

TORAH PORTION

Numbers 4:2,3 <u>Take the sum</u> of the sons of Kohath from among <u>the sons of</u> <u>Levi</u>, after their families, by the house of their fathers, From <u>thirty years old</u> and upward even until fifty years old, all that enter into the host, to do the work in the tabernacle of the congregation.

Exodus 34:7 Keeping mercy for thousands, <u>forgiving</u> iniquity and transgression and sin.

Deuteronomy 31:17 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them.

Numbers 5:5-7 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to do a trespass against the LORD, and that person be guilty; Then <u>they shall **confess**</u> <u>their sin</u> which they have done: And he shall recompense his trespass with the principal thereof, and add unto it the fifth part thereof, and <u>give it to him against</u> <u>whom he has trespassed.</u>

1 John 3:4 Whoever commits sin transgresses also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Numbers 6:1,2 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say to them, When either man or woman shall separate themselves to vow a vow of a Nazarite, to separate themselves to the LORD.

Numbers 6:5 All the days of the vow of his separation there shall <u>no razor come</u> <u>on his head</u>: Until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separates himself to the LORD, he shall be holy, and <u>shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow</u>.

Numbers 6:13-15 This is the law of the Nazirite: When the days of his separation are fulfilled, he shall be brought to the door of the Tent of Meeting, and he shall offer his offering to the LORD, one **male lamb** a year old without blemish for a burnt offering, and one **ewe lamb** a year old without blemish for a sin offering, and **one ram** without blemish for peace offerings, and **a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mixed with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and their meal offering, and their drink offerings.**

Numbers 6:18 The Nazirite shall shave the head of his separation at the door of the Tent of Meeting, and shall take the hair of the head of his separation, and put it on the fire which is under the sacrifice of peace offerings.

Acts 18:18 Paul, having stayed after this many more days, took his leave of the brothers, and sailed from there for Syria, together with Priscilla and Aquila. He shaved his head in Cenchreae, for he had a vow.

Acts 21:23,24 Therefore do what we tell you. We have <u>four men</u> who have taken a vow. Take them, and <u>purify yourself with them, and pay their</u> <u>expenses</u> for them, that they may shave their heads. Then all will know that there is no truth in the things that they have been informed about you, but that you yourself also walk keeping the Torah.

Acts 6:7 The word of God increased and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem exceedingly. A great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.

Numbers 6:22-27 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron and to his sons saying, <u>In this way you shall bless the sons of Israel</u>, **saying to them**, **The LORD** bless you and keep you. **The LORD** make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you. **The LORD** lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. And they <u>shall put **My name** upon the sons of Israel</u>. And **I**, **I** will bless them.


1 Chronicles 29:20 And David said to all the congregation, Now <u>bless <barak></u> <u>the LORD</u> your God. And all the congregation <u>blessed the LORD God</u> of their fathers, and bowed down their heads.

Psalm 95:6 O come, let us worship and bow down: Let us kneel <barak> before the LORD our maker.

Philippians 2:7,8 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Genesis 1:16,17 And God made two great lights, the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: He made the stars also. And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give <u>light</u> upon the earth.

Deuteronomy 31:17,18 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them, so that they will say



in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God is not among us? And I will surely <u>hide my face</u> in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

Psalm 31:9 Have <u>mercy</u> upon me, O LORD, for I am in trouble.

Romans 5:8 But God commended his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Genesis 4:6 And the LORD said unto Cain, Why are you angry? And why is your countenance fallen?

Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Luke 24:50 And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he <u>lifted up</u> his hands, and <u>blessed</u> them. And it came to pass, while he <u>blessed</u> them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

Judges 13:2 And there was *a certain man* <u>of Zorah</u>, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah, and <u>his wife</u> was barren, and bore not.

Judges 13:3 The angel of the LORD appeared to the woman.

Judges 13:6 Then the woman came and told her husband.

Judges 13:9 And the angel of God came again to **the woman** as she sat in the field.

Judges 13:10 The woman made haste, and ran, and told her husband.

Judges 13:11 Manoah arose, and went after his wife, and came to the man, and said to him, Are you the man who spoke to **the woman**?

Judges 13:13 The angel of the LORD said to Manoah, Of all that I said to the woman let her beware.

Joshua 19:40,41b The seventh lot came out for the tribe of the <u>children of Dan</u> according to their families. The border of their inheritance was <u>Zorah</u>.

