TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 21:10 When you go to war against your enemies.

Deuteronomy 21:15-17 *If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated, and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he makes his sons to inherit that which he has, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn: But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated for the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath for he is the beginning of his strength.*

Deuteronomy 22:1-3 You shall not see **your brother's ox** or his sheep go astray, and hide yourself from them: You shall in any case bring them again to your brother. And if **your brother be not near to you, or if you know him not**, then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall be with you until your brother seek after it, and you shall restore it to him again. In like manner shall you do **with his ass**, and **so shall you do with his raiment**, and **with all lost things** of your brother's, **which he has lost, and you have found**, shall you do likewise: you **may not hide yourself**.

Exodus 23:5 If you see **the ass** of him **that hates you** lying under his burden, and would forbear to help him, you **shall surely help** with him.

Deuteronomy 22:4 You shall not see **your brother's ass or his ox** fall down by the way, and **hide yourself** from them: you **shall surely help him** to lift them up again.

Deuteronomy 22:6,7 If a bird's nest chance to be before you in the way in any tree, or on the ground, whether they be young ones, or eggs, and the dam sitting on the young, or on the eggs, you shall not take the dam with the young: But you shall in any

wise let the dam go, and take the young to you, that it may be well with you, and **that you may prolong your days.**

Luke 13:34,35 Jerusalem, Jerusalem, that kills the prophets, and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, **like a hen gathers her own brood** under her wings, and you refused! Behold, your house is left to you desolate. I tell you, you will not see me, until you say, Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

Deuteronomy 22:8 When you build a new house, then **you shall** make a battlement for your roof, that you bring not blood on your house, if any man fall from there.

Deuteronomy 23:7,8 You shall **not abhor** an Edomite, **for he is your brother!** You shall **not abhor an Egyptian**, because you were a stranger in his land. The children that are begotten of them shall enter into the congregation of the LORD **in their third generation.**

Deuteronomy 23:21–23 When you shall vow a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not slack to pay it: For the LORD your God will surely require it of you, and it would be sin in you. But if you shall forbear to vow, it shall be no sin in you. **That which is gone out of your lips you shall keep and perform**, even a freewill offering, according as you have vowed to the LORD your God, which you have promised with your mouth.

Deuteronomy 23:24,25 When you come into your neighbor's vineyard, then you may eat grapes your fill at your own pleasure, but you shall not put any in your vessel. When you come into the standing corn of your neighbor, then you may pluck the ears with your hand, but you shall not move a sickle to your neighbor's standing corn.

Matthew 12:1,2 At that time, Yeshua went on the Sabbath day through the grain fields. His disciples were hungry and began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. But the Pharisees, when they saw

it, said to him, Behold, your disciples do what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath.

Deuteronomy 24:9 Remember what the LORD your God did to Miriam by the way, after that you were come forth out of Egypt.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: And they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Proverbs 15:2-4 The tongue of the wise uses knowledge aright: But the mouth of fools pours out foolishness. **The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.** A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: But perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

Deuteronomy 24:14,15 You shall not oppress an hired servant that is poor and needy, whether he be of your brothers, or of your strangers that are in your land within your gates: At his day you shall give him his hire, neither shall the sun go down on it, for he is poor, and sets his heart on it: Lest he cry against you to the LORD, and it be sin to you.

Deuteronomy 24:19-22 When you cut down your harvest in your field, and have forgot a sheaf in the field, you shall not go again to fetch it: It shall be for the **stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow:** That the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands. When you beat your olive tree, you shall not go over the boughs again: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow. When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, you shall not glean it afterward: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow. And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt: Therefore I command you to do this thing.

Deuteronomy 25:4 You shall **not muzzle the ox** when he treads out the corn.

1 Timothy 5:17,18 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially they who labor in the word and doctrine. For the scripture said, You shall **not muzzle the ox that treads out the corn**. And, The laborer is worthy of his reward.

Deuteronomy 25:15,16 You shall have a **perfect and just weight**, a perfect and just measure, **that your days may be lengthened** in the land which the LORD your God is giving you. For all who do such things, all who behave unrighteously, are an abomination to the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 25:17-19 Remember what Amalek did to you by the way, when you were come forth out of Egypt, How he met you by the way, and smote the hindmost of you, even all that were feeble behind you, when you were faint and weary, and he feared not God. Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from all your enemies round about, in the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance to possess it, that you shall blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven, you shall not forget it.

