TORAH PORTION

Numbers 8:1-5 Now the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron and say to him, When you <u>set up</u> the lamps, the <u>seven lamps</u> shall give light in front of the lampstand. And Aaron did so: He set up its lamps in front of the lampstand, as the Lord commanded Moses. And this was the workmanship of the lampstand, hammered work of gold. From its base to its flowers, it was hammered work, <u>according to the pattern</u> that the Lord had shown Moses, so he made the lampstand.

Revelation 4:5 And <u>out of the throne</u> proceeded <u>lightnings and</u> <u>thunderings</u> and <u>voices</u>: And there were <u>seven lamps of fire</u> burning before the throne, <u>which are the seven Spirits of God.</u>

Zechariah 4:1,2 And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep, And said unto me, **What seest thou**? And I said, I have looked, and behold <u>a candlestick</u> all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and <u>his seven lamps</u> thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof.

Zechariah 3:8-10 Hear now, Joshua the high priest, you and your fellows who sit before you, for they are men who are a sign: for, behold, I will bring forth my <u>servant</u>, <u>the Branch</u>. For, behold, the stone that I have set before Joshua, <u>on one stone are seven eyes</u>: Behold, I will engrave its engraving, says the LORD of Hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day. In that day, says the LORD of Hosts, you will invite every man his neighbor under the vine and under the fig tree.

Zechariah 4:5,6 Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord. Then he answered and spoke unto me, saying, This is the word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but <u>by my Spirit</u>, saith the Lord of hosts.

Revelation 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, <u>in the midst of the throne</u> and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood <u>a Lamb</u> as it had been slain, having seven horns and <u>seven eyes</u>, which are the <u>seven Spirits of God sent</u> forth into all the earth.

Revelation 1:4-8 Yochanan, to the seven assemblies that are in Asia: <u>Grace</u> <u>to you</u> and peace, from God, <u>who is and who was and who is to come</u>, and <u>from the seven Spirits</u> who **are before his throne**; and from Yeshua the Messiah, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and washed us from our sins by his blood, and he made us to be a Kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. Behold, <u>he is coming</u> with the clouds, and every eye will see him, including those who pierced him. All the tribes of the earth will mourn over him. Even so, Amen. I am the <u>Alef and the Tav</u>, says the Lord God, <u>who is and who</u> was and who is to come, the Almighty.

Revelation 1:10,11a I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud **voice like a trumpet** saying, I am the '<u>Aleph' and the 'Tav'</u>, the First and the Last," and, Write in a book what you see.

Revelation 1:12-14 And I turned to see <u>the voice</u> that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks, And <u>in the midst of the seven</u> <u>candlesticks</u> one like unto the <u>Son of man</u>, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow, and <u>his eyes were as a flame of fire</u>.

John 1:1,2 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God.

Numbers 9:1-3 And the Lord spoke unto Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the first month of the second year after they were come out of the land of Egypt, saying, Let the children of Israel also keep the Passover at his appointed season. In the fourteenth day of this month, at even, ye shall keep it in his appointed season: According to all the rites of it, and according to all the ceremonies thereof, shall ye keep it.

Numbers 9:9-11 The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the people of Israel, saying, If any one of you or of your descendants is unclean through touching a dead body, or is on a long journey, he shall still keep the Passover to the Lord. In the second month on the fourteenth day at twilight they shall keep it. They shall eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs. They shall leave none of it until the morning, nor break any of its bones, according to all the statute for the Passover they shall keep it.

Numbers 9:15,16 And on the day that the tabernacle was <u>reared up</u> the cloud covered the tabernacle, namely, the tent of the testimony: And at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning. So it was alway: The cloud covered it by day, and the appearance of fire by night.

Numbers 10:11,12 And it came to pass on the twentieth day of the second month, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the testimony. And the children of Israel took their journeys out of the wilderness of Sinai, and the cloud rested in the wilderness of Paran.

Numbers 10:33,34 And they departed from the mount of the Lord <u>three</u> <u>days journey</u>: And the ark of the covenant of the Lord went before them in the <u>three days' journey</u>, to search out a resting place for them. And the cloud of the Lord was upon them by day, when they went out of the camp

Numbers 10:35 And it came to pass, when the ark set forward, that Moses said, <u>**Rise up**</u>, Lord, and let thine enemies be scattered, and let them that hate thee flee before thee.

