TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 12:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, If a woman conceives, and bears a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days, as in the days of her monthly period she shall be unclean. In the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.

Leviticus 12:6 And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest.

Luke 2:22 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord,

Leviticus 12:8 And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons, the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: And the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

Leviticus 13:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, When a man shall have a rising in his body's skin, or a scab, or a bright spot, and it becomes in the skin of his body the **plague** נגע of **leprosy**, צרעה then he shall be brought to Aaron the priest, or to one of his sons, the priests: And **the priest shall examine** the plague in the skin of the body: And if the hair in the plague has turned white, and the appearance of the plague is deeper than the body's skin, it is the plague of leprosy, and **the priest shall examine him**, and pronounce him unclean.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he has borne our sickness, and carried our suffering, yet we considered him plagued, **struck** נגע by God, and **afflicted**.

John 19:1 So Pilate then took Yeshua, and **flogged him**.

John 19:3 And said, Hail, King of the Jews! And they **smote him with their hands**.

Luke 22:63,64 The men who held Yeshua mocked him and beat him. Having blindfolded him, they **struck him on the face** and asked him, Prophecy! Who is the one who struck you?

Matthew 27:30 And they spit upon him, and **took the reed, and smote him** on the head.

Leviticus 13:5a **The priest shall examine him** on the seventh day.

Leviticus 13:6a **The priest shall examine him again** on the seventh day.

Leviticus 13:8 The priest shall examine him, and behold, if the scab has spread on the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean. It is leprosy.

Leviticus 13:9,10a When the plague of leprosy is in a man, then he shall be brought to the priest, and **the priest shall examine him.**

Leviticus 13:12,13 If the leprosy breaks out all over the skin, and the leprosy covers all the skin of the infected person from his head even to his feet, as far as it appears to the priest, then **the priest shall examine him**, and, behold, if the leprosy has covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce him clean of the plague. It has all turned white: He is clean.

Leviticus 13:15 The priest shall examine the raw flesh, and pronounce him unclean: The raw flesh is unclean. It is leprosy.

Leviticus 13:17a and the priest shall examine him.

Leviticus 13:20 and the priest shall examine it.

Leviticus 13:21a But if the priest examines it.

Leviticus 13:26a But if the priest examines it.

Leviticus 13:27a The priest shall examine him on the seventh day.

Leviticus 13:30a then the priest shall examine the plague.

Vs 31,32,34,36,39,43, 50,53,55

Matthew 8:2-4 Behold, a leper came to him and worshiped him, saying, Lord, if you want to, you can make me clean. Yeshua stretched out his hand, and touched him, saying, I want to. Be made clean. Immediately his leprosy was cleansed. Yeshua said to him, See that you tell nobody, but go, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.

Numbers 12:10 The cloud departed from over the Tent; and behold, Miriam was leprous, as white as snow. Aaron looked at Miriam, and behold, she was leprous.

Psalms 64:3 Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words.

Leviticus 14:1-7 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his cleansing. He shall be brought to the priest, and **the priest shall go forth out of the camp**. The priest shall examine him, and behold, if the plague of leprosy **is healed** in the leper, then the priest shall command them to take

for him who is **to be cleansed** *two living clean birds, and cedar wood, and scarlet, and hyssop*. The priest shall command them to kill one of the birds in an *earthen vessel over running water*. As for the living bird, he shall take it, and the cedar wood, and the scarlet, and the hyssop, and shall dip them and the living bird in the *blood of the bird that was killed over the running water*. He shall sprinkle on him who is to be cleansed from the leprosy seven times, and shall pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird go into the open field. And he that is to be cleansed shall wash his clothes, and shave off all his hair, and wash himself in water, that he may be clean: And after that he shall come into the camp, and shall tarry abroad out of his tent seven days.