Joshua 15:21 The farthest cities of the tribe of the <u>children of **Judah**</u> toward the border of Edom in the South were Kabzeel, Eder, Jagur,

Joshua 15:33 In the lowland, Eshtaol, Zorah, Ashnah,

Judges 15:7,8 Samson said to them, If you behave like this, surely I will be avenged of you, and after that I will cease. He struck them hip and thigh with a great slaughter: And he went down and <u>lived in the cleft of the rock of **Etam**</u>.

1 Chronicles 4:1-3 The <u>sons of Judah</u>: Perez, Hezron, and Carmi, and Hur, and Shobal. Reaiah the son of Shobal became the father of Jahath, and Jahath became the father of Ahumai and Lahad. These are the families of the **Zorathites.** These were the sons of the father of **Etam**: Jezreel, and Ishma, and Idbash, and the <u>name of their sister</u> was <u>Hazzelelponi.</u>

Judges 13:3-5 And the angel of the LORD appeared to the woman, and said to her, Behold now, you are barren, and bore not: **But you shall conceive, and bear a son**. Now therefore beware, I pray you, and drink <u>not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean thing</u>: For, see, **you shall conceive, and bear a son**, and <u>no razor shall come on his head</u>: For the child shall <u>be a Nazarite unto God from the womb</u>: and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.

Judges 13:24 And <u>the woman</u> bore a son, and called his name <u>Samson</u>: And the child grew, and the LORD blessed him.

Judges 13:6 Then the woman came and told her husband, saying, <u>A man of God</u> came to me, and his countenance was like the countenance of <u>an angel of God</u>, very terrible: But I asked him not where he was, <u>neither told he me his name</u>.

Judges 13:22 And Manoah said to his wife, We shall surely die, because we have seen God.

Judges 13:17,18 And Manoah said to the <u>angel of the LORD</u>, <u>What is your</u> <u>name</u>, that when your sayings come to pass we may do thee honor? And <u>the</u> <u>angel of the LORD</u> said to him, Why ask you thus after my name, seeing it is <u>secret</u>?

Psalm 139:6 Such knowledge is too <u>wonderfu</u>l for me, it is high, I cannot attain unto it.

Judges 13:19 So Manoah took a kid with a meat offering, and offered it on a rock to the LORD: And the angel did **wondrously**, and Manoah and his wife looked on.

Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us <u>a son is given</u>: And the government shall be on his shoulder: And <u>his name shall be called **Wonderful**</u>, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

John 3:16a For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son,

Exodus 19:1-20:23, Ezekiel 1:1-28, 3:12, Acts 2:1-21 Deuteronomy 14:22-16:17, Habakkuk 3:1-19 Acts 2:21-42

Ruth 2:23 So she kept fast by the maidens of Boaz to glean unto the end of barley harvest and of wheat harvest, and dwelt with her mother in law.

Exodus 19:18-20 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: And the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly. And when **the voice of the trumpet** sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spoke, and **God answered him by a voice**. And the LORD came down upon mount Sinai, on the top of the mount: And the **LORD called Moses up to the top of the mount**; and Moses went up.

Revelation 4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: And the first voice which I heard was **as it were of a trumpet talking with me,** which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

Exodus 20:18-21 And all the people saw the <u>thunderings, and the lightnings,</u> <u>and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking</u>: And when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off. And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: But let not God speak with us, lest we die. And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: For God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not. **And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near** unto the thick darkness where God was.

Deuteronomy 16:16 Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, in the feast of unleavened bread, and **in the feast of weeks**, and in the feast of tabernacles: And they shall not appear before the LORD empty.

Ezekiel 3:12-14 Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me **a voice of a great rushing**, saying, Blessed be the glory of the LORD from his place. I heard also the noise of the wings of the living creatures that touched one another, and the noise of the wheels over against them, and a noise of a great rushing. So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit, but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me.

Ezekiel 1:26-28 And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of **a throne**, as the **appearance of a sapphire stone**: And upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it. And I saw as the color of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were **the appearance of fire**, and it had brightness round about. As the appearance **of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain**, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was **the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD.** And when I saw it, I **fell upon my face**, and I heard a voice of one that spoke.

Revelation 4:2,3 And immediately I was in the spirit: And, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: And there **was a rainbow round about the throne**, in sight like unto an emerald.

Revelation 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded <u>lightnings and thunderings</u> <u>and voices</u>: And there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Revelation 1:10-18 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: And, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia, unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea. And I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks. And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were as a flame of fire, And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: And his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength. And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not, I am the first and the last: I am he that liveth, and was dead, and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen, and have the keys of hell and of death.

