TORAH

Leviticus 25:1,2 The LORD said to Moses **in Mount Sinai**, Speak to the children of Israel, and tell them, When you come into the land **which I give you**, then the land shall keep a Sabbath to the LORD.

Psalm 24:1 The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof, the world, and they that dwell therein.

Revelation 21:16,17 And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: And he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal. And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

Leviticus 25:3,4 Six years you <u>shall</u> sow <u>your</u> field, and six years you shall prune <u>your</u> vineyard, and gather in its fruits, but in the <u>seventh year</u> there shall be a Sabbath of solemn rest for the land, <u>a Sabbath to the LORD</u>. You shall not sow <u>your</u> field or prune <u>your</u> vineyard.

Leviticus 25:6,7 And the Sabbath of the land will give food for you and your man-servant and your woman-servant and those working for payment, and for those of another country who are living among you, And for your cattle and the beasts on the land; all the natural increase of the land will be for food.

Exodus 23:10,11 For six years put seed into your fields and get in the increase, But in the seventh year let the land have a rest and be unplanted; so that the poor may have food from it: and let the wildlife take the rest. Do the same with your vine-gardens and your olive-trees.

Leviticus 25:8,9 'And **you shall count** <u>seven sabbaths</u> of years for yourself, <u>seven times</u> <u>seven years</u>, and the time of the <u>seven sabbaths</u> of years shall be to you forty-nine years. Then you shall sound the loud shofar <u>on the tenth day of the seventh month</u>. On <u>the Day of Atonement</u> you shall sound the shofar throughout all your land.

Leviticus 25:10-13 And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and **proclaim liberty throughout the land unto all the inhabitants thereof**, it shall be a **jubilee** unto you; and ye shall return every man unto his possession, and ye shall return every man unto his family. A jubilee shall that fiftieth year be unto you, ye shall not sow, neither reap that which groweth of itself in it, nor gather the grapes in it of the undressed vines. For it is a jubilee, it



shall be holy unto you, ye shall eat the increase thereof out of the field. In this year of jubilee ye shall return every man unto his possession.

Leviticus 25:23 The land shall not be sold forever: For the land <u>is mine</u>, for you are strangers and **sojourners with me.**

Jeremiah 16:14-16 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be said, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt, But, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north, and from all the lands whither he had driven them: and I will bring them again into their land that I gave unto their fathers. Behold, I will send for many fishers, saith the LORD, and they shall fish them; and after will I send for many hunters, and they shall hunt them from every mountain, and from every hill, and out of the holes of the rocks.

Jeremiah 34:12-16 The word of the LORD came to Jeremiah from the LORD: Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel: I myself made a covenant with your fathers when I brought them out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery, saying, At the end of seven years each of you must set free the fellow Hebrew who has been sold to you and has served you six years, you must set him free from your service. But your fathers did not listen to me or incline their ears to me. You recently repented and did what was right in my eyes by **proclaiming liberty**, each to his neighbor, and you made a covenant before me in the house that is called by my name, but then you turned around and profaned my name when each of you took back his male and female slaves, whom you had set free according to their desire, and you brought them into subjection to be your slaves.

1 Samuel 12:16-19 Now therefore, stand and see this great thing which the Lord will do before your eyes: Is today not the wheat harvest? I will call to the Lord, and He will send thunder and rain, that you may perceive and see that your wickedness is great, which you have done in the sight of the Lord, in asking a king for yourselves. So Samuel called to the Lord, and the Lord sent thunder and rain that day, and all the people greatly feared the Lord and Samuel. And all the people said to Samuel, Pray for your servants to the Lord your God, that we may not die, for we have added to all our sins the evil of asking a king for ourselves.

Leviticus 25:17-19 You shall not wrong one another, but you shall fear your God: For I am the LORD your God. Therefore you shall do my statutes, and keep my ordinances and do them, and you shall dwell in the land <u>in safety</u>. The land shall yield its fruit, and you shall eat your fill, and dwell therein in safety.



Leviticus 25:20,21 And if ye shall say, What shall we eat <u>the seventh year</u>? Behold, we shall not sow, nor gather in our increase: Then I will command my blessing upon you <u>in the sixth year</u>, and it shall bring forth fruit **for three years**.

