TORAH PORTION

Exodus 7:7 And Moses was **fourscore years old**, and Aaron fourscore and three years old, when they spake unto Pharaoh.

Deuteronomy 1:3 And it came to pass in the **fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month**, that Moses spake unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the LORD had given him in commandment unto them.

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 **And Moses went** and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, **I am an hundred and twenty years old this day**.

What day was this? Adar 7 Mar 7th 2025

Deuteronomy 34:7 And Moses was an **hundred and twenty years old when he died**: His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab **thirty days**: So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:10,11 Then Joshua commanded the officers of the people, saying, Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals, for within **three days ye shall pass over this Jordan**, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God giveth you to possess it.

Joshua 4:19 And the people came up out of Jordan on the **tenth day of the first month**, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Deuteronomy 29:10-15 You stand *today*, all of you, before the LORD your God, your captains of your tribes, your elders, and your officers, all the men of Israel, your little ones, your wives, and your **stranger** that is in your camp, from the cutter of your wood to the drawer of your water, so that **you should enter into covenant** with the LORD your God, and into His oath, which the LORD your God makes you **today**, that He may establish you

today for a people to Himself, and that He may be a God to you, as He has said to you, and as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. **Nor do I make this covenant and this oath with you only, but with him who stands here with us today** before the LORD our God, **and also with him that is not here with us today.**

Deuteronomy 29:19 And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst.

Deuteronomy 29:20,21 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law.

Deuteronomy 29:24-28 Even all nations shall say, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this land? What meaneth the heat of this great anger? Then men shall say, Because **they have forsaken the covenant** of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt: For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, gods whom they knew not, and whom he had not given unto them: And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book: And the LORD **rooted them** out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and **cast them** into another land, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 29:29 **The secret things** belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong **unto us and to our children forever**, that we may **do all the words of this law.**

Deuteronomy 30:1 And it shall be when all these things have come on you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and when you shall call them to mind לִבָּב among all the nations where the LORD your God has driven you.

Deuteronomy 30:2 and shall return שׁוּב to the LORD your God and shall obey His voice according to all that I command you today, you and your sons, with all your heart, and with all your soul.

Deuteronomy 30:3,4 Then the LORD your God will turn שׁוּב your captivity. And He will have compassion on you, and will return שׁוּב and gather you from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you. If you are driven out into the outermost parts of the heavens, the LORD your God will gather you from there, and He will bring you from there.

Deuteronomy 30:5 And the LORD your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. And He will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers.

Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD your God **will circumcise your heart and the heart** of your seed, to love the LORD your God with **all your heart and with all your soul**, so that you may live.

Deuteronomy 30:7-10 And the LORD your God will **put all these curses on your foes and enemies who persecuted you.** And you shall again obey the voice of the LORD and keep all his commandments that I command you today. The LORD your God will make you abundantly prosperous in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your womb and in the fruit of your cattle and in the fruit of your ground. For the LORD will again take delight in prospering you, as he took delight in your fathers, when you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that are written in this Book of the Law, when **you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.**

Deuteronomy 30:11-16 For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. It is not in heaven, that you should say, Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it. See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil. If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Deuteronomy 30:19,20 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live, loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

Deuteronomy 31:6-8 Be strong and of good courage, fear not, nor be affrighted at them, for the LORD thy God, He it is that doth go with thee, He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. And Moses called unto Joshua, and said unto him in the sight of all Israel: **Be strong and of good courage**, for thou shalt go with this people into the land which the LORD hath sworn unto their fathers to give them, and thou shalt cause them to inherit it. And the LORD, He it is that doth go before thee, He will be with thee, He will not fail thee, neither forsake thee, fear not, neither be dismayed.

Deuteronomy 31:10-12 And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD your God **in the place which he**

shall choose, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the people together, men and women, and children, **and your stranger** that is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and **to do all the words of this law**.

Deuteronomy 31:17-19 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and **I will hide** my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall come on them, so that they will say in that day, Haven't these evils come on us because our God is not **among us**? **I will surely hide** my face in that day for all the evil which they shall have worked, in that they are turned to other gods. **Now therefore write this song for yourselves**, and teach it to the children of Israel: Put it in their mouths, **that this song may be a witness for me** against the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 31:20-23 For when **I have brought them into the land** flowing with milk and honey, which I swore to give to their fathers, and **they have eaten and are full and grown fat**, they will turn to other gods and serve them, and despise me and break my covenant. And when *many evils and troubles have come upon them*, this song shall confront them as a witness (for it will live unforgotten in the mouths of their offspring). **For I know what they are inclined to do even today, before I have brought them into the land that I swore to give**. So Moses wrote this song the same day and taught it to the people of Israel. And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said: **Be strong and of good courage**, for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I swore unto them, and I will be with thee.

Deuteronomy 31:28-30 Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to record against them. **For I know that after my death** you will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you, and evil will befall you in the latter days, because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands. And **Moses spoke in the ears of all the**

congregation of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended

Isaiah 61:4,5 And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations. **And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.**

Isaiah 61:8,9 For I the Lord love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering, and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. And **their seed shall be known among the Gentiles**, and their offspring among the people: All that see them shall acknowledge them, that **they are the seed** which the Lord hath blessed.

