**TORAH PORTION**

**Deuteronomy 11:26-29 Behold,** I set before you this day a **blessing and a curse**: The blessing, if you shall listen to the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day, and the curse, if you shall not listen to the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which you have not known. It shall happen, when the LORD your God shall bring you into the land where you go to possess it, that you shall set the blessing on Mount Gerizim, and the curse on Mount Ebal.

**Joshua 8:30** Then **Joshua built an altar** unto the LORD God of Israel in Mount Ebal.

**Deuteronomy 11:30** Aren't they beyond the Jordan, behind the way of the going down of the sun, in the land of the Canaanites who dwell in the Arabah, over against Gilgal, beside the **oaks of Moreh**?

**Genesis 12:5-7** Abram took Sarai his wife, Lot his brother's son, all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls whom they had gotten in Haran, and they went to go into the land of Canaan. Into the land of Canaan they came. Abram passed through the land to the place of Shechem, **to the oak of Moreh**. The Canaanite was then in the land. The LORD appeared to Abram and said, I will give this land to your seed. He built an altar there to the LORD, who appeared to him. We're going there!

**Deuteronomy 12:2,3** You shall utterly destroy all the places, wherein the nations which you shall possess served their gods, on the high mountains, and on the hills, and under every green tree: And you shall overthrow their altars, and break their pillars, and burn their groves with fire; and you shall hew down the graven images of their gods, and destroy the names of them out of that place.

**Deuteronomy 12:5** But unto **the place** which the **LORD your God shall choose** out of all your tribes to put his name there, even unto his habitation shall ye seek, and thither thou shalt come.

**Deuteronomy 12:8** You shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatever is right in his own eyes.

**Deuteronomy 13:18** When you shall listen to the voice of the LORD your God, to keep all his commandments which I command you this day, to do that which is right in the eyes of the LORD your God.

**Judges 21:25** In those days there was no king in Israel: Every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

**Deuteronomy 12:10,11** But when you go over the Jordan and live in the land that the LORD your God is giving you to inherit, and when he gives you rest from all your enemies around, so that you live in safety, then **to the place that the LORD your God will choose**, to make his name dwell there, there you shall bring all that I command you: Your burnt offerings and your sacrifices, your tithes and the contribution that you present, and all your finest vow offerings that you vow to the LORD.

**Deuteronomy 12:5 in all places where I record my name** I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

**Genesis 22:2,3** And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah, and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto **the place** of which God had told him.

**Genesis 22:4** Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw **the place** afar off.

**Genesis 22:14** And Abraham called the name of **that place** Jehovah jireh יְהוָה יִרְאֵה as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be **seen**.

**Deuteronomy 12:28-32** Observe and hear all these words which I command you, that it may go well with you, and with your children after you forever, when you do that which is **good and right in the sight of the LORD your God**. When the LORD your God shall cut off the nations from before you, where you go to possess them, and you succeed them, and dwell in their land; Take heed to yourself that you be not snared by following them, after that they be destroyed from before you; and that you inquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? Even so will I do likewise. You shall not do so to the LORD your God: For every abomination to the LORD, which he hates, have they done to their gods, for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods. What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: Thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it.

**Deuteronomy 13:1-5** If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and **giveth thee a sign or a wonder, And the sign or the wonder come to pass**, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them, **Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet**, or that dreamer of dreams: For the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether **ye love the LORD your God** with all your heart and with all your soul. Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him. And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death, because he hath spoken to turn you away from the LORD your God,

**Acts 2:22** Ye men of Israel, hear these words, Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you **by miracles and wonders and signs**, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know.

**Matthew 24:24** For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew **great signs and wonders**, insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

**2 Thessalonians 2:8,9** And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan **with all power and signs and lying wonders**, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

**Deuteronomy 14:7,8** Nevertheless these ye shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the cloven hoof; as the camel, and **the hare**, and the coney: For they chew the cud, but divide not the hoof, therefore they are unclean unto you. And the swine, because it divideth the hoof, yet cheweth not the cud, it is unclean unto you: Ye shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcass.

**Deuteronomy 14:11-21** Of all clean birds ye shall eat. But these are they of which ye shall not eat: The eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray, And the glede, and the kite, and the vulture after his kind, And every raven after his kind, And the owl, and the night hawk, and the cuckow, and the hawk after his kind, The little owl, and the great owl, and the swan, And the pelican, and the gier eagle, and the cormorant, And the stork, and the heron after her kind, and the lapwing, and the bat. And every creeping thing that flieth is unclean unto you: They shall not be eaten. **But of all clean fowls ye may eat. Ye shall not eat of anything that dieth of itself: Thou shalt give it unto the stranger that is in thy gates, that he may eat it, or thou mayest sell it unto an**

**alien:** For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God. Thou shalt not see the a kid in his mother's milk.

