TORAH PORTION

Numbers 19:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, This is the ordinance of the law which the LORD hath commanded, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring thee a **red heifer** without spot, wherein is no blemish, and upon which never came yoke:

Numbers 19:3,4 And ye shall give her unto Eleazar the priest, that he may bring her forth without the camp, and one shall slay her <u>before his face:</u> (panay) And Eleazar the priest shall take of her blood with his finger, and <u>sprinkle of her blood directly before the tabernacle of the congregation seven times.</u>

#6440. פנים paniym, paw-neem', <u>to face (the Judge)</u> *The guilty party must face the Judge!*

Numbers 19:6-8 And the priest shall take <u>cedar wood</u>, and <u>hyssop</u>, and <u>scarlet</u>, and <u>cast it into the midst of the burning of the heifer</u>. Then the priest shall wash his clothes, and he shall bathe his flesh in water, and afterward he shall come into the camp, and the <u>priest shall be unclean</u> until the even. And <u>he that burneth her shall wash his clothes in water</u>, and bathe his flesh in <u>water</u>, and **shall be unclean** until the even.

Leviticus 1:3 If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish: He shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation <u>before</u> the LORD.

Leviticus 3:7 If he offer a lamb for his offering, then shall he offer it before כנים the LORD.

Leviticus 6:25 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed shall the sin offering be killed <u>before כנים</u> the LORD: It is most holy.

Matthew 27:50,51,54 And, behold, the <u>veil of the temple was rent</u> in twain from the top to the bottom, and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent, Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Yeshua, saw the earthquake, and <u>those things that were done</u>, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

Numbers 19:9-12 And **a man that is clean** shall gather up the ashes of the heifer, and lay them up **without the camp** in a clean place, and it shall be kept for the congregation of the children of Israel for a water of separation: It is a purification for sin. And he that gather the ashes of the heifer shall wash his clothes, and **be unclean** until the even: And it shall be unto the children

of Israel, and unto the stranger that sojourn among them, for a statute forever. He that touch the dead body of any man <u>shall be unclean seven days</u>. He shall purify himself with it on the **third day, and on the seventh day** he shall be clean: But if he purify not himself the third day, then the seventh day he shall not be clean.

Numbers 19:13,14 Whosoever touchs <u>the dead body of any man that is dead</u>, and purifies not himself, defiles the tabernacle of the LORD, and that soul shall be cut off from Israel: Because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him, he shall be unclean, his uncleanness is yet upon him. This is the law, **when a man dieth in a tent**: All that come into the tent, and all that is in the tent, shall be unclean seven days.

Ezekiel 36:24-28 For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land. Then will <u>I</u> **sprinkle clean water** upon you, and ye shall be clean: From all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: And I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them. And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

Numbers 19:17,18 And for an unclean person they shall take of the ashes of the burnt heifer of purification for sin, and <u>running water</u> shall be put thereto in a vessel: And **a clean person** shall take hyssop, and dip it in the water, and sprinkle it upon the tent, and upon all the vessels, and upon the persons that were there and upon him that touched a bone, or one slain, or one dead, or a grave.

Numbers 20:1-5 Then came the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the **first month**: And the people abode in Kadesh, and <u>Miriam מרים died there</u> and was buried there. And there was no water for the congregation: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron. And the people chode with Moses, and spoke, saying, Would God that we had died when our brethren died before the LORD! And why have ye brought up the congregation of the LORD into this wilderness, that we and our cattle should die there? And wherefore have ye made us to come up out of Egypt, to bring us in unto this evil place? It is no place of seed, or of figs, or of vines, or of pomegranates, neither is there any water to drink.

Jeremiah 17:13 O Lord, <u>the hope</u> of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the Lord, the <u>fountain of living waters.</u>

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word.

Numbers 20:6-10 And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: And the glory of the LORD appeared unto them. And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, <u>Take the rod</u>, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and <u>speak ye unto (the) rock</u> before their eyes, and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: So thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink. <u>And Moses took the rod from before the LORD</u>, as he commanded <u>him</u>. And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, <u>ye rebels</u>, must <u>we</u> fetch you water out of this rock?

1 Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: And that Rock was Messiah.

Numbers 17:10 And the Lord said unto Moses, <u>Bring Aaron's rod again</u> before the testimony, to be kept for <u>a token **against the rebels**</u>, and thou shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not.

Numbers 20:11 And Moses <u>lifted up</u> his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: And the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

Numbers 20:23,24 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and Aaron in mount Hor, by the coast of the land of Edom, saying, Aaron shall be gathered unto his people: For he shall not enter into the land which I have given unto the children of Israel, **because you rebelled** against my word at the water of Meribah.