Acts 2:1-3 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of **a rushing mighty wind**, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Acts 2:5-11 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem <u>Jews, devout men, out of</u> <u>every nation under heaven.</u> Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, <u>Jews and proselytes</u>, Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

Acts 2:15 these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

Acts 2:36,37 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Yeshua, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: And the same day there were added unto them about **three thousand souls.**

Acts 3:25-4:4 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Yeshua, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities. And as they spoke unto the people, the **priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees**, came upon them, Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Yeshua the resurrection from the dead. And they laid hands on them, and put them in hold unto the next day: For it was now eventide. Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed, and the number of the men was about five thousand.

Acts 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many <u>(tens) of thousands of Jews</u> there are which believe, and <u>they are all zealous of the law.</u>

Acts 2:46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart.

Acts 5:42 And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Yeshua HaMashiach.

Exodus 6:2-4 And God said to Moses, I am Yahweh: I let myself be seen by Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, as God, the Ruler of all, **but they had no knowledge of my name Yahweh.** And I made an agreement with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their wanderings.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call upon <u>the name</u> of the Lord shall be saved.

Psalm 18:3 I will **call upon the LORD**, who is worthy to be praised: <u>So shall</u> <u>I be saved from mine enemies.</u>

Psalm 55:16 As for me, I will call upon God, and the LORD shall save me.

Psalm 116:13 I will take the <u>cup of salvation</u>,(Yeshuah) and <u>call upon the</u> <u>name of the Lord.(YHWH)</u>

Psalm 145:18-20 The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth. He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: He also will hear their cry, and will save them. The LORD preserveth all them that love him: But all the wicked will he destroy.

Zephaniah 3:9 For then will **I turn to the people a pure language**, that they may all **call upon the name of the LORD**, to serve him with one consent.

Romans 10:10-13 For <u>with the heart man believeth</u> unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the <u>Scripture saith</u>, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is <u>no difference</u> <u>between the Jew and the Greek</u>: For <u>the same Lord (YHWH) over all</u> is rich unto <u>all that call upon him</u>. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord (YHWH) shall be saved.

Isaiah 25:9 And it shall be said in that day, See, this is our **God**, we have waited for Him, and <u>**He will save us**</u>: This is the **LORD**, we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in <u>his salvation</u>.

Isaiah 44:1-5 Yet listen now, **Jacob** my servant, and **Israel**, whom I have chosen. This is what the **LORD** (YHWH) who made you, and formed you from the womb, who will help you says: Don't be afraid, Jacob my servant, and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, and streams on the dry ground. I will pour my Spirit on your seed, and my blessing on your offspring: And they will spring up among the grass, as willows by the watercourses. <u>One will say</u>, **I am the LORD's**, (YHWH) and another will be called by the name of Jaco, and another will write with his hand to the **LORD**, (YHWH) and honor the name of Israel.

Isaiah 44:6 This is what the **LORD**, **(YHWH)** <u>the King of Israel, and his</u> <u>Redeemer</u>, the **LORD (YHWH)** of Hosts, says: <u>I am the first, and I am the</u> <u>last</u>; and <u>besides me there is no God</u>.

John 12:13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the <u>King of Israel</u> that cometh in the <u>name of the Lord</u>.

Revelation 1:17,18 When I saw him, I fell at his feet like a dead man. He laid his right hand on me, saying, Don't be afraid. <u>I am the first and the last</u>, and the Living one. I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. I have the keys of Death and of Sheol.

Isaiah 45:21,22 Declare and present it. Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has shown this from ancient time? Who has declared it of old? **Haven't I, the LORD**? <u>There is no other God besides me, a just God and a Savior</u>; There is no one besides me. <u>Look to me</u>, and be saved, <u>all the ends of the earth</u>, for I am God, and <u>there is no other.</u>

Philippians 2:9-11 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Yeshua HaMashiach is LORD, (YHWH) to the glory of God the Father.

Romans 14:10,11 But you, why do you judge your brother? Or again, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of Messiah. For it is written, As I live, says the LORD, to me every knee will bow. Every tongue will confess to God.

Isaiah 45:23-25 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That <u>unto me every knee shall bow, every</u> tongue shall swear. Surely, shall one say, in the LORD have I righteousness and strength: Even to him shall men come, and <u>all that are incensed against him shall be ashamed</u>. In the LORD (YHWH) shall all the seed of Israel be justified, and shall glory.
