TORAH PORTION

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and **you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.**

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD: Stand ye in the ways and see, and **ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls.** But they said: We will not walk therein.

Leviticus 22:17,18 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, **Speak unto Aaron, and to his sons, and unto all the children of Israel, and say unto them,** Whatsoever he be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers in Israel, that will offer his oblation for all his vows, and for all his freewill offerings, which they will offer unto the LORD for a burnt offering.

Leviticus 6:24,25 And the Lord said to Moses, **Say to Aaron and his sons, This is the law for the sin-offering:** The sin-offering is to be put to death before the Lord in the same place as the burned offering, it is most holy.

Leviticus 6:9 Command Aaron and his sons, saying, **This is the law of the burnt offering:** The burnt offering shall be on the hearth on the altar **all night** until the morning, and **the fire of the altar shall be kept burning** on it.

Genesis 46:2 And God said to Israel **in a night-vision,** Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here am I. And he said, I am God, the God of your father: Go down to Egypt without fear, for I will make a great nation of you there.

Genesis 19:27 And Abraham got up early in the morning and went to the place where he had been talking with the Lord.

Genesis 25:21 Isaac made prayer to the Lord for his wife because she had no children, and the Lord gave ear to his prayer, and Rebekah became with child.

Leviticus 6:10 And the priest shall put on **his linen garment,** and **his linen breeches** shall he put upon his flesh, and he shall **take up the ashes** whereto the fire hath consumed the burnt-offering on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar.

Leviticus 6:12 **And the fire upon the altar shall be kept burning thereby, it shall not go out,** and the priest shall kindle wood on it every morning, and he shall lay the burnt-offering in order upon it, and shall make smoke thereon the fat of the peace-offerings.

Leviticus 6:13 Fire shall be kept burning upon the altar continually, it shall not go out.

Leviticus 6:25,26 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed shall the sin offering be killed before the LORD: **It is most holy**. The priest that offereth it for sin shall eat it: In the holy place shall it be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Leviticus 7:1,2 This is the law of the **trespass offering**. It is most holy. In the place where they kill the burnt offering, he shall kill the trespass offering, and its blood he shall sprinkle around on the altar.

Leviticus 7:6,7 Every male among the priests may eat of it. It shall be eaten in a holy place. It is most holy. As is the sin offering, so is the trespass offering; There is one law for them. The priest who makes atonement with them shall have it.

Leviticus 7:11,12a This is the law of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which one shall offer to the LORD. If he offers it **for a thanksgiving**, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving **unleavened cakes mixed with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mixed with oil.**

Psalm 107:1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for He is good, for His mercy endureth for ever.

Psalm 107:2-6 So let the redeemed of the LORD say, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the adversary, And gathered them out of the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the sea. They wandered in the wilderness in a desert way, they found no city of habitation. Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses.

Psalm 107:8-16 Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He hath satisfied the longing soul, and the hungry soul He hath filled with good. Such as **sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron**. Because they rebelled against the words of God and contemned the counsel of the Most High. Therefore, He humbled their heart with travail, they stumbled, and there was none to help. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and broke their bands in sunder. Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.

Psalm 107:17-22 Crazed because of the way of their transgression, and afflicted because of their iniquities. Their soul abhorred all manner of food, and **they drew near unto the gates of death. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses, He sent His word, and healed them, and delivered them from their graves.** Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! And let them offer the sacrifices of thanksgiving and declare His works with singing.

Psalm 107:23-32 **They that go down to the sea in ships,** that do business in great waters. These saw the works of the LORD, and His wonders in the deep, For He commanded, and raised the stormy wind, which lifted up the waves thereof, They mounted up to the heaven, they went down to the deeps, their soul melted away because of trouble, They reeled to and fro, and staggered like a drunken man, and all their wisdom was swallowed up. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and **He brought them out of their distresses. He made the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof were still. Then were they glad because they were quiet, and He led them unto their desired haven.** Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! Let them exalt Him also in the assembly of the people and praise Him in the seat of the elders.