Isaiah 62:10-12 Go through, Go through the gates! Prepare the way for the people, Build up, Build up the highway! Take out the stones, Lift up a banner for the peoples! Indeed the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world: Say to the daughter of Zion, Surely your **salvation**(Yeshua) **is coming**, **Behold, His reward is with Him, And His work before Him.** And they shall call them The Holy People, The Redeemed of the LORD, And you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.

Revelation 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly, and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am the Aleph and the Tav, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

SOS 6:1 Whither is thy beloved gone, O thou fairest among women? whither is thy beloved turned aside? That we may seek him with thee.

Song 6:2,3 My beloved has gone to **his garden**, To the beds of spices, To **feed his flock** in the gardens, And **to gather lilies.** **I**

am my beloved's, And my beloved is mine. He feeds his flock among the lilies.

Psalms 126:6 He who continually goes forth weeping, Bearing seed for sowing, Shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, **Bringing his sheaves with him.**

Song 2:16 My beloved is mine, and I am his. He feeds his flock among the lilies.

Song 6:4-9 O my love, you are as beautiful as **Tirzah**, Lovely as Jerusalem, Awesome as **an army with banners!** Turn your eyes away from me, For they have overcome me. Your hair is like a flock of goats Going down from Gilead. Your teeth are like a flock of sheep which have come up from the washing, Everyone bears twins, And none is barren among them. Like a piece of pomegranate are your temples behind your veil. **There are sixty queens and eighty concubines, and virgins without number. My dove, my perfect one, is the only one, the only one of her mother.** The favorite of the one who bore her. The daughters saw her and called her blessed, The queens and the concubines, And they praised her.

Psalms 87:5,6 And of Zion it shall be said, This and that man was born in her: And the highest himself shall establish her. The LORD shall count, when he writeth up the people, that this man was born there. Selah.

Numbers 27:1-5 Then came the **daughters of Zelophehad**, the son of Hopher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of Manasseh the son of Joseph: And these are the names of his daughters, Mahlah, Noah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and **Tirzah**. And they stood before Moses, and before Eleazar the priest, and before the princes and all the congregation, by the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, saying, Our father died in the wilderness, and he was not in the company of them that gathered themselves together against the LORD in the company of Korah, but died in his own sin, and

had no sons. Why should the name of our father be done away from among his family, because he hath no son? Give unto us therefore a possession among the brethren of our father. And Moses brought their cause before the LORD.

1 Kings 15:33 In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all **Israel in Tirzah**, twenty and four years.

Psalms 137:5,6 If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget her cunning. If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth, if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy.

Genesis 22:2 And He said: Take **now thy son, thine only son, whom thou lovest**, even Isaac, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt-offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

Song 6:10 Who is she who looks forth as the morning, Fair as the moon, Clear as the sun, **Awesome as an army with banners?**

Isaiah 13:1-8 The burden against Babylon which Isaiah the son of Amoz saw. **Lift up a banner on the high mountain**, Raise your voice to them, Wave your hand, that they may enter the gates of the nobles. I have commanded My sanctified ones, I have also called My mighty ones for My anger-Those who rejoice in My exaltation. The noise of a multitude in the mountains, Like that of many people! A tumultuous noise of the kingdoms of nations gathered together! The LORD of hosts musters The army for battle. They come from a far country, From the end of heaven-The LORD and His weapons of indignation, To destroy the whole land. Wail, for the day of the LORD is at hand! It will come as destruction from the Almighty. Therefore all hands will be limp, Every man's heart will melt, And they will be afraid. Pangs and sorrows will take hold of them, They will be in pain as a woman in childbirth; They will be amazed at one another, Their faces will be like flames.

Isaiah 13:9-11 Behold, **the day of the LORD cometh**, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. For **the stars of heaven** and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: **The sun shall be darkened** in his going forth, and **the moon** shall not cause her light to shine. And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity, and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and will lay low the haughtiness of the terrible.

Genesis 1:2,3 And the earth was without form, and void, and **darkness** was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God **said**, Let there be **light**: And there was light.

Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let there be **lights in the firmament** of the heaven to **divide the day from the night, and let them be for signs**, and for seasons, and for days, and years.

Genesis 15:5 And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and **count the stars**, if you be able to number them: And he said unto him, **So shall your seed be**.

Daniel 12:3,4 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament, and they that turn many to righteousness **as the stars** for ever and ever. But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and **seal the book, even to the time of the end: Many shall run** to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Isaiah 60:1-3 Arise, shine, for **thy light** is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen **upon thee**. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: But the LORD shall arise **upon thee**, and his glory shall be seen **upon thee**. And the Gentiles shall come to **thy light**, and kings to the brightness of **thy rising**.

Genesis 15:12-16 And when **the sun** was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram, and, lo, an horror of great darkness fell

upon him. And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that **thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs**, and shall serve them, and they shall afflict them **four hundred years**, And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: And afterward shall they come out with great substance. And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace, thou shalt be buried in a good old age. But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: For the **iniquity of the Amorites** is not yet full.

Numbers 10:13,14 And they took their first journey, according to the commandment of the LORD by the hand of Moses. And in the first place the standard of the camp of the children of Judah set forward according to their hosts, and over his host was Nahshon the son of Amminadab.
