TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 31:30 And Moses spoke <u>in the ears of all the congregation of Israel</u> the words of this <u>song</u>, until they were ended.

Deuteronomy 32:1 Give ear, O you heavens, and I will speak, and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

Deuteronomy 32:3,4 Because I will publish the name of the LORD: <u>Ascribe you greatness</u> to our God. <u>He is the Rock, his work is perfect</u>: For all his ways are <u>judgment</u>: A <u>God of truth and without iniquity</u>, <u>just and right</u> is he.

Revelation 15:3,4 And they <u>sing the song of Moses</u> the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, <u>Great and marvelous</u> are <u>your works</u>, Lord God Almighty, <u>just and true</u> are your ways, you King of saints. Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and **glorify** your name? For you only are holy: For all nations shall come and worship before you, for **your judgments** are made manifest.

Revelations 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

Psalm 19:1-4 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

Psalm 148:3-5 Praise ye Him, **sun and moon**, praise Him, **all ye stars** of light. Praise Him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that are above the heavens. Let them praise the name of the LORD, for He commanded, and they were created.

Revelation 5:11-13 And I beheld, and I heard the **voice of many angels** round about the throne and **the beasts** and the elders: And the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and



thousands of thousands, Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. And <u>every creature which is in heaven</u>, and **on the earth**, and **under the earth**, and such as are **in the sea**, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Deuteronomy 32:5 They have dealt corruptly with him. They are not his children, because of their defect. They are a perverse and crooked generation.

Deuteronomy 32:6 Do you do this to יהוה, O foolish and unwise people? <u>Is He not your Father</u>, who bought you, <u>Who created</u> you and established you?

Genesis 2:4 These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth **when they were created**, *in the day* that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

<u>Psalm 89:26-29</u> He shall cry to me, <u>You are my father</u>, my God, and <u>the rock</u> of my salvation. Also I will make him my firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth. My mercy will I keep for him for ever more, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. <u>His seed also will I make to endure forever</u>, and his throne as the days of heaven.

Psalm 89:30-36 If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments, If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments, Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. Nevertheless my loving kindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure forever, and his throne as the sun before me.



Deuteronomy 32:10 He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness, he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye.

Deuteronomy 32:15-18 But <u>Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked</u>: You are waxen fat, you are grown thick, you are covered with fatness, then <u>he forsook God which made him</u>, and lightly esteemed <u>the Rock of his salvation</u>. They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger. They sacrificed to devils, not to God, to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not. <u>Of the Rock that begat you, you are unmindful</u>, and have forgotten God that formed you.

Isaiah 1:2,3 <u>Hear</u>, O heavens, and <u>give ear</u>, O earth: For the LORD has spoken, <u>I have nourished and brought up children</u>, and <u>they have rebelled against me</u>. The ox knows his owner, and the ass his master's crib: But Israel does not know, <u>my people</u> do not consider.

Zechariah 7:11-13 But they refused to listen, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear. Yes, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts has sent in his spirit by the former prophets: Therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts. Therefore it is come to pass, that as he cried, and they would not hear, so they cried, and I would not hear, said the LORD of hosts.

Jeremiah 6:16-19 Thus says the LORD, Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, Where is the good way? And walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk in it. I set watchmen over you, saying, <u>Listen to the sound of the shofar! But they said, We will not listen!</u> Therefore hear, you nations, and know, congregation, what is among them. Hear, earth! Behold, I will bring evil on this people, even the fruit of their thoughts, <u>because they have not listened to my</u> words, and as for **my law**, they have rejected it.



Deuteronomy 32:20,21 And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: For they are a very perverse generation, Children in whom is no faithfulness. They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God, They have provoked me to anger with their vanities: And I will move them to jealousy with those that are not a people, I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

Romans 10:19,20 But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses said, I will provoke you to jealousy by them that are no people, and by a foolish nation I will anger you. But Isaiah is very bold, and said, I was found of them that sought me not, I was made manifest to them that asked not after me.

Romans 11:11,12 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: But rather through their fall <u>salvation is come to the Gentiles</u>, for to provoke them to jealousy. Now if the fall of them be the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles, how much more their fullness?

Jeremiah 16:19 O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come to you from the ends of the earth, and shall say, <u>Surely our fathers have</u> inherited lies, vanity, and things wherein there is no profit.

Deuteronomy 32:26,27 I said, I would scatter them into corners, I would make the remembrance of them to cease from among men: Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, and lest they should say, <u>Our hand is high, and the LORD has not done all</u> this.

