Deuteronomy 26:1,2 And it shall be, when you come into the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance, and possess it, and live in it, you shall take of the first of all the fruit of the earth which you shall bring of your land that the **LORD your God gives you,** and you shall put it in a basket, and shall go to the place which the **LORD your God shall choose to place His name** there.

Deuteronomy 26:3,4 And thou shalt go unto the priest that shall be in those days, and say unto him, **I profess** this day unto the LORD thy God, that **I am come** unto the country which the LORD swore unto our fathers for to give us. And the priest shall take the basket out of thine hand, and set it down before the altar of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 26:10 And now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits ראשית of the land,

In the beginning

John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except **a grain** of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the **firstfruits** of them that slept.

Leviticus 23:10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest.

Psalm 30:1 I will extol thee, O LORD, for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

Psalm 30:3 O LORD, you have brought up my soul from the grave: You have kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

Deuteronomy 26:8-11 And the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terribleness, and with signs, and with wonders: And he hath brought us into this place, and hath given us **this land**, even a land that floweth with milk and honey. And now, behold, I have brought the *firstfruits* of the land, which thou, O LORD, hast given me. And thou shalt set it before the LORD thy God, and worship before the LORD thy God: And thou shalt rejoice in every good thing which the LORD thy God hath given unto thee, and unto thine house, thou, and the Levite, and the stranger that is among you.

Deuteronomy 26:16-19 Today the LORD your God has commanded you to do these statutes and judgments. You therefore shall keep and do them with all your heart and with all your soul. You have today said that the LORD is your God, and that you would **walk in His ways**, and keep His statutes and His commandments and His judgments, and listen to His voice. And the LORD has taken you today to be His peculiar people, as He has promised you, and to keep all His commandments, and to make you high above all nations which he has made, in praise and in name and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the LORD your God, even as He has spoken.

Deuteronomy 27:9,10 And Moses and the priests the Levites spoke to all Israel, saying: Take heed and listen, O Israel. **Today** you have become the people of the LORD your God. You shall therefore obey the voice of the LORD your God, and do His commandments and His statutes which I command you **today**.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these **blessings** shall come on thee, **and overtake thee**, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

Deuteronomy 28:8,9 The Lord shall **command the blessing** upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto, and he shall **bless** thee in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. The Lord shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the Lord thy God, and walk in his ways.

Deuteronomy 28:13 And the Lord shall **make thee the head, and not the tail**; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath, if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the Lord thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them.

Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, **if thou wilt not hearken** unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day, that **all these curses shall come upon thee**, and overtake thee.

Deuteronomy 28:45-47 All these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and **overtake you** till you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your offspring forever. **Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, because of the abundance of all things.**

Deuteronomy 27:25,26 Cursed be he that **taketh reward to slay an innocent person.** And all the people shall say, Amen. **Cursed be he that confirmeth not all the words of this law to do them. And all the people shall say, Amen.**

Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: For it is written, **Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.**

Deuteronomy 27:19-24 Cursed be he that perverteth the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his father's wife, because he uncovereth his father's skirt. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with any manner of beast. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his sister, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his mother in law. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that smiteth his neighbour secretly. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Deuteronomy 29:19,20 And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst: The Lord will not spare him, but then the anger of the Lord and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the Lord shall blot out his name from under heaven.

Galatians 3:11 But that **no man is justified by the law** in the sight of God, it is evident: For, **The just shall live by faith.**

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: But the just shall live by his faith.

Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness.

Matthew 27:45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.

Matthew 27:51-53 And, behold, **the veil of the temple was rent in twain** from the top to the bottom, and the **earth did quake, and the rocks rent**, And the **graves were opened**, and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

Amos 8:9,10 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down **at noon**, and I will darken the earth in the clear day: And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation, and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head, and I will make it as the mourning of an only son, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

Isaiah 60:1-3 Arise, shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: But the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

Isaiah 60:5 Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged, because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

Isaiah 60:11,12 Therefore thy gates shall be open continually, they shall not be shut day nor night, that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought. **For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish, Yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.**

Isaiah 60:14 The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come **bending unto thee**, and all they that despised thee shall **bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet**, and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

Song 5:3 I have taken off my robe. Indeed, must I put it on? I have washed my feet. Indeed, must I soil them?

