TORAH PORTION

Exodus 40:17-20 And it came to pass in the **first month** in the second year, on the **first day of the month**, that the tabernacle was reared up. And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and laid its sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up its pillars. And he spread the tent over the tabernacle, and put the covering of the tent above upon it; as the LORD commanded Moses.

Leviticus 9:3,4 And to the children of Israel you shall speak, saying, Take you a kid of the goats for a sin offering, and a calf and a lamb, both of the first year, without blemish, for a burnt offerin. Also a bullock and a ram for peace offerings, to sacrifice before the LORD, and a meat offering mingled with oil: For today the LORD will appear to you.

Leviticus 9:6 And Moses said, This is the thing which the LORD commanded that you should do: <u>and the glory of the LORD shall appear to you.</u>

Exodus 40:34 Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.

Leviticus 9:22-24 And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and *blessed them*, and came down from offering of the sin offering, and the burnt offering, and peace offerings. And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and *blessed the people*: and the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people. And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed on the altar the burnt offering and the fat: which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

Leviticus 9:1,2 And it came to pass <u>on the eighth day</u>, that Moses called Aaron and his sons, and the elders of Israel, and he **said to Aaron**, <u>Take a calf</u> from the herd for a <u>sin offering</u>, and a <u>ram</u> for a burnt offering, without blemish, and offer them before the LORD.

Leviticus 10:1,2 And **Nadab and Abihu**, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and <u>put fire therein</u>, and put incense thereon, and <u>offered strange fire</u> before the LORD, which he commanded them not. And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Leviticus 10:3 Then Moses said to Aaron, This is it that the LORD spoke, saying, I will be sanctified in them that **come near me**, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his peace.

Amos 3:1,2 Hear this word that the LORD has spoken against you, children of Israel, against the whole family which I brought up out of the land of Egypt, saying:



You only have I chosen of all the families of the earth. Therefore I will punish you for all of your sins.

Leviticus 10:8-11 And the LORD spoke to Aaron, saying, Do not drink wine nor strong drink, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest you die: It shall be a statute forever throughout your generations: And that you may put difference between holy and common, and between unclean and clean, And that you may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them by the hand of Moses.

Leviticus 10:12,13 And Moses spoke to Aaron, and to Eleazar and to Ithamar, his sons that were left, Take the <u>meat offering</u> that remains of the offerings of the LORD <u>made by fire, and eat it</u> without leaven beside the altar: for it <u>is most holy</u>: And <u>you shall eat it in the holy place</u>, because it is your due, and your sons' due, of the sacrifices of the LORD <u>made by fire: for so I am commanded</u>.

Leviticus 6:24-26 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, <u>This is the law of the **sin offering**</u>: In the place where the burnt offering is killed, the **sin offering** shall be killed before the LORD. <u>It is most holy</u>. The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. <u>It shall be eaten in a holy place</u>, in the court of the Tent of Meeting.

Leviticus 10:16-18 And Moses <u>diligently sought</u> the goat of <u>the sin offering</u>, and, behold, it was burnt: And he was angry with Eleazar and Ithamar, the sons of Aaron which were left alive, saying, Why have you not eaten the sin offering in the holy place, seeing <u>it is most holy</u>, and God has given it you to bear the iniquity of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD? Behold, <u>the blood of it was not brought in within the holy place</u>: You should indeed have eaten it in the holy place, as I commanded.

Leviticus 10:16a And Moses diligently sought. Sought sought.

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, **rightly dividing** the word of truth.

John 5:39 You **search** the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life, and it is they **that bear witness about me.**

Leviticus 11:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and to Aaron, saying to them, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, <u>These are the beasts which you shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth.</u>

1 Thessalonians 4:7-12 Because it is God's purpose that our way of life may be not unclean but holy. Whoever, then, goes against this word, goes against not man



but God, who gives his Holy Spirit to you.

Genesis 1:28,29 God blessed them. God said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth, and subdue it. <u>Have dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the sky, and over every living thing that moves on the earth. God said, Behold, I have given you <u>every herb yielding seed</u>, which is on the surface of all the earth, <u>and every tree</u>, which bears fruit yielding seed. It will be your food.

