TORAH

Leviticus 16:1 And the LORD spoke unto Moses <u>after the death</u> of the two sons of Aaron, when <u>they drew near</u> before the LORD, and died.

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Hebrews 4:14-16 Having then a great high priest, who has passed through the <u>heavens</u>, Yeshua, the Son of God, let us hold tightly to our confession. For we don't have a high priest who can't be touched with the feeling of our infirmities, but one who has been in all points tempted like we are, yet without sin. <u>Let us therefore</u> <u>draw near with boldness</u> to <u>the throne of grace</u>, that we may receive <u>mercy</u>, and <u>may find grace</u> for help in time of need.

Leviticus 16:2 And the LORD said to Moses, Speak to Aaron your brother, that he <u>come not at all times</u> into the holy place within the veil before the <u>mercy seat</u>, which is on the ark; that <u>he die not</u>: For I will appear <u>in the cloud</u> on the <u>mercy seat</u>.

Leviticus 16:4 He shall put on the holy <u>linen coat</u>, and he shall have the <u>linen</u> <u>breeches</u> on his flesh, and shall be girded with a <u>linen girdle</u>, and with the <u>linen</u> <u>turban</u> shall he be attired: <u>These are holy garments</u>, therefore shall <u>he wash his flesh</u> <u>in water</u>, and so put them on.

Leviticus 16:8-10 And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats, one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat. And Aaron shall bring the goat upon which the LORD's lot fell, and offer him for a sin offering. But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

Leviticus 16:11-14 And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which is for himself: And he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from off the altar before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring it within the vail: And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not: And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward, and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.

Revelation 8:2-5 And I saw the **seven angels** which stood before God, and to them were given seven trumpets. And another angel came and stood at

the altar, having a golden censer, and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake.

Revelation 11:18,19 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great, and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was **seen in his temple the ark of his testament:** And there were **lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.**

Leviticus 16:17 And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

Revelation 15:6-8 And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his powerm, **and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.**

Leviticus 16:30 For on that day shall the priest make an <u>atonement</u> for you, to <u>cleanse</u> you, that ye <u>may be clean</u> from all your sins before the Lord. It shall be a sabbath of rest to you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute forever.

Revelation 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, do you not **judge and avenge our blood** on them that dwell on the earth?

Deuteronomy 32:40-44 For I lift up my hand to heaven, and say, I live forever. If I whet my <u>glittering sword</u>, and my hand take hold on judgment, I will **render vengeance** to mine enemies, and will reward them that hate me. I will make my arrows drunk with blood, and my sword shall **devour flesh**, and that with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revenges on the enemy. Rejoice, O ye nations, with his people:

For <u>he will avenge the blood of his servants</u>, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful to his land, and to his people. And Moses came and spoke all the words of this song in the ears of the people, he, and Hoshea the

son of Nun.

Revelation 19:15-18 And <u>out of his mouth goes a **sharp sword**</u>, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he has on his clothing and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. And I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the middle of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God, That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Hebrews 4:12a For <u>the word of God</u> is living, and active, and sharper than any <u>two-edged sword</u>.

Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: For he has judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and <u>has avenged the blood of his servants</u> at her hand.

Leviticus 17:15 And every soul that eateth that which died of itself, or that which was torn with beasts, whether it be one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the even: Then shall he be clean.

Leviticus 18:1-5 And the Lord spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, I am the Lord your God. After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: And after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do, neither shall ye walk in their ordinances. Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I am the Lord your God. Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: Which if a man do, he shall live in them: I am the Lord.

Leviticus 18:26-28 Ye shall therefore keep my statutes and my judgments, and shall not commit any of these abominations, neither any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourneth among you: (For all these abominations have the men of the land done, which were before you, and the land is defiled;) That the land spue not you out also, when ye defile it, as it spued out the nations that were before you.

1 Samuel 20:18 Then Jonathan said to him, Tomorrow is the new moon: And it will be seen that you are not present, for there will be no one in your seat.

1 Samuel 20:24-27 So David went to a secret place in the country: And when the new moon came, the king took his place at the feast. And the king took his seat, as at other times, by the wall: And Jonathan was in front, and Abner was seated by

Saul's side, but there was no one in David's seat. But Saul said nothing that day, for his thought was, Something has taken place making him unclean, it is clear that he is not clean. And on the day after the new moon, that is, the second day, there was still no one in David's seat: And Saul said to his son Jonathan, Why has the son of Jesse not come to the feast yesterday or today?

1 Samuel 20:28,29 And answering Saul, Jonathan said, He made a request to me that he might go to Beth-lehem, Saying, Our family is making an offering in the town, and my brothers have given me orders to be there: So now, if I have grace in your eyes, let me go away and see my brothers. This is why he has not come to the king's table.

1 Samuel 20:30,31 Then Saul was moved to wrath against Jonathan, and he said to him, You son of an evil and uncontrolled woman, have I not seen how you have given your love to the son of Jesse, to your shame and the shame of your mother? For while the son of Jesse is living on the earth, your position is unsafe and your kingdom is in danger. So make him come here to me, for it is certainly right for him to be put to death.

1 Samuel 20:32-34 And Jonathan, answering his father Saul, said to him, Why is he to be put to death? What has he done? And Saul, pointing his spear at him, made an attempt to give him a wound: From which it was clear to Jonathan that his father's purpose was to put David to death. So Jonathan got up from the table, burning with wrath, and took no part in the feast the second day of the month, being full of grief for David because his father had put shame on him

Matthew 15:10-12 And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand: Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man, but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man. Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?

Matthew 15:13-16 But he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up. Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall

into the ditch. Then answered Peter and said unto him, Declare unto us this parable. And Jesus said, Are ye also yet without understanding?

Matthew 15:17-20 Do you not see that whatever goes into the mouth goes on into the stomach, and is sent out as waste? But the things which come out of the mouth come from the heart, and they make a man unclean. For out of the heart come evil thoughts, the taking of life, broken faith between the married, unclean desires of the flesh, taking of property, false witness, bitter words: These are the things which



make a man unclean, but to take food with unwashed hands does not make a man unclean.

Mark 7:18,19 And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Perceive ye not, that whatsoever from without goeth into the man, it cannot defile him, because it goeth not into his heart, but into his belly, and goeth out into the draught? *This he said, making all meats clean*.
