TORAH

Leviticus 26:3 If you walk <u>in my statutes</u>, and <u>keep</u> my commandments, and <u>do</u> them.

Leviticus 26:4 Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit.

Leviticus 26:5b-8 And there will be bread in full measure, and you will be living in your land safely. I will give peace in the land, and you shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid. And I will remove harmful beasts from the land, and the sword shall not go through your land. You shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword. Five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall chase ten thousand, and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to **observe and to do** all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these blessings shall come on thee, **and overtake thee**, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 28:8-10 The LORD shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto, and he shall bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways. And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the LORD; and they shall be afraid of thee.

Leviticus 26:11,12 And I set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you. And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and you shall be my people.

Deuteronomy 23:12-14 You shall have a place outside the camp, and you shall go out to it. And you shall have a trowel with your tools, and when you sit down outside, you shall dig a hole with it and turn back and cover up your excrement. Because **the LORD your God walks in the midst of your camp**, to deliver you and to give up your enemies before you, therefore your camp must be holy, so that he may not see anything indecent among you and turn away from you.

Leviticus 26:13 I am the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their slaves, <u>and I have</u> broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go upright.

Ezekiel 34:22-24 Therefore will I save my flock, and they shall no more be a prey, and I will judge between cattle and cattle. And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David, he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd. And I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it.

Ezekiel 34:25-31 And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: And they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing, and I will cause the shower to come down in his season, there shall be showers of blessing. And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them. And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them, but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid. And I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be **no more consumed** with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen anymore. Thus shall they know that I the LORD their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, said the Lord GOD. And you my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, said the Lord GOD.

Leviticus 26:14-19 But <u>if you will not listen to me</u>, and will not do all these commandments, And if you shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that you will not do all my commandments, but that you break my covenant: I also will do this to you, I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it. And I will set my face against you, and you shall be slain before your enemies: They that hate you shall reign over you, <u>and you shall flee when no one pursues you.</u> And if you will not yet for all this listen to me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins. And I will break the pride of your power, and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass.

Leviticus 26:20,21 And your strength shall be spent in vain: For your land shall not yield her increase, neither shall the trees of the land yield their

fruits. And if ye walk contrary unto me, and will not hearken unto me, **I** will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins.

Leviticus 26:22-24 I will also send wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children, and destroy your cattle, and make you few in number, and your highways shall be desolate. And if ye will not be reformed by me by these things, but will walk contrary unto me, Then will I also walk contrary unto you, and will punish you yet seven times for your sins.

Leviticus 26:25 And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of my covenant: And when ye are gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you, and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.

Leviticus 26:26-28 And when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver you your bread again by weight: And ye shall eat, and not be satisfied. And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me, Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury, and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

Leviticus 26:29-31 And ye shall <u>eat the flesh of your sons</u>, and the flesh <u>of your daughters</u> shall ye eat. And **I will** destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcasses upon the carcasses of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you. And **I will** make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and **I will** not smell the savour of your sweet odors.

Jeremiah 19:8,9 And I will make this city desolate, and an hissing, every one that passes thereby shall be astonished and hiss because of all the plagues thereof. And I will cause them to eat the flesh of their sons and the flesh of their daughters, and they shall eat everyone the flesh of his friend in the siege and straightness, wherewith their enemies, and they that seek their lives, shall straiten them.

Deuteronomy 28:36,37 The LORD shall bring thee, and thy king which thou shalt set over thee, unto a nation which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, and there shalt thou serve other gods, wood and stone. And thou **shalt become an astonishment**, a proverb, and a byword, among all nations whither the LORD shall lead thee.

Leviticus 26:32-34 And I will bring the land into desolation: And your enemies which dwell therein shall be astonished at it. And I will scatter

you among the heathen, and will draw out a sword after you: And your

land shall be desolate, and your cities waste. Then **shall the land enjoy her sabbaths**, as long as it lieth desolate, and ye be in your enemies' land, even then shall **the land rest and enjoy her sabbaths**.

Leviticus 26:35-39 As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest, because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it. And upon them that are left alive of you I will send a faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies, and the sound of a shaken leaf shall chase them, and they shall flee, as fleeing from a sword, and they shall fall when none pursuits. And they shall fall one upon another, as it were before a sword, when none pursueth, and ye shall have no power to stand before your enemies. And ye shall perish among the heathen, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up. And they that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands, and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them.

2 Chronicles 36:20,21 And them that had escaped from the sword carried he away to Babylon, where they were servants to him and his sons until the reign of the kingdom of Persia: To fulfil the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her sabbaths: For as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten years.

Leviticus 26:40-42 If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary to me, And that I also have walked contrary to them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies, if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember, and I will remember the land.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

If a judge in his mercy suspends the death penalty - continue and expect continued mercy?

Leviticus 26:44 And yet for all that, when they be in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, neither will I abhor them, to destroy them utterly, and to break my covenant with them: For I am the LORD their God.

Leviticus 26:45 But I will for their sakes remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the heathen, that I might be their God: I am the LORD.

