers from death.

Acts 3:13-15 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his Servant Yeshua, whom you delivered up, and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had determined to release him. But you denied the Holy and <u>Righteous</u> One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and <u>killed the Prince of life</u>, whom God raised from the dead, to which we are witnesses.

Exodus 30:30-33 And you shall anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister to me in the priest's office. And you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil to me throughout your generations. On man's flesh shall it not be poured, neither shall you make any other like it, after the composition of it: it is holy, and it shall be holy to you. Whoever compounds any like it, or whoever puts any of it on a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people.

Exodus 31:1-5 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, See, I have called **by name <u>Bezaleel</u> the son of <u>Uri</u>, the son of <u>Hur</u>, of the <u>tribe of</u> <u>Judah</u>: And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, And in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship.**

Exodus 31:13,14a Tell the people of Israel, You are to <u>observe My</u> <u>Shabbats</u>, for <u>this is a sign</u> between me and you through all your generations, so that you will know that I am Adonai, <u>who sets you apart</u>



for me. Therefore you are to keep <u>My Shabbat</u>, because it is set apart for you.

Exodus 31:16,17 The people of Israel are <u>to keep the Shabbat</u>, <u>to observe</u> <u>Shabbat through all their generations as a perpetual covenant</u>. It is a sign between me and the people of Israel <u>forever</u>, for in six days Adonai made heaven and earth, but on the seventh day he stopped working and rested.

Exodus 31:18 When he had finished speaking with Moshe on Mount Sinai, Adonai gave him the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone inscribed by the finger of God.

Exodus 32:1-3 When the people saw that Moshe was taking a long time to come down from the mountain, they gathered around Aaron and said to him, Get busy, and make us gods to go ahead of us, because this Moshe, **the man** that brought us up from the land of Egypt we don't know what has become of him. Aaron said to them, Have your wives, sons and daughters strip off their gold earrings, <u>and bring them to me</u>. The people stripped off their gold earrings and brought them to Aaron.

Exodus 32:4 He received what they gave him, <u>melted it down</u>, and <u>made</u> <u>it into the shape of a calf</u>. They said, Israel! Here is your god, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!

Exodus 32:7,8 Adonai said to Moshe, Go down! <u>Hurry</u>! <u>Your people,</u> <u>whom you brought up</u> from the land of Egypt, have become <u>corrupt</u>! So quickly they have turned aside <u>from the way</u> I ordered them to follow! They **have cast a metal statue** of a calf, **worshipped it**, **sacrificed to it** and said, Israel! Here is <u>your god</u>, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!

Exodus 32:9,10 <u>Adonai continued</u> speaking to Moshe: I have been watching these people, and you can see how <u>stiff necked they are</u>. <u>Now leave me alone</u>, so that my anger can blaze against them, and <u>I can put an end to them</u>! **I will make a great nation out of you instead.**

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people**, which **you have brought forth** out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 32:12 Why should **the Egyptians speak**, and say, For <u>mischief</u> did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume



them from the face of the earth? Turn from your fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against your people.

Exodus 32:15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: The tables were written on both their sides, on the one side and on the other were they written.

Exodus 32:21-24 Moshe said to Aaron, What did these people do to you to make you lead them into such a terrible sin? Aaron replied, My lord shouldn't be so angry. You know what these people are like, that <u>they are determined to do evil</u>. So they said to me, Make us gods to go ahead of us, because this Moshe, the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt we don't know what has become of him. I answered them, Anyone with gold, strip it off! So they gave it to me. <u>I threw it in the fire, and out came this calf!</u>

Exodus 32:28 And the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And that day about **three thousand men** of the people fell.

Exodus 32:30-32 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said to the people, you have sinned a great sin: And now I will go up to the LORD, peradventure **I shall make an atonement** for your sin. And Moses returned to the LORD, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold. Yet now, if you will forgive their sin and if not, **blot me, I pray you, out of your book which you have written.**

Exodus 33:2,3 <u>I will send an angel before you</u>, and <u>I will drive out</u> the Canaanite, the Amorite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite: To a land flowing with milk and honey: For <u>I will not go up</u> in the midst of you, for you are a stiff-necked people, lest I consume you in the way.

Exodus 33:12,13 Moshe said to Adonai, Look, you say to me, Make these people <u>move on</u>! But you haven't let me know <u>whom you will be</u> <u>sending with me</u>. Nevertheless you have said, I know you by name, and also, You have found favor in my sight. Now, please, if it is really the case that I have found favor in your sight, <u>show me your ways</u>, so that <u>I</u> <u>will understand you</u> and continue finding favor in your sight. Moreover, keep on seeing this nation <u>as your people</u>.

Exodus 33:14-16 He said, My presence <u>will go with you, and I will give</u> <u>you rest</u>. He said to him, If your presence doesn't go with me, don't carry us up from here. For how would people know that I have found favor in



your sight, I and your people? Isn't it in that <u>you go with us</u>, so that we are separated, I and your people, from all the people who are on the surface of the earth?

Exodus 33:18-20 He said, Please <u>show me your glory</u>. He said, I will make all my goodness pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be **gracious**, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. He said, You cannot see my face, for man may not see me and live.

Exodus 34:4,5 He chiseled two tablets of stone like the first, and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up to Mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand two stone tablets. The LORD descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and <u>proclaimed the name of the LORD</u>.

Exodus 34:6-8 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, and on the children's children, to the third and to the fourth generation. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

DIGGING DEEPER INTO THE GOSPELS

John 4:3-5 He left Judaea and departed again into Galilee. And he had to go through Samaria. Then He came to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar (Shechem), near to the parcel of ground that <u>Jacob gave to</u> his son Joseph.

