

#### TORAH

**Numbers 12:15** And **Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days:** And the people **journeyed not** till Miriam was brought in again. And afterward the people removed from Hazeroth, and pitched in the wilderness of Paran.

**Numbers 13:1-3** And **the LORD spoke** to Moses, saying, <u>Send you men</u>, that they may <u>search</u> (spy) the land of Canaan, which I give to the children of Israel: Of every tribe of their fathers shall <u>you send</u> a man, <u>every one a ruler</u> among them. And **Moses by the commandment of the LORD** sent them from the wilderness of Paran: All those men were heads of the children of Israel.

**Deuteronomy 1:20-23** And I said to you, You are come to the mountain of the Amorites, which the LORD our God does give to us. Behold, the LORD your God has set the land before you: Go up and possess it, as the LORD God of your fathers has said to you, fear not, neither be discouraged. And you came near to me every one of you, and said, <u>We will send men before us</u>, and they shall **search** us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: And I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

**Deuteronomy 1:24** And they turned and went up into the mountain, and came unto the valley of Eshcol, and <u>searched</u> <ragal> it out.

**Numbers 13:17-20** And **Moses sent them to spy** out the land of Canaan, and said to them, Get you up this way southward, and go up into the mountain: And see the land, what it is, and the people that dwells therein, whether they be strong or weak, few or many, And what the land is that they dwell in, whether it be good or bad, and what cities they be that they dwell in, whether in tents, or in strong holds, <u>And what the land is, whether it be fat or lean, whether there be wood therein, or not.</u> <u>And be you of good courage, and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time was the time of the first ripe grapes.</u>

**Ezekiel 20:1** And it came to pass <u>in the seventh year</u>, **in the fifth month, the tenth day of the month**, that certain of the elders of Israel came to inquire of the LORD, and sat before me.

**Ezekiel 20:5-8** And say to them, Thus said the Lord GOD, In the day when I chose Israel, and <u>lifted up my hand</u> to the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known to them in the land of Egypt, when I <u>lifted up my hand to them</u>, saying, I am the LORD your God, In the day that <u>I lifted up my hand to them</u>, to bring them forth of the land of Egypt into a land that <u>I had espied for them</u>, flowing with milk and honey, which is the glory of all lands: Then said I to them, <u>Cast you away every man the abominations of his eyes</u>, and defile not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: I am the LORD your God. But <u>they rebelled against me</u>, and would not **listen to** 

<u>me</u>: They did not every man cast away <u>the abominations of their eyes</u>, **neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt.** 

**Numbers 13:22-24** And they ascended by the south, and came <u>to Hebron</u>, where <u>Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak</u>, were. (Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.) And they came to the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from there a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bore it between two on a staff; and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs. The place was called the brook Eshcol, because of the cluster of grapes which the children of Israel cut down from there.


**Numbers 13:28,29** Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: And moreover we saw the children of Anak there. The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: And the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: And the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

**Numbers 13:32** And they spread an evil report of the land which they had spied out unto the children of Israel, saying: The land, through which we have passed to spy it out, is a land that <u>eateth up the inhabitants</u> thereof, and all the people that we saw in it are men of great stature.

**Ezekiel 36:8-15** But you, mountains of Israel, you shall shoot forth your branches, and yield your fruit to my people Israel, for they are at hand to come. For, behold, I am for you, and I will turn into you, and you shall be tilled and sown, and I will multiply men on you, all the house of Israel, even all of it, and the cities shall be inhabited, and the waste places shall be built, and I will multiply on you man and animal, and they shall increase and be fruitful, and I will cause you to be inhabited after your former estate, and will do better [to you] than at your beginnings: And you shall know that I am the LORD. Yes, I will cause men to walk on you, even my people Israel, and they shall possess you, and you shall be their inheritance, and you shall no more henceforth bereave them of children. Thus says the Lord GOD: Because they say to you, **You are a devourer of men**, and have been a bereaver of your nation, therefore you shall devour men no more, neither bereave your nation any more, says the Lord GOD, neither will I let you hear any more the shame of the nations, neither shall you bear the reproach of the peoples any more, neither shall you cause your nation to stumble any more, says the Lord GOD.

**Genesis 48:19** And his father refused, and said, I know it, my son, I know it: He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great: But truly his younger brother shall be greater than he.

**Numbers 13:30** And **Caleb stilled the people before Moses**, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it, for we are well able to overcome it.