Genesis 2:16,17 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat, but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, <u>you</u> shall not eat of it, for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die.

Genesis 7:2 You shall take seven pairs of every clean animal with you, the male and his female. Of the animals that are not clean, take two, the male and his female.

Genesis 9:1-3 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth. And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be on every beast of the earth, and on every fowl of the air, on all that moves on the earth, and on all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered. **Every moving thing that lives shall be meat for you**, even as the green herb have I given you all things.

Genesis 9:4-6 But flesh with its life, its blood, you shall not eat. And surely your blood of your lives will I require, at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man, even at the hand of every man's brother, will I require the life of man. Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed, for in the image of God made He man.

Deuteronomy 14:21a You shall not eat of anything that dies of itself: You shall **give it to the stranger** that is in your gates, **that he may eat it**; or you **may sell it to an alien**: For you are a **holy** people to the LORD your God.

Leviticus 11:39,40 If any animal, <u>of which you may eat</u>, dies, he who <u>touches its carcass shall be unclean</u> until the evening. He <u>who eats</u> of its carcass shall wash his clothes, and <u>be unclean until the evening</u>. He also who carries its carcass shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the evening.

Leviticus 11:44,45 For I am the LORD your God: you shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and **you shall be holy**; **for I am holy**: Neither shall you <u>defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creeps on the earth.</u> For I am the LORD that brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: **You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy**.



Leviticus 11:46,47 This is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature that moves in the waters, and of every creature that creeps on the earth: <u>To make a difference between the unclean and the clean</u>, and <u>between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten.</u>

Leviticus 13:45 The leper in whom the plague is shall wear torn clothes, and the hair of his head shall hang loose. He shall cover his upper lip, and shall cry, Unclean! Unclean!

Acts 10:7 And when the angel which spoke unto Cornelius was departed, he called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier of them that waited on him continually;

Acts 10:9-16 On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour: And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: But while they made ready, he fell into a trance, And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of four footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat. But Peter said, Not so, Lor, for I have never eaten anything that is common or unclean. And the voice spoke unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common. This was done thrice: And the vessel was received up again into heaven.

Acts 10:19 While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee.

Acts 10:28 And he said unto them, Ye know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation, but <u>God</u> <u>hath shewed me</u> that I should <u>not call any Man common or unclean.</u>

Luke 11:37-39 Now, while he was talking, a **Pharisee** made a request that he would come to a meal with him, and he went in and took his seat at the meal. And when the Pharisee saw it, he was surprised because he came to the meal without **first washing himself.** And the Lord said to him, You Pharisees make the outside of the cup and the plate clean, but inside you are thieves and full of evil.



Matthew 23:27,28 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness. Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

Malachi 2:17 Ye have wearied the LORD with your words. Yet ye say, Wherein have we wearied him? When ye say, Everyone that doeth evil is good in the sight of the LORD, and he delighteth in them.

Isaiah 1:16-20 Wash you, make you clean, put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes, cease to do evil, Learn to do well, seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow, though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: For the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

John 3:1-5 Now there was among the Pharisees a man named Nicodemus, who was one of the rulers of the Jews. He came to Jesus by night and said to him, Rabbi, we are certain that you have come from **God as a teacher**, because no man would be able to do these signs which you do if God was not with him. Jesus said to him, Truly, I say to you, With out a new birth no man is able to see the kingdom of God. Nicodemus said to him, How is it possible for a man to be given birth when he is old? Is he able to go into his mother's body a second time and come to birth again? Jesus said in answer, Truly, I say to you, If a man's birth is not from water and from the Spirit, it is not possible for him to go into the kingdom of God.

Isaiah 30:20 And though the Lord will give you the bread of trouble and the water of grief, you will no longer put your teacher on one side, **but you will see your teacher.**

Mark 10:21-27 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: Go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: And come, take up the cross, and follow me. And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: For he had great possessions. And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God! And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. And they were astonished out of measure, saying among themselves, Who then can be saved? And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: For with God all things are possible.



Proverbs 3:33,34 The curse of the LORD is on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of <u>the just</u>. Surely He scorns the scornful, But <u>gives grace to the humble</u>.