Mark 1:40-45 A leper came to him, begging him, kneeling down to him, and saying to him, If you want to, you can make me **clean**. Being moved with compassion, he stretched out his hand, and **touched him**, and said to him, I want to. Be made clean. When he had said this, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was made clean. He strictly warned him, and immediately sent him out, and said to him, See you say nothing to anybody, but **go show yourself to the priest**, and offer for **your cleansing the things which Moses commanded, for a testimony to them**. But he went out, and began to proclaim it much, and to spread about the matter, so that Yeshua could no more openly enter into a city, but was outside in desert places: And they came to him from everywhere.

2 Kings 5:1 Now Naaman, captain of the army of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honorable, because by him the LORD had given victory to Syria: He was also a mighty man of valor, **but he was a leper**.

Luke 4:27-29 There were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet, yet not one of them was cleansed, **except Naaman**, the Syrian. They were all filled with wrath in the synagogue, as they heard these things. They rose up, threw him out of the city, and led him to the brow of the hill that their city was built on, that they might throw him off the cliff.

Matthew 11:4,5 Yeshua answered them, Go and tell Yochanan the things which you hear and see: The blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them.

Ezekiel 44:4-9 Also He brought me by way of the north gate to the front of the temple, so I looked, and behold, the glory of the Lord filled the house of the Lord, and I fell on my face. And the Lord said to me, Son of man, mark well, see with your eyes and hear with your ears, all that I say to you concerning all the ordinances of the house of the Lord and all its laws. Mark well who may enter the house and all who go out from the sanctuary. Now say to the rebellious, to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord God: O house of Israel, let Us have no more of all your

abominations. When you brought in foreigners, uncircumcised in heart and uncircumcised in flesh, to be in My sanctuary to defile it My house and when you offered My food, the fat and the blood, then they broke My covenant because of all your abominations. And you have not kept charge of My holy things, but you have set others to keep charge of My sanctuary for you. Thus says the Lord God: No foreigner, uncircumcised in heart or uncircumcised in flesh, shall enter My sanctuary, including any foreigner who is among the children of Israel.

Ezekiel 45:16,17 All the people of the land shall give this offering for the prince in Israel. Then it shall be the prince's part to give burnt offerings, grain offerings, and drink offerings, at the feasts, the New Moons, the Sabbaths, and at all the appointed seasons of the house of Israel. He shall prepare the sin offering, the grain offering, the burnt offering, and the peace offerings to make atonement for the house of Israel.

Ezekiel 45:18-20 Thus says the Lord God: In the first month, on the first day of the month, you shall take a young bull without blemish and cleanse the sanctuary. The priest shall take some of the blood of the sin offering and put it on the doorposts of the temple, on the four corners of the ledge of the altar, and on the gateposts of the gate of the inner court. And so you shall do on the seventh day of the month for everyone who has sinned unintentionally or in ignorance. Thus you shall make atonement for the temple.

Ezekiel 45:21-25 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month, you shall observe the Passover, a feast of seven days; unleavened bread shall be eaten. And on that day the prince shall prepare for himself and for all the people of the land a bull for a sin offering. On the seven days of the feast he shall prepare a burnt offering to the Lord, seven bulls and seven rams without blemish, daily for seven days, and a kid of the goats daily for a sin offering. And he shall prepare a grain offering of one ephah for each bull and one ephah for each ram, together with a hin of oil for each ephah. In the seventh month, on the fifteenth day of the month, at the feast, he shall do likewise for seven days, according to the sin offering, the burnt offering, the grain offering, and the oil.

Ezekiel 46:1 Thus says the Lord God: The gateway of the inner court that faces toward the east shall be shut the six working days, but on the Sabbath it shall be opened, and on the day of the New Moon it shall be opened.

Ezekiel 46:3 Likewise the people of the land shall worship at the entrance to this gateway before the Lord on the Sabbaths and the New Moons.

Ezekiel 46:13-15 You shall daily make a burnt offering to the Lord of a lamb of the first year without blemish, you shall prepare it every morning. And you shall prepare a grain offering with it every morning, a sixth of an ephah, and a third of a hin of oil to moisten the fine flour. This grain offering is a perpetual ordinance, to be made

regularly to the Lord. Thus they shall prepare the lamb, the grain offering, and the oil, as a regular burnt offering every morning.
