TORAH PORTION

Exodus 38:21 These are the <u>accounts</u> of the tabernacle, even the tabernacle of the testimony, as they were rendered according to the commandment of Moses, through the service of the Levites, by the hand of Ithamar, the son of Aaron the priest.

Exodus 38:24 All the gold that was used for the work in all the work of the sanctuary, even the gold of the offering, was twenty-nine *talents*, and seven hundred thirty shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary.

Exodus 38:27-29 The <u>one hundred *talents* of silver</u> (7000 pounds) were for casting the sockets of the sanctuary, and the sockets of the veil, one hundred sockets for the <u>one hundred talents, a talent</u> for a socket. Of the one thousand seven hundred seventy-five shekels he made hooks for the pillars, overlaid their capitals, and made fillets for them. The <u>brass of the offering was seventy</u> <u>talents</u>, and two thousand four hundred shekels.

Numbers 12:7 My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house.

Luke 16:1,2 And he said also unto his disciples, There was a certain rich man, which had a steward, and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods. And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? <u>Give an account of thy stewardship</u>, for thou mayest be no longer steward.

Luke 16:10,11 He who is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much. He who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much. If therefore you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?

Romans 14:12 So then each one of us will give account of himself to God.

Matthew 25:14,15 For it is like a man, going into another country, who called his own servants, and entrusted his goods to them. To one he gave *five talents*, to another two, to another one, to each according to his own ability. Then he went on his journey.

Matthew 25:18,19 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money. After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

Matthew 25:24-30 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown,

and gathering where thou hast not strawed: And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: Lo, there thou hast that is thine. His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed: Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury. Take therefore the talent from him and give it unto him which hath ten talents. For unto everyone that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: But from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath. And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Ephesians 5:15,16 Look therefore carefully how ye walk, not as unwise, but as wise, **redeeming the time**, because the days are evil.

Matthew 12:36,37 I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

2 Corinthians 5:10,11 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad. Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men, but we are made manifest unto God, and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.

1 Corinthians 3:12-15 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble, Every man's work shall be made manifest: For the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire, and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: But he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

2 Timothy 2:20,21 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth, and some to honor, and some to dishonor. If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honor, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.

Exodus 12:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and Aaron <u>in the land of</u> <u>Egypt</u>, saying, This month shall be unto you <u>the beginning of months: it</u> <u>shall be the first month of the year</u> to you.

Exodus 40:1-3 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, <u>On the first day of</u> <u>the first month</u> shalt thou set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.

And thou shalt put therein the ark of the testimony, and cover the ark with the vail.

Exodus 40:16 Thus did Moses: According to all that <u>the LORD commanded</u> him, so did he.

Exodus 40:17 And it came to pass in the <u>first month in the second year, on</u> <u>the first day of the month</u>, that the **tabernacle was reared up**.

Exodus 40:19 And he spread abroad the tent over the tabernacle, and put the covering of the tent above on it, as <u>the LORD commanded</u> Moses.

Exodus 40:21 And he brought the ark into the tabernacle, and set up the veil of the covering, and covered the ark of the testimony, as <u>the LORD commanded</u> Moses.

Exodus 40:23 And he set the bread in order on it before the LORD, as <u>the</u> <u>LORD had commanded</u> Moses.

Exodus 40:25 And he <u>lit the lamps</u> before the LORD, as <u>the LORD</u> <u>commanded</u> Moses.

Exodus 40:34,35 Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. <u>And Moses was not able to enter</u> into the tent of the congregation, <u>because the cloud stayed thereon</u>, and <u>the glory of the LORD</u> filled the tabernacle.

Isaiah 66:22-24 For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD. And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcases of the men that have transgressed against me: For their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh.

1 Kings 11:5-8 For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites. And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as did David his father. Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.

1 Kings 11:9-11 And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had **appeared unto him twice**, And had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods: But he kept not that which the LORD commanded. Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, **I will surely rend the kingdom from thee**, and will give it to thy servant.

Leviticus 20:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Again, thou shalt say to the children of Israel, Whosoever he be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn in Israel, that giveth **any of his seed unto Molech, he shall surely be put to death**: The people of the land shall stone him with stones.

Leviticus 20:4,5 And if the people of the land do any ways hide their eyes from the man, when he giveth of his seed unto Molech, and kill him not: Then I will set my face against that man, and against his family, and will cut him off, and all that go a whoring after him, to commit whoredom with Molech, from among their people.

1 Kings 8:63,64 And Solomon offered a sacrifice of peace offerings, which he offered unto the LORD, two and twenty thousand oxen, and a hundred and twenty thousand sheep. So, the king and all the children of Israel dedicated the house of the LORD. The same day did **the king hallow the middle of the court** that was before the house of the LORD: For there he offered burnt offerings, and meat offerings, and the fat of the peace offerings: **Because the brazen altar that was before the LORD was too little to receive the burnt offerings,** and meat offerings, and the fat of the peace offerings.

Genesis 1:2-4 And the earth was without form, and void, and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved on the face of the waters. And God said, <u>Let there be light</u>: And there <u>was light</u>. And God saw <u>the light</u>, that it was good: And God divided <u>the light from the darkness</u>.

Psalm 119:130 The <u>entrance of your words gives light</u>; it gives understanding to the simple.

DIGGING DEEPER INTO THE GOSPELS

John 18:39 But ye have a custom, that I should release unto you one at **the Passover**: Will ye therefore that I release unto you the King of the Jews?

John 19:26,27 When Yeshua saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, Woman, behold, your son! Then he said



to the disciple, Behold, your mother! And from **that hour the disciple took her to his own home.**

Leviticus 23:5,6 In the <u>fourteenth day</u> of the <u>first month</u> at even is the <u>LORD's Passover</u>. And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: Seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.


Exodus 12:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, **This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: It shall be the first month of the year to you.**

Acts 12:1-3 About that time Herod (Agrippa) the king laid violent hands on some who belonged to the church. He killed James <u>the brother of John</u> with the sword, and when he saw that **it pleased the Jews**, he proceeded to arrest **Peter** also. This was during the days of Unleavened Bread.

Acts 12:4 And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him, intending after **Easter** to bring him forth to the people.

2 Timothy 4:22b The second [epistle unto Timotheus, ordained **the first bishop of the church of the Ephesians**, was written from Rome, when Paul was brought before Nero the second time.

Numbers 9:9-11 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If any man of you or of your posterity shall be unclean by reason of a dead body, or be in a journey afar off, yet **he shall keep the Passover unto the LORD. The fourteenth day of <u>the second month</u> at even they shall keep it, and eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.**