Numbers 20:27-29 And Moses did as the LORD commanded: And they went up into mount Hor in the sight of all the congregation. And Moses stripped Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son, and Aaron died there in the top of the mount: And Moses and Eleazar came down from the mount. And when all the congregation saw that Aaron was dead, they mourned for Aaron thirty days, even all the house of Israel.

Numbers 21:8,9 And the LORD said unto Moses: Make thee a fiery **serpent**, and set it upon a **pole**, and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he seeth it, shall live. And Moses made a **serpent of brass**, and set it upon the **pole**, and it came to pass, that if a **serpent** had bitten any man, when he looked unto the **serpent of brass**, he lived.

John 3:13,14 No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.

Solomon the Epitome of a Human King And the Biggest Failure

Deuteronomy 17:14 When thou art come unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, and shalt possess it, and shalt dwell therein, and shalt say, I will set a king over me, like as all the nations that are about me.

Deuteronomy 17:18 And it shall be, when he sits upon the throne of his kingdom, that <u>he shall write him a copy of this law in a book</u> out of that which is before the priests the Levites: And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: That he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them: **That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren,** and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: To the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.

Ezekiel 28:1-5 The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying, Son of man, say unto the prince of Tyrus, Thus saith the Lord GOD, **Because thine heart is lifted up**, and thou hast said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of God, in the midst of the seas, yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God: Behold, thou art wiser than Daniel, there is no secret that they can hide from thee: With thy wisdom and with thine understanding thou hast gotten thee riches, and hast gotten gold and silver into thy treasures: By thy great wisdom and by thy traffic hast thou increased thy riches, and thine heart is lifted up because of thy riches.

1 Samuel 8:7-21 And the LORD said to Samuel, Listen to the voice of the people in all that they say to you. For they have not rejected you, but **they have rejected Me**, that **I should not reign over them.** According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt

even until this day works with which they have forsaken Me and served other gods so they do also to you. And now listen to their voice. Only, you shall surely protest solemnly to them, and show them the kind of king who shall reign over them. And Samuel told all the words of the LORD to the people who asked a king of him. And he said, This will be the privilege of the king who shall reign over you. He shall take your sons and appoint them for himself, for his chariots, and his horsemen. And they shall run before his chariots. And he will appoint commanders over thousands, and commanders over fifties, and some to plow his ground and reap his harvest, and make his weapons of war and weapons for his chariots. And he will take your daughters to be perfumers and cooks and bakers. And he will take your fields and your vineyards and your olive-yards, the best, and give them to his servants. And he will take the tenth of your seed and of your vineyards, and give it to his eunuchs and to his servants. And he will take your male slaves and your slave girls, and your finest young men, and your asses, and put them to his work. He will take the tenth of your sheep, and you shall be his servants. And you shall cry out in that day because of your king whom you have chosen for yourselves, and the LORD will not answer you in that day. But the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel. And they said, No, but we will have a king over us. And we shall be, also we, like all the nations, so that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles. And Samuel heard all the words of the people, and he repeated them in the ears of the LORD.

Hosea 13:9-11 O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself, but in me is thine help. I will be thy king: Where is any other that may save thee in all thy cities? And thy judges of whom thou saidst, Give me a king and princes? I gave thee a king in mine anger, and took him away in my wrath.

2 Samuel 12:24,25 And **David** comforted Bathsheba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her: And she bare a son, and he called his name **Solomon: And the LORD loved him.** And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet, and he called his name **Jedidiah**, because of the LORD.

1 Chronicles 29:1 Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, is yet young and tender, and the work is great: For the palace is not for man, but for the LORD God.

1 Kings 3:7 And now, O LORD my God, thou hast made thy servant king instead of David my father: And I am but a little child: I know not how to go out or come in.

1 Kings 3:13,14And I have also given thee that which thou hast not asked, both <u>**riches, and honor:**</u> So that there shall not be any among the kings like unto thee all thy days. And <u>if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes</u> and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will <u>lengthen</u> thy days.

1 Kings **4:29-31** And God <u>gave Solomon wisdom</u> and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt. For he was wiser than all men, than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: And his <u>fame was in all nations round about.</u>

1 Kings 4:34 And there came of all people to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from <u>all kings of the earth</u>, which had heard of his wisdom.

1 Kings 9:22 But Solomon did not make any slave out of the sons of Israel. But they were men of war, and <u>his servants</u>, and <u>his rulers</u>, and <u>his</u> <u>commanders</u>, and <u>rulers of his chariots</u>, and <u>his horsemen</u>. These were the chief of the officers who were over <u>Solomon's work</u>.