Deuteronomy 32:29 O that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end.

Deuteronomy 32:30,31 How should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, except their Rock had sold them,



and the Lord had shut them up? For their rock is not as our Rock, even our enemies themselves being judges.

Deuteronomy 32:41,42 If I <u>whet my glittering sword</u>, and my hand take hold on judgment, I will render vengeance to my enemies, and will reward them that hate me. I will make my arrows drunk with blood, and <u>my sword</u> shall devour flesh, and that with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from <u>the beginning of revenges on the enemy.</u>

Revelation 19:15 And out of his <u>mouth goes a sharp sword</u>, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the wine press of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Deuteronomy 32:43 Rejoice, O you nations, with his people: For he will avenge the blood of his servants, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful to his land, and to his people.

Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: For he has judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and has avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

Romans 15:8-12 Now I say that Messiah has been made a servant of the circumcision for the truth of God, that he might confirm the promises given to the fathers, and that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy. As it is written, Therefore will I give praise to you among the Gentiles, and sing to your name. Again he says, Rejoice, you Gentiles, with his people. Again, Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles! Let all the peoples praise him. Again, Isaiah says, There will be the root of Jesse, he who arises to rule over the Gentiles; in him the Gentiles will hope.

Deuteronomy 34:10-12 And there hath not arisen a prophet since in Israel like unto Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face, **in all the signs and the wonders**, which the LORD sent



him to do in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh, and to all his servants, and to all his land, and in all the mighty hand, and in all the great terror, which Moses wrought in the sight of all

SONG OF SONGS A RETURN TO GOD AS OUR KING

Shepherd addresses the Shulamite:

SOS 7:1 How beautiful are **thy feet with shoes,** O prince's daughter! The joints of thy thighs are like jewels, the work of the hands of a cunning workman.

Isaiah 52:7,8 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace, that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation, that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth! Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice, with the voice together shall they sing: For they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion.

Shepherd speaking to the Shulamite:

SOS 7:2-4 Thy navel is like a round goblet, which wanteth not liquor: Thy belly is like an heap of wheat set about with lilies. Thy two breasts are like two young roes that are twins. Thy neck is as a tower of ivory, thine eyes like the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bathrabbim: **Thy nose is as the tower of Lebanon** which looketh toward Damascus.

Job 27:1-3 Moreover Job continued his parable, and said, As God liveth, who hath taken away my judgment, and the Almighty, who hath vexed my soul, All the while my breath is in me, and the **spirit of God is in my nostrils**.

Hebrews 5:12-14 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God, and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For everyone that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: For he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those



who by reason of use have their **senses** exercised to **discern** both good and evil.

Shepherd Continues:

SOS 7:5-8 Thy head upon thee is like Carmel, and the hair of thy head like purple, the king is held captive in the tresses thereof. How fair and how pleasant art thou, O love, for delights! This thy stature is like to a palm tree, and thy breasts to clusters of grapes. I said, I will go up to the palm tree, I will take hold of the boughs thereof: Now also thy breasts shall be as clusters of the vine, and the **smell of thy nose like apples.**

SOS 2:3 Like an apple tree among the trees of the woods, So is my beloved among the sons. I sat down in his shade with great delight, And his fruit was sweet to my taste.

Shulamite responds:

SOS 7:9 And the roof of thy mouth like the best wine for **my beloved**, that goeth down sweetly, causing the lips of those that **are asleep to speak.**

SOS 7:10-13 <u>I am my beloved's, and his desire is toward me</u>. Come, my beloved, <u>let us go forth into the field</u>; <u>let us</u> lodge in the villages. <u>Let us get up early</u> to the vineyards, <u>let us</u> see if the vine flourish, whether **the tender grape appear**, and the pomegranates bud forth: **There** will I give thee my loves. The mandrakes give a smell, and at **our gates** are all **manner of pleasant fruits**, <u>new and old</u>, which I have laid up for thee, O my beloved.

(HHBNT) Matthew 13:52 So Yeshua told them, For this cause, every scribe who has become a trained disciple of the kingdom of heaven resembles an owner of property who brings out of his treasure storage things **new and old**.

Shulamite responds:

SOS 8:1-3 Oh, that you were like my brother, who nursed at my mother's breasts! If I should find you outside, I would kiss you, I would not be despised. I would lead you and bring you into the



house of my mother, She who used to instruct me. I would cause you to drink of spiced wine, of the juice of my pomegranate. His left hand is under my head, and his right hand embraces me.

