## TORAH PORTION

**Exodus 34:27,28** And the LORD said unto Moses, **Write thou these words:** For after the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with thee and with Israel. And he was there with the LORD **forty days and forty nights,** he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

**Exodus 35:1** And Moses <u>assembled</u> all the <u>congregation</u> of the children of Israel, and said to them, These are the words which **the LORD has commanded**, that you should do them.

**Exodus 35:2a** Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be a holy day for you, a **Sabbath of solemn rest** to the LORD.

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah <u>is the goal of the Torah</u> unto righteousness' to everyone who believes.

**Exodus 35:4,5** Moses said to all the congregation of the people of Israel, This is the thing that **the Lord has commanded.** Take from among you a contribution to the Lord. **Whoever is of a generous heart**, let him bring the Lord's contribution: Gold, silver, and bronze.

**Exodus 35:10** And every **wise hearted** among you shall come, and make all that **the LORD hath commanded.** 

Exodus 35:20-22 And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him up, and everyone whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD's offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: and every man that offered, offered an offering of gold to the LORD.

**Exodus 35:25,26** And all the <u>women that were wise hearted</u> did spin with their hands, And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' hair.

**Exodus 35:29** All the men and women, the people of Israel, whose **heart** moved them to bring anything **for the work** that **the Lord had commanded** by Moses to be done brought it as a freewill offering to the Lord.

**Exodus 35:30,31** And Moses said to the children of Israel, See, the LORD has called **by name Bezaleel** the **son of Uri**, the **son of Hur**, of the tribe of **Judah**, And he has **filled him with the spirit of God.** in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner **of workmanship.** 

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.

Genesis 1:27 God created man in his own image. In God's image צלם he created him: male and female he created them.

**Psalm 91:1** He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will rest in the **shadow** of the Almighty.

Colossians 2:16,17 Let no one therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a **feast day** or a **new moon** or a **Sabbath day**, which are a **shadow** of the things to come, **but** the body is Messiah's.

**John 1:9** That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah <u>is the goal of the 'Torah</u> unto righteousness' to everyone who believes.

**Exodus 35:34,35a** And he has put in his heart that he may teach, both he, and **Aholiab**, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. Them has he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work.

Exodus 36:1,2 Then worked <u>Bezaleel and Aholiab</u>, and <u>every wise hearted man</u>, in whom the LORD put wisdom and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded. And Moses called **Bezaleel and Aholiab**, and <u>every wise hearted man</u>, in <u>whose heart the LORD had put wisdom</u>, even everyone <u>whose heart</u> stirred him up to come to the work to do it.

**Exodus 36:5-8** And they spoke to Moses, saying, The people bring much more than enough for the service of the work, which the LORD commanded to make. And Moses gave commandment, and they caused it to be proclaimed throughout the camp, saying, Let neither man nor woman make any more work for the offering of the sanctuary. So **the people were restrained from bringing**. For the stuff they had was sufficient for all the work to make it, and too much. And **every wise hearted** 



man among them that worked the work of the tabernacle made ten curtains of fine twined linen.

**Exodus 37:3-5** And he cast for it four rings of gold, to be set by the four corners of it, even two rings **upon the one side of it, and two rings upon the other side** of it. And he made staves of shittim wood, and overlaid them with gold. And he put the **staves into the rings by the sides of the ark,** to bear the ark.

1 Kings 8:8 And they drew out the staves, that the ends of the staves were seen out in the holy place before the oracle, and they were not seen without: And there they are unto this day.

Exodus 38:25,26 The silver of those who were numbered of the congregation was one hundred talents, and one thousand seven hundred seventy-five shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary: A beka בקע a head גלגלת, that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that passed over to them that were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

Mark 15:22 And they bring him to the place <u>Golgotha</u>, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.

Genesis 24:2-4 And Abraham said unto his oldest servant of his house, that ruled over all that he had, Put, I pray you, your hand under my thigh: And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that you shalt not take a wife to my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell: But you shalt go to my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife to my son Isaac.

**Genesis 24:22** And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a golden earring of <u>half a shekel</u> בקע weight, and two bracelets for her hands of ten shekels weight of gold.

## DIGGING DEEPER INTO THE GOSPELS

**Exodus 35:1** And Moses <u>assembled</u> all the congregation of the children of Israel. #6950 *Kahal to assemble* 

**Deuteronomy 4:10** The day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me: 'Assemble Me the people, and I will make them hear My words that they may learn to fear Me all the days that they live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children.