1 Kings 12:9-11 And he said to them, What advice do you give that we may answer this people who have spoken to me, saying, Lighten the yoke which your father put on us? And the young men who had grown up with him spoke to him, saying, So shall you speak to this people who spoke to you, saying, <u>Your father made our yoke heavy</u>, but you make it lighter for us, so you shall say to them: My little finger shall be thicker than my father's loins. And now <u>my father loaded you with a heavy yoke</u>, and I will add to your yoke. <u>My father has whipped you with whips</u>, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

1 Chronicles 28:11-19 And David gave to his son Solomon the pattern of the porch, and of its houses, and of its treasuries, and of its upper rooms, and of its innermost rooms, and of the place of the mercy-seat, and the pattern of all that he had by the Spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the rooms all around the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the holy things, And for the divisions of the priests and the Levites, and for all the work of the service of the house of the LORD, and for all the vessels of service in the house of the LORD, even gold by weight for things of gold, for all instruments of every kind of service, silver for all the vessels of silver by weight, for all vessels every kind of service, and by weight for the lampstands of gold, and for their lamps of gold, with the weight of each lampstand and its lamps. And he gave for the lampstands of silver by weight, for the lampstand and for its lamps, according to the use of each lampstand, and by weight gold for the tables of the showbread, for every table, silver for the tables of silver, and pure gold for the flesh-hooks, and the bowls, and the cups, and for the golden basins by weight for each basin, and by weight for each basin of silver, and the altar of incense refined gold by weight, and gold

for the pattern of the chariot of the cherubs, who spread out their wings, and covered the ark of the covenant of the LORD. <u>All was in writing from the hand of the LORD.</u> He made me understand all the work of this pattern.

1 Chronicles 29:1-8,16,19 And David the king said to all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God has chosen, is young and tender, and the work is great. For the palace is not for man, but for the LORD God. And I have prepared with all my might for the house of my God the gold for things of gold, and the silver for things of silver, and the bronze for things of bronze, the iron for things of iron, and wood for things of wood, onyx stones, and stones to be set, and also stones of antimony, and stones of many colors, and every precious stone, and stones of alabaster, in abundance. And also, because I have delighted in the house of my God, out of my own treasure of gold and silver I have given to the house of my God over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house, three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses, the gold for things of gold, and the silver for things of silver, and for all kinds of work by the hands of skillful workers. And who is willing to consecrate his service this day to the LORD? And the chiefs of the fathers, and the rulers of the tribes of Israel, and the commanders of thousands and of hundreds, with the rulers of the king's work, offered willingly. And they gave for the service of the house of God five thousand talents of gold and ten thousand darics, and ten thousand talents of silver, and eighteen thousand talents of bronze, and one hundred thousand talents of iron. And he who had precious stones gave to the treasury of the house of the LORD by the hand of Jehiel the Gershonite.

16 O LORD our God, <u>all this store that we have prepared to build You a</u> house for Your holy name comes from Your hand, and is all Your own.

19 And give to Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep Your commandments, Your testimonies, and Your statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the magnificent house <u>for which I have made ready</u>.

1 Kings 6:1 And it happened in the four hundred and eightieth year after the sons of Israel had come out of the land of Egypt, <u>in the fourth year of Solomon's reign</u> over Israel, in the month Zif, which is the <u>second month</u>, <u>he began to build the house of the LORD</u>.

1 Kings 6:37,38 In the fourth year, in the month Zif, the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. And in the eleventh year, in the month Bul, which is the eighth month, the house was finished as to all its parts, and as to all its plans. So he was seven years in building it.

1 Kings 7:1 And Solomon was thirteen years building his own house. And he finished all his house.

1 Kings 7:8b Solomon made also an house for Pharaoh's daughter, whom he had taken to wife.

Psalm 127:1 A Song of degrees <u>for Solomon</u>. Unless <u>the LORD builds the</u> <u>house</u>, they **labor in vain** who build it, unless the LORD keeps the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.

1 Kings 8:13 I have surely built thee an house to dwell in, a settled place for thee to abide in forever.


1 Kings 8:20 The LORD hath performed his word that he spoke, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and **have built an house for the name of the LORD God of Israel.**

1 Kings 8:44 If thy people go out to battle against their enemy, whithersoever thou shalt send them, and shall pray unto the LORD toward the city which thou hast chosen, and toward **the house that I have built for thy name.**

1 Kings 8:48 And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gave unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name.

Ecclesiastes 2:11 Then I looked on all the works that my hands had done, and on the labor that I had labored to do, and, behold, all is vanity and vexation of spirit, and there is no profit under the sun.

Ecclesiastes 2:17-19 Therefore I hated life, because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: For all is vanity and vexation of spirit. Yea, I hated all my labor which I had taken under the sun: Because I should leave it unto the man that shall be after me. And who know whether he shall be a wise man or a fool? Yet shall he have rule over all my labor wherein I have labored, and wherein I have shewed myself wise under the sun. This is also vanity.