Leviticus 25:25-28 If your brother becomes poor, and has to give up some of his land for money, his nearest relation may come and get back that which his brother has given up. And if he has no one to get it back for him, and later he himself gets wealth and has enough money to get it back, Then let him take into account the years from the time when he gave it up, and make up the loss for the rest of the years to him who took it, and so get back his property. But if he is not able to get it back for himself, then it will be kept by him who gave a price for it, till the year of Jubilee, and in that year it will go back to its first owner and he will have his property again.

Leviticus 25:35 If one of your brethren becomes poor, and falls into poverty among you, then you shall help him, like a stranger or a sojourner, that he may live with you.

Leviticus 25:39-41 And if one of your brethren who dwells by you becomes poor, and sells himself to you, you shall not compel him to serve as a slave. As a hired servant and a sojourner he shall be with you, and shall serve you until the Year of Jubilee. And then he shall depart from you—he and his children with him—and shall return to his own family. He shall return to the possession of his fathers.

Leviticus 25:47,48 Now if a sojourner or stranger close to you becomes rich, and one of your brethren who dwells by him becomes poor, and sells himself to the stranger or sojourner close to you, or to a member of the stranger's family, after he is sold he may be redeemed again. One of his brothers may redeem him.

Leviticus 25:54,55 And if he is not redeemed in these years, then **he shall be released in the Year of Jubilee he and his children with him. For the children of Israel are servants to Me,** they are My servants whom I brought out of the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God.

Luke 4:16-21 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. And as was his custom, he went to the **synagogue on the Sabbath day**, and he stood up to read. And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written, The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me **to proclaim liberty** to the captives



and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor. And he rolled up the scroll and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. And he began to say to them, Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.

A Church without Spot, Wrinkle or Blemish

CROOKED BACK: (loaded with cares of this world)

Mark 4:18-19 And these are they which are sown among thorns, such as hear the word, And the <u>cares of this world</u>, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me, for I am meek and lowly in heart: <u>And ye shall find rest unto your souls</u>. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and *walk therein*, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, *We will not walk* therein.

Galatians 6:2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

DWARF: Perfect in form & function but much below the standard.

- **1 Peter 2:2** As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby.
- **2 Peter 3:18** But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever. Amen.
- **1 Corinthians 13:11** When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: But when I became a man, I put away childish things.

Ephesians 4:14-15 That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and from, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive, But speaking the truth in love, <u>may grow up</u> into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ.

BLEMISH IN EYE: (distorted vision)

Matthew 7:2-5 For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: And with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again. And why beholds thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considers not the beam that is in thine own eye? Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye, and, behold, a beam is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Romans 2:1 Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judges: For wherein thou judges another, thou condemns thyself, for thou that judges does the same things.

Proverbs 30:12 There is a generation that are pure in their own eyes, and yet is not washed from their filthiness.

Isaiah 11:2-3 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD, And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: And he shall <u>not judge after the sight of his eyes</u>, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears.

SCURVY: (Improper diet)

1 Peter 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere <u>milk</u> of the word, that ye may grow thereby.

Hebrews 5:13-14 For ever one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: For he is a babe. But strong <u>meat</u> belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

John 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: He that cometh to me shall never hunger, and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

Galatians 5:22-23 But the <u>fruit</u> of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: Against such there is no law.

Acts 20:27-28 For I have not shunned to <u>declare unto you all the counsel</u> of God. Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to <u>feed the church</u> of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.



SCABBED: (Skin diseases primarily affecting the scalp)

Psalm 68:21 But God shall wound the head of his enemies, and the <u>hairy</u> scalp of such an one as goeth on still in his trespasses.

Isaiah 3:15-17 What mean ye that ye beat my people to pieces and grind the faces of the poor? Saith the LORD GOD of hosts. Moreover the LORD saith, Because the daughters of Zion are <u>haughty</u>, and walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes, walking and mincing as they go, and making a tinkling with

their feet: Therefore the LORD will smite with <u>a scab the crown of the head</u> of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts.

Ezekiel 16:11,12 I decked thee also with ornaments, and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and <u>a chain on thy neck</u>. And I put a jewel on thy forehead, and earrings in thine ears, and a <u>beautiful crown upon thine head</u>.


Proverbs 1:8-9 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother: For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.

Ezekiel 16:48-50 As I live, saith the Lord GOD, Sodom thy sister hath not done, she nor her daughters, as thou hast done, thou and thy daughters. Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, <u>pride</u>, <u>fulness of bread</u>, <u>and abundance of idleness</u> was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. And they were <u>haughty</u>, and committed abomination before me: Therefore I took them away as I saw good.