Genesis 33:18,19 And Jacob came to Shalem, a city of Shechem, which is in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padanaram, and pitched his tent before the city. And he bought a parcel of a field, where he had spread his tent, at the hand of the children of Hamor, Shechem's father, for an hundred pieces of money.

Genesis 50:13 For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought



with the field for a possession of a burying place of **<u>Ephron the Hittite</u>**, before Mamre.

Acts 7:15,16 And Jacob went down to Egypt, and came to his end there, and so did our fathers, And <u>they</u> were taken over to Shechem, (Hebron) and put to rest in the place which Abraham got for a price in silver from the sons of Hamor in Shechem.

Acts 7:59 And Stephen, while he was being stoned, made prayer to God, saying, Lord Jesus, take my spirit.

1 Samuel 7:1,2 And the men of Kiriath-jearim came and took up the ark of the LORD and brought it to <u>the house of Abinadab on the hill.</u> And they consecrated his son Eleazar to have charge of the ark of the LORD. From the day that the ark was lodged at **Kiriath-jearim**, a long time passed, <u>some twenty years</u>, and all the house of Israel lamented after the LORD.

1 Samuel 10:24 And Samuel said to all the people, Do you see him whom the LORD has chosen? There is none like him among all the people. And all the people shouted, Long live the king!

2 Samuel 6:2,3 And David arose and went with all the people who were with him from Baale-judah **to bring up from there the ark of God**, which is called by the name of the LORD of hosts who sits enthroned on the cherubim. And they carried the ark of God on a new cart and brought it out of **the house of Abinadab**, which was on the hill.

Acts 13:21 And afterward they desired a king: And God gave unto them Saul the son of Kis, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, by the space of <u>forty years.</u>

1 Chronicles 2:13-17 And Jesse begat his firstborn Eliab, and Abinadab the second, and Shimma the third, Nethaneel the fourth, Raddai the fifth, Ozem the sixth, **David the seventh**: Whose sisters were Zeruiah, and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruiah, Abishai, and Joab, and Asahel, three. And Abigail bare Amasa: And the father of Amasa was Jether the Ishmeelite.

1 Samuel 17:12 Now David was the son of an Ephrathite of Bethlehem in Judah, named Jesse, who had **eight sons.** In the days of Saul the man was already old and advanced in years.

1 Samuel 4:11 And the ark of God was captured, and the two sons of Eli, <u>Hophni and Phinehas, died.</u>	
1 Samuel 10:24 And Samuel said to all the people, Do you see him whom the LORD has chosen? There is none like him among all the people. And all the people shouted, Long live the king!	
1 Samuel 11,12 Saul established as king.	
1 Samuel 13:1 <u>two years go by</u> and Saul offers sacrifice without waiting for Samuel.	
1 Samuel 13:14 Saul told his kingdom will not continue.	
1 Samuel 14:3 Ichabods older brother Ahiah is now priest.	
1 Samuel 14:35 Saul builds his first altar to the LORD.	
1 Samuel 15:28 And Samuel said to him, <u>The LORD has torn the</u> <u>kingdom of Israel from you</u> this day and has given it to a neighbor of yours, who is better than you.	
1 Samuel 16:13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers. And the Spirit of the LORD rushed upon David from that day forward. And Samuel rose up and went to Ramah.	
1 Samuel 17:13 The three oldest sons of Jesse had followed Saul to the battle. And the names of his three sons who went to the battle were Eliab the firstborn, and next to him Abinadab, and the third Shammah.	
1 Samuel 17:49 And David put his hand in his bag and took out a stone and slung it and struck the Philistine on his forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell on his face to the ground.	
1 Samuel 18:1,2 As soon as he had finished speaking to Saul, the soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul. And Saul took him that day and would not let him return to his father's house.	
1 Samuel 18:7-9 And the women answered one another as they played, and said, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands. And	



Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him, and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed but thousands: And what can he have more but the kingdom? **And Saul eyed David from that day and forward.**

1 Samuel 31:6 Thus Saul died, and his three sons, and his armor-bearer, and all his men, on the same day together.

2 Samuel 2:4 And the men of Judah came, and there they <u>anointed David</u> <u>king over the house of Judah</u>. And they told David, saying, That the men of Jabeshgilead were they that buried Saul.

2 Samuel 2:8-11 But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim, And made him king over Gilead, and over the Ashurites, and over Jezreel, and over Ephraim, and over Benjamin, and over all Israel. Ishbosheth Saul's son was <u>forty years old</u> when he began to reign over Israel, and reigned two years. But the house of Judah followed David. And the time that David was king in Hebron over the house of Judah was seven years and six months.

2 Samuel 5:3-5 So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: And they anointed David king over Israel. David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years. In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah.

2 Samuel 6:2,3 And David arose and went with all the people who were with him from Baale-judah to bring up from there the ark of God, which is called by the name of the LORD of hosts who sits enthroned on the cherubim. And they carried the ark of God on a new cart and brought it out of <u>the house of Abinadab</u>, which was on the hill.

2 Samuel 6:6-11 And when they came to Nachon's threshing floor, Uzzah put forth his hand to the ark of God, and took hold of it, for the oxen shook it. And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah, and God smote him there for his error, and there he died by the ark of God. And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzzah: And he called the name of the place Perezuzzah to this day. And David was afraid of the LORD that day, and said, How shall the ark of the LORD unto him into the city of David: But David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite. And the ark of the LORD continued in



the house of Obededom the Gittite three months: and the LORD blessed Obededom, and all his household.