Song 5:4-6 My beloved thrust his hand in through the latch opening. My heart pounded for him. I arose to open for my beloved, And my hands dripped with myrrh, My fingers with liquid myrrh, On **the handles of the lock**. I opened for my beloved, But my beloved had turned away and was gone. My heart leaped up when he spoke. I sought him, but I could not find him, I called him, but he gave me no answer.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: If any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

Luke 12:35,36 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning, And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding, that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately.

Psalms 32:5,6a I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the Lord, and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah. For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee **in a time when thou mayest be found.**

Proverbs 1:24-31 Because I have called, and ye refused, I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded, But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof: I also will laugh at your calamity, I will mock when your fear cometh,

When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind, when distress and anguish cometh upon you. Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer, they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me: For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the Lord: They would none of my counsel: They despised all my reproof. Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices.

Zechariah 7:8-14a And the word of the Lord came unto Zechariah, saying, Thus speaketh the Lord of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother: And oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor, and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart. But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear. Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the Lord of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: Therefore came a great wrath from the Lord of hosts. Therefore it is come to pass, that as he cried, and they would not hear, so they cried, and I would not hear, saith the Lord of hosts: But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not.

Song 5:7,8 The watchmen who went about the city found me. They struck me, they wounded me, The keepers of the walls took my veil away from me. I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, If you find **my beloved**, That you tell him I am lovesick!

Isaiah 56:10-12 His **watchmen are blind, They are all ignorant, They are all dumb dogs, They cannot bark, Sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber.** Yes, they are greedy dogs which never have enough. And they are **shepherds who cannot understand, they all look to their own way, everyone for his own gain,** From his own territory. Come, one says, I will bring wine, and we will fill ourselves with intoxicating drink, Tomorrow will be as today, And much more abundant.

Song 5:9 What is your beloved More than another beloved, O fairest among women? **What is your beloved More than another beloved**, that you so charge us?

Song 5:10-16 My beloved is white and ruddy, Chief among ten thousand. His head is like the finest gold, His locks are wavy, And black as a raven. His eyes are like doves By the rivers of waters, Washed with milk, And fitly set. His cheeks are like a bed of spices, Banks of scented herbs. His lips are lilies, Dripping liquid myrrh. His hands are rods of gold Set with beryl. His body is carved ivory Inlaid with sapphires. His legs are pillars of marble Set on bases of fine gold. His countenance is like Lebanon, Excellent as the cedars. His mouth is most sweet, Yes, he is altogether lovely. This is **my beloved**, And this is **my friend**, O daughters of Jerusalem!

Wow, how powerful! Now she's talking. Even declaring him as her friend.

James 2:23 And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, **Abraham believed** God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” And he was called the friend of God.

John 15:14,15 You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. “No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing, but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

Song 6:1 Where has your beloved gone, O fairest among women? Where has your beloved turned aside, **That we may seek him with you?**

Romans 11:15 For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead.

Zechariah 8:20-23 So says the LORD of hosts: There yet shall be peoples and inhabitants of many cities, and the residents of

one shall go to another, saying, Let us go at once to seek favor of the face of the LORD, and to seek the LORD of hosts, I will go also. And many peoples and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem and to seek the favor of the face of the LORD. Surely you shall call a nation you do not know, **And nations who do not know you shall run to you, Because of the LORD your God,** And the Holy One of Israel, For He has glorified you. Seek the LORD while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts, Let him return to the LORD, And He will have mercy on him, And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.

Matthew 23:38,39 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate. For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Hosea 5:14-6:3 For I will be like a lion to Ephraim, And like a young lion to the house of Judah. I, even I, will tear them and go away, I will take them away, and no one shall rescue. **I will return again to My place** till they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My face, In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me. Come, and let us return to the LORD, For He has torn, but He will heal us, He has stricken, but He will bind

us up. After two days He will revive us, On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight. Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning, He will come to us like the rain, like the latter and former rain to the earth.