STONES BROKEN: (Unable to reproduce)

Galatians 4:18-19 But it is good to be zealously affected always in a good thing, and not only when I am present with you. My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you.

John 15:6-8 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered, and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit, so shall ye be my disciples.



Colossians 1:10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God.

2 Timothy 2:2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same <u>commit thou to faithful men</u>, who shall be able to <u>teach</u> others also.

SPOTS

Ephesians 5:26,27 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, <u>not having spot.</u>

Jude 1:11,12 Woe unto them! For they have gone in the <u>way of Cain</u>, and ran greedily after the <u>error of Balaam</u> for reward, and perished in <u>the gainsaying of Korah</u>. **These are spots**.

Genesis 4:8-10,12,13 Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him. And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper? And he said, What hast thou done? The voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground. A fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth. And Cain said unto the LORD, My punishment is greater than I can bear.

1 John 3:11,12 For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should <u>love one another</u>. Not as *Cain*, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And *wherefore slew he him?* Because *his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous*.

THE WAY OF CAIN:

1. He was religious

James 1:27 *Pure religion and undefiled* before God and the Father is this, To <u>visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction</u>, and to keep himself *unspotted* from the world.

- 2. He was envious
- 3. He was full of hatred, wrath, strife
- 4. He was a murderer
- 5. He was irreverent and a liar
- 6. He was a man of the flesh

Galatians 5:19-21 Now the <u>works of the flesh</u> are manifest, which are these, Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, *hatred*, variance, emulations, *wrath*, *strife*, seditions, heresies, *Envyings*, *murders*, drunkenness, revellings, and such like. Of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

THE ERROR OF BALAAM

Loved the wages of unrighteousness, Self-willed, Disobedient

2 Peter 2:13-15 *Spots* they are and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they feast with you, Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin, beguiling unstable souls: An heart they have exercised with covetous practices, cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the *way of Balaam* the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness.

Numbers 22:6 Therefore, I pray you, come now and curse this people for me. For they are too mighty for me. Perhaps I shall prevail so that we may strike them, and so that I may drive them out of the land. <u>For I know that</u> he whom you bless is blessed, and he whom you curse is cursed.

James 3:10 Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.

Evil counselor


Numbers 31:16 Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD.

Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

Joel 3:1,2 For, behold, in those days and in that time, when I will bring again the exiles of Judah and Jerusalem, I will also gather all nations and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat. And <u>I will fight with them there for My people and for My inheritance Israel</u>, whom they have scattered among the nations, and divided *My land*.

THE WAY OF KORAH Conspirator Envious Jealous Makes false accusations

Numbers 16:1-3 Now *Korah*, the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, and Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and On, the son of Peleth, sons of Reuben, took men: And they rose up before Moses, with certain of the children of Israel, two hundred and fifty princes of the assembly, famous in the congregation, men of renown: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron, and said unto them,



Ye take too much upon you, <u>seeing all the congregation are holy, every one of them</u>, and the LORD is among them: Wherefore then <u>lift ye up yourselves above the congregation</u> of the LORD?

Exodus 6:18,20 And the *sons of Kohath*, *Amram*, and *Izhar*, and Hebron, and Uzziel. And *Amram* took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife; and she *bare him Aaron and Moses*:

Numbers 16:8-10 And Moses said unto Korah, Hear, I pray you, <u>ye sons of Levi</u>: Seemeth it but a small thing unto you, that the God of Israel <u>hath separated you</u> from the congregation of Israel, to bring you near to himself to do the service of the tabernacle of the LORD, and to stand before the congregation to minister unto them? And he hath brought thee near to him, and all thy brethren the sons of Levi with thee: and *seek ye the priesthood also*?

Numbers 16:19-21 And *Korah gathered all the congregation against them* unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: And the glory of the LORD appeared unto all the congregation.

Numbers 16:32-35 And the earth opened her mouth and swallowed them up, and their households, <u>and all the men who were for Korah</u>, and all their goods. They and all that they had went down alive into Sheol, and the earth closed upon them. And they perished from among the congregation. And all Israel around them fled at their cry. For they said, Lest the earth swallow us up. And there <u>came out a fire from the LORD and burned up</u> the two hundred and fifty men who offered incense.