**Numbers 13:31** But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger <u>than we.</u>

Numbers 13:33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: And we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

**Numbers 14:22-24** Because all these men, having seen my glory and the signs which I have done in Egypt and in the waste land, still have put me to the test ten times, and have not given ear to my voice, They **will not see** the land about which I made an oath to their fathers, not one of these by whom I have not been honored will see it. **But my servant Caleb**, because he had a different spirit in him, and has been true to me with all his heart, him I will take into that land into which he went, and his seed will have it for their heritage.

**Joshua 2:9-11** And she said to the men, I know that the LORD has given you the land, and that your terror is fallen on us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you. For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when you came out of Egypt; and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom you utterly destroyed. And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: For the LORD your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

**Joshua 2:23,24** So the two men returned, and descended from the mountain, and passed over, and came to Joshua the son of Nun, and told him all things that befell them: And they said to Joshua, Truly the LORD has delivered into our hands all the land; for even all the inhabitants of the country do faint because of us.

**Numbers 14:1-4** And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried, and the people wept that night. And all the children of Israel <u>murmured against Moses</u> and against Aaron: And the whole congregation said to them, <u>Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt</u>! or would <u>God we had died in this wilderness</u>! And why has the LORD brought us to this land, to fall by the sword, that our wives and our children should be a prey? Were it not better for us to return into Egypt? And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

**Deuteronomy 11:7-9** But your eyes have seen all the great acts of the LORD which he did. Therefore shall you keep all the commandments which I command you this day, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land, where you go to possess it, And that you may prolong your days in the land, which <u>the LORD</u> swore to your fathers to give to them and to their seed, a land that flows with milk and honey.

**Numbers 14:6-9** And **Joshua the son of Nun**, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes: And **they spoke** to all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land. If the LORD delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land which flows with milk and honey. Only rebel not you against the LORD, neither fear you the people of the land, for they are bread for us: Their defense is departed from them, and the LORD is with us: Fear them not.

**Numbers 14:11,12** And the LORD said to Moses, How long will this people provoke me? And how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have showed among them? I will smite them with the pestilence, <u>and disinherit</u> them, and will make of you a greater nation and mightier than they.

**Numbers 14:15-19** Now if you shall kill all this people as one man, then the nations which have heard the fame of you will speak, saying, Because the LORD was not able to bring this people into the land which he swore to them, therefore he has slain them in the wilderness. And now, I beseech you, let the **power of my LORD be** <u>Great</u>, according as you have spoken, saying, The LORD is <u>long-suffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech you, the iniquity of this people according to the greatness of your mercy, and as you have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.</u>

**Numbers 14:26-29** And the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, How long shall I bear with this evil congregation, which <u>murmur against me</u>? I have heard <u>the murmurings</u> of the children of Israel, which <u>they murmur against me</u>. Say to them, As truly as I live, said the LORD, <u>as you have spoken in my ears, so will I do to you: Your carcasses shall fall in this wilderness</u>, and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward which have <u>murmured against me</u>.

**Numbers 14:30** Not one will come into the land which I gave my word you would have for your resting-place, but **only Caleb**, the son of Jephunneh, **and Joshua**, the son of Nun.

**Romans 10:14,15** How then shall they **call on him** in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

#### The Thirteen <u>Attributes</u>/Names

**Numbers 14:15-19** Now if thou shalt kill all this people as one man, then the nations which have heard the fame of thee will speak, saying, Because the <u>LORD</u> was not able (was not strong enough) to bring this people into the land which he sware unto them, therefore he hath slain them in the wilderness. And now, I beseech thee, let the power of my Lord be great, according as thou hast spoken, saying, The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

**Numbers 14:20-23** And the **LORD** said, I have pardoned according to thy word: But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the **LORD**. Because all those men which have seen my glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice; Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it:

**Exodus 22:26,27** If thou at all take thy neighbor's raiment to pledge, thou shalt deliver it unto him by that the sun goes down: For that is his covering only, it is his raiment for his skin: wherein shall he sleep? and it shall come to pass, when he crieth unto me, that I will hear, for I am <u>gracious</u>.


**Isaiah 30:19** For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: Thou shalt weep no more: He will be very **gracious** unto thee at the voice of thy cry, when he shall hear it, he will answer thee.

**Exodus 3:7** And the LORD said, I have <u>surely seen</u> the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and <u>have heard</u> their cry by reason of their taskmasters, for I <u>know</u> their sorrows,I am feeling their pain.

**Genesis 42:21** And they say one unto another, Verily we are guilty concerning our brother, because <u>we saw</u> the distress of his soul, in his making supplication unto us, and <u>we did not hear</u>: therefore hath this distress come upon us.

**1 Peter 4:18** And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?