**Deuteronomy 9:10** And the LORD delivered unto me two tables of stone written with the finger of God, and on them was written according to all the words, which



the LORD spoke with you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of **the** assembly.

**Deuteronomy 10:4** And he wrote on the tables, according to the first writing, the ten commandments, which the LORD spake unto you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of the **assembly**: And the LORD gave them unto me.

The Old Testament *ekklesia* was a war assembly. This is asserted in these passages:

Judges 20:2 And the chief of all the people, even of all the tribes of Israel, presented themselves in the <u>assembly</u> of the people of God, four hundred thousand footmen that drew sword.

**1 Samuel 17:47** And all this <u>assembly</u> shall know that the LORD saveth not with sword and spear: For the battle is the LORD's, and he will give you into our hands.

**Psalm 89:5-7** And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD: Thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints. For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? Who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD? God is greatly to be feared in **the assembly** of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all **them that are about him.** 

Matthew 16;18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. #1577 Ekklesia assembly

Acts 7:38 This is he that was in **the church in the wilderness** with the angel that spoke to him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers: Who received living oracles to give unto us.

Acts 7:38 This is he who was in the **assembly** in the wilderness, with the messenger who is speaking to him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers who did receive the living oracles to give to us.

Acts 19:33,34 Some of the crowd prompted Alexander, whom the Jews had put forward. And Alexander, motioning with his hand, wanted to make a defense to the crowd. But when they recognized that he was a Jew, for about two hours they all cried out with one voice, Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!

Acts 19:35,41 And when the town clerk had quieted the crowd, he said, Men of Ephesus, who is there who does not know that the city of the Ephesians is temple keeper of the great Artemis, and of the sacred stone that fell from the sky? And when he had said these things, he **dismissed the assembly**.



**Luke 12:15** And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: For a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

Luke 12:16-20 And he spoke a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully: And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits? And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater, and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years, take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry. But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: Then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

Ecclesiastes 2:4-6 I made me great works; I builded me houses; I planted me vineyards: I made me gardens and orchards, and I planted trees in them of all kind of fruits: I made me pools of water, to water therewith the wood that bringeth forth trees.

Ecclesiastes 2:9 So I was great, and increased more than all that were before me in Jerusalem: Also my wisdom remained with me.

Ecclesiastes 2:16 For there is no remembrance of the wise more than of the fool for ever, seeing that which now is in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dieth the wise man? as the fool.

Ecclesiastes 2:17,18 Therefore I hated life, because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: For all is vanity and vexation of spirit. Yea, I hated all my labour which I had taken under the sun: Because I should leave it unto the man that shall be after me.

Ecclesiastes 8:15a Then I commended mirth, because a man hath no better thing under the sun, than to eat, and to drink, and to be merry.

Deuteronomy 17:16-20 But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses: Forasmuch as the LORD hath said unto you, Ye shall henceforth return no more that way. Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: Neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold. And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: That he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them: That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: To the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.



- 1 Chronicles 28:11,12 Then <u>David gave to Solomon his son the pattern</u> of the **porch**, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlors thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat, And the pattern of all that <u>he had by the spirit</u>, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things.
- 1 Kings 5:13 And king Solomon raised a levy out of all Israel, and the levy was thirty thousand men.
- 1 Kings 5:15 And Solomon had <u>threescore and ten thousand</u> that bare burdens, and <u>fourscore thousand</u> hewers in the mountains. 180,000!!
- Psalm 127:1 A SONG OF DEGREES FOR SOLOMON. Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it:
- **1 Kings 8:13 I have surely built thee an house** to dwell in, a settled place for thee to abide in forever.
- 1 Kings 8:20 And the LORD hath performed his word that he spoke, and <u>I am risen</u> <u>up</u> in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and <u>I have built an house</u> for the name of the LORD God of Israel.
- **1 Kings 8:44** If thy people go out to battle against their enemy, whithersoever thou shalt send them, and shall pray unto the LORD toward the city which thou hast chosen, and toward **the house that I have built** for thy name.
- **1 Kings 8:48** And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and **the house which I have built** for thy name.

**Deuteronomy 8:11-14** Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day: Lest when thou hast **eaten and art full, and hast <u>built goodly houses</u>, and dwelt therein; And when thy <u>herds and thy flocks multiply</u>, and thy <u>silver and thy gold is multiplied</u>, and all that thou hast is multiplied, Then <u>thine heart be lifted up</u>, and thou forget the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.**