Ezekiel 34:11,12 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out. As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered, so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

Ezekiel 34:15,16 I will feed my flock, and I will cause them to lie down, saith the Lord GOD. I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: But I will destroy the fat and the strong, I will feed them with judgment.

Matthew 15:24 But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

John 10:11-14 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: And the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep. The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep. I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

John 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: Them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice, and there shall be one-fold, and one shepherd.

WRINKLES

Job 16:8 And thou hast filled me with <u>wrinkles</u>, which is a witness against me: and my *leanness* rising up in me bears witness to my face.

Proverbs 28:25 He that puts his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.

Proverbs 13:4 The soul of the diligent shall be made fat.

Leviticus 3:16 All the *fat* is the LORD's.

Genesis 45:18 And ye shall eat the *fat* of the land.

Genesis 4:4 And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock <u>and of</u> <u>the fat</u> thereof.

Psalm 119:70-72 <u>Their heart</u> is as *fat* as grease, but <u>I delight in your law</u>. It is good for me that I have been afflicted, that I might learn your statutes. The <u>law of your mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and silver</u>.

Deuteronomy 32:13-15 He made him ride on the <u>high places</u> of the earth, so that he might eat the increase of the fields. And He made him suck honey out of the rock, and oil out of the flinty rock, butter from cows, and milk from sheep, with <u>fat</u> (best) of lambs, and rams of the sons of Bashan, and goats, with the <u>fat</u> (best) of kidneys of wheat. And you drank the blood of the grape. But Jeshurun grew <u>fat</u> (oily,gross) and kicked. You grew <u>fat</u> (oily,gross), thick, and <u>satisfied</u>. <u>Then he forsook God</u> who made him, and <u>lightly esteemed</u> the Rock of his salvation.

Revelation 3:17 Because you say, I am rich, and increased with goods, and <u>have need of nothing</u>, and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked.

Deuteronomy 32:18-20 You forgot the Rock who brought you forth, and ceased to care for God who formed you. And the LORD saw and despised them because of the provoking of His sons and of His daughters. And He said, I will hide My face from them, I will see what their end shall be. For they are a very perverse generation, sons in whom is no faithfulness.

Luke 18:8 Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall <u>he find faith</u> <u>on the earth</u>?

Psalm 78:40-42 How oft did they <u>provoke him</u> in the wilderness and <u>grieve him</u> in the desert! Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and *limited* the Holy One of Israel. They <u>remembered not</u> his hand, nor the day when he delivered them from the enemy.

Isaiah 17:4 And in that day, it shall come to pass, that the glory of Jacob shall be made thin, and the <u>fatness of his flesh shall wax lean</u>.

Isaiah 17:10 Because thou hast forgotten the God of your salvation, and hast not been mindful of the rock of your strength,

Psalm 106:10-12 And he saved them from the hand of him that hated them and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. And the waters covered their enemies: There was not one of them left. <u>Then believed they his words, they sang his praise.</u>

Psalm 106:13-15 They soon forgot his works, they waited not for his counsel: But lusted exceedingly in the wilderness, and tempted God in the desert. And he gave them their request; but sent leanness into their soul. Amos 8:11-12 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the Word of the LORD, and shall not find it. Psalm 103:17-21 But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children, To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them. The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all. Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure. 1 John 3:22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. Daniel 9:4 And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments. John 15:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. **1 John 5:3** For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: And his commandments are not grievous. Jeremiah 2:32 Can a maid forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? Yet *my people* have forgotten me days without number. Ezekiel 16:11 I decked thee also with ornaments, and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and a chain on thy neck. HOW DO WE GET RID OF SPOTS, WRINKLES AND **BLEMISHES?** Jeremiah 2:23 For though thou wash thee with nitre, and take thee much soap, yet thine *iniquity* is *marked* before me, saith the Lord GOD.

Proverbs 16:6 By *mercy and truth* <u>iniquity is purged</u>: And by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil.

2 Timothy 2:24-26 And the servant of the Lord must not strive, but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves, if God peradventure will give them repentance to the *acknowledging of the truth*, And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

Leviticus 26:40-42 If they shall *confess their iniquity*, and *the iniquity of their fathers*, with *their trespass* which they trespassed against me, and that also they have *walked contrary unto me*, And that I *also have walked contrary unto them*, and have brought them into the land of their enemies, *if then their <u>uncircumcised hearts</u> be humbled*, and they then *accept of the punishment* of their iniquity: <u>Then will I remember</u> my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.

Jeremiah 3:13 Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and *ye have not obeyed* my voice, saith the LORD.

Isaiah 4:3-4 And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem: When the Lord shall have *washed away the filth* of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the *spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning*.

Malachi 3:2,3 But who may abide the day of his coming? And who shall stand when he appeareth? For he is like a *refiner's fire*, and like *fullers' soap*: And he shall <u>sit as a refiner and purifier</u> of silver: And he shall purify the sons of Levi, and <u>purge them as gold and silver</u>, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness.

Revelations 1:5-6 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us and *washed us from our sins in his own blood*, And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