The Shepherd speaks to DOJ:

(YLT) **SOS 8:4** I have adjured you, daughters of Jerusalem, How ye stir up, And how ye wake my love till she please!

Act VI. The Shulamite enjoys full communion with Shepherd {8:5-8:14} Total Sanctification

The Daughters of Jerusalem

SOS 8:5a Who is this <u>that cometh up **from the wilderness**</u>, Leaning upon her beloved?

Hosea 2:14,15 Therefore, behold, I will allure her, and bring her into the wilderness, and speak tenderly to her. And there, I will give her, her vineyards and make the Valley of Achor a door of hope. And there she shall answer as in the days of her youth, as at the time when she came out of the land of Egypt.

Shepherd then addresses the Shulamite:

SOS 8:5b I awakened you under **the apple tree**; there your mother travailed with you, there she travailed and bore you.

Ezekiel 16:4-8 As for your nativity, on the day you were born your navel cord was not cut, nor were you washed in water to cleanse you, you were not rubbed with salt nor wrapped in swaddling cloths. No eye pitied you, to do any of these things for you, to have compassion on you, but you were thrown out into the open field, when you yourself were loathed on the day you were born. And when I passed by you and saw you struggling in your own blood, I said to you in your blood, Live! Yes, I said to you in your blood, Live! I made you thrive like a plant in the field and you grew, matured, and became very beautiful. Your breasts were formed, your hair grew, but you were naked and bare. When I passed by you again and looked



upon you, indeed your time was the time of love so I spread My wing over you and covered your nakedness. Yes, I swore an oath to you and entered into a covenant with you, and you became Mine, says the Lord GOD.

The Shepherd urges the Shulamite in a call to action:

SOS 8:6,7 Set me as a seal upon your heart, As a seal upon your arm, For love is as strong as death, Jealousy as cruel as the grave, Its flames are flames of fire, A most vehement flame. Many waters cannot quench love, nor can the floods drown it. If a man would give for love all the wealth of his house, it would be utterly despised.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Deuteronomy 6:10-15 So it shall be, when the LORD your God brings you into the land of which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you large and beautiful cities which you did not build, houses full of all good things, which you did not fill, hewn-out wells which you did not dig, vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant-when you have eaten and are full- then beware, lest you forget the LORD who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage. You shall fear the LORD your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name. You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who are all around you (for the LORD your God is a jealous God among you), lest the anger of the LORD your God be aroused against you and destroy you from the face of the earth.



The Shulamite responds:

SOS 8:8 We have a little sister, And she has no breasts. What shall we do for our sister in the day when she is spoken for?

The Shepherd answers:

Song 8:9 If she is a wall, We will build upon her a battlement of silver, And if she is a door, We will enclose her with boards of cedar.

1 Samuel 25:15,16 But the men were very good to us, and we were not hurt, nor did we miss anything as long as we accompanied them, when we were in the fields. They were a wall to us both by night and day, all the time we were with them keeping the sheep.

Proverbs 26:14 As a door turns on its hinges, So does the lazy man on his bed.

The Shulamite responds:

SOS 8:10 <u>I am a wall</u>, And my breasts like towers, Then I became in his eyes As one who found peace.

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

SOS 8:11,12 Solomon had a vineyard at Baal Hamon, He leased the vineyard to keepers, Everyone was to bring for its fruit a thousand silver coins. My own vineyard is before me. You, O Solomon, may have a thousand, And those who tend its fruit two hundred.

1 Samuel 8:14-17 And he will take the best of your fields, your vineyards, and your olive groves, and give them to his servants. He will take a tenth of your grain and your vintage, and give it to his officers and servants. And he will take your male servants, your female servants, your finest young men, and your donkeys,



and put them to his work. He will take a tenth of your sheep. And you will be his servants.

The Shepherd reminds the Shulamite:

SOS 8:13 You who <u>dwell in the gardens</u>, The companions listen for your voice- **Let me hear it!**

SOS 2:14 O my dove, in the clefts of the rock, In the secret places of the cliff, Let me see your face, **Let me hear your voice**, For your voice is sweet, And your face is lovely.

Shulamite responds:

SOS 8:14 Make haste, my beloved, And be like a gazelle Or a young stag on the mountains of spices.

Micah 4:2 Many nations shall come and say, Come, and let us go up **to the mountain of the LORD,** To the house of the God of Jacob, He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths. For out of Zion the law shall go forth, And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