Mark 4:35-41 And the same day, when the evening was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships. And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full. And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: And they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish? And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no faith? And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

Psalm 50:23 Whoever offers the **sacrifice of thanksgiving** glorifies me, and prepares his way so that I will show God's salvation to him.

Leviticus 8:3-7 And let all the people come together at the door of the Tent of meeting. And Moses did as the Lord said, and all the people came together at the door of the Tent of meeting. And Moses said to the people, This is what the Lord has given orders to be done. Then Moses took Aaron and his sons, and after **washing them with water,** He put the coat on him, making it tight with its band, and then the robe, and over it the ephod, with its band of needlework to keep it in place.

Leviticus 8:35,36 Therefore shall ye abide at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation day and night **seven days, and keep the charge of the LORD, that**

ye die not: For so I am commanded. So Aaron and his sons did all things which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses.

Jeremiah 7:22-26 For I spoke not unto your fathers, nor commanded them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices: But this thing commanded I them, saying, Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: And walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you. But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels and in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward. Since the day that your fathers came forth out of the land of Egypt unto this day I have even sent unto you all my servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending them: Yet they hearkened not unto me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: They did worse than their fathers.

DIGGING DEEPER INTO THE GOSPELS

Matthew 11:1-3 And it came to pass, when Yeshua had made an end of commanding his twelve disciples, he departed thence to teach and to preach in their cities. Now when John had heard in the prison the works of Messiah, he sent two of his disciples, And said unto him, Art thou he that should come, or do we look for another?

Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion, shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: Behold, thy King cometh unto thee: He is just, and having salvation, lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Daniel 7:13,14 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Isaiah 35:3-6 Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees. Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: Behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence, he will come and save you. Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: For in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

Isaiah 61:1,2 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek, he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to

them that are bound, To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all that mourn.

Genesis 38:27-29 And it came to pass in the time of her travail, that, behold, twins were in her womb. And it came to pass, when she travailed, that the one put out his hand: And the midwife took and bound upon his hand a scarlet thread, saying, This came out first. And it came to pass, as he drew back his hand, that, behold, his brother came out: And she said, How hast thou broken forth? This breach be upon thee: Therefore his name was called **Pharez**.

Ruth 4:18-22 Now these are the generations of Pharez: Pharez begat Hezron, And Hezron begat Ram, and Ram begat Amminadab, And Amminadab begat Nahshon, and Nahshon begat Salmon, And Salmon begat Boaz, and Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.

Malachi 3:1 Behold, I will send My messenger, and He will clear the way before Me.

Malachi 4:3-6 And ye shall tread down the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith the LORD of hosts. Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: And he shall turn **the heart of the fathers to the children**, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.

Luke 1:17 **And he will go before his face in the spirit and power of Elijah, turning the hearts of fathers to their children**, and wrongdoers to the way of righteousness, to make ready a people whose hearts have been turned to the Lord.

Matthew 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

Micah 2:12 I will surely gather all of you, O Jacob, I will surely gather the remnant of Israel. I will put them together like the sheep of Bozrah, like the flock in the midst of their fold.

Micah 2:13 They shall be in commotion because of men. The breaker has come up before the.; they have broken up (Broken out), and have passed through the gate, and have gone out of it. And their king shall pass before them, and the LORD at the head of them.

Luke 16:16,17 The Law and the Prophets continued until John came: From that time the Good News of the Kingdom of God has been spreading, and all classes

have been forcing their way into it. But it is easier for earth and sky to pass away than for one smallest detail of the Law to fall to the ground. (WNT)

Matthew 12:3 But he said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him; How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the shewbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?

Matthew 12:5-8 Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless? But I say unto you, That in this place is one greater than the temple. But if ye had known what this meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless. For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

Matthew 12:22-28 Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: And he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spoke and saw. And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David? But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself, how shall then his kingdom stand? And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges. But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Luke 11:20 But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you.

Exodus 31:18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.