Isaiah 54:1-3 Sing, O barren, you that did not bear, break forth into singing, and cry aloud, you that did not travail with child: For more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, said the LORD. Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of your habitations: Spare not, lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes, For you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left; And your seed **shall inherit the Gentiles**, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

Isaiah 54:5-7 For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name, and your Redeemer the Holy One **of Israel**, The God of the whole earth shall he be called. For the LORD has called you as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when you were refused, said your God. For a small

moment have I forsaken you, but **with great mercies will I gather you.**

Isaiah 54:8-10 In a little wrath I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on you, said the LORD your Redeemer. For this is **as the waters of Noah** to me: For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed, but my kindness shall not depart from you, **neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, said the LORD that has mercy on you.**

Malachi 3:7 Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. **Return unto me, and I will return unto you,** saith the LORD of hosts.

Matthew 24:27,28 For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

Matthew 24:7 For **nation shall rise against nation,** and kingdom against kingdom: And there shall be famines, and pestilences, and **earthquakes,** in divers places.

Matthew 24:32-34 Now learn a parable of the fig tree, When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.**

Shepherd Speaks:

SOS 4:8 Come with me **from Lebanon, my spouse**, with me **from Lebanon**: look from the top of Amana, from the top of Shenir and **Hermon, from the lions' dens, from the mountains of the leopards.**

Hosea 1:2 The beginning of the word of the LORD by Hosea. And the LORD said to Hosea, Go, take unto thee a wife of whoredoms and children of whoredoms: For the land hath committed great whoredom, departing from the LORD.

Hosea 13:6-11 According to their pasture, so were they filled, **they were filled, and their heart was exalted, therefore have they forgotten me. Therefore I will be unto them as a lion:** **As a leopard by the way will I observe them:** I will meet them as a bear that is bereaved of her whelps, and will rend the caul

of their heart, and there **will I devour them like a lion: The wild beast shall tear them.** O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself, but in me is thine help. **I will be thy king:** where is any other that may save thee in all thy cities? And thy judges of whom thou saidst, **Give me a king and princes? I gave thee a king in mine anger, and took him away in my wrath.**

Shepherd Speaks:

SOS 4:9-11 You have captivated my heart, my sister, my bride, you have captivated my heart with one glance of your eyes, with one jewel of your necklace. How beautiful is your love, my sister, my bride! How much better is your love than wine, and the fragrance of your oils than any spice! Your lips drip nectar, my bride, **honey and milk** are under your tongue, the fragrance of your garments is like the fragrance of Lebanon.

Deuteronomy 31:20-22 For when I have brought them into the land **flowing with milk and honey**, which I swore to give to their fathers, and they have eaten and are full and grown fat, they will turn to other gods and serve them, and despise me and break my covenant. And when many evils and troubles have come upon them, this song shall confront them as a witness (for it will live unforgotten in the mouths of their offspring). For I know what they are inclined to do even today, before I have brought them into the land that I swore to give. So Moses wrote this song the same day and taught it to the people of Israel.

Jeremiah 32:22,23 And you gave them this land, which you swore to their fathers to give them, a land **flowing with milk and honey.** And they entered and took possession of it. But they did not obey your voice or walk in your law. They did nothing of all you commanded them to do. Therefore you have made all this disaster come upon them.

SOS 4:12 A **garden enclosed** is my sister, my spouse, **a spring shut up, a fountain sealed.**

Shepherd Speaks: SOS 4:13-15 Thy plants are an orchard of pomegranates, with pleasant fruits, camphire, with spikenard, Spikenard and saffron, calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense, myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices: A fountain of gardens, **a well of living waters**, and streams from Lebanon.

Shulamite responds:

SOS 4:16 Awake, O north wind, and come, thou south, blow upon **my garden**, that the spices thereof may flow out. Let **my beloved** come into **his garden** and eat his pleasant fruits.

Shepherd responds:

SOS 5:1a I am come into **my garden, my sister, my spouse**: I have gathered **my myrrh** with **my spice**, I have eaten **my honeycomb** with **my honey**, I have drunk **my wine** with **my milk**.

Shulamite responds:

SOS 5:1b eat, O friends, drink, yea, drink abundantly, **O beloved**.

SOS 5:2a I **sleep**, but my heart waketh, Hark! my beloved **knocketh**.

Daniel 12:2 And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake,

1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: And the dead in Christ shall rise first.

Judges 19:22 As they were enjoying themselves, suddenly certain men of the city, perverted men, surrounded the house and beat on the door.