Numbers 10:36 And when it rested, he said, Return, O Lord, unto the many thousands of Israel.

Matthew 1:1 A record of the genealogy of Yeshua the Messiah, the <u>son of</u> <u>David</u>, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are <u>fourteen</u> <u>generations</u>, from David to the exile to Babylon <u>fourteen generations</u>, and from the carrying away to Babylon to the Messiah, <u>fourteen generations</u>.

Numbers 11:1 And when the people complained, it displeased the Lord: And the Lord heard it, and his anger was kindled, and the fire of the Lord burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp.

Numbers 11:4-6 And the mix multitude that was among them fell a lusting: And the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat? We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely, the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlick: But now our soul is dried away: There is nothing at all, **beside this manna**, before our eyes.

Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended to heaven and come down? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has wrapped up the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name? Surely you know!

Exodus 16:31a And the house of Israel call <u>its</u> name Manna.

Numbers 11:10 Moses heard the people weeping throughout their clans, everyone at the door of his tent. And the anger of the Lord blazed hotly, and Moses was displeased.

Numbers 11:12-15 Did I conceive all this people? Did I give them birth, that you should say to me, Carry them in your bosom, as a nurse carries a nursing child, to the land that you swore to give their fathers? Where am I to get meat to give to all this people? For they weep before me and say, Give us meat, that we may eat. I am not able to carry all this people alone; the burden is too heavy for me. If you will treat me like this, kill me at once, if I find favor in your sight, that I may not see my wretchedness.

Numbers 11:33 While the meat was yet between their teeth, before it was consumed, the anger of the Lord was kindled against the people, and the Lord struck down the people with a very great plague.

Numbers 12:1,2 And Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: For he had married an Ethiopian woman. And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? Hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard it.

Numbers 12:9,10 And the anger of the Lord was kindled against them, and he departed. When the cloud removed from over the tent, behold, Miriam was leprous, like snow. And Aaron turned toward Miriam, and behold, she was leprous.

The Thirteen Attributes/Names

Genesis 1;1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 2:4 These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches, To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, **and in the stone a new name written**, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Revelation 3:12,13 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: And I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: And I will write upon him my new name.

John 14:13,14 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask anything in my name. I will do it. **Romans 10:12** For there is **no difference between the Jew and the Greek**: For the same Lord over all, is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Psalm 55:16 As for me, I will call upon God, and the LORD shall save me. **Deuteronomy 4:7** For what nation is there so great, who hath God so nigh unto them, as the LORD our God is in all things that we call upon him for? 1 Chronicles 16:8 Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. Psalm 18:3 I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: So shall I be saved from mine enemies. Psalm 105:1 O give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name: Make known his deeds among the people. Psalm 116:17 I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD. Psalm 145:18 The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth. Isaiah 55:6,7 Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: And let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. Zephaniah 3:9 For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him with one consent. Isaiah 44:3-5 For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing

upon thine offspring: And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses. One shall say, I am the LORD's, and another shall call himself by the name of Jacob, and another shall subscribe with his hand unto the LORD, and surname himself by the name of Israel.

Romans 9:15,16 For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy.

Exodus 33:18,19And he said, I beseech thee, **show me** thy glory. And he said, I will **make all my goodness pass before thee**, and **I will proclaim the name of the LORD** before thee, **and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.**

Exodus 34:5-8 And the LORD descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, <u>and **proclaimed**</u> the name of the LORD. And the LORD passed by before him, <u>and proclaimed</u>. The <u>LORD</u>, The <u>LORD God</u>, <u>Merciful</u> and <u>Gracious</u>, <u>Longsuffering</u>, and <u>Abundant in Goodness</u> and <u>Truth</u>, Keeping mercy for thousands, Forgiving Iniquity and Transgression and Sin, and that will by no means Clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

John 1:12-15 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those <u>who believe in His name</u>: Who were born, **not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man**, but of God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and <u>we beheld</u> His Glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of <u>Grace</u> <u>and Truth</u>.

Exodus 33:20-23 And he said, Thou canst not see my face: For there shall no man see me, and live. And the LORD said, Behold, there is a place by me, and thou shalt stand upon a rock: And it shall come to pass, while my glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a cleft of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by: And I will take away mine hand, and thou shalt see my back parts: But my face shall not be seen.

Ezekiel 18:23 Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? Saith the Lord GOD: And not that he should return from his ways, and live?
