TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 1:1a These are the words which Moses spoke unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness,

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue.

Psalm 34:12,13 Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit.

Ephesians 4:29,31 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all **malice**.

Deuteronomy 1:34,35 And the Lord <u>heard the voice of your words</u>, and was wroth, and swore, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I swore to give unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 1:2,3 (There are eleven days' journey from Horeb by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.) And it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spake unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the Lord had given him in commandment unto them.

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed unto yourselves, <u>lest ye forget</u> the covenant of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of anything, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.

Deuteronomy 4:9-13 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: But teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons, Especially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children. And ye came near and stood under the mountain, and the mountain burned with fire unto the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness. And the LORD spake unto you out of the midst of the fire: Ye heard the voice of the words, but saw no similitude, only ye heard a voice. And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, even ten commandments, and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.

Deuteronomy 5:15 And **remember that you were a servant** in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: Therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

Deuteronomy 7:17-19 If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations are more than I, how can I dispossess them? Thou shalt <u>not be afraid of them</u>: But shalt well <u>remember</u> what the LORD thy God did unto **Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt,** The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: So shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.

Deuteronomy 8:2 And thou shalt <u>remember</u> all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember, and forget not, how thou provoke the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: From the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

Deuteronomy 24:9 Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 32:7-8 Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: Ask thy father, and he will shew thee, thy elders, and they will tell thee. When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 32:6 Is this your answer to the Lord, O foolish people and unwise? Is he not **your Father** who has given you life? He has made you and given you your place.

Deuteronomy 7:6-9 For you are an holy people unto the LORD your God: The LORD your God hath chosen you to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people, for ye were the fewest of all people: But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations.

Deuteronomy 1:22,23 And **you** came near to me every one of you, and said, We will send men before us, and they shall search us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: And I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye murmured in your tents, and said, <u>Because</u> <u>the Lord hated us</u>, he hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.

Matthew 25:24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew you that you are an hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not strewed.

Deuteronomy 1:29,30 Then I said unto you, Dread not, neither be afraid of them. The Lord your God which goes before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes.

Deuteronomy 1:31 And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the Lord thy God bare thee, as <u>a man doth bear his son</u>, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place. Yet in this thing ye did not believe the Lord your God.

Deuteronomy 1:32-35 Yet in this thing **you did not believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to show you by what way you should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard **the <u>voice</u> of your words**, and was wroth, and sware, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this **evil generation** see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers,

Deuteronomy 1:39 Moreover **your little ones, that ye said should be a prey,** and your children, that this day have no knowledge of good or evil, they shall go in thither, and unto them will I give it, and they shall possess it.

Deuteronomy 1:45 And ye returned and wept before the Lord, but the Lord would not hearken to your voice, nor give ear unto you.

Deuteronomy 2:4,5 And command thou the people, saying, Ye are to pass through the coast of your brethren the **children of Esau**, which dwell in Seir, and they shall be afraid of you: Take ye good heed unto yourselves therefore: **Meddle not with them**, for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth, because I have given mount Seir unto Esau for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:9 And the Lord said unto me, **Distress not** the **Moabites**, neither contend with them in battle: For I will not give thee of their land for a possession, because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:19 And when thou comest nigh over against the children of **Ammon**, **distress them not**, nor meddle with them: For I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon any possession, because I have given it unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:10 The Emims dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims, but the Moabites call them Emims.

Deuteronomy 2:12 The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime, but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead, as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the Lord gave unto them.

Deuteronomy 2:20 (That also was accounted a land of giants: Giants dwelt therein in old time, and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims, A people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, but the Lord destroyed them before them, and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead.

Isaiah 1:1-4 The <u>vision</u> of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah. Hear, heavens, and listen, earth, for the LORD has spoken: I have nourished and brought up children, and **they have rebelled against me**. The ox knows his owner, and the donkey his master's crib, but Israel doesn't know, my people don't consider. Ah sinful nation, a people loaded with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children who deal corruptly! They have forsaken the LORD. They have despised the Holy One of Israel. They are estranged and backward.

Solomon the Epitome of a Human King And the Biggest Failure

Deuteronomy 17:16 a king shall **not multiply horses for himself**, nor cause the people to **return to Egypt to multiply horses**, for the LORD has said to you, 'You shall not return that way again.

- 1 Kings 4:26 Solomon had forty thousand stalls of horses for his chariots and twelve thousand horsemen.
- **1 Kings 10:26** And Solomon gathered together chariots and horsemen: And he had a **thousand and four hundred chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen**, whom he bestowed in the cities for chariots, and with the king at Jerusalem.
- 1 Kings 10:29 And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred shekels of silver, and a horse for an hundred and fifty: And so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring them out by their means.

Deuteronomy 17:18 Also it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, that <u>he shall write for himself a copy of this law in a book</u>, from the one before the priests, the Levites.

Deuteronomy 17:19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God and be careful to observe all the words of this law and these statutes, that his heart may not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right hand or to the left, and that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel.

Deuteronomy 31:9-13 And Moses wrote this law, and delivered it unto the priests the sons of Levi, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and unto all the elders of Israel. And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and thy stranger that is within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law: And that their children, which have not known anything, may hear, and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as ye live in the land whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.

Matthew 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one <u>jot</u> or one <u>tittle</u> shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Deuteronomy 17:17 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away.

1 Kings 11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods.

2 Corinthians 3:6-11 Who also has made us able ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter, but of the spirit: For the letter kills, but the spirit gives life. But if the ministration of death, written and engraved in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not steadfastly behold the face of Moses for the glow of his countenance, which glory was not to be standing forever: How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious? For if the ministration of judgment be glorious, much more does the ministry of righteousness exceed in glory. For how is the glory of the first ministry compared to the value of the weightier ministry? For if that which is short lived was glorious, much more that which is eternal is glorious.

2 Corinthians 3:12-18 Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech: And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not steadfastly look to the end of that which is **finite**: But their minds were blinded: For until this day the same vail remains un-taken away in the reading of the old **covenant**, which vail is done away in **the Messiah**. But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart. Nevertheless, when **Israel** shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away. Now the Lord is that Spirit: And where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we



all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