**Leviticus 22:8** He shall not eat what dies of itself or is torn by beasts, and so make himself unclean by it: I am the LORD.

**Deuteronomy 15:1,2** At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release. And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth ought unto his neighbour shall release it, he shall not exact it of his neighbour, or of his brother; because it is called the LORD's release.

**Deuteronomy 15:7-9** If there be among you a poor man of one of your brothers within any of your gates in your land which the LORD your God gives you, you shall not harden your heart, nor shut your hand from your poor brother: But you shall open your hand wide to him, and shall surely lend him sufficient for his need, in that which he wants. Beware that there be not a thought in your wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand, and your eye be evil against your poor brother, and you give him nothing, and he cry to the LORD against you, and it be sin to you.

**Matthew 6:22-24** The light of the body is the eye: If therefore your eye be single, your whole body shall be full of light. But if your eye be evil, your whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you be darkness, how great is that darkness! No man can serve two masters: For either he will hate the one, and love the other, or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

**Proverbs 28:22** He that hastens to be rich has an evil eye, and considers not that poverty shall come on him.

**Proverbs 22:9** He that has a bountiful eye shall be blessed, for he gives of his bread to the poor.

**Deuteronomy 16:1-3** Observe the month of Abib, and keep the Passover unto the LORD thy God: For in the month of Abib the LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night. And you shall offer the Passover sacrifice to the Lord your God, from the flock or the herd, at the place that the Lord will choose, to make his name dwell there. You shall eat no leavened bread with it. Seven days you shall eat it with unleavened bread, the bread of affliction for you came out of the land of Egypt in haste that all the days of your life you may remember the day when you came out of the land of Egypt.

**Deuteronomy 16:15,16** Keep the feast to the Lord your God for seven days, in the place marked out by the Lord: Because the blessing of the Lord your God will be on all the produce of your land and all the work of your hands, and you will have nothing but joy. Three times in the year let all your males come before the Lord your God in the place named by him, at the feast of unleavened bread, the feast of weeks, and the feast of tents: And they are not to come before the Lord with nothing in their hand.;

## SONG OF SONGS A RETURN TO GOD AS OUR KING

**1 Peter 5:2-4** Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly, nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock, and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.

**Genesis 25:13** And these were the names of the sons of Ishmael, by their names, according to their generations: The firstborn of Ishmael, Nebajoth, then **Kedar**, Adbeel, Mibsam.

**Psalms 120:1-7** In my distress I cried to the LORD, And He heard me. Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips And from a deceitful tongue. What shall be given to you, Or what shall be done to you, You false tongue? Sharp arrows of the warrior,

With coals of the broom tree! Woe is me, that I dwell in Meshech, That **I dwell among the tents of Kedar!** My soul has dwelt too long **with one who hates peace.** I am for peace, But when I speak, they are for war.

**Isaiah 60:5-7** Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged, because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee. The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah, all they from Sheba shall come: They shall bring gold and incense, and they shall shew forth the praises of the LORD. **All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together unto thee,**

**Ezekiel 16:48-52** As I live, says the Lord GOD, neither your sister Sodom nor her daughters have done as you and your daughters have done. Look, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter **had pride, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. And they were haughty and committed abomination before Me,** therefore I took them away as I saw fit. Samaria did not commit half of your sins, but you have multiplied your abominations more than they, and **have justified your sisters by all the abominations which you have done.** You who judged your sisters, bear your own shame also, because the sins which you committed were more abominable than theirs, they are more righteous than you. Yes, be disgraced also, and bear your own shame, because you justified your sisters.

**Ezekiel 16:60-63** Nevertheless I will remember My covenant with you in the days of your youth, and I will establish an everlasting covenant with you. Then you will remember your ways and be ashamed, when you receive your older and your younger sisters, **for I will give them to you for daughters,** but not because of My covenant with you. And I will establish My covenant with you. Then you shall know that I am the LORD, that you may remember and be ashamed, and never open your



mouth anymore because of your shame, when I provide you an atonement for all you have done, says the Lord GOD.

*Shepherd*

**SOS 1:9-10** I have compared you, **O my love**, to a **company of horses** in Pharaoh's chariots. Your cheeks are comely with rows of jewels, **your neck with chains of gold**.

**Job 39:19-25** Have you given the horse strength? Have you clothed his neck with thunder? Can you frighten him like a locust? His majestic snorting strikes terror. He paws in the valley, and rejoices in his strength, He gallops into the clash of arms. He mocks at fear, and is not frightened, Nor does he turn back from the sword. The quiver rattles against him, The glittering spear and javelin. He devours the distance with fierceness and rage, Nor does he come to a halt because the trumpet has sounded. At the blast of the trumpet he says, Aha! He smells the battle from afar, The thunder of captains and shouting.

**Proverbs 1:9** My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and **forsake not the law** of thy mother: For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and **chains about thy neck**.

*DOJ speaking:*

**SOS 1:11** We will make you borders of gold with studs of silver.

**Exodus 30:7-9a** And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: When he dresses the lamps, he shall burn incense upon it. And when Aaron lights the lamps at even, he shall burn incense upon it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations. Ye shall offer no strange incense thereon.

**Exodus 30:23-25** And the Lord said to Moses, Take **the best spices, five hundred shekels' weight of liquid myrrh, and of sweet cinnamon** half as much, that is, two hundred and fifty shekels, and two hundred and fifty shekels of sweet calamus, And of cassia, five hundred shekels' weight measured by the

scale of the holy place, and of olive oil a hin: And make these into a holy oil, a perfume made by the art of the perfume-maker, it is to be a holy oil.

***Shulamite speaking back to the DOJ:***

**SOS 1:12-14** While the king was on **his** couch, **my** nard gave forth its fragrance. **My beloved** is to **me** a sachet **of myrrh** that lies between my breasts. **My beloved** is to **me** a **cluster of henna** blossoms **in the vineyards** of Engedi.

**Jeremiah 2:2** Go and cry in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, Thus saith the LORD, **I remember you**, the kindness of thy youth, **the love of thine espousals**, when **you went after me in the wilderness**, in a land that was not sown.

**Isaiah 5:1,2** Now will I sing to my well beloved a song of my beloved touching his vineyard. My well beloved hath a vineyard in a very fruitful hill: And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: And he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought forth wild grapes.

***Shepherd speaking:***

**SOS 1:15** Behold, you are beautiful, **my love**, behold, you are beautiful, **your eyes are as doves**.

***Shulamite speaking:***

**SOS 1:16,17** Behold, you are beautiful, **my beloved**, truly delightful. **Our bed** is green; the beams of **our house** are cedar, **our rafters** are fir.

**SOS 2:1** I am a **rose** of Sharon, a **lily** of the valleys.

**Hosea 14:1,4,5** O Israel, return to the LORD your God, For you have stumbled because of your iniquity, I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, For My anger has turned

away from him. I will be like the dew to Israel, he shall grow like the lily, And lengthen his roots like Lebanon.

*Shepherd speaking:*

**SOS 2:2** As **the lily among thorns**, so is **my love among the daughters.**

**Psalms 137:5,6** If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget her cunning. If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth, **if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy.**

*Shulamite responds:*

**SOS 2:3** As **an apple tree** among the trees of the forest, so is **my beloved** among the young men. With great delight **I sat down under his shadow, and his fruit was sweet to my taste.**

**Psalms 91:1** He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

**Psalms 34:8** Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good, Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!

**Psalms 119:103** How sweet are Your words to my taste, Sweeter than honey to my mouth!

**Hosea 14:8,9** Ephraim shall say, What have I to do anymore with idols? I have heard and observed him. I am like a green cypress tree, **Your fruit is found in Me.** Who is wise? Let him understand these things. Who is prudent? Let him know them. For the ways of the LORD are right, The righteous walk in them, But transgressors stumble in them.

**Galatians 5:22,23** But **the fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: Against such there is no law.

**SOS 2:4,5** He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love. Sustain me with flagons, comfort me with apples: For I am sick of love.

**Hosea 3:1-5** Then said the LORD unto me, Go yet, love a woman beloved of her friend, yet an adulteress, **according to the love of the LORD toward the children of Israel, who look to other gods, and love flagons of wine.** So I bought her to me for fifteen pieces of silver, and for an homer of barley, and an half homer of barley: And I said unto her, You shalt abide for me many days, you shall not play the harlot, and you shalt not be for another man: So will I also be for you. For the children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without a sacrifice, and without an image, and without an ephod, and without teraphim: **Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king, and shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days.**

**Exodus 21:32** If the ox gores a male or female servant, he shall give to their master **thirty shekels of silver,** and the ox shall be stoned.

*Shulamite continues:*

**SOS 2:6** His left hand is under my head, and his right hand embraces me!

**Psalms 121:4** Behold, He who keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

*Shepherd speaking:*

**SOS 2:7** I have adjured you, daughters of Jerusalem, By the roes or by the hinds of the field, Stir not up nor wake the love till she please!
